

PRESSMAN has known DAN ROSTENKOWSKI for approximately twenty-five years. Their relationship is a personal one that began when they both owned vacation homes in a small community in Wisconsin. Their wives were also friends and PRESSMAN's daughter babysat for ROSTENKOWSKI'S children on occasion.



Through the years PRESSMAN has received a variety of gifts from ROSTENKOWSKI. Most of these gifts have been commemorative items signifying an event or occasion in ROSTENKOWSKI's career. These include a commemorative book on ROSTENKOWSKI'S life that was issued when he became Chairman of the House of Representatives Ways and Means Committee. also recived a book on the U.S. Congress. PRESSMAN remembers receiving a pair of cufflinks that commemorated some occasion, but he believes he lost these. PRESSMAN may have also received a commemorative plate, but he does not recall for what occasion or if he still has it. PRESSMAN never received a chair from ROSTENKOWSKI.
