Overview of Deputy Director McCabe's Recusal Related To Dr. McCabe's Campaign for Political Office

NOTE TO FBI EXECUTIVES: The purpose of this document is to provide FBI executive management with a factual basis by which to inform discussions with employees or interested parties in the community.

This document is not for distribution, either internally or externally.

Executive Summary

On Monday, October 24, 2016, the Wall Street Journal published a front page story that detailed Deputy Director Andrew McCabe's recusal from matters that may have presented an actual or potential conflict-of-interest while his wife, Dr. Jill McCabe, ran for political office in Virginia.

In the story, a timeline of events draws a comparison between positions held by Andrew McCabe and the FBI's investigation into Secretary Clinton's email server. The timeline misstates when McCabe was promoted to Associate Deputy Director and makes invalid associations between the events.

Talking Points

Below is the full statement provided to *The Wall Street Journal*:

"When Jill McCabe first considered running for the state Senate seat, ADIC McCabe consulted with top FBI headquarters and field office ethics officers for guidance, including briefings on the Hatch Act, to prevent against any actual or potential conflict-of-interest, in the event she decided to go forward. When she chose to run, ADIC McCabe and FBI lawyers implemented a system of recusal from all FBI investigative matters involving Virginia politics, a process followed for the remainder of her campaign. During the campaign, he played no role, attended no events, and did not participate in fundraising or support of any kind. Months after the completion of her campaign, then-Associate Deputy Director McCabe was promoted to Deputy, where, in that position, he assumed for the first time, an oversight role in the investigation into Secretary Clinton's emails."

Frequently Asked Questions

Did Andrew McCabe have any oversight of the investigation into Secretary Clinton's email server while his wife was running for political office?

No. The FBI investigation into Secretary Clinton's email server began in July 2015 after a referral was received by the Intelligence Community Inspector General. At that time, Andrew McCabe served as the Assistant Director in Charge of the Washington Field Office and had no oversight of the investigation. Jill McCabe lost the election on Nov. 3, 2015. It was not until he assumed the position of Deputy Director in February 2016 that he had oversight of the investigation, well after her political campaign had concluded.

Did he recuse himself from any matters involving politics in Virginia?

Yes. From the first contemplation that his wife would run for office in Virginia, then-ADIC McCabe sought out and consulted with ethics officers, which included briefings on the Hatch Act. Once Jill McCabe decided to seek office, there was a system of recusal put in place to prevent any real or potential conflicts of interest. This system was adhered to throughout Jill McCabe's campaign for office.

It was not until months after Jill McCabe's campaign had ended that Andrew McCabe first entered a role in which he assumed an oversight role in the investigation into Secretary Clinton's email server. Prior to that point in February 2016, McCabe was not in a position that required a recusal in that investigation as he had no oversight of it.

Did he provide any support to his wife's campaign?

No. Then-ADIC McCabe played no role, attended no events and did not participate in fundraising or support of any kind.

Dr. McCabe announced she planned to run for Virginia state senate in mid March 2015. Earlier that month the New York Times reported Hillary Clinton used a private e-mail server while serving as Secretary of State. In March Clinton also acknowledged using private e-mail. Is it relevant that the existence of Secretary Clinton's email server was reported in the same month that Dr. McCabe announced her candidacy for state senate?

No. The FBI was not conducting an investigation regarding Secretary Clinton in March 2015. Four months later in July 2015 the State Department Inspector General made a referral to the FBI for investigation. The allegation centered on the possibility Clinton had classified e-mail on her personal system. At the time of the referral Mr. McCabe was serving as ADIC at WFO and was not supervising the Clinton investigation.

While at WFO did Mr. McCabe provide assistance to the Clinton investigation?

After the referral was made, FBI Headquarters asked the Washington Field Office for personnel to conduct a special investigation. McCabe was serving as ADIC and provided personnel resources. However, he was not told what the investigation was about. In February 2016 McCabe became Deputy Director and began overseeing the Clinton investigation.

Dear Deputy Director McCabe:

News accounts have raised questions about a potential conflict of interest related to donations from the political action committee (PAC) of Virginia Governor Terry McAuliffe, a longtime fundraiser for the Clintons, to the state Senate campaign of your wife, Dr. Jill McCabe. ¹

According to reports, Governor McAuliffe and others met with you and your wife on March 7, 2015,² five days after it was publicly revealed that Secretary Clinton used a personal email account to conduct government business as secretary of state.³ At the time, you served as Assistant Director in Charge of the FBI's Washington Field Office. The FBI has released a public statement that when your wife considered running for the Senate of Virginia, you "consulted with top FBI headquarters and field office ethics officers for guidance, including briefings on the Hatch Act, to prevent against any actual or potential conflict-of-interest, in the event she decided to go forward."

In the spring and summer of 2015, the FBI interacted with multiple agencies regarding Secretary Clinton's emails. In April or May 2015, Under Secretary of State for Management Patrick Kennedy began contacting officials in the FBI's National Security Branch, which you headed prior to serving as head of the Washington Field Office.⁵ Under Secretary Kennedy

pressured FBI officials to reverse a decision regarding an email deemed by the FBI to contain classified information.⁶ The email was included in a batch of documents released pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act on May 22, 2015.

In June 2015, the Office of the Inspector General of the Intelligence Community (IC IG) learned that classified information was not redacted in one of the emails released by the State Department on May 22, and that classified information was therefore outside the control of the U.S. government.⁷

On June 25, 2015, IC IG Charles McCullough reportedly contacted an FBI official running the National Counterintelligence and Security Center to report the matter. The Director of the Center is William Evanina, a former Assistant Special Agent in Charge of the Washington Field Office who, like you, had also served in the FBI's National Security Branch. Mr. McCullough was advised to make a referral to the FBI's National Security Branch in accordance with 50 U.S.C. § 3381(e), which requires that the FBI be advised immediately of any information which indicates classified information is being, or may have been, disclosed in an unauthorized manner to a foreign power or an agent of a foreign power.

On July 6, 2015, Mr. McCullough referred the matter to the FBI.¹¹ Four days later, the FBI opened its investigation, ¹² reportedly after discussions between Director Comey and National Security Branch Executive Assistant Director John Giacalone, your successor in that position. ¹³ On July 30, 2015, the FBI announced your promotion from the Washington Field Office to the position of Associate Deputy Director, ¹⁴ a role you served in until February 1, 2016. ¹⁵

Between September 30 and October 29, 2015, Governor McAuliffe's PAC Common Good VA donated \$450,000 to your wife's state senate campaign, ¹⁶ while the Democratic Party of Virginia made additional in-kind contributions totaling \$207,788. ¹⁷ Much of that money was raised by McAuliffe following a June 26, 2015, Fairfax, Virginia fundraiser headlined by former Secretary Clinton. ¹⁸ Some of the money raised from Clinton associates, such as Doug Band ¹⁹ and Robert Johnson, was donated prior to the commencement of the FBI's investigation. ²⁰ However, a significant amount was donated after the FBI had initiated its investigation and begun meeting with Secretary Clinton's attorneys in August 2015. ²¹

The FBI stated it was not until you were promoted to the position of Deputy Director that you "assumed for the first time... an oversight role in the investigation into Secretary Clinton's emails."²² There are outstanding questions, however, regarding a possible conflict of interest in this case. To address those questions, please provide the following documents and information as soon as possible, but no later than noon on November 10, 2016:

- 1. All documents referring or relating to the ethics guidance received from the FBI regarding your wife's state senate campaign.
- 2. When you first became aware the State Department was pressuring the FBI to reverse its decision regarding the classification of one of Secretary Clinton's emails, and how you became aware, including any related documents and communications.
- 3. Whether you ever had any contact with the State Department regarding the classification of any of Secretary Clinton's emails, including any related documents and communications.
- 4. When you first became aware the FBI had opened an investigation into Secretary Clinton's email server, and how you became aware, including any related documents and communications.

 - a. The number of employees;
 - b. Their roles within the Washington Field Office; and
 - c. The support they provided.
- 6. Whether you were present for any briefings on the investigation during your tenure as Associate Deputy Director.

Responding to Committee Document Requests

- 1. In complying with this request, you are required to produce all responsive documents that are in your possession, custody, or control, whether held by you or your past or present agents, employees, and representatives acting on your behalf. You should also produce documents that you have a legal right to obtain, that you have a right to copy or to which you have access, as well as documents that you have placed in the temporary possession, custody, or control of any third party. Requested records, documents, data or information should not be destroyed, modified, removed, transferred or otherwise made inaccessible to the Committee.
- 2. In the event that any entity, organization or individual denoted in this request has been, or is also known by any other name than that herein denoted, the request shall be read also to include that alternative identification.
- 3. The Committee's preference is to receive documents in electronic form (i.e., CD, memory stick, or thumb drive) in lieu of paper productions.
- 4. Documents produced in electronic format should also be organized, identified, and indexed electronically.
- 5. Electronic document productions should be prepared according to the following standards:
 - (a) The production should consist of single page Tagged Image File ("TIF"), files accompanied by a Concordance-format load file, an Opticon reference file, and a file defining the fields and character lengths of the load file.

- 16. This request is continuing in nature and applies to any newly-discovered information. Any record, document, compilation of data or information, not produced because it has not been located or discovered by the return date, shall be produced immediately upon subsequent location or discovery.
- 17. All documents shall be Bates-stamped sequentially and produced sequentially.
- 18. Two sets of documents shall be delivered, one set to the Majority Staff and one set to the Minority Staff. When documents are produced to the Committee, production sets shall be delivered to the Majority Staff in Room 2157 of the Rayburn House Office Building and the Minority Staff in Room 2471 of the Rayburn House Office Building.

19. - 5. The term "identify," when used in a question about individuals, means to provide the following information: (a) the individual's complete name and title; and (b) the individual's business address and phone number.
- 6. The term "referring or relating," with respect to any given subject, means anything that constitutes, contains, embodies, reflects, identifies, states, refers to, deals with or is pertinent to that subject in any manner whatsoever.
- 7. The term "employee" means agent, borrowed employee, casual employee, consultant, contractor, de facto employee, independent contractor, joint adventurer, loaned employee, part-time employee, permanent employee, provisional employee, subcontractor, or any other type of service provider.

The political organization of Virginia Gov. Terry McAuliffe, an influential Democrat with longstanding ties to Bill and <u>Hillary Clinton</u>, gave nearly \$500,000 to the election campaign of the wife of an official at the Federal Bureau of Investigation who later helped oversee the investigation into Mrs. Clinton's email use.

Campaign finance records show Mr. McAuliffe's political-action committee donated \$467,500 to the 2015 state Senate campaign of Dr. Jill McCabe, who is married to Andrew McCabe, now the deputy director of the FBI.

The Virginia Democratic Party, over which Mr. McAuliffe exerts considerable control, donated an additional \$207,788 worth of support to Dr. McCabe's campaign in the form of mailers, according to the records. That adds up to slightly more than \$675,000 to her candidacy from entities either directly under Mr. McAuliffe's control or strongly influenced by him. The figure represents more than a third of all the campaign funds Dr. McCabe raised in the effort.

Mr. McAuliffe and other state party leaders recruited Dr. McCabe to run, according to party officials. She lost the election to incumbent Republican Dick Black.

A spokesman for the governor said he "supported Jill McCabe because he believed she would be a good state senator. This is a customary practice for Virginia governors... Any insinuation that his support was tied to anything other than his desire to elect candidates who would help pass his agenda is ridiculous."

Among political candidates that year, Dr. McCabe was the third-largest recipient of funds from Common Good VA, the governor's PAC, according to campaign finance records. Dan Gecker received \$781,500 from the PAC and \$214,456 from the state party for a campaign that raised \$2.9 million, according to records; and Jeremy McPike received \$803,500 from the PAC and \$535,162 from the state party, raising more \$3.8

million that year for his candidacy.

The governor could recall only one meeting with Mr. McCabe—when he and other state Democrats met with the couple on <u>March 7, 2015</u>, to urge Dr. McCabe to run, according to the spokesman.

The FBI said in a statement that during his wife's campaign Mr. McCabe "played no role, attended no events, and did not participate in fundraising or support of any kind. Months after the completion of her campaign, then-Associate Deputy Director McCabe was promoted to Deputy, where, in that position, he assumed for the first time, an oversight role in the investigation into Secretary Clinton's emails."

FBI officials said that after that meeting with the governor in Richmond on March 7, Mr. McCabe sought ethics advice from the bureau and followed it, avoiding involvement with public corruption cases in Virginia, and avoiding any campaign activity or events.

Mr. McCabe's supervision of the Clinton email case in 2016 wasn't seen as a conflict or an ethics issue because his wife's campaign was over by then and Mr. McAuliffe wasn't part of the email probe, officials said.

At the time the investigation was launched in July 2015, Mr. McCabe was running the FBI's Washington, D.C., field office, which provided personnel and resources to the Clinton email probe.

That investigation examined whether Mrs. Clinton's use of private email may have compromised national security by transmitting classified information in an insecure system. A review of Mrs. Clinton's emails concluded that 110 messages contained classified information. Mrs. Clinton has said she made a mistake but that she never sent or received messages that were marked classified.

At the end of July 2015, Mr. McCabe was promoted to FBI headquarters and assumed the No. 3 position at the agency. In February 2016, he became FBI Director James Comey's second-in-command.

As deputy director, Mr. McCabe was part of the executive leadership team overseeing the Clinton email

investigation, though Foi officials say any final decisions on that probe were made by ivir. Comey, who served as a high-ranking Justice Department official in the administration of George W. Bush.

Mr. McAuliffe has been under investigation for months by the FBI's Washington field office, a probe that includes an examination of donations made on behalf of a Chinese businessman, according to people familiar with the matter. His lawyers have denied any wrongdoing and said the investigation is seeking to determine if Mr. McAuliffe may have violated a law requiring people to register as agents of a foreign entity.

It was unclear the extent to which Mr. McCabe may have recused himself from discussions involving Mr. McAuliffe. When Mr. McCabe's wife began her campaign, he shied away from involvement in Virginia public corruption cases, according to officials.

Once the campaign was over, officials said, Mr. McCabe and FBI officials felt the potential conflict-ofinterest issues ended.

A spokesman for the governor said he "supported Jill McCabe because he believed she would be a good state senator. This is a customary practice for Virginia governors... Any insinuation that his support was tied to anything other than his desire to elect candidates who would help pass his agenda is ridiculous."

Dr. Jill McCabe was a Virginia state senate candidate in 2015. Longtime Clinton family consigliere and Virginia Gov. Terry McAuliffe, sent her approximately \$675,000 to fund the Democrat hopeful's campaign coffers. Dr. McCabe, a physician, is married to Andrew McCabe, the second in charge of the FBI. Only FBI Director James Comey outranks McCabe.

According to one FBI insider, the McAuliffe-generated campaign funds may have ultimately bought Clinton same strategic breathing room.

"McCabe was one of the few people who backed Comey's decision not to refer Hillary Clinton to the Justice Department for indictment," a FBI source said of the July decision not to refer Clinton for criminal charges for violating email and document safeguards for classified and Top Secret national security intelligence. "McCabe and Comey are both lawyers. They aren't street agents. They're more political. We wanted her (Clinton) indicted. They did not."

Gov. McAuliffe has been an important Clinton family insider for decades. During Bill Clinton's presidential candidacy and subsequent reelection, McAuliffe often spearheaded investigations into Clinton critics and helped silence women who alleged Bill Clinton harassed or sexually assaulted them, sources said.

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McAuliffe's contributions to Dr. McCabe's campaign match the exact time frame of the FBI's parallel Clinton investigation. No contributions were made prior to the FBI's probe of Clinton. McCabe was overseeing personnel decisions, including assigning agents to the Clinton investigation team, at the FBI's Washington D.C.'s field office when his wife began her 2015 campaign. His wife lost the election after spending an estimated \$1.8 million on the senate run. Three months later, Comey promoted McCabe to FBI Deputy Director in February 2016. The promotion helped fill a very large void created by the retirement of John Giacalone, who was the supervisor of the bureau's National Security Branch and also the FBI brains and genesis behind the Clinton email and private server investigation. Since the inception of the case, Giacalone had spearheaded the Clinton investigation, and helped hand select top agents who were highly skilled but also discreet. Many of those agents were concerned when Giacalone abruptly resigned in the middle of the investigation.

FBI insiders said Giacalone used the term "sideways" to describe the direction the Clinton probe had taken in the bureau. Giacalone lamented privately he no longer had confidence in the direction the investigation was headed. He felt it was simpler to quietly step aside, walk away instead of fight to keep the investigation on its proper track. Giacalone was a true heavyweight agent at FBI. In fact, he likely should have been running the entire show. His pedigree included running and creating FBI divisions in New York, Philadelphia, Washington D.C. and even serving as deputy commander in the Iraqi theater of operations. But in the midst of the Clinton investigation, Giacalone handed the bureau his retirement papers in Feb.

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Again, McAuliffe is currently under investigation by the FBI for alleged campaign-related finance infractions. However, given what we now know about McAuliffe's infiltration into the finances of state politics linked to the FBI and Clinton, it is likely the FBI's probe is little more than intelligence theater in action, absent any genuine plans to refer the governor's alleged misdeeds for an indictment.
