Dear Mr. Dowers:

On May 24, 1977, the Commission mailed you an Official Notice of Violation (FCC Form 795), notifying you that your Amateur radio station WA6DJT had been operated on various dates in April and May, 1977, in violation of the following Sections of the Commission's Rules: 97.87(a) (station identification); 97.114(c) (business communications); 97.121 (false call sign), and 97.123 (operator identification).

At the time, you had located your station in the People's Temple facilities in San Francisco, California, and had permitted it to be operated by members of People's Temple to communicate with their missionary outpost in Guyana.

In your reply to the Commission's notice, you indicated what action you had taken to prevent any recurrence of the violations. Your reply also requested an interpretation of Section 97.111(c) as it relates to the communications between People's Temple, a non-profit charitable organization, and its missionary outpost.

Section 97.111(c) provides as follows:

97.111 Third party traffic.

The transmission or delivery of the following amateur radiocommunication is prohibited:

- (a) Intentional third party traffic except with countries which have assented thereto.
- (b) Third party traffic involving material compensation, either tangible or intangible, direct or indirect, to a third party, a station licensee, a control operator, or any other person.

- (c) Except for an emergency communication as defined in this part, third party traffic consisting of business communications on behalf of any party. For the purpose of this section business communication shall mean any transmission or communication the purpose of which is to facilitate the regular business or commercial affairs of any party.

In adopting this rule, the Commission gave consideration to what types of third party communications should be permitted. The Commission believed "that the best solution lies between the extremes of prohibiting entirely third party communication and permitting unlimited third party operations. To prohibit entirely third party traffic would tend to stifle one of the basic purposes of the Amateur Radio Service, which is to provide a voluntary non-commercial radio service. But to allow all third party communications would tend to cause increased congestion in the Amateur bands." (In the Matter of Inquiry Into the Extent to Which Amateur Stations Should Be Used on Behalf of Non-amateur Organizations, p. 493, Docket No. 19245 (FCC 72-895), 37 F.C.C. Reports, p. 492). Thus, the Commission limited the prohibition on third party traffic to business communications which "facilitate the regular business or commercial affairs of any party." (Emphasis supplied.)

By letter dated November 28, 1975, the Commission issued a declaratory ruling on Section 97.114 in response to an inquiry from Mr. Orvis L. Wertz, Trustee, Trinity Radio Station, WB9LIG, C-1905 Trinity College, Deerfield, Illinois 60015. (FCC 75-1241/97245). In its letter, the Commission stated, in part:

Under these rules personal and emergency third party communications are permitted. In addition, third party traffic on behalf of an organization is permitted to the extent it does not involve the regular business or commercial affairs of the organization, or during emergencies. Organizational third party traffic involving regular business or commercial affairs is, however, prohibited. Under these rules an organization like the Red Cross is allowed to use Amateur radio to coordinate disaster activities but not for its day-to-day functions.

As indicated in Docket 19245 more than 2000 comments were received so as to consider them for inclusion and

organizations from encroaching upon the amateur radio frequency spectrum, and legitimate purposes of the Amateur Service. In adopting these rules, it was the Commission's belief that amateur radio should not become a quasi-business type radio service. Such activities would be outside of the scope and purpose of the Amateur Service. (Sec 97.1).

The Amateur Service was never intended to take the place of a two-way business radio communication service or a common carrier operation. Simply because a non-amateur organization finds amateur stations convenient with which to meet its regular non-emergency communications needs cannot justify the use of amateur frequencies. While the Commission encourages amateur operators to handle and develop a message handling capability, it would not be consistent with the purposes of the Amateur Radio Service to permit an amateur station to operate what amounts to a communications service for a third party entity -- notwithstanding the fact that the entity may be highly meritorious. (FCC 75-1241/97246, dated November 23, 1973).

The communications involving your radio station related to the normal day-to-day administrative details of operating the missionary outpost of People's Temple. This type of communication has previously been interpreted by the Commission as constituting the regular business affairs of a charitable organization. (Letter from Chief, Safety and Special Radio Services Bureau, to Brother Paul Keiner, St. Meinrad Archabbey, St. Meinrad, Indiana 47577, dated May 26, 1977).

You are therefore advised that the use of your radio station to facilitate the administrative and operating functions of the People's Temple missionary outpost are prohibited third party communications, as defined in Section 97.114(c) of the Commission's Rules. You are further cautioned that a continuation of such transmissions by Amateur radio station W401J, could result in the imposition of enforcement sanctions such as monetary forfeiture, or, if necessary, revocation and/or cease and desist proceedings.

Dear Mr. Bowers:

Your correspondence to the Commission's facility, at Post Office Box 6, Douglas, Arizona 85607, received May 15, 1978, has been referred to this office for disposition.

In your letter, in reference to notices of violation, you state that you cannot control the use of your station. After acknowledging your responsibility to control your station, you further state that "to that end I am enclosing my current license."

In our previous correspondence to you, dated May 8, 1978, we advised that your radio communications on behalf of People's Temple on the dates of violation had constituted business communications, in violation of Section 97.114(c) of the Commission's Rules. We further cautioned you to discontinue such communications. We did not ask you for your license. Accordingly, we are enclosing your license.

If, in fact, you cannot control the use of your station, and therefore wish to have your license cancelled, you may do so by submitting a letter to this office requesting cancellation, and enclose your license.

In re: Amateur radio station WD6DVI.

Dear Mr. Adams:

On May 16, 1978, Commission engineers monitored radio transmissions between your station and Amateur radio station W4CETJ. Your communications related to the business affairs of People's Temple. A transcript of the communications is enclosed. The communications appear to be in violation of Section 97.114(c) of the Commission's Rules.

Section 97.114(c) provides as follows:

§97.114 Third party traffic.

The transmission or delivery of the following amateur radio communication is prohibited:

- (a) International third party traffic except with countries which have assented thereto.
- (b) Third party traffic involving material compensation, either tangible or intangible, direct or indirect, to a third party, a station licensee, a control operator, or any other person.
- (c) Except for an emergency communication as defined in this part, third party traffic consisting of business communications on behalf of any party. For the purpose of this section business communication shall mean any transmission or communication the purpose of which is to facilitate the regular business or commercial affairs of any party.

In adopting this rule, the Commission gave consideration to what types of third party communications should be permitted. The Commission believed "that the best solution lies between the extremes of prohibiting entirely third party communication and permitting unlimited third party operations. To prohibit entirely third party traffic would tend to stifle one of the basic purposes of the Amateur Radio Service, which is to provide a voluntary non-commercial radio service. But to allow all third party communications would tend to cause increased congestion in the Amateur bands." (In the Matter of Inquiry Into the Extent to Which Amateur Stations Should Be Used on Behalf of Non-amateur Organizations, p. 493, Docket No. 19245 (FCC 72-895), 37 F.C.C. Reports, p. 492). Thus, the Commission limited the prohibition on third party traffic to business communications which "facilitate the regular business or commercial affairs of any party." (Emphasis supplied.)

By letter dated November 28, 1973, the Commission issued a declaratory ruling on Section 97.114 in response to an inquiry from Mr. Oris L. Wertz, Trustee, Trinity Radio Station, W89LIG, C-1005 Trinity College, Deerfield, Illinois 60015 (FCC 73-1241/97246). In its letter, the Commission stated, in part:

Under these rules personal and emergency third party communications are permitted. In addition, third party traffic on behalf of an organization is permitted to the extent it does not involve the regular business or commercial affairs of the organization, or during emergencies. Organizational third party traffic involving regular business or commercial affairs is, however, prohibited. Under these rules an organization like the Red Cross is allowed to use Amateur radio to coordinate disaster activities but not for its day-to-day functions.

The rules adopted in Docket 19245 were written, among other reasons, so as to preclude non-amateur communications and organizations from encroaching upon the amateur radio frequency spectrum, and legitimate purposes of the Amateur Service. In adopting these rules, it was the Commission's belief that amateur radio should not become a quasi-business type radio service. Such activities would be outside of the scope and purpose of the Amateur Service. (Sec. 97.1).

The Amateur Service was never intended to take the place of a two-way business radio communication service or a common carrier operation. The communications involving your radio station related to the normal day-to-day administrative details of operating the missionary outpost of People's Temple. This type of communication has previously been interpreted by the Commission as constituting the regular business affairs of a charitable organization. (Letter from Chief, Safety and Special Radio Services Bureau, to Brother Paul Keiner, St. Meinrad Archabbey, St. Meinrad, Indiana 47577, dated May 26, 1977).

You are therefore advised that the use of your radio station to facilitate the administrative and operating functions of the People's Temple missionary outpost are prohibited third party communications, as defined in Section 97.114(c) of the Commission's Rules. You are further cautioned that a continuation of such transmissions by Amateur radio station W6SOVI, could result in the imposition of enforcement sanctions such as monetary forfeiture, or, if necessary, revocation and/or cease and desist proceedings.

As discussed in our telephone conversation of May 16, 1978, WA6DTJ has submitted his license for cancellation. Unfortunately, this did not resolve the problem. On May 12, 1978, WA6DTJ was observed in communications with WB6MID/8R3 and WB6RTH/8R1 conducting church business, as they have daily for over a year. Comments were made by the subjects which alluded to your letter of May 9, 1978, and our most recent notice of violation to WA6DTJ. WA6DTJ stated at that time that he was going to "turn in his union card". After a brief pause, they resumed their conversation using the call sign "WD6DVI" instead of WA6DTJ.

Station Location: 1859 Geary Street, San Francisco, CA

WD6DVI is listed as a technician licensee in the current microfiche. You should be aware, however, that Mr. Adams was upgraded to general at our San Francisco field office on April 26, 1978. Their activity continues daily, using the call sign WD6DVI, conducting church business as usual. Attached, please find a sample of intercept from May 18, 1978. Note their attempt to code or disguise their references to real estate transactions. To reaffirm our telephone conversation, based on the attached intercept, you will address a letter to WD6DVI similar to the one you recently mailed to WA6DTJ. If they continue after receipt of the letter we will then issue a violation notice to WD6DVI charging non-compliance with Section 97.114(c). Your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.

This is a written response to an official notice of violation sent May 24, 1977, and issued by Harry E. Johnston.

With regard to the violations observed on April 22, 1977; April 27, 1977; April 28, 1977; April 29, 1977 and May 3, 1977; please be advised that the station was not under the direct supervision of a control operator at all times. This situation has now been corrected by taking the following steps:

1. The radio room, where all equipment is located, has been locked.
2. A control operator is present at all times when the equipment is operated. The control operator will be responsible that no such further violations take place.

With regard to the transmission of May 11, 1977, the undersigned would appreciate some clarification of the term "business". These conversations relate to a non-profit, charitable organization communicating with a missionary outpost in the interior of South America with no other means of telecommunicating to the outside world. I would make every effort to conform to established guidelines, but I remain unsure of the limit in this context and would appreciate your furnishing me some examples or illustrations so that I might better understand the existing limits.

The pastor of Peoples Temple of the Disciples of Christ, James V. Jones, was recently named one of the 100 most outstanding clergymen in the nation by Religion In American Life, an inter-faith organization.

Jones was honored for his guidance and inspiration in establishing the many humanitarian programs and facilities in Peoples Temple that attempt to meet every type of human need.

Peoples Temple is scattered over California, with members in many cities, traveling in the church's fleet of Greyhound type buses to worship services in San Francisco, Los Angeles, and the church in Redwood Valley.

A native of Indiana, Pastor Jones has been in California for 10 years. In that decade, Peoples Temple has grown from a meeting place in the garage of his home to 10,500 members in the three congregations.

RESPONDS

This ministry is known for responding to both public and private appeals for assistance, giving support to the local school system and law enforcement. The Temple has rehabilitated over 175 young people from hard-core drug habits and educated many local residents through its college program.

Pastor Jones and Peoples Temple have been viewed by many people. Dr. John Moore, District Superintendent of the United Methodist Church said, "Peoples Temple is a caring community of people of all

races and classes. They bear the mark of compassion and justice — compassion for the hungry and jobless, lonely and disturbed, and also for the earth and her offspring."

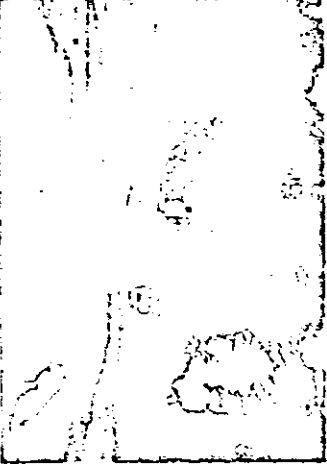

Whether through work projects, tutoring services, field trips, or music and dance programs, Peoples Temple strives to provide members a wholesome, well-rounded environment where social and intellectual growth is encouraged. Many Temple children have been adopted from broken homes and taken from the courts when no one else wanted them or thought there was hope for change. The love, guidance, and constructive programs have proven these doubts wrong in every case.

Group therapy, work skills training, recreational and educational activities are vital ingredients in the Temple's drug rehabilitation program, which has helped to free well over 300 young people from complete addiction to hard-line drugs. One young man was so disturbed from drug use that he hardly knew his own name when he arrived at our door. Now he is graduating from medical school at the top of his class. Another, once a juvenile delinquent deeply involved in hard drugs, is now a practicing attorney. The church

having supported him through law school. A former of Temple youth have been removed from lives of crime and irresponsible militancy. The mother of an addict is so great that not one active Temple young person has ever been to the courts or jail.

Rev. Jones spends hours counselling with young people and children, listening to their problems and helping guide them in constructive channels. Because children and seniors are very often ignored in a fast-moving world, he is especially concerned that they get the attention they deserve.

Senior citizens lead busy, productive and independent lives through Peoples Temple's comprehensive program for the elderly. Whether enjoying one of their special social dance evenings, or working together to make handicrafted items, it is assured that these seniors will maintain their dignity and self-respect, and not have to face loneliness. They set the standards they need to sustain as much self-sufficiency as possible, including transportation, medical attention, and legal services... all free of charge.

Through the Peoples Temple Wood Trades Shop, printing press, mechanics shop, and other programs, young people have developed a sense of responsibility and self-esteem while cultivating valuable skills. The woodshop has placed some 34 people in jobs. Its curriculum consists of rough carpentry, finishing, and cabinet making.

The Temple has also had success in its physical therapy department. Dr. Carlton Goodlett is one of the doctors who has been kind enough to help us organize our family assessment centers for physical therapy, Jacuzzi bath, ultra-sound and diathermy treatment equipment.

It is our belief that if every church would attempt to meet the needs of at least its own, it would have the effect of revitalizing our society, providing an effective answer from within to the problems of the "welfare state" by taking the burden of providing for people off the government. It is the fervent desire of Rev. Jim Jones and his congregation to help establish a society where hate and violence do not exist, where poverty and starvation are eliminated, and where, instead, a co-operative spirit of harmony and brotherhood prevails.

Agriculture Mission Offers New Hope For Young Urban "Incorrigibles"

Tommy, a young man who grew up in the slums of the big city, was in much of a problem that nobody, if asked, could deal with him. As a last resort, juveniles are usually released from the custody of Peoples Temple. He chose to go to the agricultural project (located in Guyana), and today he is a skilled worker, in charge of acres of gardens, with major responsibilities in a livestock development program he has helped set up.

He is just one of 21 "incorrigible" youths who have succeeded in a changed environment, in which they were given useful, rewarding work and training, a feeling of being cared for, and in which they discovered for the first time that they could really accomplish something worthwhile.

From every indication, it is certain that, without this program, many of the youths who have gone to Guyana would today be part of the crime problem in our city—some would right now be engaged, not only in theft and vandalism, but also in much more serious crime.

The temple's project is located on several thousand acres in the lush interior of the newly developing nation. The land is rapidly being transformed from virgin jungle into productive cropland and pasture. More than 200 varieties of vegetables, fruits and nuts are being cultivated. Cattle, chickens, and pigs are raised. A fully equipped and professionally staffed medical clinic is in the works, and a sawmill and pulping processing plant have been constructed.

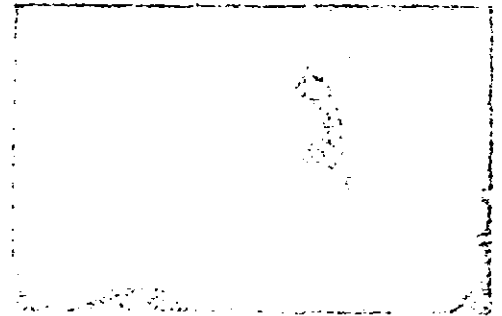
The community surrounding these projects is a busy, cooperative, native Guianese town and works along with the North Americans in a lifestyle that combines work, recreation, and cultural enrichment, in a rural setting.

The project has been visited and enthusiastically praised by both Guyanese and American officials.

The positive, healthful, and natural environment has proved remarkably successful in bringing about fundamental changes in individuals considered "hopeless cases" in settings where there were frustration, alienation, and very few opportunities.

One of the project coordinators says, "Our experience with the Guyana project and the dramatic changes that have come over the lives of the young people who have participated there have made us 'environmental determinists,' so to speak. We are convinced that a change in the physical and social conditions in which a child grows up play a critical role in shaping the personality."

Prisons, where the environment reinforces and significantly hardens the negative, destructive patterns of inmates, contribute to the problem. Rev. Jim Jones, who initiated the Guyana project, warns that "we had better, as a society, begin seriously to explore and develop environments and social structures that attack the problem at the roots. The setting of despair, violence, and poverty that characterizes inner cities is the culprit. The prisons merely release their inmates back into

the environment, bitter, and with the stigma of 'ex-con.' What else can we expect but a high recidivism rate?

"It is time for society," Jones continued, "to break this vicious circle. It is time to develop alternatives, such as co-operative communities where real rehabilitation can take place, where young people can be given a chance to develop their talents rather than having them frustrated and channeled into criminal and antisocial patterns. It could be that initiatives in this area might become a starting point for larger efforts to solve the problem of decaying inner cities and the ghettoization of its residents.

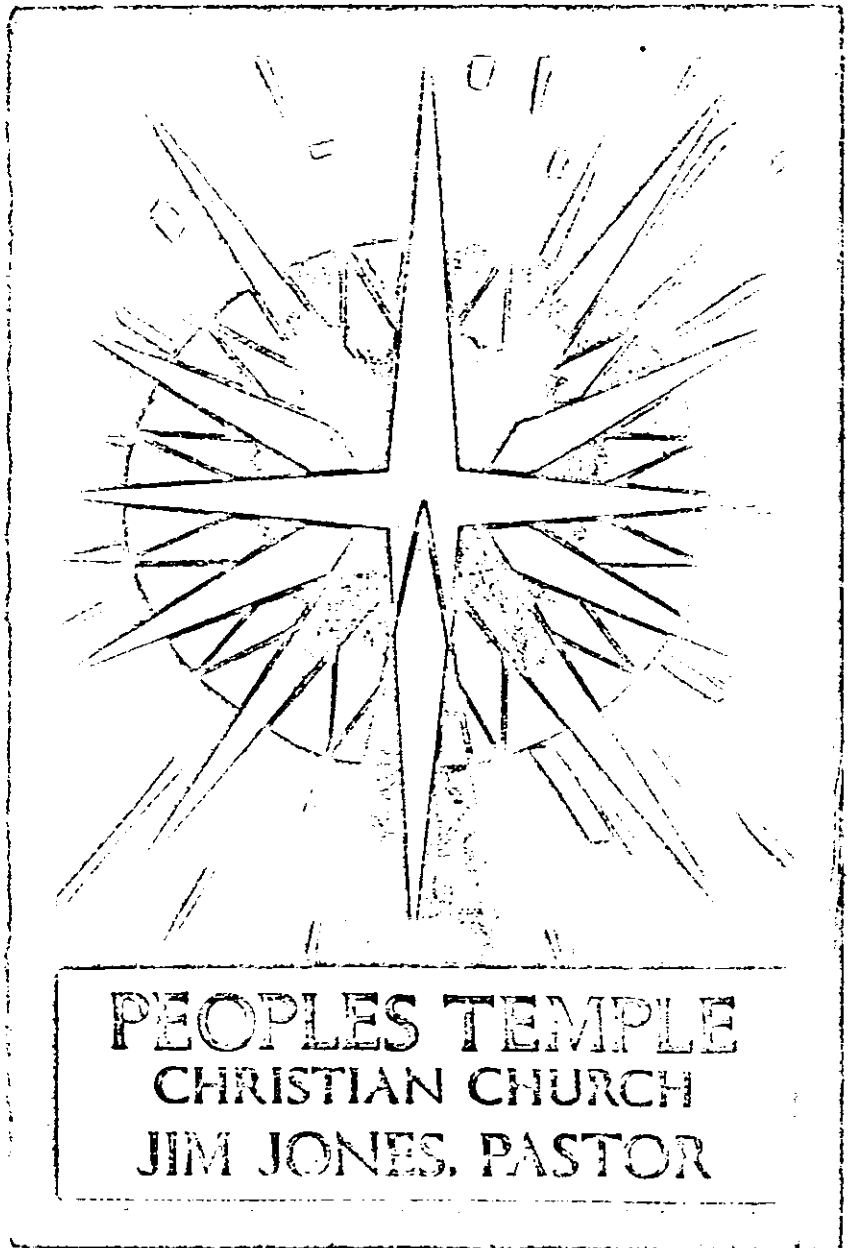
"It is time to take a cue from organizations that are building such communities, which are not only pointing out social ills, not only discussing and proposing meaningful remedies, but making them work to bring about practical solutions. If we don't make a beginning, time and lives will continue to be wasted in futile efforts to

make outmoded and ineffective formulas work."

Jones also feels some discomfort about the fact that the public is receiving what can only be termed a form of brainwashing through so many TV shows. Popular programming has had its effect in encouraging people to hate others who are not "normal" or well-adjusted, to consider them as somehow socially unacceptable, thus providing a ready-made justification for their removal from society for punitive incarceration. Even people who are mentally ill, he notes, are being put in this category and are regarded as not quite "human."

The Guyana project, Rev. Jones feels, could serve as a model for similar experiments here in the United States. "We need to humanize our institutions and see people as not essentially bad or 'incorrigible,' but as victims of environment—and we need to do something about that environment."

Peoples Temple is an extensive ministry based on the practical teachings of Jesus as literally set forth in Matthew 25, in which He admonishes us to feed the hungry, shelter the homeless, and minister to the sick and imprisoned. The Temple teaches one to meet every type of human need. Through its programs which have rehabilitated over 200 young people from drug habits. More than 100 students, many of whom live in dormitories provided by the church, are being financed in medicine, law, teaching, and other human service fields. The Temple provides care in its own facilities for senior citizens, medical consultations, orphans, and disabled children. These and other humanitarian efforts demonstrate the conviction in Peoples Temple that the highest worship of God is service to one's fellow man.

Rev. Jim Jones is an officially ordained minister of the 1.4 million member mission Church (Districts of Christ) denomination. He is a graduate of Bowler University and has been pastor of his church for almost 25 years. He has served as a public school teacher and also has been very successful in business. Pastor Jones spent two years on sabbatical as a foreign missionary, establishing programs for orphans. More recently, he has begun a foreign agricultural mission on thousands of acres to produce food for distribution to critical hungry regions. He travels many hundreds of miles each week with the Temple fleet of Greyhound-type buses to minister to the three Peoples Temple churches in Redwood Valley, Los Angeles, and San Francisco.

Pastor Jones' steadfast support of the Constitution and encouragement of responsible citizenship have led to his serving with acclaim in many civic posts. These include Grand Jury Foreman and Executive Secretary of the Human Rights Commission of a large mid-western city. He has received numerous commendations for his work, including a special award for civic leadership presented by the President of the National Newspaper Publishers Association. Pastor Jones and his wife, Marjorie, who is a state official, live modestly in a comfortable house in Redwood Valley, California. Their home is next to one of the Temple's large refuge centers where they take in and care for 100 and abandoned animals of every kind. Pastor Jones and his wife have one natural born son and five adopted many impoverished children of different races and ethnic backgrounds.

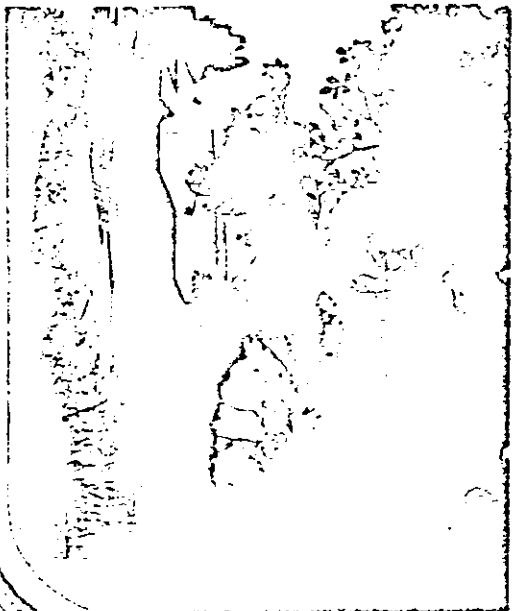

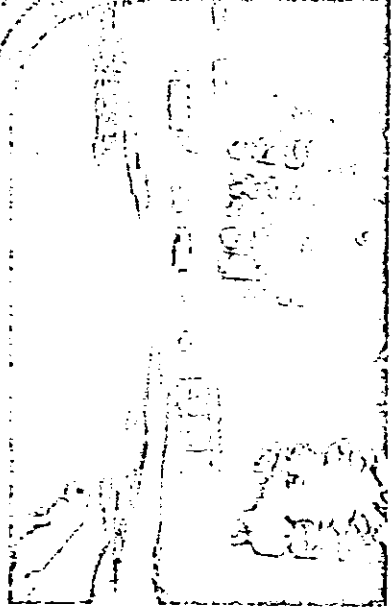

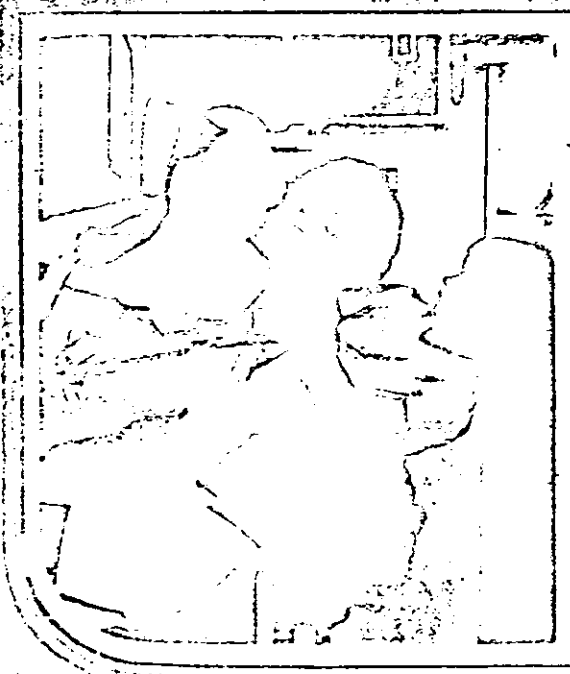
Out-of-town members tour the grounds of one of the church facilities. This rest home, typical of other Temple facilities, has earned highest awards for excellent care.



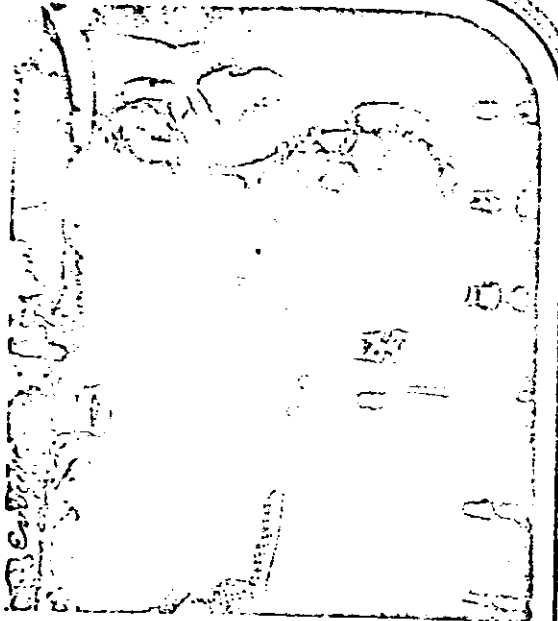

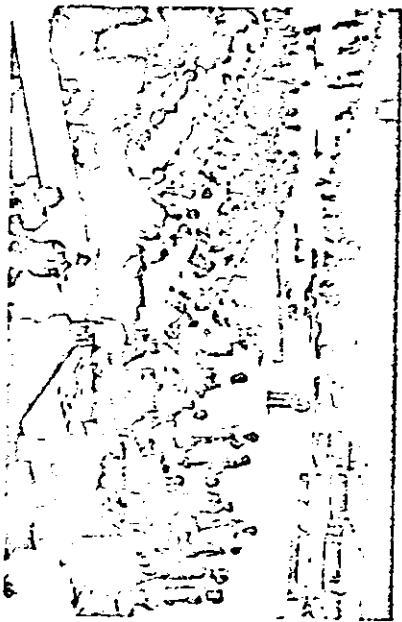

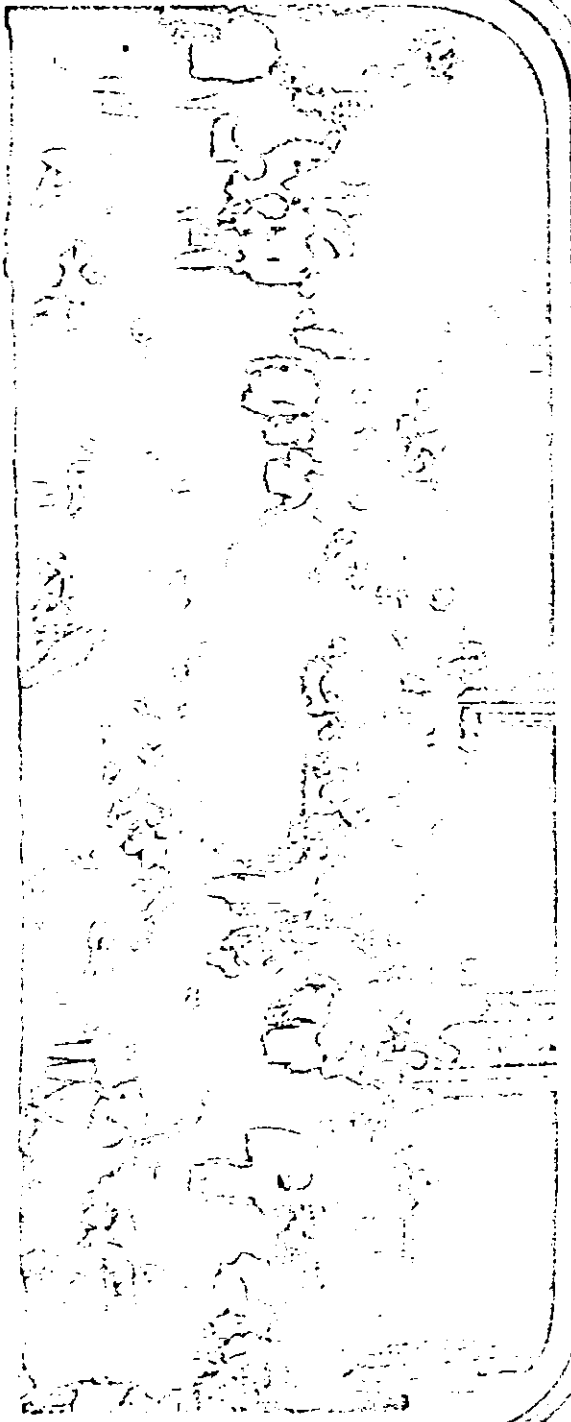
