2. A letter sent to the U. S. State Department in October, 1962, signed by "[redacted]" This letter alleges irregularities in the FBI in Chicago.
3. Letter sent to Special Agent [redacted], FBI, Chicago, on August 8, 1961, signed "[redacted]"

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The style of type on the typewriter used in the preparation of these documents conforms to Royal pica type which is foreign made for use on Royalite and Dart portable typewriters. This style of type is possibly used on other machines.

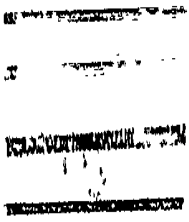
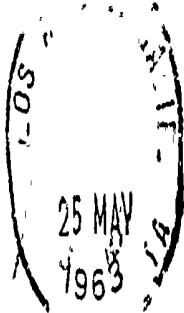
Sir;
