At 12:25 AM January 5, 1974, [redacted]
was arrested by members of the Homicide Detail, Las Vegas
Metropolitan Police Department (LVMPD) after [redacted] was
observed to place what appeared to be a dynamite bomb
underneath a 1973 Lincoln four-door sedan, Nevada license
CEA 681. This vehicle is owned by Ash Resnick, a resident
of Las Vegas, Nevada, who is employed as a greeter at
Caesar's Palace, Las Vegas. At the time of this attempted
bombing, the vehicle was unoccupied and parked in the park-
ing lot of Caesar's Palace.

Detective Lieutenant [redacted] LVMPD, advised
that informant information had been received indicating
[redacted] was to place a dynamite bomb in Resnick's vehicle on
January 5, 1974. [redacted]

Detective [redacted] advised that he was in possession
of video tapes which depicted [redacted] under-
neath the victim's vehicle, placing the bomb. [redacted]

The victim of the attempted bombing, Ash Resnick, resides at 3570 Las Vegas Boulevard South, Las Vegas. He is described as follows:

He could furnish no reason as to why anyone would attempt to kill him.

Detective [redacted] was advised of the services of the FBI Laboratory and Identification Division and that they would be available in connection with this matter. He was also advised that the FBI could handle any coverage of out of state leads. [redacted] requested that positive identification of [redacted] be made through the Identification Division as soon as [redacted] fingerprints were available.

Detective [redacted] advised at the time of [redacted] arrest, three agents of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms were present. These agents were working through the Los Angeles Strike Force.

On January 7, 1974, Detective [redacted] advised that [redacted] was arrested by the LVMPD based upon a fugitive warrant issued by the St. Louis, Missouri Police Department charging [redacted] with burglary. This warrant was issued as a result of an appeal denial. [redacted] had previously been sentenced to five years in State Prison for this burglary conviction. [redacted] advised that the police informant furnished information that [redacted] had offered \$5,000 cash payment to the person responsible for the death by bombing of Ash Resnick. Attempted murder charges will not be filed against [redacted] by the LVMPD.

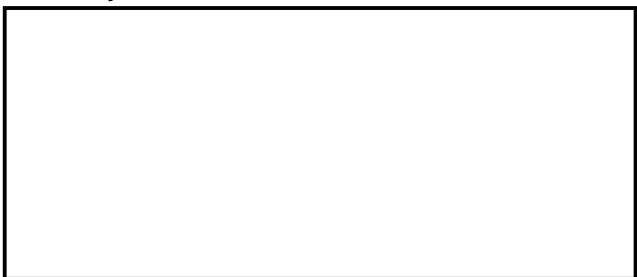
