At the very conclusion of the program one of the newsmen who was interviewing Humphrey asked him whether he would replace J. Edgar Hoover as Director of the FBI if elected. Although his reply was cut short because of time, the Vice President clearly indicated that he would retain Mr. Hoover as Director of the FBI should he be elected. He stated that Mr. Hoover has compiled an outstanding record of dedication and service to the country in his position as Director of the FBI and advised that, should he be elected, Humphrey would sit down with Mr. Hoover and discuss the question of the Director remaining in his position. Although time did not permit him to continue with his reply, his clear implication was that he fully intended for the Director to retain his position should Humphrey be elected.





At approximately 7:45 p.m., August 2, 1968, the seven groups mentioned above began picketing in front of Cobo Hall, Detroit, Michigan, in anticipation of the planned appearance of Vice President Hubert Humphrey at the Frank Sinatra Show to be held at 8:30 p.m. the same evening. The picketers, numbering approximately 250, carried various signs protesting the United States involvement in the war in South Vietnam.

At 8:30 p.m., Vice President Humphrey arrived at the rear entrance of Cobo Hall and was ushered to his seat within the hall without incident. The Frank Sinatra Show was at approximately 8:45 p.m.

At 9:00 p.m., August 2, 1968, approximately 150 of the persons who had been picketing in front of Cobo Hall forced their way in the lobby and hallway of the arena and began chanting "Hell no, we won't go".

Mr. Humphrey indicated, that if elected President, he would attempt to bring firm but not repressive law enforcement to the United States.




