This UCO, as a fencing operation, supplies the gang members a service that they will utilize to turn some of their criminal activity into cash. This alone will instill trust in the UCA's and create an atmosphere where other criminal activity is discussed. Obtaining this information is the primary goal of this operation. To accomplish this, the trust of the subjects must be gained, which is an extremely slow and difficult task. Most of the subjects and members of the targeted gangs have been raised together since early childhood and have formed peer bonds to the extent that it is virtually impossible for an outsider to break into the group. The trust of a person who has not been raised with these groups must be built over a long period. It is only after this trust is built, that the gang member will open up and tell someone who is not a member of this peer group of the gangs criminal activity.

The benefits of this operation are two-fold. First and obvious is that it will help solve a lot of local burglaries and other street crime which plagues the South Dade area. During the first four months of 1995, the Cutler Ridge District of Metro Dade Police Department had 1262 burglaries reported. This is in comparison to 728 in Kendall, 819 in Doral and 957 in the Hammock's Districts. Robberies are also high in this district with 326 being reported, compared to 119 in Kendall, 138 in the Hammock's and 131 in Doral for the same period. Narcotics crimes maintain a similar statistical pattern with 260 in Cutler Ridge, 126 in Kendall, 100 in the Hammock's and 101 in Doral. Finally, Aggravated Assaults in Cutler Ridge District number 193 for this period, compared to 82 in Kendall, 106 in the Hammock's and 65 in Doral. As is evident from the above statistics, street crime is extremely high in the district where this UCO is targeted, compared to the three neighboring Districts, all of which lie within the Homestead RA territory, and much of the street crime is attributable to the street gang problem in the area.
