In deal, church avoids prospect of indictment

The Catholic Archdiocese of Boston, in an effort to avoid a federal indictment, has reached an unprecedented agreement with the US government that will require intensive scrutiny of local priests who seek to work as federal chaplains and will obligate the archdiocese to repeatedly assess the effectiveness of its child-protection programs.

The agreement, the first in the nation between a Catholic diocese and a federal prosecutor, settles an allegation by US Attorney Michael J. Sullivan that in 1999 the admin-

istration of Cardinal Bernard F. Law misled the federal government about the background of a priest of the archdiocese who had been hired as a military chaplain. The federal government says the priest was an accused child abuser; the archdiocese disputes that description.

The decision by both sides to settle the case spares the scandal-wracked Catholic Church from the public-relations damage of a federal criminal indictment against a Catholic diocese.

But the settlement marks a significant concession by the church, which is protected by the US Constitution from most forms of government oversight, in agreeing to give federal officials a say in how the archdiocese trains its employees and in requiring the archdiocese to report publicly assessments of its programs.

"I think we've achieved a much greater good by entering into an agreement that addresses some of the misconduct from the past and will prevent children from being victimized in the future," Sullivan said in an interview yesterday. "No matter what we do in terms of prosecutions, we'll never be able to make whole those people who have been victimized by priests. But, it's really their courage that got us to the point where we're at."

The archdiocese said it was pleased to have avoided criminal or civil charges. "The archdiocese has consistently maintained that there was no basis for a criminal prosecution," the archdiocese said in a statement. "By reaching a resolution and avoiding a prolonged and costly dispute, we can devote our energies and resources toward the advancement of our goal of protecting children and fulfilling the church's mission in this archdiocese."

The federal investigation stemmed from the church's handling of the case of the Rev. William J. Scanlan, an archdiocesan priest who went on to serve as a military chaplain. His secret archdiocesan personnel file included a note with an anonymous allegation that the priest had "fooled around with kids" while working at a home for troubled adolescent boys and an evaluation from an intern at a psychiatric facility who said Scanlan had become infatuated with a boy at the home.

Sullivan said that his investigation, which began in 2004, is complete and that he does not intend to indict Law or Bishop William F. Murphy.

"Unless there is a breach of this agreement, this investigation is concluded, and we're not anticipating bringing any charges," he said.

"We did not have any evidence to indicate Cardinal Law had committed any crime during the period in which we were investigating," Sullivan said. "He was obviously the leader of the archdiocese, and any leader has to take responsibility for the conduct of the organization."

Neither lawyers for Law and Murphy nor a spokesman for Murphy returned phone calls and e-mails seeking comment.

Law was the archbishop of Boston from 1984 until he resigned in 2002 over criticism of his failure to remove abusive priests from ministry; he was later appointed by Pope John Paul II to oversee a prominent basilica, St. Mary Major, in Rome.

Murphy was Law's top aide and signed the document that was part of a background investigation conducted by the government after Scanlan was hired as chaplain; in 2001, Murphy was named by the pope to oversee the diocese of Rockville Center, in Long Island, N.Y.

Both Law and Murphy testified last year before a federal grand jury investigating the case. Bishop John B. McCormack of New Hampshire, a former top official of the Boston Archdiocese, testified as a witness, but was never a target of the investigation, according to his lawyer, Joseph L. Doherty.

Under the agreement, the archdiocese promised to provide detailed background on all priests who currently serve or who in the future apply to serve as chaplains in the military, in the federal prison system, or in Veterans Affairs facilities. The archdiocese has 15 priests serving with the active military, and 22 authorized by the church to serve as chaplains with the reserves or National Guard.

The archdiocese also agreed to report any suspected violations of federal child abuse and child exploitation laws to federal authorities. That requirement is in addition to the archdiocese's obligation, imposed by the Legislature since the abuse crisis, to report suspected child abuse to state

authorities.

The federal government will have the right to review and approve the archdiocese's proposed program for training employees to report federal crimes, according to the agreement.

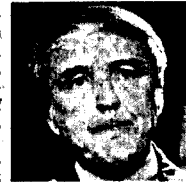
In addition, the archdiocese agreed to continue to audit parishes and schools for implementation of child protection programs and to finance a committee of specialists to study the effectiveness of child protection programs. The archdiocese will be required to report publicly on its efforts to improve child protection policies every six months for three years, starting in May.

The archdiocese agreed to a two-year waiver of the statute of limitations; if the church does not implement the agreement within that period, the federal government can then prosecute the case.

Archbishop Sean P. O'Malley, who was not an official of the archdiocese at the time of the alleged crime, carefully considered church-state implications of the agreement

before signing it, according to lawyer Michael K. Fee, who represented the archdiocese. O'Malley came to the conclusion that the agreement puts in writing practices underway at the archdiocese or practices that he thinks are desirable for the church's health.

"We do not have in this agreement any intrusion into the operations of the archdiocese or the decision-making of the archbishop, and we really believe there is not a constitutional violation or an intrusion into the sovereignty of the archbishop," said Fee. "The agreement, in large part, continues the implementation of policies to which the archdiocese is already committed."

Sullivan said the federal government was also cautious about the constitutional implications of the agreement. "We're not going to monitor a religious institution," he said. "We're going to ensure that they're in compliance with regard to the agreement."

A former state prosecutor who teaches criminal law at Boston College said the archdiocese benefits by avoiding an indictment and trial, even if the church believes it could have won in court.

"The church very much wants to put this whole abuse incident behind it," said R. Michael Cassidy, associate professor of law at BC. "It is important for the church's fund-raising and its membership, and had there been protracted litigation for two years, that would be two more years that the Archdiocese of Boston could not begin to heal from this."

But some victim advocates were disappointed that Sullivan did not pursue what would have been the first federal case stemming from the abuse scandal.

"Federal prosecution is the one thing that hasn't been tried, and deals like this [between dioceses and other prosecutors] don't seem to have deterred the criminal behavior within the church hierarchy," said David Clohessy of the Survivors Network of Those Abused by Priests. "But it is encouraging to finally see some federal intervention."

Mitchell Garabedian, a lawyer who has represented multiple abuse victims, said Sullivan should have insisted on greater independence for people who would be appointed, under the agreement, to audit the church's child protection programs.

In a list of allegations released yesterday, Sullivan said that in 1999 a bishop had "falsely certified" to the federal government, which was conducting a routine background check on Scanlan after he had been hired as chaplain, that the archdiocese had no adverse information about the priest. Sullivan did not name the bishop, but the Globe has previously identified him as Murphy, based on review of the document.

Sullivan alleged that the archdiocese violated a law that prohibits making false statements in matters over which the federal government has jurisdiction.

The archdiocese disputes the allegations made by Sullivan, pointing out that the information in the file was anonymous, secondhand, and nonspecific.

"The archdiocese does not believe that any federal crime was committed in connection with the posting of this priest to service in the Veterans Affairs chaplaincy," Fee said. "At the time this priest entered federal service, not a single person had come forward and complained that they had been abused by the priest."

Scanlan was accused in 2000 of having abused a young woman years earlier; an archdiocesan review board found the allegation to be unsubstantiated. Scanlan is now retired and unassigned; he could not be located for comment yesterday.

For Law and Bulger, it's about power

THE STORIES of the cardinal who protected sexually predatory priests and the university president who protected a violent gangster brother boiled over in a poisonous brew last week. It was ugly, that's for sure.

But the ugliness surrounding Cardinal Bernard Law and University of Massachusetts president William Bulger is well worth pondering, no matter how much it hurts the eyes or turns the stomach. In it lie truths about the past — and lessons for the future.

Law and Bulger each chose family — the family of priests in Law's case, a brother in Bulger's — over victims and their families. Each defined loyalty in the narrowest, most parochial way, as in loyalty to an individual rather than to a higher authority, be it to

God or the rule of law. Each used love as an excuse to coddle wrongdoers and, indeed, to protect criminals from the consequences of their alleged crimes.

Law and Bulger each chose a path; each is responsible for the path he chose. But those decisions did not happen in a vacuum. They were made with a certain understanding of the local culture — its love of power, its tolerance for moral corruption amongst the powerful, and its willingness to keep silent about it.

The Rev. James D. Foley, the priest who fathered two children with a woman who later died of a drug overdose after going to bed with him, put the understanding in writing. In a 1994 letter to Bishop John McCormack, a top aide to Law, Foley asked: "How can the

church suffer scandal from an episode that will never possibly be revealed? Who will reveal it? The cardinal?"

Foley could not envision circumstances that would lead to the headline published last week on the front page of The Boston Globe: "Cleric had 2 children, kept status." And it is safe to assume that up until a year ago, Law could not envision such circumstances either — not because people did not know, but because he was confident people would not talk.

No one on the inside would talk; and no one on the outside would ever have enough standing to get legitimate attention and generate outrage. That was the underlying assumption with every predatory priest the cardinal protected, and with every sexual

abuse victim he ignored.

To know this city is to know its strongest allegiance is not to truth, or even to money. It is to power and access to the powerful. Very few men or women are willing to speak up against wrongdoing, as long as the wrongdoer retains power, through access to other powerful people.

Over the past year, Law's power was stripped, headline by headline. Finally sensing weakness, his fellow powerbrokers turned on him. Now the power-worshipping crew that once lined up to pay him homage at his annual garden party is scattered. But it stands ready, at the drop of a cardinal's hat, to line up to kiss his successor's ring.

The powerbrokers have not turned en masse against Bulger.

The former Senate president appeared last week before a congressional committee investigating the FBI's relationship with his fugitive brother James "Whitey" Bulger.

After being summoned by subpoena, William Bulger cited his rights under the constitution and refused to answer any questions about Whitey, who is accused of murdering 22 men and women. Afterwards, University of Massachusetts trustees expressed confidence in their president; and Grace Fey, chair of the UMass board, praised him for showing "dignity and courage."

The city's political, business and academic power barons are mostly quiet in the aftermath of Friday's dramatic showdown. But there are some welcome cracks in the old Boston order that for so long protected Bulger from awkward questions about his decision to choose his lawless brother over the law.

Governor-elect Mitt Romney said he was "disappointed" that Bulger did not answer the committee's questions, adding, "I hope some way can be found to provide the committee with the information it requires." Stephen P. Lynch, the congressman from South Boston, declared, "This is not a political game of settling old scores. It's an honest, thoughtful and diligent pursuit of the truth. . . People want to know the truth."

Some people may want to know the truth, but, in this town, until the truth strips power from the powerful, most people are happy to ignore it. In the meantime, the old Boston is not going gently. As it fights for survival, it clings to power in the highest sanctums of church and state.

Bulger slips off moral high ground in Law rebuke

He was among the small circle of ultra high-octane Boston Catholics who answered a distress call from their cardinal in February.

According to one prominent Catholic who attended the Feb. 19 meeting, the gentleman who did not hesitate to lay a grim prognosis in Law's lap was the guy who sat next to him — UMass President William M. Bulger.

"I can recall Bulger going on about how devastating the PR was," said one source, who spoke under a grant of anonymity. "Law had this look on his face, as if he couldn't grasp Bulger's urgency as to how bad everything looked."

"When Bulger asked Law how deep the issue went," the gentleman recalled, "Law said something about pedophilia being no different in the priesthood than the rest of society at large. It was pretty obvious, to just about everyone in the room, that Bulger wasn't buying it. Oh, yeah, I'd say he (Bulger) was pretty animated."

"I saw the account in the paper, where Bulger is quoted telling Law that (the priest sex abuse scandal) was a disaster. I don't have a specific recollection of him using that word. But it's possible, because like I said, Bulger was more animated than the rest of us."

Infinitely more animated, no doubt, than he was two weeks ago in a downtown courtroom, when silence was Billy's response to a pending disaster. Talk about the pot calling the kettle

Without taking a thing away from the scandal Law helped to enable and perpetuate, Billy Bulger has got to be the last person on the face of the universe to reach for a pebble, to say nothing of lobbing moral stones.

Perhaps if Bernard Law had been raised closer to where the late Cardinal Cushing came from — those Southie streets where Whitey Bulger unleashed 30 years of physical and sexual abuse — our fallen cardinal might've been able to put Billy in his place with a simple: "You've got some nerve."

There is no small amount of symmetry between a disgraced cardinal who protected predatory priests by shuffling them throughout his archdiocese and a former Senate President who protected his predatory gangster brother by making sure Whitey was shuffled into the protective embrace of a morally bankrupt FBI agent. "You know, when I think about all that's happened since we met that day at the chancery," the source said, "I'm kind of blown away by the sad irony of it all."

"In the end, I'd have to call both these men, Law and Bulger, enablers," he said. "I think of them both as unfinished men. For all of their so-called intellect, they are not nearly as smart as they would have you believe." Enabler? Lately, plenty of people have used harsher words to describe the role the cardinal and the UMass president played in their respective disasters. Words like co-conspirator come to mind.

Actually, it's perfectly appropriate that Billy Bulger would become visibly outraged at someone of the cardinal's rank being run over by an express train of bad press. After all, the single thread linking both their sagas is control.

Likewise, in the halls of the State House or the gin joints of Southie, you don't get to rule as the Bulger brothers once did without controlling everyone and everything.

Ultimately, my source did not know what advice, if any, Billy Bulger gave to Bernard Law. It's hard to imagine Billy ever urging Law to fall on his crosier. Then again, Billy wasn't stuck with some 150,000 pages of sex crimes and twisted desires. He doesn't have to worry about rebel priests, or an empowered laity.

Yes, there's at least 21 people we know Whitey killed. There's the fortune he made moving drugs and breaking legs. Yes, there's the unethical legal advice Billy gave his fugitive brother to stay out on the lam. You know, if a cop should die trying to take Whitey in, Billy will play Pontius Pilate.

But for now, Billy has been blessed with something the cardinal did not have: sheep masquerading as a board of trustees.

In time, however, they may grow as sick and tired as the pope.

Law made Dallas trip on Minor's private jet

The night before he was scheduled to board an American Airlines flight for the bishops' conference last Wednesday, Cardinal Bernard Law suddenly shelved that plan and told confidants he was taking a private jet owned by Biloxi lawyer Paul Minor's company instead.

With memories still fresh of Law's secret trip to Rome in April for a private meeting with Pope John Paul II, reporters pressed Donna Morrissey, Law's spokeswoman, for details on the switch when Law failed to show up for the scheduled flight. Morrissey said Law had accepted the invitation of a friend, whom she declined to identify, to use his plane for the trip.

Minor acknowledged this week that he had offered the use of the plane to Law because of longstanding ties between the cardinal and his family. The plane, a Falcon-10 turbojet, is registered to a Mississippi corporation, Gulf Aire II Inc., of which Minor is president.

Minor's father, W.E. "Bill" Minor, a former political columnist with the New Orleans Times-Picayune, and Law have

been longtime friends.

"I knew there was going to be a lot of media following the cardinal to and from Dallas, and I thought it might make it a little easier on him if he could get there without cameras poking at him at every step," Minor said.

Law and Bill Minor met in the late 1950s when Law moved to Jackson for one of his first assignments as a priest. Both men were advocates of human rights, working to improve race relations, and quickly formed a bond, Paul Minor said.

Law, Paul Minor said, provided solace to his family when they were targets of violence during that time.

Although Minor did not divulge the precise cost of making the plane available to Law, it was much higher than the \$300 to \$500 coach ticket that he would have paid had he flown on American Airlines. An executive for Jet Aviation of America, which charters private planes, said it would cost about \$20,000

to lease a similar plane for the round-trip flight between Boston and Dallas.

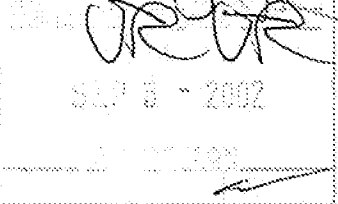
Law's chief secretary, the Rev. John J. Connolly, accompanied him on the private flight.

Law's whereabouts since he left Dallas on Saturday remain a mystery.

Minor said that while he had not met with Law, he expected the cardinal to spend some time in Mississippi meeting with old friends, including Bill Minor. He said he did not know Law's exact schedule and that he didn't think Law had stopped in South Mississippi.

Bill Minor on Tuesday said he had spoken to Law by telephone and hopes to meet with him in Jackson.
