Clayton has changed his story several times, however, was paid by the "National Enquirer," San Francisco, for his story. Oglesby stated Clayton would be a good witness to the incident. SA [REDACTED] was advised. (u)

[redacted] advised that [redacted] ROBERT HOMER
 STROUD, DOB [redacted], presently residing [redacted]
 [redacted], is a member of
 People's Temple and was in Georgetown, Guyana, 11/18/78.
 Since the incident at Georgetown, Guyana on 11/18/78, she
 has received what might be considered threats by unknown
 individuals. People are insinuating that since [redacted]
 was "over there," she does not deserve to live in a re-
 spectable community such as [redacted]. She does
 not consider the community attitudes to be in the form
 of threats to harm her person, relatives, home, or
 possessions, but it is those attitudes which she considers
 harassments and which give her an uncomfortable feeling.
 She mentioned this to [redacted] when he called her on 12/31/78.
 He advised her to contact the FBI and request pro-
 tection. [redacted] was later interviewed and was ad-
 vised the FBI could furnish her no protection and in
 the event of any threats, she should contact local law
 enforcement agencies. (u)

[redacted] was interviewed at John F. Kennedy International Airport, Queens, New York (NY), after his departure from Pan American flight 228 arriving from Georgetown, Guyana. [redacted] was interviewed in the presence of Agent [redacted], United States Secret Service and furnished the following information: (u)

[redacted] he first got involved with the Peoples Temple (PT) Church in 1975, when his mother took him to several meetings at the PT headquarters in Los Angeles, California. He stated as his mother was a member, he also joined the PT. In 1976, [redacted] stated he moved to [redacted] San Francisco and then attended meetings at the PT headquarters in San Francisco. He advised he was part of [redacted]

He advised he maintained the position until March, 1978, when he left San Francisco by bus en route to Florida where he eventually took a plane to Georgetown, Guyana (u)

Upon arrival in Jonestown, [redacted] he remained assigned to [redacted]

[redacted] it was not an easy job as he was required to work twelve hours a day. At the end of his work hours, [redacted] advised everyone then went to the pavilion for a meeting with Rev. JONES. (u)

He stated although he was [REDACTED] he knew other members in Jonestown that did have authority to carry weapons. These weapons consisted of shotguns, rifles, and handguns. [REDACTED] advised the individuals that used these weapons were: (u)

- ED CRENSHAW
- JIMMY JONES
- TIM JONES
- LOU JONES
- BILLY OLIVER
- BRUCE OLIVER
- DANNY MOTTEN

[REDACTED] JOE WILSON was in charge of training the men with the weapons although he never saw them actually train. [REDACTED] he did not know how or where these weapons came from, but that they were to be used to defend Jonestown in case of attack.

[REDACTED] Rev. JONES would tell the members that the CIA or other groups in the United States may try to attack Jonestown and we have to be prepared for such an attack. (u)

[REDACTED] if Jonestown was attacked and we had to relocate some place else, he felt it might be Russia because a Soviet doctor and Ambassador named TIMOFEYEV came to Jonestown several months ago to praise us and our work. After the visit from the Soviet Ambassador, Rev. JONES had some of the members learning how to speak Russian. (u)

[REDACTED] the weapons were kept in JIMMY JONES and JOHNNY COBB's cottage and when a "white night" was called, the weapons would be brought out. He advised these "white night" drills were strange. Everyone would be in the pavilion and Rev. JONES would ask questions about who wanted to die and if you were prepared to die. [REDACTED] you had to say you wanted to die or the Rev. would want to know why you were not prepared to die. [REDACTED] the whole thing was very strange (u)

[REDACTED] he was not aware of any plans to kill any officials of another government, including Congressman RYAN. He advised that Friday morning, when RYAN was coming to Jonestown, he was assigned to [REDACTED] members of the group that were at the airport that morning were: (u)

JOHNNY JONES
JIM MAC ELVANE
HARRIET TROPP
JUDY IJAMES
MIKE PROKES
STANLEY GIEG

[REDACTED] at first, they were not going to let the plane land. STANLEY GIEG, who was driving the truck, was going to ride up and down the landing field so the plane could not set down. [REDACTED] when the plane was in sight, JOHNNY JONES ordered STANLEY to let it land. After the plane landed, RYAN and his party got on the truck [REDACTED] RYAN was also accompanied by MARK LANE and CHARLES GARY, who were friends of Rev. JONES. [REDACTED] Friday night RYAN was entertained in Jonestown and then spent the night there. (u)

[REDACTED] on Saturday morning everyone was supposed to have the day off, however, [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] on Saturday night the Guyana Defense Force soldiers told him about the shooting of RYAN and then the next day they learned about the mass suicides at Jonestown. [REDACTED] he had no advanced knowledge that either of these events were going to take place. (u)

[REDACTED] he then went to Georgetown where he has been staying. (u)

[REDACTED] he does not feel anyone is going to try to kill him or any other survivors of Jonestown because he does not consider themselves defectors. He feels the PT will continue in San Francisco, but that something like Jonestown will never happen again. (u)

[REDACTED] ORDELL RHOADES was at Jonestown on the day of the RYAN killing and when the suicides were taking place and he would be able to advise what happened that day. (u)

[REDACTED] he would be returning to his wife's [REDACTED] residence at [REDACTED] and could be reached there if further needed. (u)

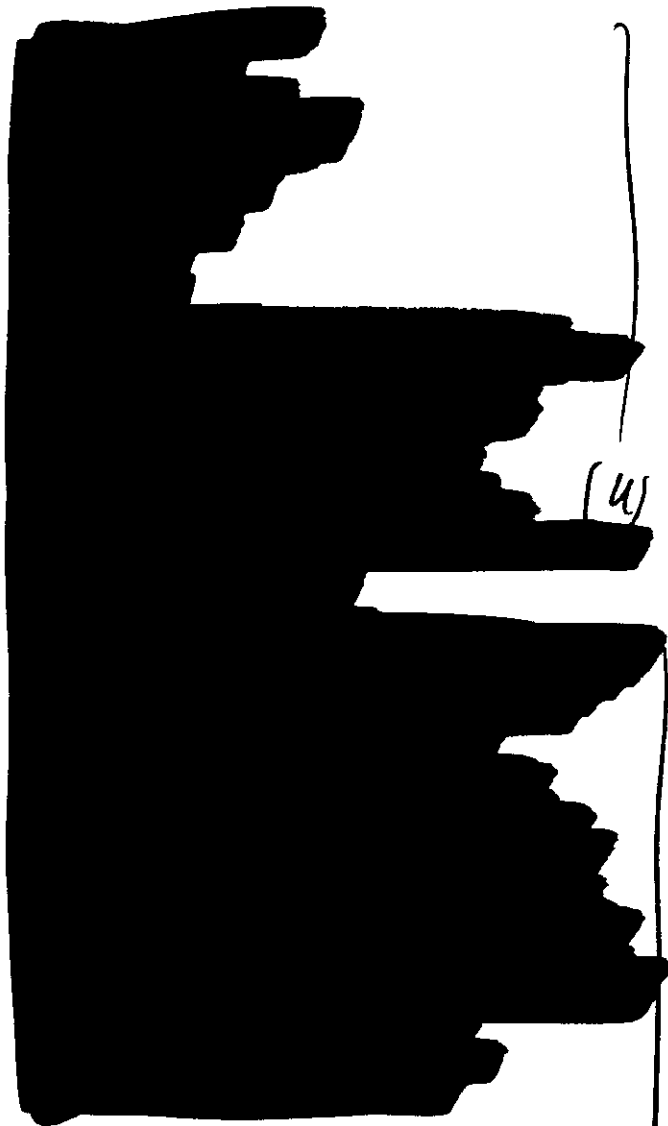

On December 21, 1978, at approximately 8:00 PM, [REDACTED] was interviewed at John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFKIA), concerning the assassination of Congressman LEO J. RYAN by [REDACTED] Special Agent (SA) of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI). Also present during the interview was Secret Service Agent [REDACTED] (u)

[REDACTED] was appraised of the nature of the interview and the identities of the Agents (u)

[REDACTED] stated that she was willing to be interviewed without the presence of an Attorney. (u)

[REDACTED] she first became aware of the People's Temple [REDACTED]. She stated that [REDACTED] met Reverend JONES while [REDACTED] in night school. [REDACTED] she became involved in the People's Temple through [REDACTED] when she was about [REDACTED] she signed approximately 25 - 30 blank pieces of paper. Other papers, which she signed, had compromising statements printed on them, such as that she would be willing to help conspire to blow up government monuments. [REDACTED] explained forms of torture that were executed by Reverend JONES to discipline his followers. One of the most used forms of torture was "spankings" with a board. Individuals were "spanked" with a board approximately 75 to 100 times. [REDACTED] was disciplined in this manner two times, once for being drunk and once for refusing to do something. The older people of the compound were known as seniors. The seniors disciplined other seniors by hitting those to be disciplined with their canes. Other forms of torture were boxing and putting those to be disciplined in a box with a tape playing which constantly repeated the same message, "I'll be a changed person when I get out". (u)

[REDACTED] only the staff would have knowledge of the Planning Commission or bribery. [REDACTED] to her knowledge, two officials from the Russian Embassy came to the compound and said they would all be moving to Russia. (u)

[REDACTED] there were approximately 75 guns, pistols and rifles in the compound. [REDACTED] they were shipped in crates from San Francisco. [REDACTED] JONES loved to bury things. [REDACTED] some guns were probably buried or dropped down the well. (u)

[REDACTED] firearms was taught by the security heads. In San Francisco and Los Angeles, the female members of the People's Temple carried guns but not in Jonestown. [REDACTED] JOE WILSON, TOM KICE, STEVEN JONES and CALVIN DOUGLAS were some of the firearms instructors. (u)

As for any public official, state, federal or international being targeted for murder, [REDACTED] JONES did make comments but said nothing specific. (u)

[REDACTED] involved in two suicide rehearsals, but does not know of any relocation plans in the event of a mass suicide. (u)

[REDACTED] the Attorneys GERRY and LANE talked JONES into letting Congressman RYAN come to Jonestown. GERRY and LANE were aware of the potential danger of RYAN's life. While GERRY and LANE were in Jonestown, they were guarded by PONCHO. (u)

[REDACTED] the radio operators used many difference codes and that the Guyanese Government attempted to close down the radio. (u)

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[REDACTED] any member of the People's Temple in San Francisco would be capable of killing since they did not commit suicide. [REDACTED] PAULA ADAMS did favors for public officials. (u)

[REDACTED] helped build a primitive nuclear device. DON FITCH, JOE WILSON, MIKE TOUCHETTE and STEVEN JONES, also worked on the nuclear device. [REDACTED] it could be buried. (u)

[REDACTED] the term Alpha concerned JONES, who believed he was the Alpha and the Omega, like a God. (u)

[REDACTED] Dr. LAWRENCE SCHACHT was the cruelist, most vulgar person in Jonestown. SCHACHT was always "freaked out" on drugs and was only interested in JONES. (u)

[REDACTED] living conditions were very crowded in Jonestown and that no one except security could get close to West House or JONES. (u)

[REDACTED] the cyanide arrived on the Wednesday before the assassination. The cyanide was not on any inventory sheet [REDACTED] questioned its arrival, she received no real answer. (u)

[REDACTED] JONES said if anything happened in Jonestown, they should kill defectors. [REDACTED] its very hard to unravel this whole thing. [REDACTED] JONES played with their minds but she does not understand why. (u)

[REDACTED] she and her family accompanied RYAN to the airstrip and after the shooting, she hid in the bush for two days and two nights when she was picked up by the Guyanese and taken to the "Rum House" (u)

[REDACTED] she would not commit suicide and believes that the cheese sandwiches that were served for lunch that day were drugged. And then the people drank the punch. (u)

[REDACTED] she rode out to the airstrip on a dump truck and that there was a gun in the cabin. [REDACTED] there was another truck at the airstrip. The Guyanese police were on this truck and that they did nothing to stop the shooting (u)

[redacted] was interviewed at John F. Kennedy International Airport (JFKIA) upon his arrival from Guyana, in the presence of Special Agent (SA) [redacted] United States Secret Service (USSS), [redacted] the following information: (u)

[redacted] he knew Reverend JONES back in Indiana, however, at this time he was not a member of the People's Temple (PT) Church. [redacted] he moved to California to obtain employment, and at this time joined the PT Church. [redacted] at the time he joined the PT Church it was located in Redwood Valley, California, and there were no requirements to become a member. [redacted]

[redacted] Reverend JONES started searching members of the PT Church as they entered the building. These searches were conducted because Reverend JONES stated that threats had been made on his life. Also, about this time, new members had to attend three or four meetings before they were issued a membership card in the PT Church. (u)

[redacted] he never lived communal as other Church members did, and that he continued to reside and work outside the Church. [redacted] he donated 25% of his income to the PT Church, as was required. (u)

[redacted] he never made an oral oath or signed an oath to the PT Church. He stated that Reverend JONES did make members sign blank sheets of paper, and [redacted] this was some sort of attendance control. [redacted] he did not know what happened to these blank sheets of paper. [redacted] sometime later Reverend JONES required the members to write down statements incriminating themselves. [redacted] if you had a criminal record you would have to write this out and sign it. [redacted] other people were told to write down that they were homosexuals and sign the paper. (u)

b7c [REDACTED] Reverend JONES had approximately four to five bodyguards before he left Redwood Valley, California. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES took these bodyguards with him when he relocated in San Francisco. [REDACTED] he had no knowledge whether these bodyguards were armed or unarmed. [REDACTED] the bodyguards were called Security and also known as Apostolic Guardian. [REDACTED] he never saw a gun in the San Francisco Temple, however, he heard that there were guns there. [REDACTED] the searches of members entering the Temple continued in San Francisco. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES believed there was a conspiracy against him and the PT Church by deserters, or members who had left the Church. (u)

[REDACTED] the Planning Commission, which was made up of PT members close to Reverend JONES, began in Redwood Valley. [REDACTED] the Planning Commission really began to develop after Reverend JONES had moved to San Francisco. [REDACTED] he was not a member of the Planning Commission and had never attended a Planning Commission meeting. [REDACTED] he did not know what the purpose or function of the Planning Commission was, since had never been at their meetings. [REDACTED] the following PT members were in the Planning Commission and members of an inner core very close to Reverend JONES: (u)

[REDACTED] he was originally attracted to Reverend JONES because Reverend JONES appeared to be a humanitarian and preached equality for everyone. [REDACTED] (u)

b7c [redacted] Reverend JONES was not a religious man, and that he worked within the framework of a Church because it was profitable. [redacted] Reverend JONES often said he was the only God that the members would ever see. Reverend JONES told the members that if they waited for any other God, they would wait the rest of their lives. [redacted] in the beginning Reverend JONES did do a lot of good, and was responsible for helping a great many people give up narcotics. [redacted] Reverend JONES changed a great deal between the time he first knew him and the last days at Jonestown, Guyana. (u)

[redacted] discipline within the PT Church was very strict. Smoking, drinking, and sexual misconduct were not allowed. [redacted] Reverend JONES did not want the members to have anything to do with outsiders. [redacted] Reverend JONES wanted everyone to live communal. [redacted] punishment began with a few "smacks" in front of the entire membership. [redacted] the beatings began to get more severe as time progressed. He stated that Reverend JONES would call PT members out of the audience to administer the beatings. [redacted] eventually it got to the point where the accused was brought before the Planning Commission, and if they decided that he was guilty, he was then taken before the entire membership for punishment. [redacted] he has no knowledge of any "electric shock treatment" as a form of punishment. (u)

[redacted] he realized now that Reverend JONES had used politicians to serve his own ends, as he had used the PT members themselves. [redacted] Reverend JONES moved PT members in mass from one area of California to another to turn out the vote for favored candidates. [redacted] when JONES supported MOSCONE for Mayor of San Francisco, he supported DI MALLY, and President CARTER. [redacted] could not recall whether Reverend JONES had supported Governor BROWN in the race for Governor of California. [redacted] if Reverend JONES did support Governor BROWN it was not

b7c active a support as the other candidates mentioned above. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES was a very shrewd man, and that he may have used the politicians names for his own gain after he supported them. [REDACTED] he had no knowledge of a trip made by Lieutenant Governor DI MALLY to Guyana. (u)

[REDACTED] April 1, 1978, he went to Guyana. [REDACTED] he received his tickets and made arrangements for baggage with JIM RANDOLPH. [REDACTED] each departing member was allowed to take seven duffel bags with him. [REDACTED] took two duffel bags containing his belongings and five duffel bags that were furnished by the PT Church. [REDACTED] he does not know what the additional five duffel bags contained. [REDACTED] at Georgetown, Guyana, and spent five days there before continuing on to Jonestown. [REDACTED] at Georgetown, Guyana, they were met by MIKE CARTER and JOCELYN CARTER, and taken to Lahama Gardens. [REDACTED] SHARON AMOS and KAREN LAYTON were at Lahama Gardens. (u)

[REDACTED] upon arrival at Jonestown, he immediately realized that something was wrong. [REDACTED] the guards at the front gate leading to Jonestown were armed with guns. [REDACTED] he had no knowledge of how the guns were shipped to Jonestown. [REDACTED] there were at least 20 to 25 weapons at Jonestown, consisting of shotguns, rifles, and handguns. [REDACTED] he did not know where the guns were kept, and that he had no knowledge of what was kept in Hut C-14. [REDACTED] the weapons were kept out of sight for a period of time following the defection of DEBBIE BLAKELY, because Reverend JONES feared an investigation. [REDACTED] a couple of weeks prior to November 18, 1978, the weapons were back out being carried by the Security Force. (u)

[REDACTED] the Security Force at Jonestown, Guyana, consisted of the following individuals: (u)

67c [REDACTED] Reverend JONES also had an Internal Security Force, consisting of members of the PT Church that spied on other members at Jonestown. [REDACTED] you could never be sure which members were part of this Internal Security, and therefore had to be very careful who you spoke with at Jonestown. [REDACTED], unlike the paradise they were promised, Jonestown was an armed camp where the PT members were held prisoners (u)

[REDACTED] prior to his arrival in Guyana, he had never heard Reverend JONES talk of suicide. [REDACTED] at Jonestown, Reverend JONES repeatedly talked of dying with dignity. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES called it "Revolutionary Suicide." Reverend JONES told the people that he had the poison at Jonestown. [REDACTED] the term "white night" was a code word for "Revolutionary Suicide." (u)

[REDACTED] Reverend JONES was convinced, and had many members of the PT commune at Jonestown convinced, that there was a CIA conspiracy against Reverend JONES and the PT Church. [REDACTED] he and a lot of the other people at Jonestown did not believe this, however, they were afraid to confront Reverend JONES with their opinion. (u)

[REDACTED] it was Reverend JONES' custom to have two to three meetings a week with all the members of the commune. At these meetings various problems or projects at

the commune were discussed. [REDACTED] on Friday night they usually had classes in Socialism. [REDACTED] this procedure changed during the last six weeks at Jonestown, stating that Reverend JONES held meetings which were called "Alerts" daily. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES kept the commune members busy day and night so that they were literally exhausted. [REDACTED] he learned at these alerts when JONES asked the people if they were ready to die with dignity, not to refuse. [REDACTED] the third day he was in Jonestown, he confronted Reverend JONES, stating that he saw no reason for suicide. [REDACTED] he was beaten by RONNIE JAMES and KENNY MC MURRAY, and from then on he never opposed Reverend JONES. (u)

[REDACTED] at these alerts Reverend JONES discussed problems that were confronting him and the PT Church. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES' biggest problem was the custody fight over "JOHN JOHN," the son of GRACE STONE. [REDACTED] on alert nights the Security at Jonestown were armed. Reverend JONES told the members of the PT Church that this was for their own protection, however, [REDACTED] he did not believe this. (u)

[REDACTED] he knows of one rehearsal in drinking unsweetened Kool-Aid, however, this occurred prior to his arrival at Jonestown. [REDACTED] this was supposed to be a test of the people's courage by Reverend JONES. (u)

[REDACTED] he could not recall any knowledge of Reverend JONES mentioning that Congressman RYAN would be assassinated. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES told the people that RYAN was working for the CIA and was out to get Reverend JONES and the PT Church. (u)

[REDACTED] Russian classes were being given to the members of the Jonestown commune. Reverend JONES told the people that the Russians had agreed to allow them into Russia. (u)

67C [REDACTED] Reverend JONES knew he had to get out of Guyana, that Guyana had been a bad choice. [REDACTED] this was because they were unable to raise any crops in Guyana. [REDACTED] on one occasion a member of the Russian Embassy accompanied by a Russian doctor, came to visit Jonestown. [REDACTED] on another occasion a reporter from the newspaper "Tass" was allowed to visit Jonestown. (u)

[REDACTED] every time a visitor came to Jonestown, Reverend JONES staged an act to impress them. [REDACTED] on these occasions the people were fed very well, and that they were given the answers to respond to any questions asked. [REDACTED] Reverend Jones had threatened the people with their lives if they did not give the correct answer to a question. (u)

[REDACTED] in addition to the beatings mentioned above, Reverend JONES also utilized as a form of punishment an Extended Care Unit. [REDACTED] the Extended Care Unit was a section of the clinic where individuals trying to escape from Jonestown when caught were taken and kept for a couple of days. [REDACTED] the individuals were drugged until they were completely helpless. [REDACTED] Dr. LAWRENCE SCHATZ knew what was going on in the Extended Care Unit, and that Dr. SCHATZ was not a qualified doctor. [REDACTED] this was another problem of Reverend JONES that was discussed during the nightly alerts. The Guyanese officials requested Dr. SCHATZ to come into Georgetown for licensing. JONES told them not to push him too far or they would come out and find 1200 dead bodies. [REDACTED] JONES' reply was relayed to the Guyanese Government through SHARON AMOS, PAULA ADAMS, KAREN LAYTON, and DEBBIE TOUCHETTE. (u)

[REDACTED] he had been planning an escape from Jonestown for a couple of months before the end. [REDACTED] he planned to leave with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] had hidden clothing along their escape route prior to the 18th of November. (u)

1978. [REDACTED] on November 18, 1978, he saw an individual pick up a parcel of clothing that he had hidden. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES was on to his escape plan, and felt that they would be coming after him. [REDACTED] he thought Reverend JONES knew of their escape plan. [REDACTED] went to ask Congressman RYAN if she and her family could leave with his party. [REDACTED] was talking with Congressman RYAN, MARCY JONES [REDACTED] attempted to have him talk [REDACTED] out of leaving Jonestown. MARCY JONES asked him to stay, and stated that things were going to change. [REDACTED] he knew she was lying, and that he told her it was a mistake to be in Guyana. [REDACTED] it was impossible to raise crops at Jonestown. [REDACTED] the members of the Jonestown commune could not go on much longer continuing to purchase all of their supplies. He believed that the PT would run out of money. MARCY JONES told [REDACTED] that Reverend JONES had enough money to keep them for the rest of their lives. (u)

[REDACTED] he went to speak with Congressman RYAN, and told RYAN that he [REDACTED] wished to depart with RYAN's party. [REDACTED] Reverend JONES asked him not to leave with RYAN, and stated that he was free to leave the next day. [REDACTED] knew Reverend JONES was lying. [REDACTED] he be allowed to leave with RYAN. [REDACTED] he told Congressman RYAN they were going to have trouble trying to get out of Jonestown. [REDACTED] he believed Reverend JONES would go through with his suicide idea rather than let everyone leave Jonestown. (u)

[REDACTED] he, 15 other PT members, RYAN, and the newsmen got onto the dump truck for the ride to the airstrip. [REDACTED] he observed LARRY LAYTON speaking with Reverend JONES. [REDACTED] it appeared LAYTON was trying to convince Reverend JONES to let him do something. [REDACTED] he believes this because LAYTON kept clasping his hands together in front of him in a prayer-like gesture. (u)

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[REDACTED] LAYTON put on a poncho and got on the truck explaining that he wanted to leave Jonestown. [REDACTED] he and other PT members leaving Jonestown attempted to convince RYAN and Ambassador DWYER (phonetic), who was from the Embassy and came to Jonestown with RYAN, not to allow LAYTON aboard the truck. [REDACTED] RYAN would not listen to them. [REDACTED] he and the other members departing Jonestown remained on the truck while RYAN spoke to the additional PT members wishing to leave Jonestown. [REDACTED] RYAN planned to leave with the people on the truck and put them on a plane, and then return to Jonestown for the other members wishing to leave. [REDACTED] at this time DON SLY attacked Congressman RYAN with a knife. Attorneys GARY and LANE wrestled the knife away from SLY. [REDACTED] he really did not believe that the people were going to get out of Jonestown. (u)

[REDACTED] RYAN got on the truck and they began to leave Jonestown. He stated that GARY and LANE remained behind, and he does not know the reason that they stayed. [REDACTED] when they reached the front gate of Jonestown, JOE WILSON got on the truck. As they proceeded along the road to the airstrip, WILSON kept staring at the PT defectors in the back of the truck. [REDACTED] when they arrived at the airstrip they got off the truck, and it started back towards the gate to the airfield. [REDACTED] there was only a small aircraft at the airstrip, and they had to await a larger plane. During this wait they demanded that Congressman RYAN have LAYTON searched before he was allowed on the plane. LAYTON was frisked, and the larger plane landed. [REDACTED] LAYTON insisted that he get on the first plane. Following the frisking of LAYTON, while he was still wearing the poncho, JOE WILSON walked up to LAYTON and shook his hand. [REDACTED] this is when WILSON handed LAYTON a gun. [REDACTED] as they began boarding the planes they saw the truck coming back being followed by a tractor and wagon. LAYTON, DALE PARKS, MONICA BAGBY, VERN GOSNEY, and TRACY PARKS boarded the smaller aircraft [REDACTED] the remainders boarded the larger aircraft, [REDACTED] (u)

b7c [REDACTED] observed the tractor and wagon pulling up approximately 30 feet from the aircraft (u)

[REDACTED] he observed RONNIE DENNIS, TOM KICE, JOE WILSON, ALBERT TOUCHETTE, and RONNIE JAMES, on the wagon being towed by the tractor. [REDACTED] STANLEY GEIG was driving the tractor pulling the wagon. At this point the individuals riding in the wagon opened fire on the aircraft. [REDACTED] the men were armed with M-16s and a gun that was fed by a belt of bullets, which appeared to be a machine gun. [REDACTED] other individuals aboard the dump truck were firing from the other side of the aircraft, however, he could not observe the individuals. [REDACTED] he fought to get his seat belt released and bent down as bullets were passing through the aircraft. [REDACTED] yelled, "My God look what they've done to Patty." [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED]'s head blown off, and noticed her brains splattered [REDACTED] the wagon circled the aircraft, continuing to fire at the aircraft and proceeded away toward the gate leading out of the airstrip. [REDACTED] pilot revved the engine of the aircraft attempting to take off. [REDACTED] a reporter banging on the door of the aircraft to enter, however, before the door could be opened the reporter crawled into the baggage door of the aircraft. [REDACTED] He asked the pilot not to take off without [REDACTED]. The pilot told [REDACTED] he could not get the aircraft off the ground, and all of the people exited the aircraft and ran into the jungle. (u)

[REDACTED] returned to the aircraft to get the wounded. They dragged the wounded into the high grass because they feared that the gunman may come back to see if they had killed everyone. [REDACTED] (u)

b7c [REDACTED] there were Guyanese soldiers at the airstrip when they were being shot at. [REDACTED] why they did not offer help, and they stated "It's Americans shooting Americans." [REDACTED] the Guyanese soldiers did give them a First Aid kit, and Ambassador DWYER (ph) called the Guyanese Defense Force (GDF) at Matthews Ridge, Guyana. [REDACTED] during this time LARRY LAYTON approached DALE PARKS and attempted to shoot him, however, the weapon misfired. DALE PARKS wrestled the gun away from LAYTON. [REDACTED] Ambassador DWYER (ph), although wounded himself, worked throughout the night to help the other wounded PT members. The survivors were eventually transported to Georgetown by the GDF. (u)

[REDACTED] he has no knowledge of a PT "hit list." [REDACTED] at Georgetown he was told by STEPHANIE JONES that STEVE JONES told EUGENE SMITH to get rid of the defectors. [REDACTED] the individuals he considered possible "hitmen" are STEVE JONES, CALVIN DOUGLAS, EUGENE SMITH, TERRY BUFFORD, and SANDY BRADSHAW. (u)

[REDACTED] during his stay at Jonestown, he was aware that RITA TUPPER was censoring all mail leaving Jonestown. (u)

[REDACTED] he was not that familiar with the operation of the radio, however he knows that they were using codes on the radio. [REDACTED] he was not aware of what codes were being used. He stated that SHARON AMOS and KAREN LAYTON operated the radio at Georgetown. [REDACTED] not know who operated the radio at Jonestown, however, Reverend JONES himself spent a lot of time in the radio room until he began using narcotics. [REDACTED] at San Francisco, California, the radio was operated by SANDY BRADSHAW, JEAN BROWN, and TOM ADAMS. (u)

[REDACTED] PAULA ADAMS operated out of Georgetown, Guyana, and that her job was Public Relations. [REDACTED] (u)

b7c [REDACTED] ADAMS manipulated Guyanese officials by the use of sex. (u)

[REDACTED] he had no knowledge of a bomb at Jonestown. He stated that STEVE JONES and some of the top security men were working with dynamite a couple of months prior to November 18th. (u)

[REDACTED] JOHNNY JONES, Jr. operated as the Administrator of Jonestown, and was assisted by TERRY BUFFORD when she was there. (u)

[REDACTED] Dr. LAWRENCE SCHACHT operated a shabby clinic at Jonestown, however, Dr. SCHACHT did have some fairly decent equipment. [REDACTED] the clinic was separate from the Extended Care Unit mentioned previously. [REDACTED] others working in the clinic were EDITH PARKS, DALE PARKS, DIANE LOUIE ROZYNKO, and JOYCE PARKS (DALE's wife). [REDACTED] JOYCE PARKS was in Caracas on November 18, 1978. (u)

[REDACTED] he did not know of the cyanide being at Jonestown. He stated that he had found hundred pound bags of "mono floro phosphate," and thought that it was an insecticide. [REDACTED] RUSSELL MOTEN told him that it was poison. [REDACTED] he did not know who ordered this, however, that it had been delivered on the "Cudjoe," the boat that the PT used to get back and forth between Jonestown and Georgetown. [REDACTED] he also thought that the PT owned a ship named the "Albatross," however, he learned from newsmen later that the PT Church leased the ship. [REDACTED] the operators of the ship were CHARLIE TOUCHETTE and RICHARD JANERO, who was aboard the ship as a buyer. [REDACTED] they had an outside crew that actually did the manual labor aboard the ship. (u)

[REDACTED] he knew of no drugs being produced or used at Jonestown, other than those in the Special Care Unit. [REDACTED] thoresene (ph) and valium were used in the Special Care Unit. [REDACTED] towards the end Reverend JONES was using drugs, and he believes that his nurse, (u)

ANNIE MOORE, was administering the drugs. (u)

[redacted] the people at Jonestown were making dolls to sell in Georgetown at Christmas to earn additional money. (u)

[redacted] he did not have knowledge of how much money the PT Church possessed. [redacted] the only knowledge he had was what MARCY JONES told him before he left. This was that Reverend JONES had enough money to take care of everyone for the rest of our lives. [redacted] he has no knowledge of bank accounts or where money is kept. (u)

[redacted] throughout his association with PT Church Reverend JONES had set up interracial marriages, and wanted white families to adopt black children. [redacted] did not believe in this. (u)

[redacted] the following information on the individuals listed below: (u)

TIM JONES, white male, adopted son of Reverend JONES. [redacted] not believe TIM JONES would carry out violence to the extent some others might. (u)

TIM JONES, black male. (u)

JIMMY JONES, Jr., Head of Security, adopted son of Reverend JONES. [redacted] would not rule out that JIMMY JONES, Jr. would try and get some of the defectors. (u)

EDDY CRENSHAW, truck driver. [redacted] he drove them to the airstrip of November 18, 1978. [redacted] he also drove back with the Security people that shot at the aircraft. Believed dead. (u)

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67C HERBERT NEWELL, black male, early 20's. [REDACTED] he was part time Security and member of the basketball team. [REDACTED] in the same position as JIMMY JONES, Jr. and TIM JONES.

JOHNNY COBB, black male, 20-21 years. Security, and member of basketball team.

JOHNNY JONES, Second or Third in command at Jonestown. Black male, adopted son of Reverend JONES. Associated with administrative side of operation.

MARK CORDELL, white male, 18-19 years, member of Security Force. Believed dead.

JIM MACELVANE, handled real estate at Los Angeles for the last two years. At Redwood Valley was in charge of Security. Died at Jonestown.

BILLY OLIVER, believed dead, might have been Security Patrol.

STEVE JONES, white male, son of Reverend JONES. Believed to be one of the most dangerous members of PT. "Hot Head."

67C LEE INGRAM, black male, 40's, the basketball team coach. Husband of SANDY BRADSHAW. [REDACTED] he would not trust INGRAM.

CHRIS O'NEAL, BRENDA PARKS' boyfriend, worked at the brick factory at Jonestown.

CALVIN DOUGLAS, black male, 19-20 years, Security Guard and basketball team. Alive in Georgetown.

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CLEVELAND NEWELL, black male, 25 years, Security, believed dead.

BONNIE SIMON, member of Security, believed dead.

PAUL MC CANN, white male.

PAULINE GROOT, white female, believed dead. Chemical Engineer, very intelligent person.

TOM GRUBBS, white male, 35-40 years, school teacher. GRUBBS built box half buried which was used to dry grain, and to punish PT members at Jonestown.

MARIE RANKIN, worked on insecticides. Very loyal supporter of Reverend JONES.

TERRY BUFFORD, white female, very close to Reverend JONES. Capable of devising strategy JONES used.

JEAN BROWN, white female, 40's, used to be a school teacher. Very high echelon PT member.

RENNIE KICE, black female, BOB KICE's wife. Believed dead.

LORA JOHNSTON, white female, 28-30 years. Loyal to Reverend JONES, however, she made too many mistakes to be trusted.

VERA YOUNG, not known [REDACTED]

JUNE CRYM, handled Finances at San Francisco Temple. Very close to Reverend JONES.

MIKE PROKES, white male, 35 years. Handled Public Relations in Georgetown. It was his job to keep the Guyanese Government satisfied. PROKES, TIM CARTER and MIKE CARTER, a white male, 24-25 years, were apprehended with \$500,000 and a letter to the Russian Embassy.

TIM CARTER, white male, 28-30 years.

He is ham radio operator out of his home with call letter [REDACTED]. On 12/27/78 a notice from Amateur Radio Relay League came over his radio, that any radio operator who had any contact with ALBERT TOUCHETTE of Peoples Temple in Guyana, should contact the FBI. (u)

[REDACTED] advised that on August 17, 1978, he was on his set trying to set up contact with anyone. He picked up the voice of a man who identified himself as ALBERT TOUCHETTE with call letters of WB6MID/8R3. They talked in generalities; TOUCHETTE said nothing about what he did for a living. [REDACTED] was trying to win a contest by contacting 100 countries and, realizing that TOUCHETTE's call letters meant he was a Californian operating out of the country of Guyana, he asked TOUCHETTE for his mailing address so that TOUCHETTE could verify by return mail that [REDACTED] contacted him in Guyana. TOUCHETTE provided the address of P.O. Box 893, Georgetown, Guyana. (u)

He sent required QSL card to TOUCHETTE so he could verify the conversation. He had no further radio contact with TOUCHETTE but a few days before Thanksgiving, 1978, he received back from TOUCHETTE a QSL card postmarked Guyana, 11/10/78. On the front of the card there was typed "Peoples Temple Agricultural Mission, WB6MID/8R3, ALBERT TOUCHETTE, Jonestown, Port Kaituma, N.W.R., Guyana, S.A." On the back of the card, was written "working to assist the Guyanese government to feed, cloth, house people and further the human service goals, that has territorialized the Peoples Temple for many years. Radio [REDACTED] confirms our QSO on 8117178 by SSB. Thanks for the QSL card and for your encouragement here at our Free Medical Clinic and Mission. We thank you as an amateur radio operator for your contact and expression of reassurance which has contributed to our success" (u)

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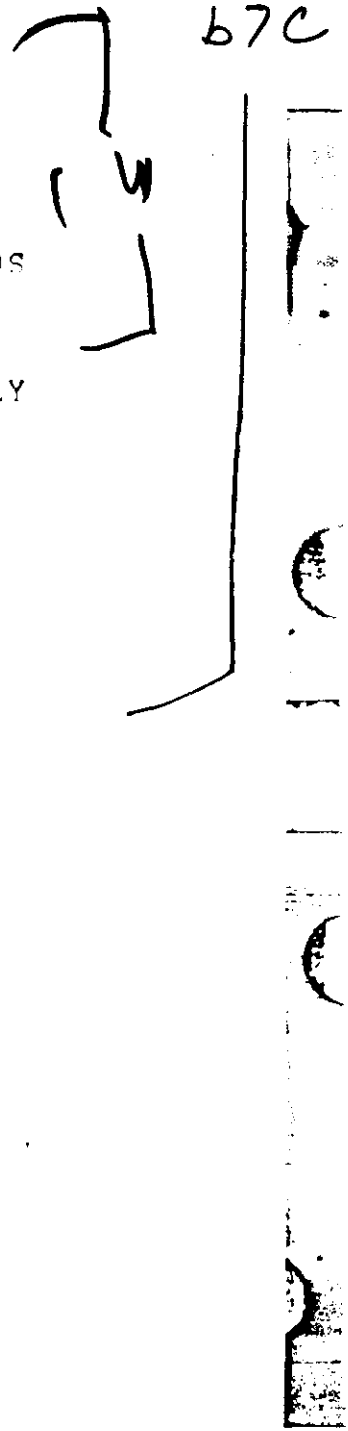

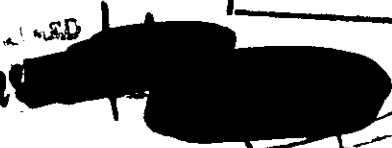

This will confirm the telephone conversation of 1/11/79 between Case Agent Don Hale of your office and Laboratory Supervisor [redacted]. During this conversation SA Hale was advised that the Technical Evaluation Unit of the Laboratory Division has in its possession sixty-one five-inch reel-to-reel recording tapes in captioned investigation. These tapes are copies produced by the Engineering Section of the Technical Services Division (TSD) from recordings made by amateur radio operator [redacted] of Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The recordings reflect radio transmissions on amateur radio (ham) frequencies, allegedly between the People's Temple in San Francisco, California, and surrounding area and the contingent located at Jonestown, and Georgetown, Guyana. The original tapes and a copy of each have been returned to the Knoxville Division. Copies have also been provided to San Francisco and the Laboratory. (u)

Upon receipt of the tapes in the Laboratory, cryptanalysts monitored them to detect the presence of any encrypted messages or other form of secret communication which could shed light on possible illegal activities of members of the People's Temple. Review of the tapes indicated the strong probability that a code of the "double-meaning" variety was being used. Copies of certain code books which were subsequently recovered in Guyana have now confirmed the presence of coded material in the transmissions. Review of the tapes also revealed that the recordings cover the time period from approximately March 12 to May 11, 1978. (u)

While it is believed unlikely that these tapes, made six months prior to the visit of Congressman Ryan to Guyana,

could be pertinent to this investigation, the possible existence of valuable information on the tapes can not be precluded. The Laboratory, however, is not in the best position to determine the potential value of the tapes at this point in the investigation. Absent such a determination, it would be unwise to make the huge manpower commitment which would be required in order to make transcripts of the tapes and thereafter decode the encrypted portions. (u)

It is noted that the recordings, aside from their sheer bulk, are of very poor quality. They were taken from very crowded and noisy radio frequencies and contain a great deal of background noise, including static and other amateur operators transmitting on the same frequencies. (u)

For the above reasons, the Laboratory will conduct no further cryptanalytic examinations on the Oak Ridge tapes. In the event San Francisco desires additional work on any of the recordings, the tape(s) and a transcript of the portion to be analyzed along with the code books (not copies) should be submitted, attention: Technical Evaluation Unit. (u)

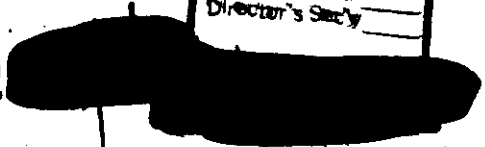

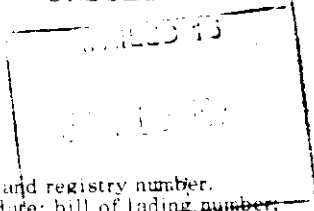

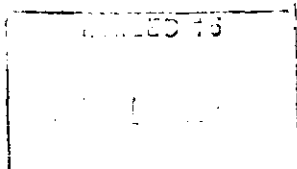
