Secret Service isolated [redacted] as prime suspect. Our Washington Field Office has been instructed to notify U. S. Capitol Police and Metropolitan Police, Washington, D. C. Our Minneapolis Office instructed to notify Minneapolis Police Department, Secret Service at Minneapolis, and the office of Senator Humphrey. Crime Records Division notifying Senator Humphrey's Washington, D. C. office.

For the information of the Bureau and Minneapolis, at 9:40 a.m. on 4/3/71, [redacted] S. Secret Service, furnished the following information:

According to [redacted], on 4/2/71, the Washington Field Office of the Secret Service received an anonymous call from an individual who described himself as a telephone "frame operator" in Minneapolis who stated that at 4:00 p.m. on 4/1/71, he happened to plug in to a line and overheard a conversation which he considered to be threatening to Senator HUMPHREY. He stated that the name [redacted] was mentioned during the conversation and that he traced the call to [redacted]

According to the anonymous source, this individual stated as follows: "I am going to Washington to get even with him. He caused me nothing but trouble and he is to be blamed for me being arrested. This time there won't be any Secret Service protection."

TABLE VI--CESSATION OF BOMBING IN INDOCHINA

Sec. 601 (a) No funds authorized or appropriated under this or any other law may be expended after the date of enactment of this Act to bomb, rocket, napalm, or otherwise attack by air, any target whatsoever within the Kingdom of Cambodia, the Kingdom of Thailand, the Democratic Republic of Vietnam, and the Kingdom of Laos.

(b) No funds authorized or appropriated under this or any other law may be expended

after the date of enactment of this Act to bomb, rocket, napalm, or otherwise attack by air any target whatsoever within the Republic of Vietnam unless the President determines any such air operation to be necessary to provide for the safety of United States Armed Forces during their withdrawal from Indochina.

Mr. GRAVEL. Mr. President, while we deliberate today in this Chamber American planes will ease into the sky over Southeast Asia. They will drop tons of explosives onto the flesh of hu-

Over the past 10 years 700,000 Laotians have been made refugees, tens of thousands have been killed or wounded, and hundreds of thousands forced to live much of the time in caves and trenches.

The bombing raids also come in the name of the U.S. Senate, until we legislate otherwise.

The war is not winding down for the peoples of Indochina. Since the much heralded bombing halt over North Vietnam, the planes have not come home. They have simply shifted their targets into Laos and Cambodia.

The bombing has continued at 100 tons an hour, 2,400 tons a day. The rate of civilian casualties and refugee generation, indicative of the overall level of violence, has if anything increased during the last 2 years.

The amendment I offer is quite straightforward. Let us stop the bombing, not just partially over North Vietnam but in all Indochina--except for those strikes inside South Vietnam demonstrably related to the security of our withdrawing troops. Is it really the desire of the Senate to continue to send out those planes?

Late on 8/23/73, Jerome Zeifman, Chief Counsel of the House Committee on Judiciary, called to advise me of a telephone conversation he had just had with Congressman Edwards. He said Edwards is currently in California and has spent considerable time in the Kern County area where there is a great deal of unrest in connection with labor activities involving grape pickers. Several individuals have been killed or injured during this labor unrest.

Zeifman said that Edwards is very concerned that the investigations of this situation are not being handled properly. He said Edwards specifically expressed his concern that the publicly stated policy of former Acting Director Gray to the effect that outside Agents would be sent in to handle civil rights cases is not being followed in this instance. He said Edwards feels a number of Agents should be sent into the area from other FBI offices and that they specifically should be Agents with Spanish speaking ability. He said Edwards had commented that he recently had some contact with the Phoenix FBI Office and had been highly impressed with the competency of the number of Spanish speaking Agents available there.

Zeifman advised Edwards has visited the FBI Resident Agency office in the area where this labor problem is centered expressing his concern over these cases and also has communicated directly with the Department of Justice about this matter. He said Edwards feels his expressions of concern have not generated the proper response and Edwards is now suggesting that he be allowed to convene his Subcommittee on Civil Rights and Constitutional Rights of the House Committee on Judiciary to conduct hearings in California concerning the handling of these cases. Zeifman said at Edwards' request he has discussed this matter with Pat McSweeney, Deputy Assistant Attorney General for Legislative Affairs in the absence of Assistant Attorney General Mike McKeivitt, and that he expects a response from McSweeney. Zeifman said he was merely advising me so that the FBI would be aware of this situation.

I told Zeifman that I was aware that Edwards had visited the resident agency. I also told him that the adequacy of personnel in the area has been considered by officials both in the field and here in Washington. He was thanked for advising us of Edwards' comments.

This matter was discussed with McSweeney who stated Edwards has been constantly agitating regarding the Kern County situation. He advised that Senator Hubert Humphrey (D.-Minn.) also has gotten into the act and sent a telegram to the Attorney General urging that a large force of personnel be sent into the area to handle the unrest that has resulted from the labor dispute. McSweeney was advised that a week ago we had inquired of the Sacramento FBI Field Office regarding the adequacy of personnel to handle civil rights complaints growing out of this situation in Kern County and were assured that there are sufficient personnel in the area to take care of the matter, including Spanish speaking Agents. He was advised that we have experienced some delays in handling the necessary investigation because of an uncooperative attitude on the part of attorneys representing the United Farm Workers.

The Civil Rights Section of the General Investigative Division advises we have had 23 civil rights cases referred to us as a result of the situation in Kern County, about half of which are preliminary types.

It is not new or unusual for Congressman Edwards to be critical of the FBI with respect to the handling of civil rights matters. He has done so consistently and with this situation being in his home area, it is natural that he will make every effort to take advantage of the publicity potential. Congressman Edwards does not represent Kern County, however. Kern County is divided between two congressional districts. One is represented by Congressman Robert B. Mathias and the other by Congressman William M. Ketchum, both Republicans.

She explained that Senator Humphrey would be leaving Washington, D. C., at 10:00 p.m. and it was not expected his speech would be completed by their typists before he left. She was told she could expect a return call shortly concerning such approval.

Personnel of the Files and Communications Division advised that if such a request was properly approved there would be no problem in transmitting the speech to the Miami Office.

Associate Director Callahan approved the request and [REDACTED] was advised.

[REDACTED] subsequently called and said the use of the telecopier would not be needed since the speech had been completed prior to Senator Humphrey's departure.
