In accordance with the Bureau's instructions, one recent cancellation was noted on that list. A separate sheet of paper has been prepared and attached to that list showing the four individuals who have been added to the Minneapolis security index list since the preparation of the Bureau statistics. Also, five memorandums have been enclosed relating to various other discrepancies noted. Two of these memorandums relate to cases where the security index card was cancelled in 1948, two relate to cases where the security index card has been transferred to another division and one relates to a case where the subject has been recently transferred to the Minneapolis Division.

As to organizational affiliations, three discrepancies were discovered and noted on the list. Six form 122's relative to discrepancies in the DETCOM tabbing are being submitted herewith, as well as similar forms for twenty other discrepancies relative to names or birth data of various security index card subjects.



SUBJECT: GENERAL SUSPECT LIST

Under date of October 20, 1949, of the Internal Security Section requested that the Liaison Section obtain the Air Force "grab list" inasmuch as it had come to his attention that the Air Force had a list of some 268 cases on civilian employees who were under investigation for Communist activities. In this connection, the Director had inquired whether these individuals are on the Bureau's Security Index list.

GENERAL

, OSI, advised that the Air Force does not have a grab list as such but stated that a list of civilian employees connected with the Air Force against whom preventive measures should be taken in the case of an emergency is presently being prepared. The Bureau will be furnished a copy of this list when completed in order that the Air Force may be advised of the names of individuals on the list against whom the Bureau plans action in the case of an emergency. In this manner the Air Force will know the names of those with whom the Air Force must deal in the case of an emergency. advised that this action is in accordance with decisions made at a recent Interdepartmental Intelligence Conference.

Special Agent _____, of the New York Office, has submitted a suggestion that in Security case files, a card be attached to the inside of the top of the file jacket, giving an abstract of the information appearing therein, especially as to the various administrative steps which have been taken in connection with the case. He suggests that this abstract card contain:

1. Name and aliases.
2. Classification.
3. File Number
4. Date individual made top functionary.
5. Date individual made Key Figure and Bureau advised.
6. Date Security Index Card authorized by Bureau.
7. Whether photograph obtained and date of photograph.
8. Whether handwriting obtained and whether amount adequate.
9. Whether description obtained and date of last description.

Special Agent _____ points out that this would be of great assistance to agents reviewing the file, especially where the files are voluminous and consist of several sections.

A review of Special Agent _____ memorandum would indicate that he is well versed and understands the administrative problem and investigative techniques of Security investigations. His suggestion further appears to have value, especially with regard to the older files containing volumes of information and serials. However, to institute such a procedure in the various case files would conceivably result in a very large project for the field, consuming much valuable time by agents assigned to Security work which could otherwise be used in actual investigations. In view of the time which would be consumed in the preparation of such abstract sheets and the difficulty in keeping such sheets in a current status, it is not believed desirable that such a system be authorized.

ACTION:

In view of the well considered grounds for the suggestion, you may desire to present this matter at the Executive Conference.
