Ash supplies 120 round trip tickets to junkateer purchased in Vegas at 60 to 70% off---These are bad tickets usually bought from the credit card ticket thieves who infested. Vegas from 60% to 70%-Tickets billed full price to T. Bird--Profit 25 to 30,000 dollars per trip. Multiply this by hundreds of trips and junkets over the years......Also in this period no call girl or madam could enter or send a girl to Bird withoit \$25 to Resnick account. Resnick during this time was close to highest rolling player(craps and baccarat only in casinos--plus sports betting) in Vegas, He could lose \$75,000 in one nite and be ready next nite to try again.
