

Queens, New York. This document, which appeared to be a test report, was classified "Secret." The envelope in which it was mailed showed a return address of Gene La Roque, Mountain State Engineers. Post Office Box 17960, Tucson, Arizona 85731. had no idea why the document was mailed to his company and was concerned that it could have been misdirected, and further, because of its classified nature, notified the NYO.

As shown above, it has been determined through the DOD that this document has been conjured up as a hoax.
