CBS Reporter Schorr Accredited by Reds 36

MOSCOW, Dec. 14 (AP)—The press department of the Soviet Ministry of Foreign Affairs today granted accreditation to Daniel Schorr of New York City as a permanent correspondent for the Columbia Broadcasting System here.

This raised the permanent U. S. news corps here to nine. Schorr is the first permanent CBS correspondent here since 1947. He came to Moscow Sept. 5 on a two weeks' visa which has been extended.

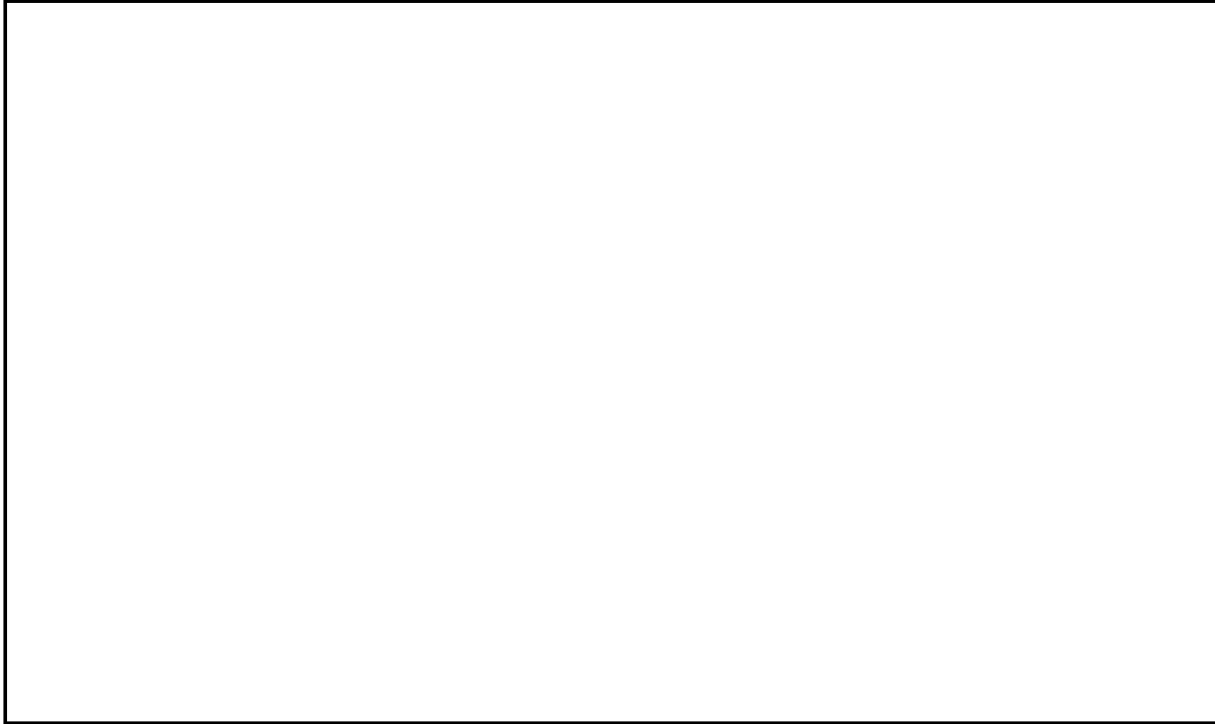
