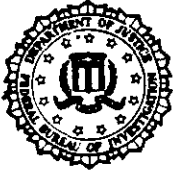

On October 22, 1968, Special Agent [REDACTED] Secret Service, Los Angeles, was advised of the planned demonstration. [REDACTED] advised that the Vice-President planned to stay at the Beverly Hilton Hotel during his visit to Los Angeles, and that on October 24, 1968, the Vice-President would attend a fund raising dinner at the hotel at approximately 9:00 PM.

On October 24, 1968, Special Agents of the FBI observed a demonstration in front of the Beverly Hilton Hotel, Beverly Hills. This demonstration commenced at 7:40 PM and consisted of a circular picket march involving 25 persons at the Wilshire Avenue entrance to the hotel. The demonstrators carried signs, some of which read "Bring the Boys Home Now", and "HHH is a War Candidate". The demonstration ended at approximately 9:00 PM. No arrests or incidents were observed in connection with the demonstration.

On September 30, 1968, at 9:00 a.m., [redacted] of the "Hanford Sentinel" newspaper, Hanford, California, advised Special Agent [redacted] that the following anonymous letter, which was postmarked at Hanford, California, September 28, 1968, had been received at the newspaper office:

"Print this so that everyone can read it; I'm gonna kill Humphrey so you'd better hide him cause if I find him I'll kill him to hell with Humphrey."

The letter was prepared on a typewriter and poorly typed.

The contents of this letter were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney Richard V. Boulger, Fresno, California, on September 30, 1968, at which time he advised that there did not appear to be a violation of the Extortion Statute in view of the nonspecific and vague nature of the letter. Further, that it appeared to be the work of a mentally ill person.

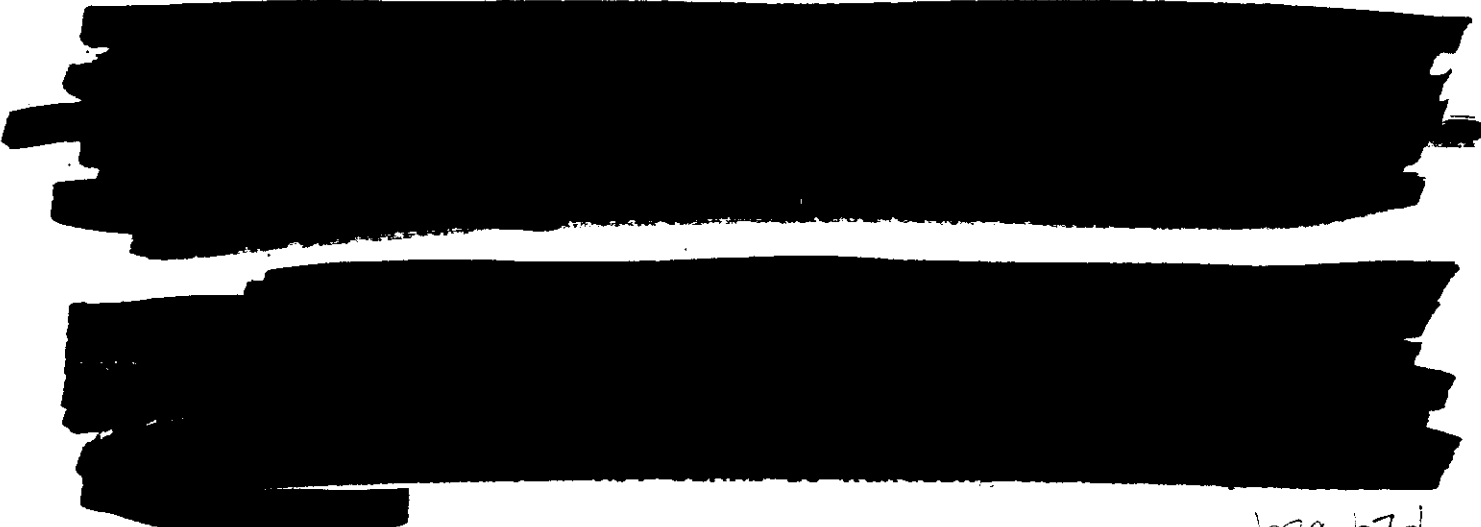

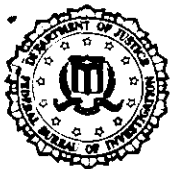

At 1:42 p.m., on November 1, 1968, a male individual, who would not furnish his name but who had a decided Southern accent, called the Chicago Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and advised that he was going to shoot Vice President Humphrey when he gets a chance, either now or after the election. This person stated his reason for contemplating such action was that the Negroes had been getting too much and that his wife recently ran away with a Negro. He stated that the only hint which he would give as to his identity was that he was from St. Louis.

This same individual called the Chicago FBI Office again at 2:01 p.m., on November 1, 1968, at which time he stated that he was then in the vicinity of Clark and Division Streets and was wearing a light plaid shirt and a light green pair of trousers.

The initial information above was furnished to U.S. Secret Service [REDACTED], Chicago, at 1:45 p.m., and the entire content of the unidentified caller's message was furnished to Special Agent [REDACTED] at 2:04 p.m., November 1, 1968, by Special Agent [REDACTED]. 

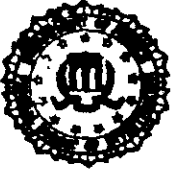

[REDACTED] In passing, [REDACTED] overheard one say, "You can get a good shot from here." [REDACTED] advised agents of the United States Secret Service that he observed these individuals getting into a 1961 or 1962 white Chevrolet, bearing a dark yellow license plate, whose numbers he could not read. He did state he thought that the license plate resembled that which is issued by the State of Wisconsin. These men then drove from the area.

[REDACTED] described these three individuals as follows:

1) A Negro male, approximately 5'9"-10" tall, in his early 20's, with black bushy hair which he wore in the natural African look. [REDACTED] stated this individual was the person he overheard doing the talking in front of 1721 West Madison Street.

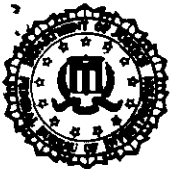
