





San Juan, Puerto Rico November 2, 1965



On October 31, 1965, an anonymous caller contacted the San Juan Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation by telephone indicating he had information concerning a plot to assassinate a high United States government official who would soon visit Puerto Rico. The complainant indicated he would come to the office personally to provide the information provided he would not be followed on departure and would not be required to disclose his identity.

That same date, the caller appeared at the San Juan Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation and provided the following information:

On November 27, 1965, the following activity was observed by Special Agents of the FBI:

At 6:30 p.m. on Calle Loiza, directly opposite the entrance driveway to the El San Juan Hotel, Isla Verde, Puerto Rico, a group of individuals, composed mainly of members of the MPIPR with some Federacion de Universitarios Pro Independencia (Federation of University Students for Independence) (FUPI) and Federacion Estudiantil Pro Independencia (Federation of Students for Independence) (FEPI) members, began to gather.

Characterizations of the FUPI and FEPI appear in the appendix.

These individuals formed a picket line at approximately 7:05 p.m. on the same site. The pickets, who numbered between 115 and 120 at 7:30 p.m., carried signs with anti-American statements, such as "Yankee Go Home". By the shouts of the pickets, it was obvious that their purpose was to protest the presence of Vice President of the United States Hubert H. Humphrey at a Democratic fund-raising dinner being held that night at the El San Juan Hotel. In addition, signs indicated displeasure with the presence of United States commercial interests in Puerto Rico and compulsory military service.

At approximately 7:35 p.m., a car bearing the Vice President arrived at the Hotel El San Juan. Humphrey's entrance was so smooth and swift that it seemed to catch the pickets by surprise and they had no opportunity to create any disturbance. Throughout the entire picket.

"Patria" stated that the FUPI was not connected with any political organization and would work for independence for Puerto Rico through logical and peaceful means.

1959 to 1964 FUPI representatives attended various student conferences in foreign countries, to promote the cause of independence for Puerto Rico.

that the FUPI was elected an integral member of the international Union of Students (IUS), Prague, Czechoslovakia, in October, 1960, and elected to the IUS Executive Committee, and since June, 1961, had maintained a representative,

of the FUPI in the international field have followed the "anti-Imperialist" theme of the IUS.

The IUS has been cited by the Internal Security Subcommittee of the Senate Judiciary Committee in 1956 as being among "International communist fronts functioning at the present time," and by the Committee on Un-American Activities, U. S. House of Representatives in 1951 as one of the "long established Soviet controlled international organizations."

, the above source stated that the primary objectives of the FUPI are to bring about Puerto Rican independence and achieve reform at the UPR. The source stated that the FUPI supports the principles of the Cuban Revolution to achieve national independence.
