NY T-5 states LOMBARDO has acted for MICHAEL COPPOLA on many occasions. NY T-6 states LOMBARDO has been an "acting boss" in NY for COPPOLA since COPPOLA's incarceration. SUBJECT SHOULD BE CONSIDERED POSSIBLY ARMED AND DANGEROUS AS HE IS BELIEVED TO HAVE PRACTICED TARGET SHOOTING.

Subject and COPPOLA met and engaged in conversation with JOE MASSEI on the sidewalk in front of MASSEI's office, 212 23rd Street, Miami Beach, Florida. It was previously reported that subject and STRETCH, who is JOSEPH ANTHONY STRACI, Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) number 72208, were possible involved in a real estate transaction in Cape Canaveral, Florida. In connection with this, the following information was obtained on the dates indicated: On November 30, 1962, NY T-2 advised that he had learned in Miami Beach, Florida, that JOSEPH STRACI and trying to obtain some land in the Cocoa Beach area. It was the impression of the informant that STRACI had been in Miami Beach and had been to Cocoa Beach to look over the area. On December 6, 1962, NY T-2 stated that STRACI and an individual known as Detroit had been in Florida and they were looking for investment possiblities, but were doing so very quietly. NY T-2 added that "a number of the boys," not further identified, had been in and out of Cocoa Beach looking over the area, but as yet an investment has not been made.

NY T-2 stated that he has not heard subject's name mentioned in the above conversation concerning real estate investments in Florida.

On December 20, 1962, Clerk, Brevard County Clerks Office, Titusville, Florida, advised SA that she could not locate any identifiable reference to subject in the official records of the above county.

As previously reported, subject met and conversed with an unknown individual on March 15, 1962, who was driving a Cadillac automobile with Illinois license plate number 755241. The following interview was conducted with WILLIAM H. JOSEPH who stated that he is the owner of a 1962 Cadillac with Illinois license plate number 755241.

Mr. WILLIAM H. JOSEPH voluntarily appeared at the Chicago Office for interview on November 1, 1962. He advised that his full name is WILLIAM HENRY JOSEPH and that he has been known by the nickname of JOEY JOSEPH since childhood. He advised that he presently resides at 7002 North Sheidan Road, Chicago, and has resided there for the past 25 years with his brothers, MEYER JOSEPH and BENJAMIN JOSEPH, who is now deceased.

Mr. JOSEPH advised that he traveled to Miami, Florida, sometime in December, 1961, in his 1962 Cadillac automobile bearing 1962 Illinois license 755241. He explained that although he owns this automobile, he seldom drives due to his age and in this instance he was driven to Florida by

He said that to the best of his recollection, he

He said that to the best of his recollection, he departed the Miami, Florida, area in about the latter part of February, 1962. Mr. JOSEPH said that while in the Miami area, he met MICHAEL COPPOLA at an Amvets Post on the beach near 21st and Liberty Streets, where he frequently went to play cards. He claimed that although he knew COPPOLA, he did not know anything of COPPOLA's business interests or activities. He said that the only place he saw COPPOLA was at the above mentioned Amvets Post.

Mr. JOSEPH stated that he does not know or to his knowledge has never heard of ANTHONY SALERNO. He said that he did not recall seeing an individual by this name at the Amvets Post in Miami where he met COPPOLA. Mr. JOSEPH further stated that he did not meet with anyone in a park in the Miami area and that it must have been someone else who met with SALERNO in Miami on or about February 13, 1962. Mr. JOSEPH said that he did not drive his 1962 Cadillac while in the Miami area and to his knowledge did not loan the car to anyone while they were there. He further advised that his brother, MEYER, traveled to Florida with him; however, his brother does not drive an automobile due to his heart condition and that his brother remained with relatives throughout their stay in the Miami area.

Mr. JOSEPH said that while in Miami, he resided at the Gamshire Apartments which are located near 21st and Washington Streets, Miami. He said that his activities in Miami consisted of playing cards at the Amvets Post mentioned above and visiting the race tracks. He said that while in Miami, he usually goes to the Tropical Park Race Track as he is not allowed on the track at Hialeah. He said; however, that he occasionally sneaks on the track at Hialeah on big days when there is a large crowd in attendance.

Concerning himself, Mr. JOSEPH advised that for approximately the past 40 years, he has made his living through bookmaking, touting horses and placing his own bets. He denied that he is presently engaged in bookmaking and said he has not been so engaged for approximately 15 years. He said he presently makes his living on placing his own bets at the track and an occasional touting of horses. He said that several years ago he had operated a horse book in the Chicago area with one JOE GLEASON and one NELLIS GOLDSMITH, both of whom are now deceased. He claimed several arrests for gambling and bookmaking in the Chicago area pror to 15 years ago, but stated that he had never served any time in connection with these arrests.

Concerning the Chicago hoodlum element, Mr. JOSEPH advised that he has always tried to avoid any contact with these individuals because he prefers to operate on his own. He said that he knows of GUS ALEX only by reputation and through what he has read in local newspapers. He stated that he has never operated a horse book or engaged in any other activities in an association with the hoodlum element in Chicago.


