At 4:26 PM, October 15, 1968, an anonymous caller, probably a male caucasian, telephoned the office of the FBI and advised of the following information:

He advised he was supposed to get Humphrey today, but could not bring himself to do so, and was now to get Nixon tomorrow. He stated he is a family man and being pushed into killing either Humphrey or Nixon, or both, by "these people," whom he refused to identify. He stated you could possibly call this a vendetta on the part of "these people" because he was involved in a homicide when he was a kid. He made continual references to his wife and children, and stated he could not identify himself or those allegedly forcing him to do these acts, as they would "ruin him." The only thing he would say concerning "these people" was that they were "Southern people" and they were from out of town. He was specifically asked how he intended to "get" the candidates, and he stated "I have a gun." He was asked information concerning the weapon and refused to tell anything about it, saying only the proper protection should be afforded the candidates in order to stop him.

The caller said he had previously contacted this office on four occasions this day and hung up each time before talking to anyone because he thought the calls were being traced. He said he called the Police Department at HArrison 1-1500, and told them this story. He concluded by saying, "I hope you catch me, because I don't want to do this terrible thing."

No further investigation is being conducted in this matter.

Dear Sir:
The information furnished herewith concerns an individual who is believed to be covered by the agreement between the FBI and Secret Service concerning Presidential protection, and to fall within the category or categories checked.

2. Has attempted or threatened to redress a grievance against any public official by other than legal means.
3. Because of background is potentially dangerous; or has been identified as member or participant in communist movement; or has been under active investigation as member of other group or organization inimical to U.S.
4. U.S. citizens or residents who defect from the U.S. to countries in the Soviet or Chinese Communist blocs and return.
5. Subversives, ultrarightists, racists and fascists who meet one or more of the following criteria:
 (a) Evidence of emotional instability (including unstable residence and employment record) or irrational or suicidal behavior: (b) Expressions of strong or violent anti-U. S. sentiment; (c) Prior acts (including arrests or convictions) or conduct or statements indicating a propensity for violence and antipathy toward good order and government.

Attached to this memorandum is a throw-away leaflet entitled "An APPEAL to Mr. HUMPHREY for PEACE" which was distributed outside the Utica Memorial Auditorium, asking the voters to listen to Mr. HUMPHREY carefully. This throw-away bears the names of the Utice Peace Center, Coalition for an Independent Candidacy, and the Vietnam Educational Council.

An article appearing in the August 1, 1966 issue of the "Utica Observer Dispatch, a Utica, N.Y., daily newspaper, stated that the Vietnam Education Council (VEC) was formed in mid-July, 1966, for the purpose of providing information and serving as a forum to people interested in the total picture of the Vietnam war. The article noted that this organization with a membership of approximately 25 persons from the Utica, N.Y., area had as its chairman, Mrs. JACOB OSER, of Clinton, New York.

It is to be noted that several newspaper articles in Utica, N.Y., during 1967 and 1968 described Mrs. OSER as continuing as Chairman of the VEC.

BLACK PANTHER PARTY, also known as BLACA FAMTHER PARTY POR SELF DEFENSE

that the Black Panther Party for Self Defense (BFFSD) was formed by HUEY PERCY NEWTON, Minister of Defense, and HORBY GEORGE SEALE, Chairman, in December, 1966, as a militant black nationalist political organization to combat "police brutality," to unite black youth, and to determine the destiny of black communities. The political philosophy was taken from writings of Chairman MAO Tse-tung of Communist China and black militant writers

In March, 1968, the name of the organization was changed to Black Fanther Farty (BPP).

The official BFF publication, "The Black Fanther Partyblack Community News Service," states that the BFP advocates use of guns and guerrilla tactics in their violent revolutionary program to end oppression of black people.

On February 17, 1968, FLURIDGE CLEAVER, Minister of Information, announced merger of the BFP and Student Nonviolent Coordinating Committee (SNCC) and bestowed title of Minister of Justice, EFF, upon H. RAP BROWN, Chairman of SNCC.

SNOC is a militant Negro organization which preaches black supremacy.





ScS To Concentrate On Compus Issues

Students for a democratic Society may be one of the most potentially volatile elements on campus.

Should SDS explode, as have numerous other campuses, the spark could likely come from SdS. The provocation could be that Bookstore prices are too high or that student assistants' salaries are too low.

SdS's first concern this semester is gaining more support. To do this, chapter leaders plan to concentrate more on campus issues than in the past.

Nationally and locally, SdS is perhaps the most ill-defined and loosely-structured organization on record. It has 250-300 satellite chapters paying lip service to the national headquarters in Chicago. Most members openly support communism and the chief activity is knocking the "Establishment."

J. Edgar Hoover, director of the FBI, has predicted an SdS-led reign of terror on campuses this fall. Several major publications have recently attempted to pinpoint the elusive philosophies of SdS. Others are warning that the group is dangerously subversive and sanctioned by the Communist Party.

SdS members have gained recognition as chaos directed idealists and as the prime force behind riots and demonsteations, such as at Columbia University.

However, the chapter here, with an unimpressive membership of 8 to 10 members, is characterized more by talk than action and has been a disenchanting experience for students who want to get something done.

Doug Tuthill, former editor of the Daily Aztec, quit after two years in SdS. "It was dull... no action," he said. "Two or three other people and I quit because we were tired of trying to get people up off their asses and do something."

Despite its small membership, SdS has been attracting crowds of about a hundred since this semester started. Most of the newcomers seem more interested in changing SDS than the world Through this interest, John Watanabe, chairman of SdS, a 21-year-old English major, hopes to

bolster SdS membership by concentrating on campus problems.

Watanabe said the group here plans to do something about Bookstore prices after studying techniques used by San Francisco State's SdS chapter in a successful campaign for student discounts at the bookstore.

"Aztec Shops makes a 100 per cent profit on the books they sell to us. Students should not have to pay the same prices they would at an off-campus store," he said.

Another issue that may gain support for SdS is more money for student assistants. Watanabe said

students at San Francisco State earn at least \$2.20 an hour. Wages here start at \$1.50 an hour.

Another gripe SdS plans to capitalize on is college construction without student consent.

But Watanabe stressed that outside concerns such as the Dow Chemical and anti-draft demonstrations last year, will not be de-emphasized in lieu of campus issues. "We can't limit ourselves to this campus. The campus is not isolated," he said.

If Vice-President Hubert H.



Humphrey appears on campus as expected in mid-October, SdS will have something to say or do. "Humphrey's coming is a golden opportunity to demonstrate, but it is also scary. We'll be there but it will take a lot of planning to prevent heads from being beaten in," Watanabe said.

The administration may or may not be concerned over possible campus unrest, but Dr. Herbert Peiffer, dean of students said, "The administration can merely judge them (SdS) on their past performance. They have been cooperative and followed the regulations of the student-faculty Activities Board. We hope they continue to work with student government."

The campus SdS, which Watanabe said is neither a communist or an anti-communist organization, started in the spring of 1965. One of its all-encompassing goals is to change the present system.

"I don't think it's being utopian or very idealistic to have that as a goal. We have already seen changes brought about by the New Left," Watanabe said.

"I wouldn't say we are pushing for communism either. People have very little understanding of what communism is. Right now we're working within the system," he said.

Watanabe admits violence may be necessary. Referring to last year's demonstrations against Dow Chemical, he said SdS was criticized for denying free speech to Dow

"Free speech is not the issue. Where do you draw the line of free speech. The issue is — what does Dow Chemical do? Make napalm! And it's not just Dow Chemical, or the Army and the Navy, they are just the most blatant. It is also the National Fruit Company that exploits South America; and General Electric that makes time devices for bombs. Nothing is clean. Nothing is pure in this system."

Watanabe said the organization has no position on the use of force, that it depends on the situation. "Most of us don't want violence, but sometimes it said only way to get what we want
