Jesse Helms, United States Senator from North Carolina, Election Laws

Reference is made to your letterhead memorandum of August 30, 1976 in which you alerted us to a newspaper story depicting Senator Jesse Helms, of North Carolina, as having hosted on August 25, 1976, in Room G-219, Dirksen Senate Office Building, a fund-raising cocktail party for Stanley C. Burger, a Montana senatorial candidate. If this story is true, 18 U.S.C. §603, which prohibits Congressmen from using "any room or building occupied in the discharge of official duties" for the solicitation or receipt of political contributions, may have been violated.

To determine whether §603 has been violated, we request that the Bureau conduct the following preliminary investigation.

1) Please determine if, in fact, the fund-raising event was held in Room G-219, Dirksen Senate Office Building as reported.

2) If that event was held, please determine the nature of Room G-219. In particular, it would be useful to determine whether this room is used for public meetings and whether it was rented by Senator Helms or the Burger for U.S. Senate Committee for the event in question.

3) Please also check the Burger for U.S. Senate Committee's expenditure records at the Federal Election Commission for the months of August through October to see whether there is any indication of a rental payment having been made for the use of that room. To avoid undue publicity, it is requested that the Bureau use the Commission's private viewing room when it examines the Burger Committee records.

(WDC), on September 22, 1982. The letter, signed "Walter B. Smalley," bore a return address of 2131 Florida Avenue, N.W., WDC.

The writer expresses his dissatisfaction with Senator Helms' political philosophy and ends with the statement, "I wish someone could push you down some stairs and break your neck."

On November 12, 1982, Walter Byron Smalley, date of birth January 17, 1908, Social Security Account Number 578-09-9383, was interviewed at his residence by SA [redacted] Smalley was shown a copy of the above letter, at which time he admitted it was written by him. Smalley advised he did not feel the letter was threatening in nature and apologized for any trouble he might have caused. He further advised he would refrain from making future statements that could be construed as threatening.

As we have discussed on the telephone concerning a number of very old cases and matters where you are in the process of clearing out bulky evidence which is no longer needed by the FBI, there are a number of categories of cases where the United States Attorneys Office would no longer have any need for physical evidence. For cases or matters in those categories, you could proceed to dispose of any evidence you have according to your agency's guidelines on disposition of physical evidence without any further consultation with prosecutors in this Office.

For cases or matters which fall within any of the following categories, I suggest that you put a copy of this letter in appropriate jackets and proceed appropriately to dispose of the evidence in those cases:

1. cases or matters where there is a case closure memorandum or letter indicating a discussion with an Assistant United States Attorney who agreed that prosecution of the case would be declined (for any of a number of reasons);
2. non-capital cases or matters where the offense is more than five years old or, if a conspiracy charge was possible, where the last overt act in furtherance of the conspiracy was more than five years ago;
3. cases where there was a not guilty verdict; and
4. cases where there were guilty verdicts or pleas of guilty as long as the agents check with the appropriate court to make sure that no appeal from the judgment was taken that might still be pending;

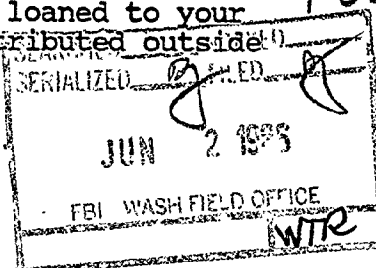

The above postcard was sent to the FBI Laboratory, who determined a similar postcard was sent from Ft. Myers, Florida, on October 2, 1982, addressed to Congresswoman LINDY BOGGS of Louisiana, that was signed "Disgusted." It was further determined that both postcards were typed on similar typewriters. Examination of the FBI Identification Division failed to develop any Latent Fingerprints of value on either postcard.

UNITED STATES SECRET SERVICE Special Agent [redacted] was contacted on January 22, 1986, and April 8, 1986, at Tampa, Florida, and informed that his office made an inquiry in to this matter, but has been unable to develop any suspects.

Contacts were made with the Punta Gorda, Florida, Police Department, the Charlotte County, Florida, Sheriff's Office in Punta Gorda, Florida, the lead county for the Sheriff's Office in Ft. Myers, Florida, and the Ft. Myers, Florida, Police Department were made, however, no suspects were developed in this matter.

No further investigation is being conducted by the FBI at this time.

Photofacsimiles of multiple mailings to captioned victims were transmitted through the Laboratory with request for psycholinguistic evaluation. The WFO case file material evidences sufficient similarities with that of the LA file materials as to warrant the conclusion that they originate from one and the same source.

The author of these communications is most likely a foreign born, high school educated, female approximately between the ages of 35 and 50. There are not sufficient dialect markers to enable determination of country of origin. The English is sufficiently facile as to suggest that the author has resided in this country for at least 15 years.

There are no content indications that the author has the means or the resolve to effectuate her threats. The language is more characteristic of political hyperbole than augury of action.
