





AS THE BUREAU IS AWARE, A CONSIDERABLE AMOUNT OF INVESTIGATION IN THE MATTER HAS BEEN CONDUCTED BY AND THROUGH THE EFFORTS OF THE CHICAGO DIVISION. MUCH OF THE INFORMATION AND EVIDENCE DEVELOPED BY CHICAGO HAS BEEN USED IN STRUCTURING THE INDICTMENT AND WILL BE UTILIZED AT TRIAL. WMFO APPRECIATES THE ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT OF THE CHICAGO OFFICE IN ITS EXPEDITIOUS HANDLING OF AN EXTREMELY SENSITIVE INVESTIGATION. TIME AND TIME AGAIN CHICAGO HAS BEEN CALLED UPON TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE UNDER DIFFICULT SITUATIONS WITH **b**6 UNREALISTIC TIME CONSTRAINTS. THE RESULTS OF THESE EFFORTS ARE EVIDENT AND CHICAGO'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE INVESTIGATION IS COMMENDABLE. THE EFFORTS OF SA AND SSA [ARE NOTEWORTHY AS THEY HAVE BEEN INSTRUMENTAL IN ORGANIZING AND COORDINATING THE CHICAGO PORTION OF THIS INVESTIGATION.
