During the robbery the unsubs stole the victim guards' weapons, one of which was a Smith and Wesson .38 calibre, 4", revolver, SN# [redacted] and escaped in a 1979 Ford bearing New York License 582-ZCK. The unsubs escaped with over [redacted] in cash. (The latent fingerprint lifts which are being submitted for examination were obtained from this getaway car).
