

Our Las Vegas office believes it is very important to conduct simultaneous electronic surveillances of both of the above-cited sport books as previous experience has shown that the sport books will immediately alter their illegal operations when they receive information of any law enforcement attempt to gather evidence concerning their illicit telephone operations.

It is believed these affidavits set forth probable cause justification for this type of coverage pursuant to the provisions of Title III of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968.

Accordingly, your authority is requested for the filing of these affidavits in finished form with the United States District Court, District of Nevada, seeking court orders for the electronic surveillance installations mentioned above. It will be appreciated if you will advise this Eureau in this regard.







The attached teletype from the Las Vegas Division describes the attempted assassination of captioned victim which occurred at approximately 8:15 P.M., Monday, 10/4/82. The victim was leaving a restaurant parking lot in Las Vegas when a bomb exploded in the vehicle. The force of the explosion ejected the victim from the vehicle. The victim sustained only minor injuries; however, the victim's vehicle and several other vehicles were totally destroyed by the subsequent fire.

Also attached is a UPF wire dispatch received at 1:26 A.M., 10/5/82, originating from Las Vegas wherein Rosenthal, age 53, was reported to be the head of the Nevada operations for now defunct Argent Corporation before both men were forced out of Nevada by Nevada gaming officials.

The dispatch relates that the explosion occurred in the parking lot of Marie Callendars restaurant.
