In connection with the Federal Bureau of Investigation's investigation into the assassination of United States Congressman LEO J. RYAN at Port Kaituma, Guyana, South America, on November 18, 1978, a tape recording was obtained. This tape recording was located in Jonestown, Guyana, South America, and was turned over to United States Officials in Guyana and subsequently transported to the United States.

On June 11, 1979, Special Agent [REDACTED] reviewed the tape numbered 1B102-C42. This tape was found to contain the following: A blank tape.
