✓ Tell Mingo and Hamilton Green: 2 top notch people in PNC told us hands off policy on PT and one impt. govt. official said that the USA tried to get us expelled. There had been pressure put on the Guyana govt. to try to kick us out. Is this true? We are sick of it. We are trying to build and don't understand why they do us this way.

Also tell them that Channel 7, KCBS, many other radio and TV stations did good stories on us - interviewed Jane and Freed and told about the conspiracy against us. Even the Examiner was forced, out of fear of being sued, to do a good story.

Regarding money: we shouldn't let it die easy. Ought to have it to give the money to the PNC, but if a man's honest, it's a shame to have taken it away. You hear people on the plane joking about hiding money in their shoes and their hair. This upsets our people when money is taken away just bec. we're so honest, when we need money so badly. We will double that gift to PNC if given it back. We would like the privilege of giving it to the PNC rather than taking it like he was doing something wrong.

✓ MINGO - MITZY-- Rabbi Washington: we don't understand why a man who we know is against PNC and came here fleeing the law is played up in the press everywhere, when there is a hands off policy against us. Even heart in the states had to admit we've been lied upon. It's not just the black press now. We don't intend to sue the govt, altho we could use the 40 million and get it. We just want them to lay off us and Guyana. Our whole concern is for peace.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURE TO FOLLOW WHEN PATIENTS ARE GOING TO G.I. 21/7/78

1. Radio room is to notify Sylvia immediately when a flight or boat will be leaving Jonestown with room for patients who need to go to Georgetown.
2. Practitioner, Doctor, Optometrist and Dental department is to notify Sylvia of the fact that he/she wants a patient to go in on the next boat or plane.
3. Sylvia is to notify Terri Jones in the radioreom so that Terri can clear the patient going to G.I., check on insurance and make appointment for the patient.
4. Sylvia is to assign Heloise Hall or Beanie Proby to do a complete health protocol on patients if there is time. He will definitely have to know the patients full legal name, date of birth, age, primary problem, family history, and any significant secondary health problems.
5. Sylvia will be responsible to see that all medical consultation letters are turned in to her on time. Penny will be available to type summaries when necessary but summaries should not wait until the last minute unless it's an emergency.
6. When summaries are completed they are to be taken by Sylvia to Rita Lenin. In emergencies a letter-clearer might have to be awakened.
7. Sylvia is to take the cleared medical summary and any X-rays to Lucy Crenshaw - cottage 34.
8. Sylvia will notify the patient who is going to G.I. 24 hour in advance, if possible, so that they will have ample time to get ready for the trip.
9. Sylvia will notify Charlie Touchette 24 hours in advance, if possible, or as soon as it is confirmed - so that the tractor can be made ready in time for the trip to the boat or airplane.
10. Sylvia will pack and have forms completed for bioties being sent into G.I. and she will give these to Lucy Crenshaw.
11. Sylvia will supervise to see that all patients are packed and have appropriate medical supplies with them and that this medication is given to Lucy Crenshaw, plus any other medical supply needed for them during their stay in G.I.
12. Sylvia will check with the pharmacy to see if the patient is on routine medication that they will need to take with them and get the medication to Lucy.
13. Sylvia will see that all people are ready in time for the tractor.
14. If the tractor is late she will notify the radio room.
15. Nationals are not to get on the tractor or boat without medical summary and their names on the boats roster directly cleared by Dad.

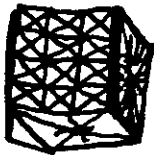
