In view of the upcoming demonstrations scheduled for Washington, D. C., in May, 1971, there is a fast developing situation wherein the Northern Virginia area will most probably be used as a staging area for some of the activities in Washington, D. C. Most probably the demonstrations would be opened with a large rock concert in the Northern Virginia area and it is anticipated that some participants will camp out in the Northern Virginia area. In view of these developments, Alexandria will remain alert for potential counterintelligence situations and keep the Bureau advised.

. 1. Potential Counterintelligence Action:

Alexandria Division currently has under investigation a commune known as "Americong" (Bufile: 62-112252) located at 1531 North 18th Street, Arlington, Virginia. Investigation has determined the owner of the building where this commune is located is Arlington, Virginia, Arlington, Virginia, It is reported that originally furnished the house at 1531 North 18th Street to the St. Charles Roman Catholic Church in Arlington, without charge, so that it could be used for youth programs. The building was, in fact, used for youth programs until approximately a year ago when the individual in charge of youth programs for the church was reassigned to another area. After that "hippies" moved in and the building has been used by various individuals since that time and is now the residence for the Americong.

Alexandria will develop background information on and if he appears to be an upright citizen, Alexandria will submit a letter to the Bureau recommending he be interviewed to determine if he is cognizant of the purpose for which his building is now being used and further to determine if he would consider evicting the residents.

Alexandria is currently attempting to uncover financial irregularities in the support of this group and will submit its recommendations under a separate cover.
