The News Democrat of Belleville, Illinois, dated August 17, 1961, carried an article reflecting an application was on file as of that date with the Secretary of State CHARLES F. CARPENTIER, Springfield, Illinois, asking for dissolution of the corporation of JACK LANGER'S Mounds Club, a former night club and gambling casino on US Highway 40 west of Collinsville. The notice of intention to dissolve was filed by JACK LANGER, 2161 Pontoon Road, Granite City, Illinois. The article stated that in its hayday, the Mounds Club flourished, but a change in political office holders forced it to close in the early 1940's. Some years later it resumed operations, but on a much less lavish scale. The Madison County State's Attorney DICK MUDGE, JR., from an airplane "bombed" the casino with leaflets in his campaign -election to his first term in 1956. MUDGE was elected and eventually the building was abandoned as a night club and casino and became a general merchandise store.

It is pointed out that the above-mentioned Mounds Club was also known in the past as the Prevue Club and was a lavish gambling casino for years in the East St. Louis area until it was finally closed in 1955 by the State Police. The operation of this club was controlled by the Wortman organization and the financial dealings of this club presently figure in the income tax indictments against FRANK WORTMAN, EIMER DOWLING, EDWARD WORTMAN, JR., GREGORY "RED" MOORE, GEORGE FRANK and SAM MAGIN. GREGORY "RED" MOORE was one of the managers of the Mounds Club and Prevue Club during the days of its operations.
