 $(\mathrm{U}//\mathrm{FOUO})$  The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) provided a digital video disk to the National Reconnaissance Office (NRO) and asked that the NRO conduct a classification review of the contents (14 e-mails, 1 e-mail attachment). The review is part of a potential compromise review of U.S. Department of State (DoS) email communications from email accounts previously used by a former Secretary of State during tenure at DoS.

(FOUC) A Classification Management Officer from the NRO's Office of Security and Counterintelligence conducted a review of the materials and concluded the files do not contain NRO information. The NRO cannot establish the e-mails are unclassified, only that they do not contain information considered classified by the NRO. The NRO systems may have contributed intelligence to some of the scenarios addressed, but any information derived from such collection would have been classified by the agency developing the intelligence under their classification guides. Further, other plausible non-NRO sources exist that would also be consistent with timelines and relative lack of details. The NRO recommends the National Security Agency, the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency, the Central Intelligence Agency, the Missile Defense Agency, and Air Force Space Command be provided the opportunity to assess for their equities.






