On July 8, 1970, Judge THOMSEN announced a decision not to pursue this particular matter further, although he commented that he does not believe the First Amendment or any other laws of the United States prevents the Court from compelling representatives of the New York Times to make a limited disclosure of the source or sources of the information they received. Judge THOMSEN commented that he had decided not to take any action against the New York Times, as he was satisfied that no member of the staff of the United States District Court, Baltimore, and no member of the Grand Jury had furnished a copy of [redacted] b3 Per FBI [redacted] to the New York Times.

Judge THOMSEN had commented earlier on June 22, 1970, that he had been informed by legal counsel representing VICTOR FRENKIL on June 20, 1970, that a member of the Grand Jury had furnished a copy of [redacted] b3 Per FBI to the New York Times.

It has been discussed with United States Attorney GEORGE BEALL, the possibility of [redacted]

[redacted] VOLOSHEN had entered a guilty plea in a case charging him in New York City during early June 1970. Mr. BEALL advised on July 16, 1970, that he had been informed by the United States Attorney's Office, New York City, that VOLOSHEN was in very bad health and in view of this, coupled with his age, was not expected to live long. 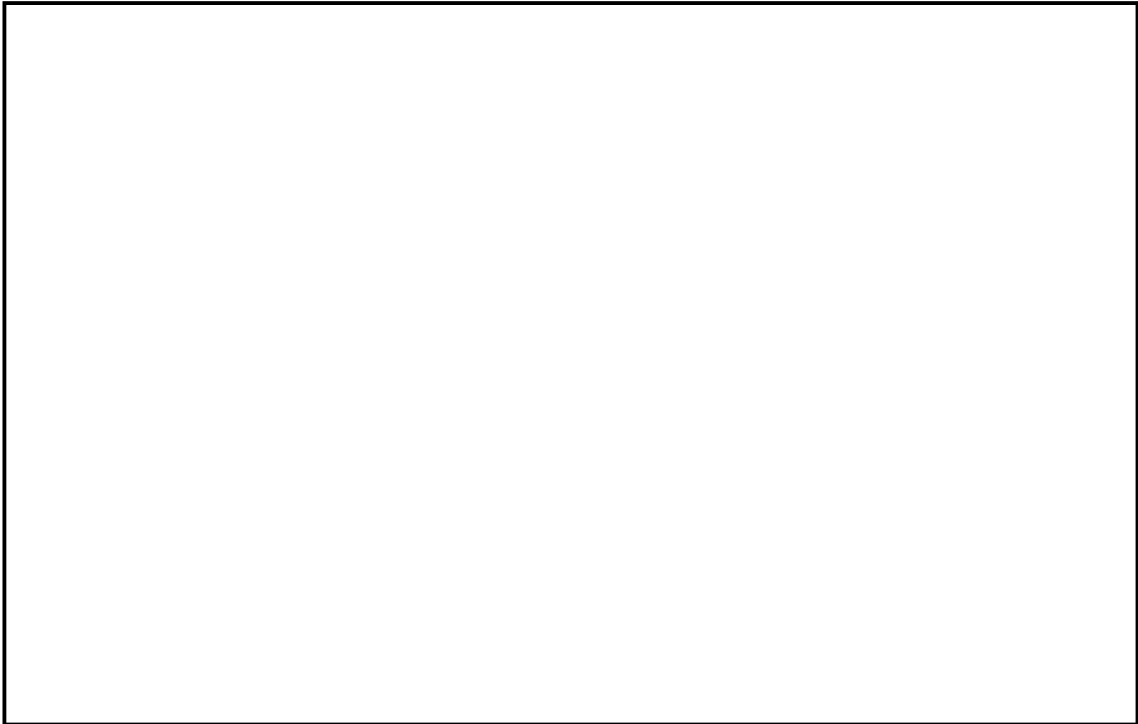

In reality, the Bureau has no leads outstanding whatsoever at the moment concerning this investigation, and Baltimore is aware from conversation with Mr. BEALL that no inquiries are being made by his office. The case has not been closed in view of pending matters involving former Senator BREWSTER on another case.

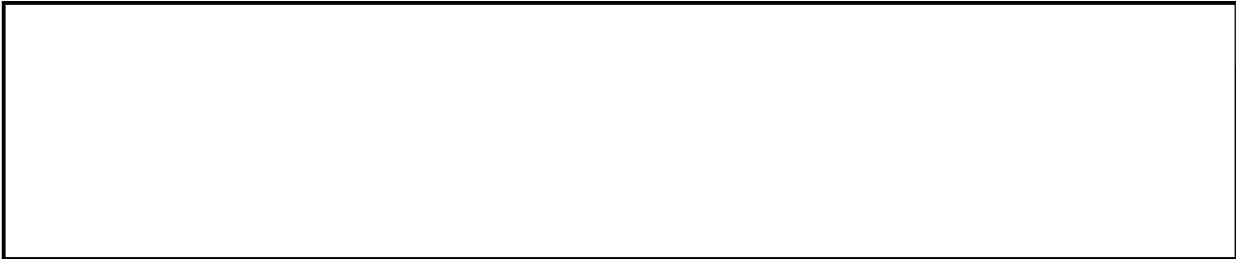

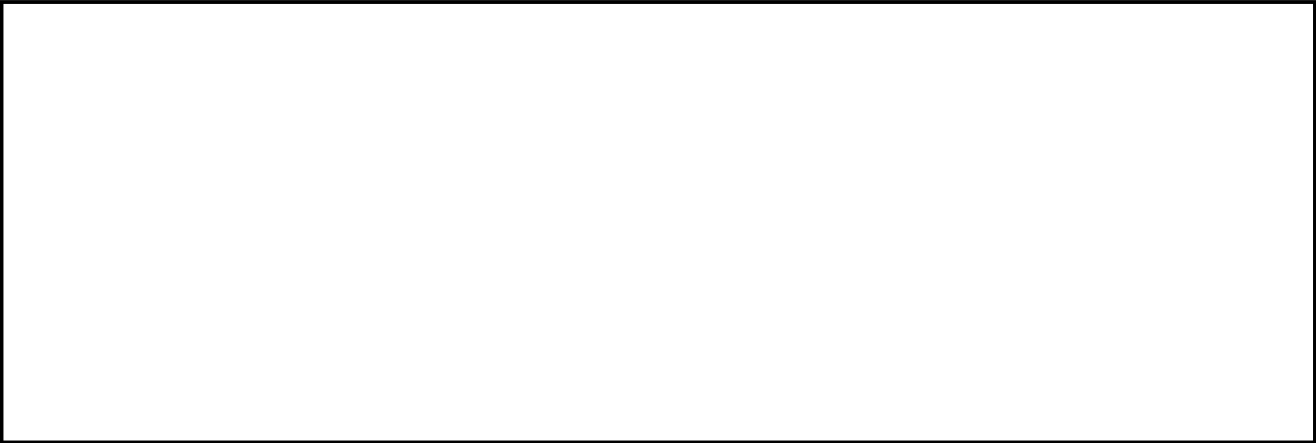
