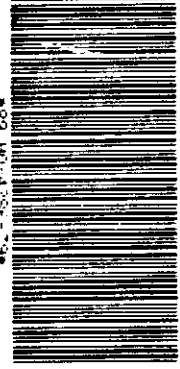

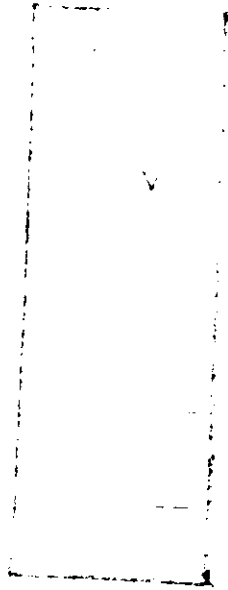

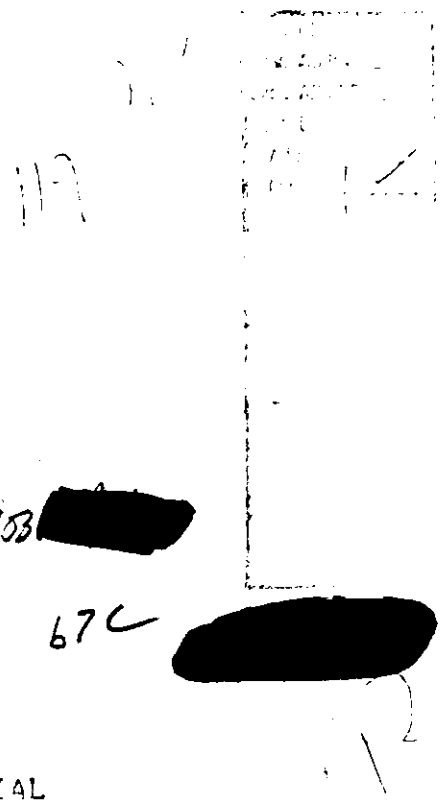

LAYTON LATER WAS CHARGED WITH THE ATTEMPTED MURDER OF TEMPLE DEFECTORS MONICA BAGBY AND VERN GOSNEY, WHO WERE WOUNDED IN THE AIRSTRIP SHOOTOUT. ON MAY 22, A GUYANESE JURY FOUND HIM INNOCENT OF THE CHARGES, BUT HE HAS REMAINED IN THE CUSTODY OF GUYANESE AUTHORITIES.

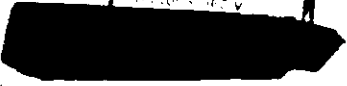

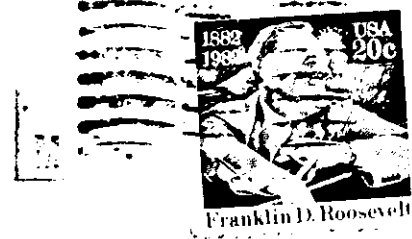

1 When the Rev. Jim Jones took his religious followers to Guyana in the  
2 belief that the way of life would be "freedom from government taxes", etc.  
3 i.e., away from political intervention in their "way of life"; it is be-  
4 lieved that he was "fully informed" of the living conditions in that part  
5 of South America, and perhaps misinformed.

6 A "moving picture", produced for television viewers in 1981, portrayed a  
7 "black boy" as being "punished" under orders by Mr. Jones for some in-  
8 conce uential act and being told by his black mother that her son had  
9 disobeyed the "orders" of Mr. Jones and was violating God's commandment  
10 therefore she concurred that "he should be punished!"

11 The story goes on about the "boys father" (who never left North America)  
12 finally getting through to the United States ~~SENATOR~~ Congressman, L. J.  
13 Ryan regarding the "horrors" being meted out to the "son".

14 The senator was, of course, murdered, and the story has it that "blacks"  
15 and "whites" committed suicide.

16 The story goes on to relate what is known or what has been publicized  
17 regarding the Rev. Jones' becoming "addicted to drugs" resulting in  
18 suicide and ordering his "cult" to follow.


19 The writer witnessed the "moving ~~picture~~ picture films#which were "taken  
20 at the scene" showing Congressman Ryan falling and his aides also included  
21 in a hail of bullets. The film also showed "blacks" running for the

23 It is the thinking of the writer that Rev. Jones was indeed on drugs, but  
24 not to his knowledge that it was "drugs" he was taking. Upon the realization  
25 that all "whites would be captured" by the "blacks" and the women and  
26 children "whites" subjected to possible torture and abuse, he "ordered  
27 them to take pills which would kill them" rather than subject the women and

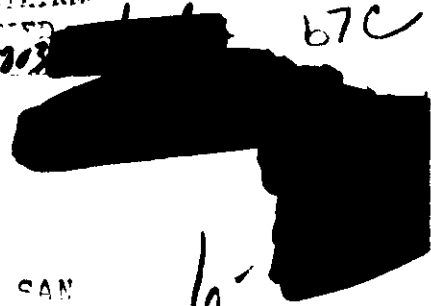

Dear Bill:

In 1979 your San Francisco office released some Peoples Temple related material to me, upon the instructions of the Civil Division of the Department of Justice. The attorney handling the case was James G. Bruen, Esq.

The material, made up of about 115 portfolios numbered A-1 through SS-1 and occupying sixteen cubic feet of space, is almost entirely photocopies of Peoples Temple documents recovered by the Bureau in Jonestown, Guyana, following the tragedy of November 18, 1978. It also includes two portfolios of photographs as well as the "final hour tape". To my mind it is of historical value only.

I am about to make the third and final distribution of assets to 588 claimants and to close the Receivership. In my final petition to the Court I am asking for authority to turn over all the files which I have collected to the California Historical Society for indexing and creation of an archives to be available for use by scholars.

I notified your San Francisco office of my intention to include the Bureau-provided material and was advised that the Bureau's permission would be required. Special Agent Don Hale of your San Francisco office said he would submit to Washington the question of whether there was any objection to release of the documents to the California Historical Society. He said he did not want them back since the Bureau has the originals, and that if they were returned to him he would destroy them.



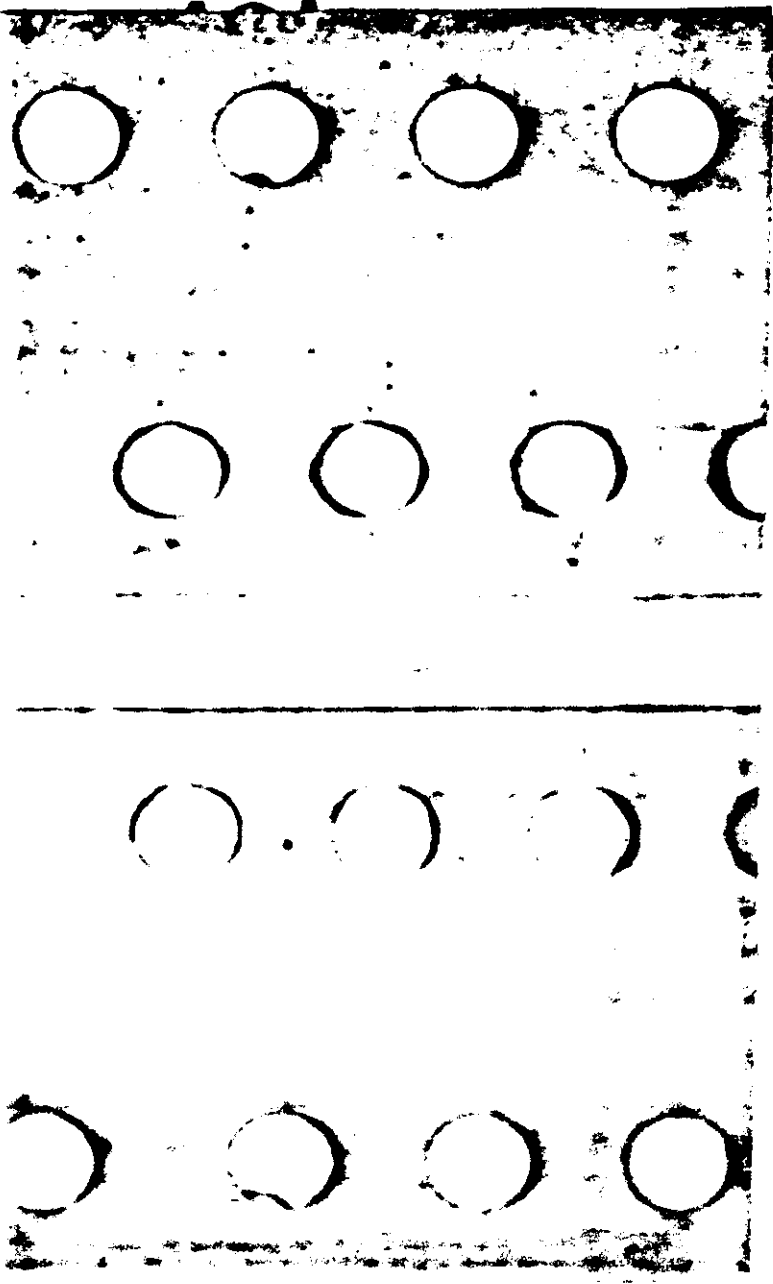

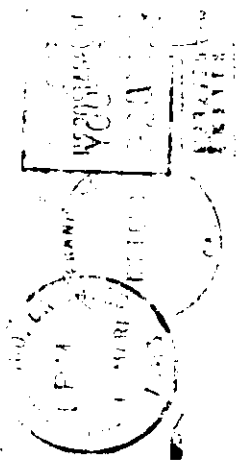

DETAILS: By way of background, on 9/26/81 in U. S. District Court, Northern District of California, a mistrial was declared in the trial of Laurence John Layton on the basis of a deadlocked jury. Layton had been charged with violation of Title 18, USC, Section 351(d) - Conspiracy to Murder; Section 351(a), 2 - Aid and Abet Murder of Congressman; Section 1117 - Conspiracy to Kill Internationally Protected Person; and Section 1116(a), 2 - Aid and Abet Attempted Murder of Internationally Protected Person, for the 11/18/78 murder of Congressman Leo J. Ryan at Jonestown, Guyana. (u)

The presiding Judge, Chief Judge Robert Peckham, had denied the Government's motion to present into evidence several Jim Jones tape recordings considered critical to the prosecution. (u)

On 8/10/83, the U. S. Court of Appeals, Ninth Circuit, issued an opinion which reversed Judge Peckham in his decision to disallow the tape recordings as evidence. The U. S. 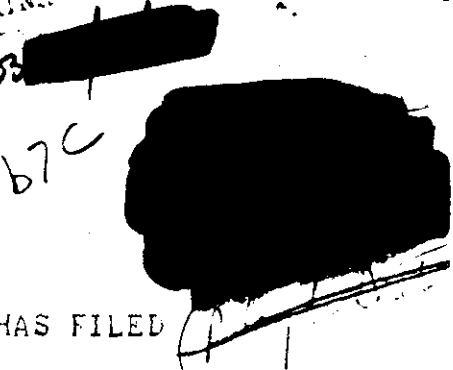

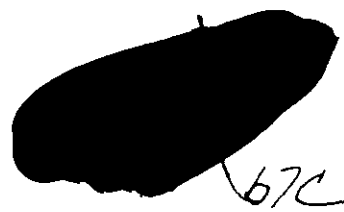
