ACCORDING TO CHARLES E. WEEKS, AGENT IN CHARGE OF THE FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION, (FBI), IN CONNECTICUT, JOHN RUSSELL PARDUE, JR., IN ANTICIPATION OF DEATH, AFTER BEING MORTALLY WOUNDED BY A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE UNITED STATES MARSHAL'S OFFICE DURING AN ABORTIVE ESCAPE ATTEMPT WHILE HE WAS ON TRIAL IN UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT, BRIDGEPORT, CONNECTICUT, REQUESTED AN INTERVIEW

BY AN FBI AGENT. HE REQUESTED THIS INTERVIEW PRIOR TO BEING TRANSFERRED TO SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, FOR ADDITIONAL MEDICAL CARE.

PARDUE IN HIS DYING DECLARATION INVOLVED HIMSELF AND HIS BROTHER JAMES IN NUMEROUS CRIMES FOR WHICH THEY HAD BEEN UNDER ACTIVE INVESTIGATION FOR MONTHS. HIS STATEMENTS HAVE CONFIRMED IN GREAT DETAIL THE INVESTIGATIVE ANALYSIS OF THESE ACTIVITIES WHICH WAS MADE SOON AFTER THEIR ARRESTS ON CHARGES OF BOMBING THE DANBURY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ROBBING AND BOMBING THE UNION SAVINGS BANK IN DANBURY, CONNECTICUT, ON FEBRUARY THIRTEEN, SEVENTY.

PARDUE, IN HIS DYING DECLARATION, VOLUNTARILY FURNISHED INFORMATION INVOLVING HIMSELF AND HIS BROTHER, JAMES PETER PARDUE, IN ROBBERIES OF THE NORTHERN WESTCHESTER NATIONAL BANK ON AUGUST SEVENTEEN, SIXTY NINE, AND THE FAIRFIELD TRUST COMPANY, GEORGETOWN, CONNECTICUT, ON OCTOBER TWENTY TWO, SIXTY EIGHT; THE CITIZEN'S BANK OF PACIFIC, IN PACIFIC, MISSOURI, ON MAY NINE, SIXTY NINE, AND THE UNITED BANK OF UNION, UNION, MISSOURI, ON NOVEMBER THIRTEEN, SIXTY NINE.

IN ADDITION, PARDUE STATED THAT ONE LEE POLK WAS ALSO A PARTICIPANT IN THE VISTA, NEW YORK, ROBBERY AND THAT POLK, AS WELL AS ONE DICK GREGORY, WAS INVOLVED IN THE GEORGETOWN ROBBERY ON OCTOBER TWENTY TWO, SIXTY EIGHT.

PARDUE STATED THAT POLK AND GREGORY WERE MURDERED BY HIM AND HIS BROTHER, JAMES, IN LATE SIXTY EIGHT OR EARLY SIXTY NINE IN REDDING, CONNECTICUT, AND THEY WERE THEREAFTER TRANSPORTED BY THEM TO KENT, CONNECTICUT, WHERE THE BODIES WERE COVERED BY BRUSH, SOAKED WITH GASOLINE AND BURNED.

THE BODIES OF TWO MALES WERE LOCATED IN KENT, CONNECTICUT, IN APRIL, SIXTY NINE, AND ALTHOUGH EXTENSIVE INVESTIGATION WAS CONDUCTED BY THE CONNECTICUT STATE POLICE, NO IDENTIFICATION WAS MADE BECAUSE OF THE CHARRED CONDITIONS OF THE BODIES AND THE ADVANCED STATE OF DECOMPOSITION. WHEN LOCATED, THE BODIES WERE COVERED WITH PARTIALLY BURNED BRUSH, INCLUDING BRANCHES OF WHAT APPEARED TO BE A DISCARDED CHRISTMAS TREE.

IN ADDITION, PARDUE, ACCORDING TO THE FBI, IN HIS DYING DECLARATION, INVOLVED HIMSELF AND HIS BROTHER, JAMES, IN THE MURDERS OF HIS FATHER JOHN RUSSELL PARDUE, SR., AND HIS GRANDMOTHER

DAISEY LINK PARDUE IN UNION, MISSOURI, ON NOVEMBER ELEVEN, SIXTY EIGHT, TWO DAYS BEFORE THE ROBBERY OF THE BANK THERE. PARDUE CLAIMED THAT HIS BROTHER JAMES KILLED HIS FATHER AND GRANDMOTHER WHEN HIS FATHER OBJECTED TO THEIR USING HIS FARM AS A HIDEOUT. THE TWO BODIES WERE THEN TRANSPORTED BY THE BROTHERS FROM MISSOURI TO LUSBY, MARYLAND, IN THEIR FATHER'S SMALL UTILITY TRAILER ATTACHED TO THE FATHER'S AUTOMOBILE. DURING THE INTERVIEW, PARDUE DREW A SKETCH MAP SHOWING WHERE THE BODIES WERE BURIED ON JAME'S PROPERTY IN LUSBY, MARYLAND. THE BODIES HAVE SINCE BEEN DISINTERRED AND IDENTIFIED.

IN THE GEORGETOWN BANK ROBBERY, ACCORDING TO PARDUE, LEE POLK AND DICK GREGORY KILLED WILLIAM ARTMAN WHEN HE REFUSED TO GIVE UP HIS AUTOMOBILE WHICH THEY SOUGHT FOR USE AS A GET-AWAY CAR IN THE ROBBERY. ARTMAN'S BODY WAS SUBSEQUENTLY FOUND IN THE TRUNK OF HIS CAR WHERE IT WAS ABANDONED A SHORT TIME AFTER THE ROBBERY.

JAMES PETER PARDUE IS CURRENTLY BEING HELD AT THE FEDERAL MEDICAL CENTER IN SPRINGFIELD, MISSOURI, WHERE HE IS UNDERGOING TREATMENT AND OBSERVATION TO DETERMINE HIS COMPETENCY TO STAND

Investigation being conducted in conjunction with Connecticut State Police in efforts to corroborate information furnished by JOHN RUSSELL PARDUE, JR. (deceased) to the effect that LEE GEORGE POLK was a participant in two bank robberies with the PARDUE brothers and that one DICK GREGORY (PH) was involved with them in one bank robbery. PARDUE advised that thereafter in late 1968 or early 1969, they murdered POLK and GREGORY in Redding, Connecticut and transported the bodies to Kent, Connecticut where they burned them beyond recognition.

Employment records at Southern New England Telephone Company, Stamford, Connecticut, list employment for LEE G. POLK in the summer of 1968 and in those records he shows his date of birth as 2/28/48 (no place given) and his social security number as 419-84-0763.

POLK was, at the same time in 1968, employed with the Courtlands Convalescent Home, Courtland Avenue, Stamford, Connecticut, where he gave his social security number as 412-74-0837 and his date of birth as 2/28/45 and place of birth in those records was listed as Nashville, Tennessee. He gave his mother's name and address as Mrs. JONNIE E. HOLMAN, 414 Gould Street, Nashville, Tennessee.

Efforts made previously by Memphis Office failed to locate either Mrs. HOLMAN or the above listed address.

Through check of records of the Courtland Convalescent Home, it was determined that one [redacted] who gave her home address as [redacted] Stamford, Connecticut, was also employed there with POLK. Both POLK and [redacted] were fired from their employment at the Courtland Convalescent Home on 8/19/68 and reason for dismissal was for personal misconduct. Allegations were made that they were engaged in immoral activities at the home.



That application further discloses that LEE attended Ward High School (no location given) and indicates he completed the 11th grade. The application also states "U.S. Army, E. (or F.) C. Center", 12th grade. His application shows he was in the United States Army from September, 1963 to May, 1968 having attained the rank of sergeant and listed his salary as \$358.60. Under comments on that application he states that he worked as an orderly for four months at the Sumner County Hospital in Tennessee (no town given) at \$2.00 per hour. He indicates that employment was in 1963.

Records of the Southern New England Telephone Company, 84 Lenox Avenue, Stamford, Connecticut, contain a copy of an application for employment executed in the name of LEE G. POLK and he gives his permanent address as Courtland Gardens, Stamford, Connecticut. In that application he lists his social security number as 419-84-0763 and telephone number 327-1033 (telephone number of Courtland Gardens) and telephone number 327-9236. He lists his date of birth as 2/28/45, his height as 5'11", weight 180 pounds and indicated that he lived at the above address for one month.

In the above application under education, he indicates attendance at the Ward High School, Chicago, Illinois from November, 1962 through the 11th grade. 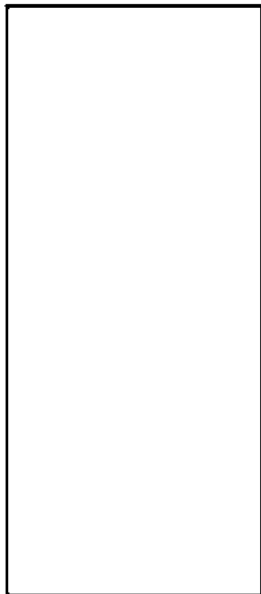

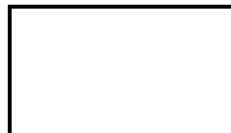
