Dear Dr. Reid:

Some persons involved in the conspiracy against us have formed a group call "Concerned Relatives". They have drawn up a petition demanding that certain relatives of theirs be sent back to the U.S. to see them for a period of one week. (They are alleging that the relatives are being held here against their will.) Ambassador Mann has stated that the petition is essentially true. Can you please give us some explanation for this man? What makes us so insecure is that he is so unprincipled and unscrupulous, as we have been told by everybody and can document ourselves. We know that he has met with those who are working against us, and it has been told to us that he has been getting money. How are we to have any security?

He has fanned the flames. We had it all cooled down but he gave some kind of statement that there is something strange going on in Peoples Temple and our opponents feed that to the press. We are direct. We'll die for you as we've declared on numerous occasions. We mean that. But please will you tell us what in the hell is the reason for retaining this man. Has he got something on high cabinet officials as he has told one of our members. If you say that this is the case, then we won't ask any more questions. If it's not the case, then it seems stupid to keep him in the U.S. He would sell out for a dollar. There is nothing he can have on anybody that would seem to us to warrant keeping such a disloyal person in such a strategic position.

Remember, Dr. Reid, we have direct information about this man. You can go back to previous letters and see that we have not given you guess-work about him, we have given facts. We would not have any more problems or trouble with relatives if he had not given them encouragement. It would have been since died down. He even admitted that it was his idea to bring them. A police official, by the way, also encouraged the idea that relatives come here, saying that he would see to it that they could go out to our project. This is absurd. We have relatives visiting right now-- and more coming. But we don't want relatives who are involved in the conspiracy, because we have proof from a publisher that they are planning to hire mercenaries to come here and kidnap children. These people are not wanted by their own relatives on the project. Those who are not involved in this mess, of course are welcome to come. You can check with Mrs. Vivian Davis who is here visiting her daughters. She is a professional medical person and has never met Jim Jones in her life. She has heard all the lies and foolishness. She also heard that Guyana (and us) had no electricity, no running water, no conveniences, and no doctor.

This is another reason why we are concerned about our doctor. His presence is vital on the project, not just for medical reasons which are the foremost consideration, but also for public relations purposes. We are viewed with such intense scrutiny that we must maintain the highest standards of health and health care services. Our doctor has one hell of an awesome job, sometimes see-

ing 50-60 Amer-Indians per day, who come from miles around. He needs to have his license approved without having to leave the project. He should not be away one minute. His competence has been proven and even the medical review board of the Ministry of Health doesn't doubt it (his competency), according to the statements of board members at a recent meeting with us. But some of the board members still insist that he go through an internship program which would take him away from Jonestown and undoubtedly cost some lives. This is unacceptable to us and we can't understand the callousness of a couple of board members who said unashamedly that this was a price that had to be paid. We couldn't believe we were hearing this.

Of all the relatives who have come to Guyana, it could only possibly be three persons at most, stirring trouble back in the U.S. All the other relatives were very positive, including Mrs. Davis who is on the project now. Others will be coming soon, such as a prominent Methodist Superintendent, Dr. John Moore and his wife. We have conversed with Dick McCoy of the American Embassy about the problems with relatives and he acts like he is our friend, but one never knows.

Please, Dr. Reid, now more than ever, take hold of Guyana with a firm hand. It is the only way to save the principles which you have stood for by living a principled life. You've never used your position to take advantage, and you've always lived humbly. Jim Jones and many many others do not want to die for an unprincipled situation. We would consider it an honor to die-- but not for nothing. We don't wish to die as a representative for people who don't believe or stand for anything-- whose course isn't firmly established. Thus we implore you-- please take firm hold of Guyana.

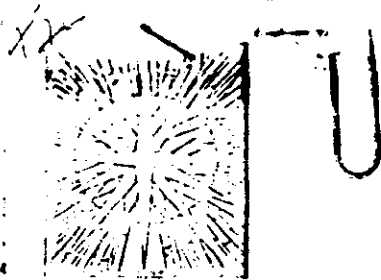

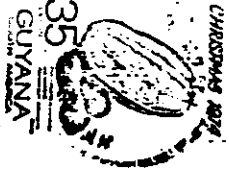
My Dear Bishop Jones in Christ

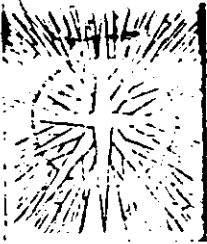

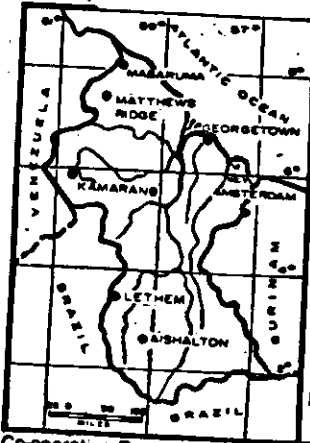

- he was friendly and positive. When Marcie asked him his impressions of Jonestown his first reaction was "interesting" (which is what he said to me on the way out of Jonestown - and that's all he would say), but then he softened a bit and went into how much he admired our resourcefulness and the project.
- he said not all his questions were answered but what he saw he was very impressed with. He said he didn't know about the medical, but the agriculture spoke for itself because you could see it.
- he said that one of the accusations was that we staged things for people when they come to visit (he just sort of dropped this in - so obviously he still has some doubts, even though his overall attitude was very positive)
- he said that he had been all over Guyana, even place where you could just drop a potato on the ground and it would grow, and nowhere in Guyana was anybody doing with agriculture what we are doing. He said again how impressed he was with our resourcefulness.
- he said he went home and told his kids all about Jonestown, and he wished that his son Raul had been there to see for himself.
- he said that unless we were hiding a lot of people away (said that jokingly) he saw an awful lot of happy faces in Jonestown.
- he said that Guyanese expect things at their fingertips, to flick a button and have their electricity etc, and here are a group of Americans who are used to such conveniences going into the jungle and sacrificing these things and producing for themselves and being happy with it
- he looked at the Goodlett quotes and said he was going to do an article based around them. Said it would be in Saturday's paper. Then he said he wanted to do a feature article on our agriculture, and put it in Sunday's paper. He said he was very busy this week because his daughter was marrying and his car had broken down, so he may not get to it, but that he would get to it the following Sunday if not. Said he would put a picture in with the Goodlett article.
- said he would also be doing something for AP to respond to some of their queries about the charges. Marcie pointed out that even to print denials to charges plants negative thoughts in people's minds. He agreed and said that he definitely would not do that here in Guyana, that he would stick with the agricultural aspects of the project and things like that, and not touch the political at all. But he said he would deal with the political aspects of the thing in the AP article. He said that he would let us see it before it went out (he offered this, we didn't ask) to change any factual errors, but he also said that his observations were his observations. I don't think he meant this as if he was going to ask us, but more that he didn't want us dictating to him everything that might be in the article, that his thoughts are his thoughts. I didn't especially like this comment, though, but I don't think there is anything we can do really.
- said he enjoyed the entertainment very much
- said he didn't panic once during the whole trip, not even when the pilot had to try and start the plane by hand. We apologized for the flat tire and he said that these things happen. He said that after all that the photographer, Oudkirk, the day after he returned broke his shoulder.
- he showed us the picture which were all very good. There was one excellent one of everybody waving good-bye. There must have been 20-30 people in that picture, all with big smiles on their face (and I mean all). The picture is useable I think, but probably needs to be cropped. It would be perfect except that John Harris is in the foreground and rather prominent in the picture with a raised fist instead of waving good-by.
- as we were leaving he came out and showed us the telegram from AP regarding John. I asked him what prompted this, if the article in the paper had gotten out of Guyana. He said that it must have, and he thought that is what the telegram was asking about. The telegram read "Added info on Peoples Temple case. Also need to know name of child, Tim Steason (that's how it was spelled), and where mother now lives. Who is the father and his whereabouts. How long has child been in Guyana and if child taken there by father. If mother, in US, need to know her address or where the family home was before child take to Guyana. Carnes. 14 Aug." Carnes is the head of this region

for AP. The AP headquarters for the Caribbean is in Puerto Rico. Blackmon first wanted us to respond on the spot. I told him we would have to check with our attorneys before answering any questions because the case was still pending etc. Then he asked if we could answer in an hour. He noticed the date was old and then thought that it may not have been related to the article that was in the Chronicle - I don't know the date the article was in, we should check it out. It would be interesting if that telegram came before Bishop's decision, strange the sudden interest in something that had been dormant for so long.
-Blackmon did say that we were a model when it came to agriculture, and there was no way to deny that. He wants to visit again. *Mike*

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- When I talked to Hamaludin ~~xx~~ about the dinner date and why he couldn't come (this was before we knew Freed wasn't coming in) he explained that he just had to do a story for CANA. He said that even though he was on leave, Cana was pressuring him to do something. He said that when he gets off leave he is going to be working for Cana-Reuters full time, and not for the Chronicle anymore.

20/2 He said that he had been in Parliament the night before listening to the debate on the IMF. I asked him if there was going to be devaluation, and he said that no, there wouldn't be, at least for the next 6 months anyway, which is the period of time this loan covers. He said that Guyana could not benefit from devaluation because it is tied to the U.S. dollar, and the dollar has been devaluating itself, so there would be nothing to gain. But the way he said this it sounds as if there will be subsequent IMF grants, and there is the possibility of devaluation then.

He said that there is so much happening in Guyana right now, and Cana is after him for more stories. He said Haynes' speech (about speeding up the judicial process) was very significant and he was going to do a story on that.

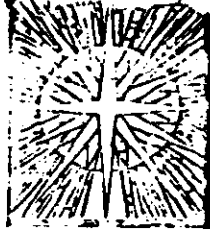
He said that we probably think he is trying to avoid us, but he really isn't. He was very friendly.

- Rev. Barry mentioned in church that the farmers were getting very alarmed over ~~xx~~ the rain, and that instead of the dry season beginning, another wet season was just beginning. Barry was very positive, as usual. Introduced us to his congregation - about 10 adults and 10 children.'

-one of Mingo's principal secretaries - a Portuguese guy whose name I still don't know (I'm finding out) - had a relative ~~xxxxxx~~ in the hospital near ~~xx~~ Gloria's bed. He saw me visiting with her. Gloria said after I left he came over and talked with her for about 10 minutes, praising the project and the good work we do. He told her that they were trying to arrange a visit to Jonestown - they are going to make it look like official business but use it just to visit. He told her they aren't coming to do anything except just visit and see Jonestown. Said he had heard so many good things about it from me, Mike Prokes, and Sharon. He is the man who got me my tax clearance when I was leaving the country and introduced us to Ms. Shirvington, who has been so helpful. Sharon and Prokes might know this guy's name.

Dear Cde. Prime Minister Burnham,

Several things have come to our attention recently that you should be aware of. They regard the media in Guyana, and renewed attacks on Peoples Temple by Tim Stoen through the media in the U.S. The situations are as follows:

"HANDS-OFF POLICY" IN GUYANA MEDIA

We have been told by several reliable sources that the government has deliberately chosen a "hands-off" policy towards Peoples Temple in terms of press/media coverage, and one media person even said that Jim Jones and Peoples Temple are expendable. We were dismayed when we heard this, and even more dismayed when we read Minister Hoyte's "Letter to the Editor" on Feb. 16th advising the Chronicle to "refrain further from publishing hand-outs...from persons who may have their own purposes to serve." This crude letter of his has had some far reaching effects, which we will go into later.

Firstly, we do not understand the "hands-off" policy, or why the Government we have devoted our lives to would choose such a course of action. We know that you have survived rumors of the cross-section in the media, and we are getting more and more used to rumors persisting about us. We follow your thinking on nationalism and socialism - we understand it fully. And we understand the complexities of the public and private sectors. But certainly people wouldn't consider anything coming from the media here as indicative of total support for Jim and the project by the government. The "adversary press" is a myth in America, and it is the general opinion there that the media does not speak for the government. We have even been told by U.S. officials that they wouldn't mind publicity on the Peoples Temple at all, as long as it wasn't presented in a light that would embarrass the U.S. (e.g. that we left the U.S. because of its racism). So if something positive was done by the media here, it would reflect well both on Guyana and the United States. Of course we would never speak in a light that would embarrass the U.S., concentrating only on the services of Jonestown, the medical clinic, the free aid, the cooperation of the Guyana government, the wonderful Guyanese people, etc. And Jim would never change from this posture unless they tried to completely destroy Peoples Temple - which is very remote and in that case they would be going after Guyana also.

We happen to know from friends that certain people in the media actually consider us an "ace-in-the-hole." Because the U.S. doesn't want to deal with any people who are unhappy with its basic beliefs, a story about us could be used as a plus for Guyana, not a minus. In fact, news clippings of a laudatory nature would be helpful to relations. We certainly are wise enough to see that to do what the U.S. feared would only hurt Guyana's survival, as well as that of Peoples Temple.

As we said earlier, we are somewhat upset by Minister Hoyte's tactics and what he effected through his letter. We don't in any way question his aptitudes, or his skill. But regardless of what-

ever talents and genius he may have, he lacks diplomatic ability. Everyone we have talked to understands what he was trying to do, and how counterproductive it was. They agree that his ordering that letter to appear in the paper shows genuinely poor judgment, and reflects much divisiveness. The reasonable thing for him to do, rather than act impetuously, would have been to tell us what the problem represented and how we could have helped to solve it. We've tried our best to give proper credits to Min. Hoyte so he is secure in his work, and we will continue to do so. One would have to be extremely short-sighted not to see that we are a very productive people, who are trying our best all the time. And it is unreasonable to not want a resolution of the matter, if such a difficulty did exist. If Min. Hoyte is foolish enough not to care for Jim, it is truly unfortunate, for we will follow the government to the ends as long as you and Dr. Reid are handling things. And when you are willing to put your life on the line, we want to know you and Dr. Reid are calling the shots, not unknown quantities.

We do not expect accolades to continuously come from the government, but this sort of thing is outrageous. We believe in criticism, both group and self, but we have never given the government a slap like the slap Jim was given, and then he was never even told why he was being slapped. We especially don't understand when we consider that we have contacted almost every Congressman on behalf of Guyana - with very encouraging results - why did this slap in the face have to happen? We have heard several things about Minister Hoyte's disposition, including his short temper. But we are calling it as we see it; we don't feel this is any way to handle your best friends, for nobody could give more loyalty to Guyana.

What is just as disconcerting is when press releases, such as the one we submitted regarding Dr. Peter Fernandes' visit, are not printed. Why wouldn't people want the good works that the Peoples Temple and Jim Jones are doing known? It just doesn't make any sense, and could easily make one paranoid. With letters like Minister Hoyte's, and reliable sources telling us there is a hands off policy towards Peoples Temple in the media, one wonders how in that kind of climate could we possibly expect any security for John Victor (which is essential to our survival). If the FIC is hesitant to identify with us, what possible assurances could there be?

TIM STOEN REVIEWS MEDIA ATTACKS AGAINST PEOPLES TEMPLE AND GUYANA

Minister Hoyte's letter has had several effects. One is that reporters abroad are taking more liberty in asking questions. Even though they are friendly, it is painful to review all the lies. But most significantly, Tim Stoen has gained confidence because of Min. Hoyte's attack on us. Emboldened because he saw a house divided, he publically is stating he now will win the custody case of John Victor. At a party that was heavily attended by the media in San Francisco, Stoen made Minister Hoyte's letter quite public, and said "You can buy anybody you want in Guyana if they haven't already been bought off. Apparently they (Jim and the Temple) haven't offered Hoyte a big enough price." We have irrefutable proof that as a result of this he was given encouragement to renew his attacks in the media. All this is a direct result of Min. Hoyte's letter, and we do not appreciate one bit his playing into their hands.

Consequently, new articles have appeared in the press. The rumors had been laid to rest and now they have been revived because of this. They have only been able to keep the conspiracy going using that persons quotations about our medical department, as they appeared in one of the 3 cheap rags that printed the story. You can review it yourself.

The articles are nothing as bad as the smear a few months ago - it wasn't as devastating as a smear. There were alot of innuendoes. Even though Stoen is trying to get the press to cooperate in smearing Jim, our Agricultural Project, and Guyana in regards to the custody case, it is not working. It seems that things are turning a bit because the articles don't have the bite they did before. We are counteracting this through Herb Caen, the most widely read columnist in California, who has stated previously in his column who the real father is. Tim Stoen had admitted to Herb Caen that Jim Jones is the real father of John Victor, and that the affidavit he wrote was genuine. (Now Stoen denies he ever wrote the affidavit, saying he was forced to sign it. This is rather odd, considering he was the Assistant District Attorney at the time, and that the style of writing is his, which anybody who knows him can testify to).

The Hearst newspaper, which had given us the worst coverage before, not only printed Stoen's far out article but gave Jim's side of the story too. The editor of this particular paper is bitter with the situation his daughter had to endure, and since then has become a captive of the extreme right. It is common knowledge that no one on either side of the political spectrum trusts that particular paper. The article did not say one thing against Guyana, and made no comments that the Guyana government was interfering with the court case. It also stated that Jim would take anatomical tests to prove paternity. In fact, they showed a ridiculous looking picture of Tim Stoen in front of a church with a Bible in his hand, looking something like a Water-gate conspirator reconverted. He was calling himself the spiritual father of the child. That kind of play will get him nowhere in San Francisco.

Tim Stoen has been trying his hardest to appeal to the right-wing in the Redwood Empire. (He must be really hard-up to go to newspapers this small - none have circulation exceeding 5000.) One of these papers said that Stoen couldn't get an interview with the Deputy Prime Minister of Guyana and that proved that the Guyanese government is prejudiced in Jim Jones favor (in regards to the court case). Can you imagine the audacity of these people - Jim Jones would never even dream of trying to get an appointment with you or Dr. Reid in regards to a matter like that. It's ridiculous. But even this paper stated that Stoen is on a vengeance campaign, and they were critical of that. The article was headlined with "Two great men have fallen.", the implication about Jim being that he and the Temple had moved to a Socialist country, and the implication about Stoen that he was not a good lawyer and he had fallen because he was bitter and vengeful. The writer is a racist and a reactionary, and has connections with the old German boom. He also writes for the other paper that tried to make it look like Guyana is prejudiced in favor of Jim. The articles show the mentality of the writer; he is not depending on the Guyana courts to hand down a fair decision and is trying to wield some influence.

As a result of these most recent attacks we have demanded an

articles presenting the full side of the story, and have threatened litigation. Not only have we threatened litigation, but we have put all newspapers on notice. They have done this sensational type of thing in an English newspaper once before, and even though it had no effect in the U.S., what seems to be appreciated more than anything is a strong posture. Once before when we were being threatened by a media attack we won when we stood up against them. One reason why Jim didn't get the upper hand on the media in the U.S. right away was because he wasn't there to coordinate and give advice, and of course now it is necessary for him to stay with his son John for John's welfare.

It is significant to us that in these articles they have allowed Jim to repudiate this whole mess. In former articles they would have printed things such as that Jim claims to be the re-incarnation of Mao or Jesus Christ (an absolute lie). One commentator cracked up and said the real issue is not that Jim Jones is Jesus Christ, but the real story is that Tim Stoen does not want to be Joseph!

Interestingly enough, the San Jose Mercury, which is part of a nationwide chain of papers, wants to expose and expose conclusively the proof that there was collusion between the Redwood paper and the first magazine that printed negative articles about us. It was their purpose to destroy a group working for social change, even though it is working within the system. They have proof of past and future plans.

Tim Stoen is now clearly stating that he is against any kind of socialism and that he is not concerned about the masses any more. The right wing posture he is now taking supports more and more evidence that he is a provocateur. While with us he tried to encourage and provoke people into radical actions. When taken in light of his trip to the German Democratic Republic, this posture is even more insidious. He told us he had never travelled there before, and, not only has he travelled there, but when he came back he made headlines by attacking its government and socialism. He now has the nerve to go to the U.S. State Dept. and ask them to take a more aggressive stance in his case. Marceline Jones (Jim's wife) and others made the rounds in Washington D.C., negating a lot of what Tim tried to do. The people they saw agreed it was none of their business, and a matter for Guyana alone. Two people even turned around and offered to write a letter on our behalf even though we weren't looking for something like that.

Jim and all of us have certainly learned a lesson with Tim Stoen. We now have some new and very thorough screening techniques, and this will never happen again, where humanly possible. Jim has learned that the loyalty he gave to people such as Tim Stoen seems to be self-serving to those people. It seems it is not worth even a penny for the most part, especially when considering how Stoen turned. But he is grateful for the experience and the lesson it taught him.

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Jim has become the focal point the Stoen attack so even if he was prepared to make the sacrifice of giving up John, it could not be. It is obvious that John Stoen is not Tim Stoen's objective, but it is rather to destroy and discredit a great man of high character.

and uncompromising principles and his organization. This issue has become a cause of life, for it is a matter of principle. Maybe we're not thinking like others but after 28 years of war all one wants is peaceful change. Principles have more meaning than life, and peace and principle are more valuable than continuation.

We know you understand this from your own example. We have known you only through Dr. Reid, Minister Mingo, and Fred Wills, but most particularly through Dr. Reid. We shall never forget your stance during the Cuba/Angola/Guyana/U.S. controversy, nor the moment the Cubana airliner was sabotaged by the CIA. Your courage in these matters is one of the reasons we have such high regard for you. It means very much to Jim that you'd rather die for the honor of our country, the country you have put your whole life into, rather than opt out to live your life in some quiet rest home. Life is finally to be laid down anyway. But one must stand up for one's principles.

We will continue to follow your non-aligned posture and will emanate goodwill. We try to pick up from the media your nuances, which is difficult. But the willingness to take your nuances and follow the course, even with the tremendous amount of pain involved, is proof positive of our absolute loyalty to you and Dr. Reid. It comes out of complete, unreserved loyalty, for no one else would have done what we have done. We understand that it is a ticklish era with the elections - which shouldn't be bothered with in the first place - but we understand. We know there has had to be major shifts made by you and Dr. Reid alone, and the intruding requirements by the U.S.S.R. by saying - dictating - what you and Dr. Reid were to do if the U.S.S.R. were to be faithful. We want to see Guyana get the IMF loan, and we are sure President Carter's position (not liking the alternative to the FNC) has not been underestimated. We have been assured that we would not be any factor in any financial aid decision being refused, but we have also been advised we could be a great asset in securing one. If it were said publically that you have reliable proof that the Peoples Temple wanted you to get an IMF loan, we were told it could be a big help in any decision made. The firm opinion of over a thousand U.S. citizens on Guyana soil carries a lot of weight.

We have never had any intention of causing a problem, we only wish they would let us alone in peace. But it is necessary for our survival that things work out for John. Jim Jones and every member of Peoples Temple honors the Guyana judicial system and we will in no way interfere. And we have been assured by friends in Washington D.C. that they would not interfere, and have been told by people in the Embassy that nothing would be done to hurt Jim or the project. Everyone here and in the U.S. know that even the application by the Stoen's was improper, and their motives are at best highly questionable. That is why it is necessary that things work out for John. To do otherwise would be a gross miscarriage of justice we feel. Disillusionment sets in when rumors and lies become so plentiful - such as that our boat doesn't check in properly or that we are smuggling things - but we remain undaunted in our loyalty to you and Dr. Reid and in our pushing to further our production. But our productivity could be increased greatly if we only had some assurances John wouldn't be taken. The strain and worry is a horrendous burden for anyone to carry. Our only

goal is to become a model cooperative in Guyana, mould you and the leadership of the FIC have cast. We will continue to work our hardest to build a greater, more prosperous Guyana.

We know you are a very busy man, and apologize for taking so much of your time. The issues discussed warranted the attention, however, and we're sure you have perceived their vital importance. Thank you for allowing us the opportunity to help partake in this great socialist experience. We will continue to strive to implement the ideals of the Peoples National Congress under your wise and astute leadership.

Dear Prime Minister Burnham,

It is with dismay that racist reactionary elements have put us in a position of informing you of diabolical schemes. They are planning to thwart what has been regarded by many on the West Coast of the U.S. as the most effective and popular socialist movement in existence. Our friends and supporters are still many and it is with their help that we are kept abreast of their conspiratorial plans.

The latest information which has reached us was given to us by a relative of someone who is an active conspirator. We were told that one of the tactics to be used to discredit our organization ~~to us~~ was to manipulate the strained relations between Guyana and Venezuela. The objective is to cause trouble between Peoples Temple and the government of Guyana by using the media to play up lies about our cooperative as being an "armed garrison" and "jungle outpost" on Venezuela's doorstep. We don't know details which makes us very unhappy but they have not succeeded in getting the major media interested in their lies and it has only been printed on a local level. There is no reason to believe that this has changed.

It is this same local media which quoted Jim Jones as saying he respected Idi Amin. The only thing Jim has said about Idi Amin is that he wished the white press would get as concerned over the racism in South Africa and talk about John Vorster in the same way they do Amin.

This person also told us that they are going to try to cause trouble between the Guyana government and the PPP over us. This makes some sense because we heard from several people, including those close to the government, that Clarence Hughes (Stoen's lawyer) is now close to the PPP. We thought we would tell you because it is impossible to keep up with moral degenerates that would use Idi Amin and an "armed garrison" to whip up racial hysteria in Northern California.

It is interesting that Clarence Hughes is close to the PPP because Jim Stoen has been maneuvering to get close to the PPP.

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We know this for a fact. Our source told us that part of Stoen's deal was a commitment from the PPP to take Jim's son, John, when the PPP is made government. Stoen has shown himself to be totally immoral in an effort to destroy us for our socialist beliefs. This is obvious from what we've heard of his approach. He plays each association for what it's worth; to an atheist, he's an atheist; to a fundamentalist Christian, he's a fundamentalist Christian; to a communist, he's a communist. Stoen would make a pact with the devil or anything or anyone if it would give him press coverage.

The racist small town rag called the Press Democrat, which has been primarily responsible for printing the lies against us, employs as their reliable reporter a past member of the Nazi party whose affiliation is with racist organizations and the American-German Bund. Dear Cde. Prime Minister Burnham,

Several things have come to our attention recently that you should be aware of. They regard the media in Guyana, and renewed attacks on Peoples Temple by Tim Stoen through the media in the U.S. The situations are as follows:

"HANDS-OFF POLICY" IN GUYANA MEDIA

We have been told by several reliable sources that the government has deliberately chosen a "hands-off" policy towards Peoples Temple in terms of press/media coverage, and one media person even said that Jim Jones and Peoples Temple are expendable. We were dismayed when we heard this, and even more dismayed when we read Minister Hoyte's "Letter to the Editor" on Feb. 16th advising the Chronicle to "refrain further from publishing hand-outs...from persons who may have their own purposes to serve." This crude letter of his has had some far reaching effects, which we will go into later.

Firstly, we do not understand the "hands-off" policy, or why the Government we have devoted our lives to would choose such a course of action. We know that you have survived rumors of the grossest nature in the media, and we are getting more and more used to rumors persisting about us. We follow your thinking on nationalism and socialism - we understand it fully. And we understand the complexities of the public and private sectors. But certainly people wouldn't consider anything coming from the media here as indicative of total support for Jim and the project by the government. The "adversary press" is a myth in America, and it is the general opinion there that the media does not speak for the government. We have even been told by U.S. officials that they wouldn't mind publicity on the Peoples Temple at all, as long as it wasn't presented in a light that would embarrass the U.S. (e.g. that we left the U.S. because of its racism). So if something positive was done by the media here, it would reflect well both on Guyana and the United States. Of course we would never speak in a light that would embarrass the U.S., concentrating only on the services of Jonestown, the medical clinic, the free aid, the cooperation of the Guyana government, the wonderful Guyanese people, etc. And Jim would never change from this posture unless they tried to completely destroy Peoples Temple - which is very remote and in that case they would be going after Guyana also.

We happen to know from friends that certain people in the media actually consider us an "ace-in-the-hole." Because the U.S. doesn't want to deal with any people who are unhappy with its basic beliefs, a story about us could be used as a plus for Guyana, not a minus. In fact, news clippings of a laudatory nature would be helpful to relations. We certainly are wise enough to see that to do what the U.S. feared would only hurt Guyana's survival, as well as that of Peoples Temple.

As we said earlier, we are somewhat upset by Minister Hoyte's tactics and what he effected through his letter. We don't in any way question his aptitudes, or his skill. But regardless of what-

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ever talents and genius he may have, he lacks diplomacy totally. Everyone we have talked to understands what he was trying to do, and how counterproductive it was. They agree that his ordering that letter to appear in the paper shows genuinely poor judgment, and reflects much divisiveness. The reasonable thing for him to do, rather than act impetuously, would have been to tell us what the problem represented and how we could have helped to solve it. We've tried our best to give proper credits to Min. Hoyte so he is secure in his work, and we will continue to do so. One would have to be extremely short-sighted not to see that we are a very productive people, who are trying our best all the time. And it is unreasonable to not want a resolution of the matter, if such a difficulty did exist. If Min. Hoyte is foolish enough not to care for Jim, it is truly unfortunate, for we will follow the government to the ends as long as you and Dr. Reid are handling things. And when you are willing to put your life on the line, we want to know you and Dr. Reid are calling the shots, not unknown quantities.

We do not expect accolades to continuously come from the government, but this sort of thing is outrageous. We believe in criticism, both group and self, but we have never given the government a slap like the slap Jim was given, and then he was never even told why he was being slapped. We especially don't understand when we consider that we have contacted almost every Congressman on behalf of Guyana - with very encouraging results - why did this slap in the face have to happen? We have heard several things about Minister Hoyte's disposition, including his short temper. But we are calling it as we see it: we don't feel this is any way to handle your best friends, for nobody could give more loyalty to Guyana.

Even though they are friendly, it is painful to review all the lies. But most significantly, Tim Stoen has gained confidence because of Min. Hoyte's attack on us. Our people pick up information and we have told you we will pass on what we hear. Ambassador Lawrence Mann made some statements about you when the debate was going on between the U.S. and Guyana over the Cubana airliner affair that were most uncomplimentary to your judgement. He said that because you were supportive of Cuba, relations between the U.S. and Guyana broke down, and your judgement was unwise. Mann said he felt that you had acted without even thinking about what he had done to improve relations with the U.S. He also said you had risked the whole future of Guyana. He was so critical he even spoke of getting a new job.

We have also heard that you have never made it clear to your ministers what your policy is toward the Peoples Temple and its members. This did not come from any official source, and we realize that people have motives other than honorable for telling us such things. The official who is assigned to talk to us is much more careful about what he says, and we appreciate the communications with him very much. We need that communications, and much more. At times tensions get so high it is overwhelming. A word directly from you or Dr. Reid would be very helpful. The only consistently loyal people we can talk about are Dr. Reid, Minister Mingo, who are totally loyal, and until he departed, Fred Wills. We treated all kinds of critical medical cases. Our doctor has found
the difference between life and death on a number of occasions. The medical
board doesn't doubt this but some on the board insist, nevertheless, that
Dr. Schacht must do a year's internship in Georgetown. He said that if
that is to be done for any extended period, it would likely result in some
unnecessary disabilities and even deaths. The response by a few of the
outspoken board members was shocking. They said there would just have
to be deaths, as there were deaths before we came. They used the argument
that they wouldn't be able to go to the States and practice without the
proper training and credentials. So we, this indicated a native born
attitude toward professional standards. (In other words, "the way they
do it here, and so must you.") For a third world developing country, this
attitude seems highly impractical. Some sort of amendment to the rules

Dear Prime Minister Burnham:

We have been informed that the judge in the child custody case has talked in open conversation about the exact time that he is going to give the decision and that it is not going to be favorable to us. Originally, we got nothing but encouraging reports, but now they are discouraging. We hope they do not reflect the reality of the situation, for Jim Jones can't live if the case goes against us.

There is a disgusting lie being told about us supposedly harassing the judge's wife. We were told by a reliable close acquaintance of the judge that he said his wife had gotten a letter from us about the case. We are not that stupid; we would not do that. Someone else who checked it out told us that she did not get any letter and had heard nothing from us about the case. This is the most abominable affair that we have ever seen, when a co-op and its leader would die for this country but cannot get a favorable resolution even when the law clearly shows that the judge made an erroneous decision. We are apparently considered of little value to Guyana by the majority of the few prominent leaders of the party at the very top echelons. Even a high official of the U.S. Embassy said that the decision should go in our favor from legal standpoint alone. In fact, he said in all of his assignments abroad, he has never known a nation in a case like this to ever decide against the resident or citizen; and he said it is absolutely Guyana's prerogative to make up her mind in our favor. We made no comments to him and he raised the issue. He said he thought the process should be speeded up so there would be no accusation from the U.S. that the decision is deliberately being sat on. Although he said he didn't expect broad support for Tim Stoen, in any event, because Stoen lost his credibility after having been caught in lies to the State Dept. and to congressmen.

We see no reason why this decision cannot be favorably handed down in our behalf. Our people cannot continue to try to live with this kind of alienation and apprehension. It is very destructive and we do hope someone is listening to this quiet desperation.

We were told there is a rule given to immigration authorities that the child is not to leave Guyana until the case is finished. We were informed by several persons that the rule was a concession to the forces helping Tim and Grace Stoen. Only one person said it was to help us. We would like clarification please.

We are loyal, so we would know better than to give public assurances to our people on the specifics of the case. Please understand that we are tired, greatly disillusioned with life, and--as much as we stoically celebrate life through such events as we presented at the National Cultural Centre--we are mostly ready to die. No one can understand what another goes through. The 25 years of constant insidious harassment--even when we were in public good favor--makes death look beautiful.

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We are also perturbed that another little boy who is five years old and very ill in the hospital in Georgetown with a brain hemorrhage, calls on Jim, his pastor, and Jim cannot come because he is a prisoner of the arrest orders. Several people associated with the government say the orders are intentional, but we deny it. We can see no reason why you want Jim locked in like this because he does nothing but speak well of Guyana and its government-- and very little talking; does he do at that. He is weary of the world of public leadership. He said he had his lion's share and wants no more. We know that many mutual friends of ours, both here and abroad, do not understand why this matter cannot be resolved favorably to us to allow our community to be a proud example of production to all.

Though some kind words from you and Dr. Reid and others dedicated to you do occasionally trickle down, we still keep hearing that we will be given no assurances. And we hear of other cruel and snide remarks reportedly by some cabinet members. For the life of us we do not understand it because the assurances we seek are minimal, necessary for survival, and even essential to Guyana. We simply want to be allowed to maintain our own school and medical department, which we hear through the grapevine is being worked out satisfactorily, and which is an absolute necessity to avoid attacks from abroad on both Guyana and us. When we submit customs papers to Minister Hope for clearance, we would like some assurance that the matter will be handled within some reasonable specified time period. And the matter of Jim's child, of course, is the most important moral concern of the entire community in Jonestown. An informant within the conspiracy has told us absolutely that if we were to yield on this case, which we would never do, then other cases will follow. So that would also be counter-productive to the interests of Guyana. Furthermore, we will never allow the child to be this kind of pawn for racists and outright fascists.

ADVISED TO GO SLOW

A month or so ago we were told that we needed to integrate more. After our successful cultural program that was praised by all sectors of government and community life which were in attendance, as well as countless others that heard about it since, we have been advised by an official whom we admire that we should "go slow." Can you give any explanation for this?

CULTURAL SHOW PRAISED BUT NO PRESS; HOYTE

It is grossly embarrassing when we are asked questions about why we didn't get a word of press on such a spectacular cultural and entertainment event as we presented on April first. Guyanese friends and acquaintances do not understand why it has gotten no coverage, and they've asked us if we are on the "outs" with the government. Of course we deny that we're on the "outs", but we've little evidence to support it-- particularly when we are told there will be no press and that we can expect even other attacks by Hoyte. If any article about the event does get published, it will only be because we raised the issue with the Ministry of Information.

A high ranking official said to us that if you didn't want our organization alienated and destroyed by lack of morale, then no one should be permitted

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to attack us who claims to be with the party, particularly when Hoyte's attack was clearly groundless. Even according to the statements of your own officials--and they volunteered their criticisms because we never bring up such matters, except with the one assigned to us who you trust--the attack was not based on fact. Friends unto death should be considerate enough to criticize each other privately, which is essential to unity. Although we have done nothing to Hoyte, we are told over and over that he doesn't like us. One person even told us (we must not name him, as we don't know how many others will read these letters now) that we are being set up at our project in the Northwest in case we must be eliminated at some point.

LETTERS RESENTED, NOT READ

We have been told that our letters are not read. Please realize that it's when we stop writing that all will be given up. So for God's sake tell us who to write to with the assurances that the highlights of the subjects will be given to you. We have not had assurances given to us to date that you read the material. Some matters, such as regarding Venezuelan officials, could be of critical importance to national security.

A high ranking person in U.S. officialdom told three of our people that "Guyanese people don't like Guyana but the U.S. government does, because Guyana has few people and many resources that the U.S. can utilize." This was said just before someone was put into a new post here. Please do read the others letters as this is something we need for life. It is up to you, but it would be foolhardy not to give us some peace on the matters of concern to us. We have few whom we can trust to discuss our feelings with--none but a few of you in government--because we do not trust easily. There is a lot of salient information in the letters, and much significant information pertaining to security; and our survival rests in them.

MEDICAL MATTERS

Recently we brought a five year old patient to the hospital. Isaac had brain hemorrhaging and we wanted to have our private professional medical personnel with him around the clock. Jim Jones was prepared to bring in a neurologist for Isaac or to even take him to Cuba if necessary. Jim wanted special RN's with him at all times, because his condition was so critical at first. The child could have died without private highly competent personnel to monitor his vital signs. We feel we have to be as perfect as possible in our medical care to avoid any problems for Guyana. We are deeply sensitive to everyone we take care of, whether they are Guyanese friends or someone in our own community. But with a person in that condition, we provide 24 hours of observation. As you know, reactionaries in the U.S. judge us not by Guyanese standards, not even by their own-- they expect perfection from us. Of course you realize that the U.S. even allows families by the bedside of the critically ill, and would judge us all harshly if we didn't have professionals by his side to monitor. Moreover, with brain damage, the vital signs can change immediately and complications and death can ensue-- so we wanted to be there. Obviously, it would be Guyana too that would be judged if we made one medical fauxpas. Thus, when we ran into difficulty in getting it cleared for our medical personnel to stay with Isaac, we wondered why we had to cut through red tape. Fortunately, the kindly Head Matron, Cde. Standiford, intervened and got it cleared for us. We appreciate that. It seems ridiculous when

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professional people cannot offer that kind of service which our personnel extend not only to the one patient but others around them. This was appreciated by the floor nurses. Anything can happen to a child in Isaac's condition, unless closely observed.

We believe that all socialists should be prepared to die and still continue being productive. It is the highest motivation to be prepared for the worst. But as much as we love and admire you, there are some things that we cannot live with. The last blow came when we were told by a prominent person in a government office that we cannot even put up a sign telling the day we give free medical care in our clinic, which has been lauded by every government official who has seen it. You can confirm that we have always given credit to the government for the medical program we have, just as we have abided by Hoyte's demands that we not give food to the people. But to not be allowed to erect a sign offering free medical services seems grossly inconsiderate to many people who are very sick. Every country has sick people needing such services, and Guyana is no exception.

NEW DEVELOPMENTS IN JONESTOWN

Just as a matter of possible interest, we are beginning to produce bricks in Jonestown, which we are sure will prove beneficial to Guyana. We have Kaolinite type clay for fire bricks. We are also mixing others clays for construction bricks. We should have quite a number finished in five weeks and success appears likely. We are also well on the road to perfecting soap totally from materials found in the beautiful jungle here and which requires no import of any kind.

LATE WORD

As I have been writing this letter, we have received word that the Youth Division of the Ministry of National Development has us under investigation. The information is reliable and we have felt that something was going on from the types of questions we've been asked lately by certain individuals. Our honesty has been clearly proven as we were told privately by a high official that we've already been investigated by the best, and nothing of a questionable nature was discovered. The fact of no crime or anti-social behavior in a group as large and mixed as ours is remarkable. So why this? Death would be highly preferable to us, particularly if there is any truth to the matter that a division under Dr. Reid is checking us out. That would be the final despair because our faith is in you, Dr. Reid and Minister Mingo.

Please give us the feedback on the above matters that we seek and very much need. It will be truly appreciated and never taken for granted.

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P.S. (For Dr. Reid): You expect us not to talk to you and we know you are very busy--busy beyond words--we realize. But when trust is needed, where do we go? We need one session of straight talk and assurances that are basic to survival, then we will not bother you. We would like freely in the lifestyle befitting compassion and concern and helping the government in the area of free medical services. If you read your letters from us, you know there are a lot of people in the party who you cannot trust. We want, out of our loyalty to you, to keep you posted about such evidence. We won't make this letter strictly confidential, but we implore you, we desperately need to communicate soon. This is all we have asked. You can send the few answers to the above questions we've raised, directly to Jim Jones through a trusted emissary. But we do need answers on these matters which are vital to our well-being.

Dear Cde. Leader,

You and Dr. Reid are the leaders of the avante garde socialists here in Guyana, and we place our future hopes with you. Minister Mingo is most helpful in allaying our fears that anyone would be able to undermine you here. It is hard to produce (which we are doing satisfactorily) when you are under vicious attack from abroad. But for us to feel there were no future at home would be paralyzing. The conspiracy is concentrating on trying to divide Peoples Temple and the Guyana government, as well as encourage hatred for Guyana with sensational, biased, and negative press reports. Following is an outline of recent developments:

MEDIA ATTACKS ON GUYANA AND PEOPLES TEMPLE

The establishment press in the United States has renewed its hysterical attacks on Peoples Temple, and also is including outright lies, misrepresentations, distortions, and sensationalistic charges against yourself and Guyana.

The most recent diabolical and insidious strategy is to try and portray Jonestown as being an armed camp. We know for a fact that part of this is to make Venezuela nervous and upset about having a socialist group on their borders, as well as to mislead and cause suspicion among our Guyanese friends. They are making up outrageous lies that we have guns all over the place. (They are even trying to make parallels with our current situation with Venezuela to the Rupununi insurrection to cause suspicion and mistrust.)

Debbi Blakey, the young woman who just left our group and stole approximately \$15,000 (US) while doing so, is also making up outrageous lies, and is working full force with the reactionary conspiracy to try and destroy our organization. Among her bizarre tales she tells the lie that Jim Jones has a high regard for Idi Amin. We don't ever remember Jim saying anything that could remotely be construed as having "respect" for Idi Amin. We do recall him making the statement that he wondered if Amin would be getting all the concerned press he is now getting if he were white. Jim doesn't know Amin but it is a fact you can't know a man by what you read in the paper. (As you mentioned about Zaire, they reported the number of white casualties but didn't mention the number of our black comrades that were killed by the imperialists.)

What Jim is really concerned about is the attacks on Guyana. They are so sensationalistic and provocative. One day they say you are a Maoist and we are working with you, and the next day they say we are pro-Soviet and pro-Cuban. The American public must be idiots not to see such contradictions. It is obvious they are setting Guyana up in every way possible to be hated by the U.S. For example: "I went to Parliament with Joe Ramson and what did I find staring me from the wall at the right hand side of the Prime Minister of Guyana? A near life sized oil of China's Mao Tse-Tung. Look's like it'd down the road to Peking for Guyana if Burnham's referendum passes - and it looks like it will." This quote was taken from an article by Kathy Hunter, the reporter who surreptitiously entered the country in May and

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whom such attention was drawn to by the incidents at the Pegasus. This type of McCarthyite ranting of hers is the most damaging kind of thing for Guyana. The U.S. press is getting more reactionary than ever. Even President Carter, by his own proclamation, states the press is serving even more reactionary elements than he.

Kathy Hunter has some other very vicious and ugly things to say about you and Guyana. It is obvious this woman was sent deliberately by the conspiracy to start trouble. It is hardly coincidental that all the trouble at the Pegasus started with her arrival and ended with her departure. An example of some of her vitriolic remarks:

"...Another fascinating tidbit making the rounds is that Forbes Burnham is holding the project up to public view as a prime example of how the Guyanese people themselves could make an all for one and one for all living without having to import outside products.

"Have also picked up the interesting rumored information that the land being used by the Peoples Temple for their experimental commune was sold to Jim Jones for an appreciable amount by the Prime Minister himself.

"All this is from the Guyanese people themselves and the latter ploy appears to be the bitterest pill of all. They are a fun-loving, free enterprising people and when the P.M. says they can only have one car and one piece of property to a family and when they can't buy replacement articles which the government has 'banned', they are slowly coming to a boil.

"From what I've learned in this very short time, it would appear that the Guyanese 'pot' is boiling over."

This kind of inflammatory reporting serves no purpose other than creating an anti-Guyana climate in America. It seems as if the troublemakers at home are in contact with the reactionary forces in the United States to try and whip up anti-referendum, anti-Burnham fever wherever they can. But it is not only directed to you, but also seems to try and discredit the government and the party in general. Example:

"...I was informed Mr. Waldron of the Immigration office was downstairs. I'd completely forgotten his asking me to bring my passport to his office that morning and had my conversation with the Police Commissioner had laid that to rest. Despite the protesting that I was waiting to be picked up and taken to Parliament to hear the Prime Minister read the bill on the referendum (which, if passed, would do away with the present constitution formed after the fashion of the United States and British Commonwealth) they hustled me off to the assistant secretary of the Ministry of Home Affairs where I was treated in most contemptuous and insulting manner and informed that my stay in the country had been cancelled. The assistant secretary said the next plane out would be at 1 p.m. Wednesday and I would be on it."

The hardly subtle innuendo that the Guyanese government is drafting a new constitution, not to try and improve conditions in the country, but rather to take a stance opposed to the U.S. and Britain, is an underhanded slap. Hunter's "horror" story gets even more disgusting in its sensationalism, trying to portray government officials as being gestapo-like, brutal, insensitive people. Example:

"...in the morning...the immigration officer called and demanded my passport. I told him I wouldn't give it to him, that it was issued by my government and I wasn't giving it up. He said if I wasn't on the 5 p.m. plane that day, they would come and put me on it by force. I told him that if he wanted to be responsible for my death, to go right ahead. He came up to my room and pounded on the door. I

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wouldn't let him in without the manager. He got the manager and came to the room again and left. I had to have the doctor again and he told them I was unable to travel and he would let them know when I could. He also told them - the Immigration officers - to stay away from me...that I was in no medical condition for their harassments.

Hunter is outrageous in her lies about Guyana and Peoples Temple. Now Debbi Blakey is the tool being used to whip up racist and reactionary emotion. They are saying that Blakey was a representative of the Temple officially and has gone to the Guyanese government as a delegate for us (a lie, but they are trying to add credibility to their fabrications). This is bizarre sensationalism. She was never a representative or sent to any government agency. Her lies are almost too ridiculous to refute.

One thing you should know is that Wesley Kirton, the son of UPI reporter Kirton, met with Debbie Blakey frequently before she absconded. There was obviously something more than a freindship going on here. Wesley has always been critical of socialism and has said things against the PNC. He has blamed the shortage of certain commodities on government corruption (rather than on the hoarders); he is opposed to the new Constitution Amendment Bill; and has questioned yours, Dr. Reids, and the party's integrity in general. We are suspicious that this is the young man Debbi became pregnant by. She contacted him the night before she left at 2:00 am. to help her with her nefarious scheme of stealing her mother's and others money. You should know that Blakey's mother, brother, and husband all live in Jonestown. Since Debbi has left and become a part of the fascist conspiracy (her mother knows fascism well - she escaped from a Nazi concentration camp) the entire family has been extremely upset and the mother is now very seriously ill.

No matter what Blakey says, the underlying reason for the USA's hostility to Guyana is the fact that we are a 3rd world, multi-racial socialist country, and we refuse to bow to their wishes (and this should be obvious to the Soviet Union as well). Racism is a prevailing motive of the United States, in spite of any images that are created to the contrary. We can attest to this with our own blood. And America is currently experiencing a wave of right-wing, McCarthyite rhetoric and feeling. President Carter is not like you and Dr. Reid - he doesn't have the courage to stand up. At best, he bows to pressure. And even if Carter's intentions are on the side of the angels, we can confirm that "personalities come and go, but institutions remain the same." We know the enemy, we have dealt with him for over 25 years.

We have an advantage in virtually being adopted by Guyana. We appreciate Guyana more than we have noticed many people do. We would defend this country to the point of dying if necessary, rather than go back and live in a racist, reactionary country. That is another reason why these absurd lies about us having bazookas and many guns is ridiculous. You know we would have no intention of doing anything but defending our people and our country. The Guyana government is black, and we are willing to die for that. We are not indicating prejudice when we say this, but we know the history of Guyana, and "apanjat" is simply not acceptable to us. We wish this government to remain in power and we have said this to people in the United States, including Soviet friends of ours.

This stuff about an armed camp, and the other lies, are stupid and ridiculous. We know you know these things are not true. But if you ever want to have help in that way in an hour of need, don't hesitate to ask us. We would be quite a formidable fighting force to reckon with because we know the ultimate price of freedom and we are prepared to pay it to live in a free country. We came here to be free, and to work hard and till the soil, and we will continue to do so - and be ready to die to keep Guyana free if necessary.

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INCIDENT WITH VENEZUELAN COLONEL AT PAPAYA

A delegation of our people went to Papaya to hear you speak. While there our people were approached by a colonel in the Venezuelan armed forces. He said he had heard what a lovely place Jonestown was from Dr. Reid, and wanted to know if he could come and visit. We have no intentions of ever getting close with Venezuela, and wanted you to be abreast of the situation. If you would like these people from Venezuela to come and see our project (and they do want to see it), then please let us know. Otherwise, we will not even entertain the notion. If they came they could be forever satisfied that we have no squads of armed guards and Jonestown is not an armed garrison. That colonel could see that for himself. This whole thing is a calculated move by forces in the United States to try and get us in trouble down here and arouse the Venezuelan suspicions.

Another thing we thought we would report is that one of our members, in Venezuela for medical attention, saw a map of Venezuela and it had the North West District of Guyana shaded in, as if it were Venezuela's territory. They saw more than one map like this.

As we said before, we will not respond to this Venezuelan officer in any way unless we hear from you to do so.

LIONEL LUCKHOO

Lionel Luckhoo is asking us to get his book published in the United States called "Verdict for the Defense". He is asking our counselor in the U.S. to get a publisher for him. What is this? This man is so critical of Marxism it is ridiculous. We know there are no perfect solutions to any problem, but this man is about as socialist as the man on the moon. He is so pro-American it is sickening, and off the record, we wonder if he will mess up our case being this way. He is very friendly to us, but it is his little indirect comments he makes about blacks that make us wonder.

Perhaps his writing will appeal to the average reader, but it certainly doesn't appeal to us. It is so narcissistic. He is interested in corporate stock. It's the kind of thing where if you read between the lines you can see how much he trusts the United States.

It does not speak against Guyana, nor will it hurt Guyana. It is quite apparent that there is no love lost for Cheddi Jagan. However, we would like to know just what the position is because we are socialists and this man is not, and his writings are not, unless he's had a change of heart since then. We can understand the necessity of using his skills - you have got to keep a country together. But we did want to point these things out. (Frankly, we know liberal Americans who wouldn't speak out some of the things he has spoken to us privately that almost eulogize the United States.)

Lastly, we did want to mention the one phrase in his book that did bother us because he reflects his concern for life: a would be client walked in his office and confessed "I've just killed my wife." Lionel offered the cheerful response "That is a minor offense." Life is sacred to Socialists, and even though this may have been just for sensationalism, it seems a bit callous.

CELEBRATE LIFE

We are people who celebrate life, but are not afraid to face death from the enemies of black liberation (3rd world, international liberation). We decided to move to Guyana years ago because of your courage in telling the United States you would not be told what to do (re: the Cuban planes) and you would die standing on your own two feet. It was this kind of courage that made us move our people here. We want to

stand with someone who has some guts. We want no changes in the leadership of the present government. Jim Jones and everybody on the project are behind you, Dr. Reis, and Minister Mingo 100%.

Imperialism will have to crush us if it ever moves against the government of Guyana. On that you can depend. We have come here to be free, and we have made our last move.

THE RACIST & REACTIONARY POLITICAL CLIMATE
IN THE UNITED STATES

Senator Brooks, the only black senator since 1880, has held this post since 1966. He is considered from moderate to conservative. He also serves as Attorney General in the state of Massachusetts. He was recently brought before the Senate Ethics Committee and indicted on 15 separate counts of financial irregularities, and faces up to 175 years in prison. The significant thing about this is that Senator Brooks was not bothered until he spoke up for the African liberation movements. As a matter of fact, the charges were brought to bear while he was in Africa, the day after he had come out strongly against the racist regimes of Vorster and Salch.

Representative Barbara Jordan, also considered a moderate, has been one of the most popular and vocal black elected officials. She is due to run again shortly, but says she will not as the racial climate in the U.S. is too severe, and would prevent her from winning.

SEPIA magazine, one of the largest black periodicals in the United States, recently published the startling evidence of how black elected officials are being singled out for persecution and prosecution. All have been smeared in the press, for one thing or another. Over half are under criminal indictment and criminal investigation at the present time. The documentation was provided by the Lt. Governor of California and the Lt. Governor of Colorado.

Mark Lane, who wrote a very enlightening book on the Kennedy assassination called Rush to Judgement has been smeared in the press recently. His crime: his book is gaining too much validity and acceptance in the U.S. He very effectively exposed the Kennedy assassination for what it is, a premeditated, conspiratorial murder. This man is now the victim of merciless smears in the media.

There is a woman witness who can give concrete evidence as to the conspiracy behind the plot to assassinate Martin Luther King Jr. and its connections with the CIA and reactionary forces in the U.S.

Frank Schnepf, an ex-CIA agent, recently published a book called Decent Interval. In this book he gives the proof and the documentation of how the United States was the country that escalated the war in Angola, did numerous things to subvert Neto's MPLA, and actually were the ones responsible for much of the bloodletting. He has had to leave the U.S. for fear of his life.

Larry Flynt, the publisher of Hustler magazine, wrote a searing indictment of the U.S. government's involvement in the Kennedy assassination. He gave much evidence and raised many valid questions, and asked for a re-opening of the investigation. Two months ago, Larry Flynt was shot in an attempted assassination. He very nearly lost his life, and is now paralyzed from the waist down permanently.

The Nazi party U.S.A. and the KuKluxKlan are enjoying a tremendous upsurge in popularity and support. Their memberships are growing by leaps and bounds. Recently the U.S. Supreme Court upheld the right for the Nazi's to hold a march in Skokie, Il. a city comprised of more than 60% escapees from Nazi concentration camps.

In what is being termed a "tax revolt", but in actuality is a backlash against the poor, there are 23 states that have now passed legislation of one sort or another reducing taxes that are being used to support public hospitals, public education, and civil servant jobs. In California, there are the frightening prospects of over 1/3 of the schools not having the funds to open, public hospitals having to close, mass transit reduced, and guaranteed job losses for several hundred thousand people, most of them black, brown, other Third World, and women. There is not a lower income family that is not affected.

Racial violence in schools across the country continues on the increase. Boston, Louis-

Dear Cde. Dr. Reid,

Please excuse the somewhat rough and unstructured nature of this communication; it was transmitted to our Georgetown secretary under less than optimum conditions. However, we have felt it was of urgency and could not wait.

MERCENARIES BEING SENT TO GUYANA

We have alarming evidence that the ringleaders of the campaign against our organization and leader have been seriously considering and perhaps have already been setting into motion machinery to fly in mercenaries to make an attempt on the life of Cde. Jim Jones and others. This is nothing new in light of the conference of all progressive countries meeting in Cotonou, Benin in which it was revealed that mercenaries are being widely employed in Asia, Africa, and Latin America. Furthermore, we have heard from an informant that is inside Tim Stoen's circle that this is the tactic to be employed against us by reactionaries backing Tim Stoen because Guyana is the lone socialist outpost on the South American continent. Mr. Stoen, who has taken a leading role in these efforts, has been in contact with a CIA front group that specializes in aerial reconnaissance. We have the name of that organization and are relating it to you in strictest confidence: the Eureka Research Association. We request that you do not divulge this name since it could possibly harm a private arrangement we have with friendly officials in the United States who have agreed to try and do something to stop such efforts, which could possibly start an international incident and could have great repercussions. One of the U.S. Embassy officials is concerned about this being a likely prospect as he told a delegation of our members.

We know of plans to conduct such insane, criminal operations via telephone communications and letter correspondence, but we want more direct proof. We also know that these individuals, fronted by Mr. Stoen, have even been trying to get the U.S. State Dep't. involved in their schemes, although they have not been successful. Mr. Tumminia, head of the Council Desk in Washington, has repeatedly said there are no grounds for the charges about this community, and has clarified that position in writing, and spoken fondly of our organization in response to inquiries about us. We were told by an official in the U.S. State Dep't. that the State Department was asked to cooperate with the mercenary operation and absolutely refused. He told this in strictest confidence, because he said it would compromise

his position if revealed. It could take a lie detector test.

We know that these threats must be taken seriously, and that we are not overreacting. Recent history is full of examples supporting a common-sense view. We know that rightist elements in the United States could undertake such an operation to test out the vulnerability of Guyana to infiltration and similar military adventures. The issue of hiring mercenaries is a real one in the U.S. for there are even national magazines (e.g. Soldier of Fortune) which act as placement services for would be mercenaries (such as Rhodesia).

In the wake of these activities, and the fact that threats to hire mercenaries against our community are publically aired in the California press by people cooperating with Tim Stoen, we urgently request clearance to adequately equip ourselves. We have not been able to get ordinary guns, and have just barely been able to secure a few gun permits for shotguns. We did make application for hunting to adequately defend ourselves. We must have what we applied for and more.

We are close to getting the direct information concerning precise plans to kidnap and assassinate Cde. Jim Jones and reportedly as many others as necessary to get through to him. Tim Stoen has contacted the man who is responsible for the murder in recent months of one of the activists dear to our group and other groups in the U.S. - Chris Lewis. Though this, Lewis acted too independently he did fight black oppression and even the press admitted it was an assassination. Tim Stoen said that before he would lie about us, something would have to be done about Lewis who was loyal to Jim because of Jim's consistent assistance to black political movements.

We now have proof that a man named Charlie Walker, an underworld leader, met with Tim Stoen and a newspaper reporter, and is also involved in plans to land mercenaries in this area. There are right wing moulans involved in it whose names we have. Unfortunately, perhaps tragically, the U.S. press is reluctant to concern itself with our situation until "something happens." And, as was brought out in the Denton conference, the U.S. press even glorifies mercenaries -- like they were cowboy adventurers, so you must understand our desire to be left at least the appearance of not being defenseless (though our interest is hunting). Our people are understandably alarmed, and would even make an unforgettable demonstration should efforts be pursued to kidnap people here without our having adequate means of self-defense.

GUYANA CONSUL TO MEET WITH CONSPIRATORS

The group involved must be taken seriously, and even moderate voices are deeply concerned, and we feel that, certainly, Socialists should be all the more concerned. The group tried several "legal" and "diplomatic" means to pursue their schemes, but they got nowhere with the press, nowhere with Congress, and nowhere with the State Dept. Now they are going to try a personal venture and we absolutely know they have right wing money behind them. Their efforts actually originate with a militantly right wing Congressman who practically has his own personal shock troops and intelligence apparatus. The group paid off a public relations firm nearly \$1,000,000 according to our reports. Our information is sound, and comes from not only our own work, but close sources which include moderates, chief of the activists, and socialists. We have learned that Tim Stoen is now in a meeting in a very few days with a T. station and the Guyana consul official in Georgetown, the late Cde. Claude Worrell's successor. We are confident to us that an official from Guyana would meet with **BB-8-m-2** the consul that is planning to hire mercenaries in Guyana.

We are doing our share we feel. We release people from the tent of us step up our schedule to maintain production in numerous occasions so that some of our people can participate in PNC work. We have given our hand free of charge for functions and have spent \$1,000 for tickets and for PNC fund raising activities, e.g. Bingo, dances, etc. One hundred of our entertainers participated in the May Day festivities and parade, dancing down the streets (one even fainted because she didn't stop for a break). We were proud to stand in support of labour solidarity under your PNC. Yet we cannot express how exasperated we are at the timidity and lack of support that we have received out of too many quarters in our government from people who could at best be called technocrats, unworthy of tying your shoes. And some of them we know to be criminal and yet they continue to function at their post. We know that their is a time and a place for "house-cleaning," but we see no reason whatsoever that we cannot now receive the guarantee that the members of the PNC, both at home and abroad, will no longer dignify the machinations employed by our government.

LICENSING OF OUR MEDICAL INTERNSHIP

Incidentally, a recent visitor to the project, Dr. Walter Thulin, a gifted and internationally known cytologist, and head of a medical network of over 2000 members in the United States and round the world praised our work after staying several days. He said that our project's physician, Dr. Larry Schacht, was one of the best he had ever met out of over 5000 doctors he knows personally. He showed Dr. Schacht a whole series of cytology slides, and Dr. Schacht astounded him by identifying every one of them correctly. We are now doing cancer research out in the jungle that is almost unknown in some quarters of the U.S.A.

The issue of licensing Dr. Schacht remains a critical one for us. That we were assured that there would be a special arrangement for him to do his internship here and come in only once very couple of weeks for special consultation with his preceptor. We have clarified that Dr. Schacht's presence in Georgetown is vital; he consults an critical cases each night with our international medical network of the world's top physicians via amateur radio (which has already saved lives). This was to be the main thrust of his internship, and providing written work to a preceptor. Minister Green told us that a compromise could be worked out, but another health official said that maybe he told us that because of a very instructive hospital case concerning a malnourished baby. We referred the baby to public hospital because our physician was told by yet another official in the Ministry of Health that he could not risk working with such a case since he was unlicensed. We transported and maintained the baby's family at our cost in our Georgetown headquarters. The baby was dying in public hospital because of poor care, according to the hospital to which the baby had subsequently been transferred. It received only black tea to control diarrhea, and no medicine. The doctor at the hospital where the baby was transferred was quite conscientious, but the child was already too far gone and died two days later of gross malnutrition.

We know that we could have taken care of the baby ourselves if Dr. Schacht felt the liberty to do so. We have lost no children and have never seen who were in a similar condition. We do not wish to be a party to this matter. We reassured the mother; we took care of her in our Georgetown headquarters, tried to make her feel that she did the best she could. When children come here with such problems, we must have our doctor here to work with them. We cannot afford to keep sending them at our expense to public hospital, and we can't conscientiously send them to municipal hospital, then we think you can understand our position that sentiment with anyone but you. BB-8-A-3

own country, and dignify the work of this conspiracy, though please understand he's been very kind and sympathetic to us personally and would gladly bow out if given notice from your good office.

We must express in the strongest terms opposition to such a meeting which will only fan the flames of their attacks and play right into their hands. We have been told repeatedly by party members that Sunny Mann is capable of taking almost any action. We have been told reliably that he would cooperate with anyone and proof of that has been provided your office, as you will know. We know that Sunny Mann will soon be going to San Francisco and Los Angeles, and we naturally wonder for what reasons, and if his trip in anyway concerns us. The consulate in Los Angeles confirmed that there was absolutely no grounds to the charges of Tim Stoen and company about our community. We based this on the statement of the head of the Guyanese desk at the U.S. State Dep't. In short we implore you to take a hand here and assist (immediately -- within 5 days -- to resolve this situation before any meeting is held to dignify those schemings of a renegade who has already insulted the integrity of the legal system in Guyana in the most brazen and arrogant fashion.

Tim Stoen is a totally amoral person. He acted like a perfect socialist in our organization for a number of years (and stated he had always been a socialist from childhood). We discovered, however, that at one time he had been arrested in the German Democratic Republic for espionage. We have already given you the evidence in this matter. Such people should not, we maintain, be dignified by any officer at any level in any meeting, especially before the media.

Just last night we discovered that one of the persons in this conspiracy told a teacher in our school - Clara Johnson - in a radio telephone patch that "it is Tim Stoen's business if they want to kill you." This worthy couple who have turned to become religious fanatics and sell-out the old Tom's, have 7 relatives here - all legally, as are all the residents. When he said "kill you" he was speaking in the collective sense in terms of exterminating the community! (And then he even specified his own relatives.) His name is Hedlock.


If we are to be able to continue to produce, to build, to live and feel accepted here, to integrate (which we've been told to do by delegations averaging 20-30 a day on of late, praising us as a model community), and make the full measure of our contribution, we recommend earnestly that some principled person in government such as yourself, act to put an end to this charade, so that these attempts to dignify their case by meeting with Guyanese officials are stopped. Such is being accomplished here - you can do it to yourself to come out here and personally see the extent of what we've done.

You may not be aware of it, but our medical facilities here have absolutely proven to be life saving. We deal with scores of dire medical situations weekly. Babies that would have succumbed are here right now recuperating and getting expert 24 hour a day treatment in our facility. The reporter from the USSR Tass news agency came and saw this work and praised it very highly, calling it a paradise. Of course we did not stress the medical difficulties that handicaps them from assimilating their food, which happens in any society. We build your name up high in our appreciation of your example and practical help as a person who lives humbly - not out as a Socialist theoretician, but as a devoted practitioner. **BB-8-m-4**

in with a resolution to this situation.

Again, we would love to have you come here and see this community first-hand. As a final note we reiterate that we cannot continue to be constantly harassed while plans of hired mercenaries and violence experts are made to be carried out against us, while having our fellow countrymen both here and in the U.S. dignify our harassment, as would be the case if the commander or any other Guyanese official were to meet with Mr. Stoen. It is ridiculous to give Stoen this opportunity as he's been able to get no press coverage on his own (and even in this case the station involved is the least interested). We know we are doing good service here, and we would like to feel a sense of acceptance, and the support of our new home in our struggle against this conspiracy. We know that we can defeat it, and move forward with you to building a great future of this nation of promise and beauty that we have come to love.

Dear Cde. Prime Minister Burnham,

We have learned that Tim Stoen is attempting to bring into the country a group of right wing provocateurs who are bent on inciting and promoting more trouble for Guyana. Their names include the Breidenbach's and the Johnson's. Tim Stoen is using as his latest appeal the accusation that Guyana and Jonestown are a communist prison camp. From what we have been told, these people have so far refused Stoen's advances and have not responded.

It seems that Tim Stoen will try to contact anybody these days to try and get his dirty work done. Another of his latest schemes was to contact Angela Davis and ask her to get in touch with the USSR. He offered her money and support if the USSR would take official stands against Jim Jones in the United States. Angela has said she would sign sworn testimony to that fact.

We are sorry to have to always bring these types of things to your attention, but have told you we will always keep abreast of everything we hear.

There is another matter of grave concern to us. But for one recent exception, we have been told there is a stand-off policy towards us in the media. Now we have received a letter from one radio station asking us to change the content of our radio program, and upon investigation the General Manager had the complaint that we "talked about socialism" for almost one entire show.

If someone could really tell us what is going on it would be to the best advantage of everyone. Out of respect to you and Dr. Reid, Minister Hugg has a real sense of loyalty. But Jim Jones is loyal also, and he needs to know desperately the difference between rumor and fact, and an explanation about the hesitancy towards us saying "socialism."

If you do not feel comfortable speaking with Jim's staff, then please speak directly to Jim or his wife. Any response would be most deeply appreciated.

- I met Roy the night our group was performing, he said he dropped in because he wanted to here us.
- He came with a man from the Cuban press in Guyana, both he and the man appeared to be very drunk.
- He said they were close friends, they had gone to school together in East Germany
- It was his birthday, (Roys) and he wanted to know if I would take a drink with him?
- I said I didn't drink, so I'd have a pepsi. He got obnoxious with persistence, said this is what we do in Guyana, and he was going to buy a drink for me and I was going to have a beer. (he got loud enough so that all standing around the bar could here; and the tone he used was accusation that I was too good). I told him I hated beer and if he wanted me to have a drink it would be a soft drink, or I wasn't going to drink with him at all.
- He finally got a drink but declared before the evening was over I was going to have one.
- He said he was going to East Germany, the govt. was asking him to go there and work in the Embassy. He felt some reservations about it because he had alot of conflicts
- said he was being put into the position directly under the ambassador (charge d affaires)
- I told him it was good and he should accept the job.
- He said he knew he could do it, but he had conflict about it. He said he didn't even like the job he had right now because of what it intalled.
- He said theres a part of him that likes us (Peoples Temple), but at the same time he has to always keep in mind his countries goals first and what they are trying to do.
- Whenever he talks to us, or any group of non-Guynese, he has to let them know that no one will rule us, or tell us how to run our country (in so many words he said this is a black country and they had to maintain their nationalism).
- I told him I didn't see how he could view our group in the same way as he did others in that we were multi-racial, not only in marriages, but our children were of different nationalities with Jim Jones as our eg.
- He maintained that people could still be racist and be married to a person of a different race, he used himself as an eg. said he was once married for nine months to a pure East Indian woman, but he still maintained that they had to protect the nationalism of the country (Blacks in Power).
- He said he knew alot of people who were married to East Indian women that would fight to keep the Indians from gaining power.
- I told him I could not understand how he could view Peoples Temple with racism at all or even a group that was trying to gain power in Guyana. I mentioned that we came working voluntarily and didn't take any jobs from Guynese, and that he should come and see how we live in that we are living co-operatively, the life style that Guyana talks about and is trying to work towards. I said if nothing else he could tell what were by the way we live.
- He said you people keep inviting me up there, but you don't seem to understand, especially Sharon and you. He said Mike understood why he couldn't come up, but Mike was one of us and he had to maintain the position that we took.
- He said the reason he didn't like his job is because he had to lie to people, people like you (Peoples Temple) and others
- He said after he came and visited with us at our home, the next day he told his colleague the young man that works with him in his office, not to talk to us unless he got instructions from him first, but to listen and learn.
- Roy said he like talking to us because he learned alot, especially Sharon, Tim & Mike. His friend from Cuba kept coming up to us and trying to get Roy to leave.
- Roy said he had originally come with his friend to go to the Cuban Embassy, said that

- May first went alot of celebrations in Cuba because labor day, meaning that the power was in the hands of the people, went alot in Cuba. He had asked him to stop off at the Pegasus so he could hear a little of our performance.
- I kept telling Roy I thought he should go with his friend in lieu of the Pegasus for some time.
- He said he didn't want to go and he would just tell his friend to go get a beer everytime he bothered him about going.
- Roy said he didn't want me to feel like he was pumping me for information (which is exactly how I felt)
- He wanted to know where Sharon was, I told him she was in the Hosp. He said he would go visit her.
- The whole time he was talking to me he kept tapping my shoulder, fiddling with my collar and holding on to the necklace around my neck, I kept moving away from him and finally told him I had to go before the next performance because I was helping to quarantine it. (before this I had taken him around to try to introduce him to some of our other people so he couldn't corner me but they were all involved in other conversations, so when I broke away from him, I asked Debbie what did she think would be the best thing to do, finally I got Tim to go with me and talk to him. Earlier I had tried to get him to go with me to see Tim, he said he didn't want to talk to Tim so he was slightly hostile when Tim came over, but just as persistent that he drink a beer and got almost nasty with Tim about this too.
- Tim had Shirley to announce a special happy birthday to him from Peoples Temple over the microphone, he became a little pleasant to deal with.
- Earlier in the conversation I reminded him he had not given us guidelines, or a code of ethics to go by.
- He said he thought the whole suggestion was ridiculous.
- He made a comment about us going from person to person asking about guidelines
- I said if we had been given some parameters in the beginning, then maybe some of our difficulties could have been avoided, such things as customs where the things we bring in are to assist Guyana, but in all the bureaucracy, those that hinder us from bringing in things with expediency are only hindering Guyana.
- He said something and I started to answer it, he told me to shut-up,
- I told him he had just better cool it.
- Some other people came up that I knew and I excused myself to say hello.
- a few minutes later, Roy introduced me to a friend of his who was working in the National Service Press.
- His name was Fabien Comer, he said he wanted to come over to our home and talk to us about our project, said he had heard about us and was interested.
- I told him we would enjoy talking to him some time.
- He said good, then he would come over Tuesday.
- I told him Tuesday was a bad day, just after the holidays,
He asked what day would be better, I told him Wed., said he would be coming at 4:30 on Wed.
- After the Show was over Roy asked Debbie Blakey to locate me, he wanted to talk to me before he left, so I kept out of sight until time to go., He caught us going out the back.
- He said another one of his friends had been left laying on the ground by members of the band and was drunk so he and the guy from the Cuban press and another Cuban fellow were trying to help him home. He asked me to step aside with him, before I heard something I wouldn't understand. (His friend was homosexual and dressed in a somewhat transvestite fashion)
- He said his father was a minister in parliament when the British were in power
- said I love my father, but he's an ass
- said people say when he goes somewhere, Oh, your so and so's son, but he (Ron)

- wanted to do something for Guyana, He wanted to do something to make people in Guyana be proud of themselves, mentioned that the people were lazy, wanted them to work to change the society.
- He said his father lived in a fine home, but he didn't want that type of life
- said he was given ever ything he wanted when he was young, and that was bad.
- He asked me to call him on Monday, I told him I could not because I would be in the parade. I told him we would come in some time this week.

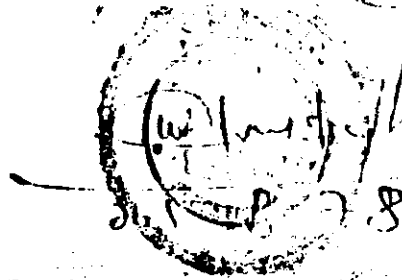

GOODLETT (dinner night he came back, next morning to airport) Tim Carter, Marcie, Tony

-the night Goodlett returned the thing he was most concerned about was that Jim not go to Moscow before a thorough work-up had been done. He wanted more malaria tests run - said you should do at least 7 before ruling out malaria completely. He said it would not look good if Jim went all the way to Moscow and they found something that could have been caught or dealt with here. He said a thorough work-up should be done. Wanted to rule out all possibilities of indigenous disease.

-Goodlett felt that the Peoples Forum should be published again. He said that we have something to talk about, and the people need to know. He also said there is protection in a newspaper, they don't like to come after people that have papers.

-he said the reason Jim was being harassed and the Temple was being harassed was because we were a threat. As long as we were just talking in a church that was one thing, but when we started putting people on the streets we became a viable force, a real threat. He said when we put out all those people to help elect the mayor of Oakland that was it. We were the most powerful voice for the movement.

-~~xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx~~ we can be thankful for small things - big things, actually. When Goodlett came down to talk on the radio he said - and thank goodness the mic was not keyed - that he was concerned that before Jim go to Moscow to get his cancer treated he should get the tests etc. - I thought I was going to shit when I heard that. We told him how to work it after that, but, whew, it was close.

-the next morning at breakfast he started in on Huey Newton. He said the New Times article was scandalous but at the same time we must realize that Huey Newton is not the same man we knew years ago. He went on that Huey had a Messianic complex, that he goes around pistol whipping people if they don't treat him with the proper respect, that he did beat up Bobby Seale, he was living above the people in an expensive place doing cocaine, that the Panthers did ~~xxxxxx~~ extort money from the people in their neighborhood, and on and on. He was saying that as revolutionaries we have to face the truth about people. He started in on this by saying something like "you know Jim was showing that article to those reporters yesterday..." It seemed to me he was trying to indirectly criticize that strategy, and also make himself look more knowledgeable than Jim (Tony Walker and Ed Crenshaw were at the table - I don't know if anyone else heard what he was saying.) It told him that Guyanese for the most part have a hard time relating to racism and to what extent the media is used to smear people who are progressive etc and this is why Jim was showing this article, not because he had any false illusions about Huey Newton. Goodlett acknowledged the point but went on about the Panthers.

He said that he was the one that introduced the Panthers to Charles Garry, and that Garry charged them nothing. He also said that the Panthers used to do stupid things, like David Hilliard saying what he did about Nixon, and going around the neighborhoods telling people what was going to be done. He said that he, the Panthers, and a couple of others were setting up a committee to raise funds (for some Panther thing) and they got several thousands of dollars raised and the Panthers came and took 20,000 dollars of it without even consulting him, and he was the treasurer. He said that the IRS came to his door asking him questions about this committee and he said he told them he knew nothing about what the Panthers were doing and they were just using his name.

-he said the Cubans were having trouble with Huey and they were glad when he decided to go back to the states. Also said it was true that Huey was a coke freak.

-he said that Cleaver was "going to make it" - I don't know what in hell he means by that. But the insinuation was that Cleaver was really on top of it and by playing along the way he was he would be out from under his charge, and Huey meanwhile by doing what he's doing is making it worse for himself.

-mentioned again about the Forum. Said we have a story to tell the world and we should tell it. He said even if he had to buy the paper for us, he would to help get the story out. Said even if we only run 5,000 or 10,000 copies it would be worth it - if it changed just one person it would be worth it. Brought up the point about protection again.

-he said he was going to give us a 2 page spread of pictures in all his papers, and when he saw the pictures he would decide what to write. He mentioned putting this stuff in his Richmond, Virginia paper w/ circulation of 76,000.

-he said he would like to work something out where he covers Jonestown in his papers on a continuing basis. He said possibly every week that the Brun doesn't come out he could give us a half-page or something like that to keep the word spreading. He said he wanted to keep getting pictures so he could run them.

-said he would make a tape of broadcast quality when he got back to San Francisco. Also said that whenever we need a tape for broadcasting to just let him know and he would be glad to do it.

-he said he knew a woman who ~~he~~ does documentaries and he was going to get in touch with her and try to get her to come to Jonestown. She said she has made documentaries that have won awards and has a program on PBS for 2 1/2 years. He said if she did a documentary on us it would win awards at Cannes, Leipzig and the other major film festivals. He said ~~he~~ was very interested in doing a film.

-said he knew some dental students in Mississippi that he would like to have come down to Jonestown for an entire summer. He said at the same time they could give some dental assistance to the community.

-he said he was going to use Jonestown as an example for all the skeptics back in San Francisco that you can do something if you put your mind to it.

-is very praiseworthy of Larry and our medical care. Said our medical clinic was excellent, said Larry was a very good doctor, called ~~it~~ him a brilliant young man, and ~~we~~ kept repeating at different times that we really had a good doctor.

-spent a lot of time on the way to the airport telling me of his career in the movement - how he was the 84th black man ever to receive a PhD and he did it in 3 years, about how he marched with Paul Robeson to help integrate the big leagues, about some of his old students who are now prominent nationally in the ~~the~~ black movement, etc.

- asked me to pass the message on to Blackmon that he would be sending him some forms for him to fill out to join the Publishers Association Caribbean branch he said that perhaps they could get something going here to the point that Guyana could send a delegation to the next Caribbean convention in Jamaica.

-when I told him that his name had been mentioned in an article, he simply replied "good" ~~xxxxxxx~~ but his face did register surprise when I first mentioned it.

-kept saying Jonestown was "fantastic" and said it was an example that "dreams can come true" (his emphasis).

GREEN 8/26 Marcie, Tim, Tony, Terry

- Green was friendly - as friendly as he has been in the past, so it seems we still are on good terms. Sonny Ogle told me when I asked if Green was aware we had been trying to get an appointment for months that Green had not been aware, that his secretary had been screening the calls.

-when Marcie asked about ~~the~~ the proposal we sent in he said he had seen it, but hadn't studied it closely. He said he referred it on to Baird ~~xxxx~~ to have him take care of it.

-when we explained to him the situation with the customs thing he ~~we~~ replied that he had set forth a very simple procedure for us to follow to get things in (to write to him in advance and he would see they're let in) ~~and~~ why hadn't we done this. We explained to him the difficulty in communication, that we had been not able to use our radio as much, etc. and he seemed to understand. We told ~~it~~ him this had never happened in this particular way - this was a first time thing (which it is, really).

-he told us to write him formally and enclose a list of the supplies and he would see they were released immediately. I asked ~~it~~ him if we still had to go to Guyana Pharmaceutical, and he said that even though they had exclusive distributorship of what medications and supplies came in the country, he would bypass that as long as the stuff was for our medical clinic. This is a good indicator of how much Green regards us, I feel. It certainly is a ~~major~~ major concession. I just hope he can really pull it off without ruffling any feathers in customs or otherwise.

-he said he had called to airport trying to find Sharon to let Goodlett in ~~with~~ as a VIP but couldn't get hold of her. He had been away for several days and had just gotten back when he got the message. (once again, Green follows through - I wish Mingo were even one quarter as efficient.)

-Green said he would be visiting, he hoped before the end of the year

-he said he had been extremely busy, he had been out of town at a conference where they were discussing the problem of opportunists setting up medical schools to try and make up for the shortage, and providing inferior education and training, set up here in the Caribbean.

In the first place, nobody has told me anything about you; what I know is what I heard on the radio that day. Don't insult my intelligence. The fact is that nothing was said about dying until you started on the radio. If you keep this stuff up, I guess I'd gladly die, alright. I can't imagine you being on the steps of the Federal Bldg. with the Mertles! It's shocking that you'd be part of what every socialist movement in history has gone through. Just shocking!

Jim and Walter and Patty and all of us still love you, if you won't destroy our love; but our destinies are inseparable. You haven't gone as far as the others yet to hurt us, and I hope you won't, because you were upheld highly here even to the point that there would be an open door for you if you don't try to hurt us here.

I know that you know all about the mercenaries, and what they are getting ready to do. I want to remind you that you'll be doing a disservice to your own flesh and blood if you cooperate with those people.

I asked Harriet if she was "assigned" to you and she said she'd take an oath that she wasn't and in fact she said you were more in than she was, and if anyone would have been "helped" it would have been her. She said it was totally laughable and untrue and she thought you would have more sense.

For your information nobody took any risks for Jim in LA. The idea that you would even question the thing down there when you know what happened right outside the church not long before - - where that was supposed to have happened so close to the church. Dear, you must be wanting to believe what is comfortable! Dr. Lapkass has Jim's records - - you can talk to him and find out about Jim's health. But he is doing fine now. Don't try to tell me what he doesn't do! I've seen him risk too many times, and you forget I was in New York with him and I saw how he tried to get on a plane to come home then. You've really come along too late.

I am glad you are all doing "fantastically" well. They sure get paid enough. The idea of you with the Mertles is something I just can't get used to. Remember what was done to Elaine Brown when they got through with her. And don't forget too, that Tim insisted John had to visit Guyana. I was there the night it was decided.

Ask Tim to be tested - - when you went out and Jim sent Mom after you. Tim said then that you ought to be killed. Put him to the test on it. Obviously you're the one being taken in. It's stupid to blame Jim for your marriage falling apart. I was there when he asked Suzanne to stay with you. And Jim won't forget the mountain side - - remember how first he went down after a baby? You've really been manipulated. You know how they stand straight up and lie about John! Even Cyrus Vance says this whole thing is a

conspiracy! I knew all about this thing in L.A. and the two letters that Dick McCoy gave me . . . and we know who set it up. Just keep in mind that your name won't be mentioned in anything or anywhere as long as you don't talk about Jim or Patty in any way.

Something you said in your letter contradicts the charges you are making. You say you care about us, you are concerned that we are likely to all die together if things don't go our way. If you're really concerned, and if you believe that, then why do you keep pushing us to a position you believe would bring that about? Then you say Jim may leave Guyana with all the money and leave the People stranded. Jim could have left or died many times and had peace, but he knew he would leave a lot of people behind untaken care of. But if you don't choose to believe that, tell me how you can on one hand say he might take everything and leave, then say he is eager to die and take everyone with him? That doesn't make any sense.

Don't send me any more letters like that one. I'm not interested in your assurances - - but it's obvious that someone is giving you assurances. Jim did not talk to me about you, so don't you talk to me about him. Mon and I do mean it! This is a beautiful place, everyone is as completely happy here as anyone on earth can be. You should check with relatives who have been here. You can even check with Tom Adams to get their names and numbers. Also you should look up an article about us in one of the largest news agencies in the world - - I think you might know which one it is. In regard to our friend coming here when he did, the only way he could build this community was to come here himself. Our enemies are trying to tear things down here the same as they are trying to do there. Of course they can't do it because we're here to stay. We're not going anywhere.

I want you to be sure you know this is from me. Remember what you said some time ago to me - - "When you have a situation of socialist commitment and capitalist commitment, the two can't function together, and one must be canceled." I would have liked to have just been able to communicate with you as sister to brother about my life here. There is plenty to talk about. We go swimming quite frequently. Last time Mon went with me, and it reminded me of the time we all went swimming at the crystal swimming pool. But I'm not going to share with you all the good things in my life while you are trying to separate me from every thing I love. By the way, I love my husband very much. You sounded sarcastic when I told you about him. I don't appreciate that kind of reflection on my marriage. I hope in the future we will have more in common. That depends on you.

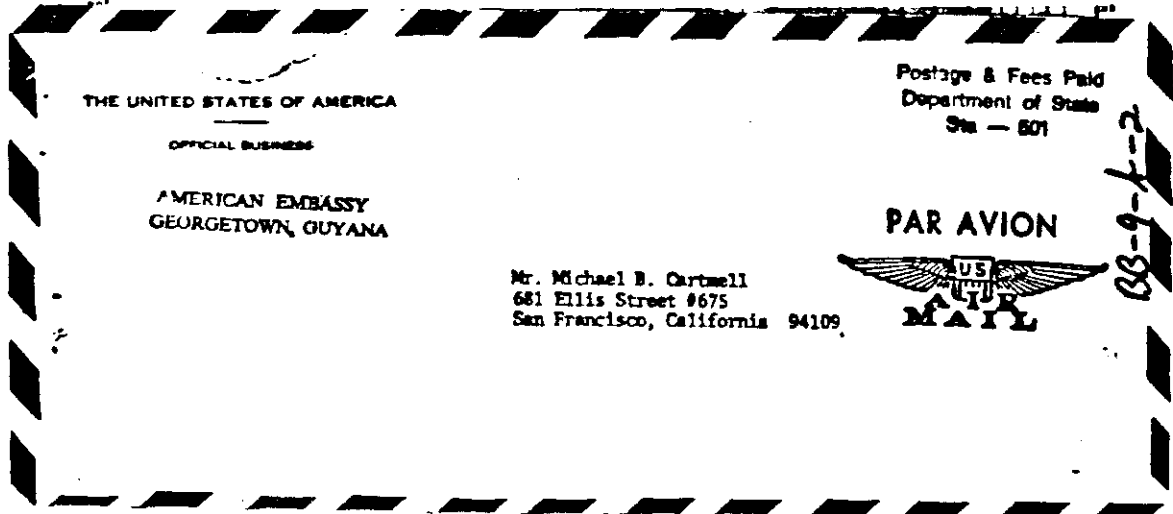

Also, I want you to know that I have a great deal of affection for you and that I will be totally lenient and forgiving and reluctant in pursuing anyone who does you any harm.

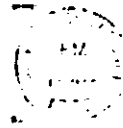

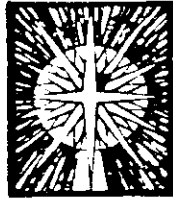

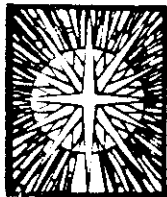

At June Crym's request, I appeared for you at a citation hearing in the above-captioned matter. The citation asked that you appear and explain why an inventory, appraisal and account should not be filed in the Lopez guardianship. At the hearing, I told Judge John Sparrow that:

- 1) You have been and will be outside the United States for an unknown period.
- 2) The Lopez file shows that in April 1977 you had prepared a first account showing no assets and no income in this estate. The account was never filed because you were unable to obtain the Guardian's signature.
- 3) On August 19, 1977, you sent a letter to Walter Jones, in care of Joseph A. Mazor and Associates, P.O. Box 99717, San Francisco, California 94109, containing a substitution of attorneys. The substitution, apparently, was never signed, returned to you and filed.

Judge Sparrow asked some questions about the minor's assets and income, and whether he is in "South America with some group." 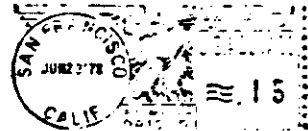

I. Eugene Chaikin, being duly sworn, declares:

I agreed to represent Mr. Walter Jones in the matter of the Guardianship of Vincent Lopez, without charge, and received no compensation therefore. Within two months subsequent to the hearing I saw him only once or twice, and have neither seen nor heard from him since then. When he left the San Francisco area he left no forwarding address nor any telephone number so I had no way to contact him. The first and only time I heard from him was the letter from Mr. Mazon to which I responded sending a substitution of attorney. I received no reply and have had no other communication with him. I do not know how to reach him. I left California and went to Guyana, South America where I now reside in September of 1977. I have been here ever since and do not plan to return to the U.S.A. for several years. The estate of Vincent Lopez had no assets. The boy himself was without assets. Prior to the Guardianship, he resided in a licensed home for boys, paid for by the State of California. That status was discontinued upon the completion of the Guardianship. To my knowledge Mr. Jones never applied for any ~~kind of~~ form of public assistance for Vincent. No assets ever came into the estate.

Thank you very much for your undated letter concerning one Timothy Stoen, which I received today. I very much appreciate your thoughtfulness in writing to me about this matter.

For the record, I have never, to my knowledge or memory, met Mr. Stoen or had any dealings or correspondence with him concerning this case. Nor do I, as Director of the Office of East Coast Affairs in the Bureau of Inter-American Affairs, have any responsibility for relations with Guyana. This office concerns itself with Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay and Uruguay. Moreover, it would be completely improper for an officer in my position to become involved in a custody case which is being tried in a Guyanese court of law.

There are one or two other Robert Zimmermans in the Foreign Service and there may be a confusion of identity, but so far as I am aware, they are not presently stationed in Washington and have had no connection with Guyana.

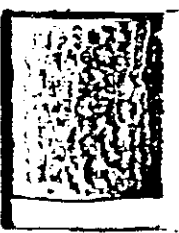

Phyllis -

I thought I would give your Department a brief rundown on my situation, for whatever you all may be able to do about it. I have a lot of the same symptoms that I had last year, but not as severe. My weight has got as low recently as 128 (which is a 20 year low for me) and as high as 134. It is now about 132. I do not feel that it is a dangerously low weight. I have little energy and fatigue very easily - this is constant. I still get a lot of major muscle spasm, internal irritation and followed by sudden sleepyness (which we have in the past attributed to low blood sugar, and corrected by increased protein - which worked well). My balance is very poor and I have some difficulty knowing just where I am putting my feet when I walk. My vision is blurred at distances closer than about 18" to 2', and I have almost constant dullache in my eyes. I get sudden emotional imbalances which are of short duration - wanting to cry usually. I get chilled easily and frequently, constantly nervous.

I had my eyes checked recently and need a new prescription. That will take care of the blurring, I am sure, but I don't know about the pain which seems to be associated with fatigue.

I saw Larry about 6 weeks ago, I guess, and recited the above liturgy. They did a couple of tests. He said that the sedimentation rate is still high - he did not know what to make of it and would get back to me, but of course never did.

I am functioning fairly well, though at perhaps only about 50% of my maximum healthy capacity. I am in no acute distress, and do not want to make any big issue about whatever isn't just right with me. As a practical matter I think that if my weight and sed rate is monitored regularly that will give some notice if things start to get too far out of balance. Additionally, from experience I know that I do better with a balanced diet with meats, greens and starch, and that the high starch diet that I get is contributive to some of my problems. Even the milk shake is full of sugar and probably is of assistance only because it has or should have a raw egg in it. I do not think that high starch snacks do help, although eating several times a day, 5 or 6, is much better for me than 3 times. I am also on the so called "high protein diet" but it is not substantially different than the regular diet, and at times actually has less protein than the normal diet.

I appreciate your concern.

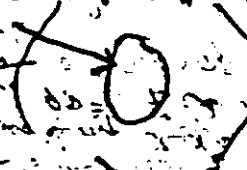

Dear Rev. Kinsolving:

I am sorry that you did not feel free to talk with us last night. The reason we called was simply to let you know that the reason our treasurer was reluctant to give you information by phone was that she had not been informed that you might want to call her. In addition to this, the meeting you attended yesterday was unusual for us. We had, besides yourself, an arch-conservative writing a book (who, it turns out, indicated he was most pleased), and two film-makers, Dave Gottlieb and Jim Ruxin, under a university grant filming aspects of our extensive human service work (and very enthusiastic).

One of the people on the financial committee got three calls from three different ministers (one from another denomination) commenting on a reporter who was very unfair and even treacherous who had come to our services. (Of course it is known that our pastor chooses not to handle our money, and its administration is entirely under the dominion of our membership.) No doubt when you phoned yesterday, our treasurer surmised that you were the one the ministers had called about. However, as of this moment, I have not been able to verify this one way or the other.

It would be a very nice thing for you to take the time to come back to Redwood Valley and talk to our officials and elders face to face. You can talk with the President of the Ministerial Association, who praised our work glowingly, and even the John Birch rancher across the way to ascertain their view on the humanistic influence of our church in the community.

Further, you should inspect the senior citizen homes, the convalescent homes (for non-church members), and the 40 acre children's homes to see how wisely the church's money is spent to serve people. It is a great joy to see ghetto children play in the meadow, so very appreciative of the beauty of nature.

Possibly you should have stayed for the sane spiritual healing part of the service. You would have learned that our pastor does, in fact, heal many persons at every meeting. Many healings have been documented and many more are the subject of written testimonies in our files. I, myself, was healed of cancer by him this past spring.

Please understand that our pastor and the whole body of the church are devoted to living a life that exemplifies brotherhood and service to mankind, as is demonstrated by our racially mixed congregation and our many human service projects. This life style has angered extremists on both sides of the color and political spectrum to the point that we have suffered threats and vandalism. Our local law enforcement agency has requested that we have trained persons carry firearms, and we have reluctantly acquiesced to the Sheriff's instructions on this matter.

Like Voltaire who said to Helvetius, "I disapprove of what you say, but will defend to the death your right to say it," our humanitarian concepts lead us to give support to all persons whose civil rights are threatened, freedom being precious and worthy of defending.

For this reason some black members of our congregation (not our pastor, the staff or the church as such) made a small donation to the Angela Davis defense fund. And, when we read in Jack Anderson's column of the Tennessee publisher whose plant was burned down because of his bravery in exposing corruption in local politics, we offered to move him to California and help him get a new start. Some of our members have also given support to such persons as Professor Oliver at the University of Illinois, whose job was threatened for being a member of the John Birch Society. As you can see, we have concern for, and will help -- within our means -- anyone whose rights are threatened.

We have enclosed some clippings, as promised, including the "letter to the editor" from the Indianapolis Star by Professor Carley. We appreciate your telling our treasurer that you were favorably impressed by what you saw and heard at our church yesterday. However, we would really like to have you get a more in-depth look at our church and its programs.

Our pastor has changed my life completely; it is whole and meaningful in stark contrast to the former life I led. He has brought happiness to so many people. He is a loyal friend to all, and he would extend this friendship to you.

GENE CHAIKIN, Self Analysis and Self Criticism

It is hard to know where to start, but I guess it does start with the very obvious fact that I was born and raised in a Jewish middle class home, and I carry with me all of the middle class elitism that is inherent in that dubious estate. More than most, I expect, I carry that disease of elitism because part of my family was petty nobility in Russia and they never let me forget it when I was a small child growing up. There was no doubt about it - we were just better than other people. On top of that I am afflicted with the twin intellectual diseases of so called intellectual independence and "cerebral sufficiency", that is, all I have to do is get an idea and have no real responsibility of what that may produce. It is sort of like the U.S. Atomic Scientists who just made it and disclaimed the responsibility for the millions of Japanese it fried. Now in my middle years, I suppose I also suffer from a sort of despondency or permanent depression that follows the realization that, ones youth passed, one is really a piss ant that has done nothing meaningful with ones life and is not likely to...any motivation for personal achievement in life has long ago dissipated. Any motivation for fulfillment is long ago recognized for the lie that it is. So, essentially, I am an middle aged elitist intellectual without any personal motivation. I have lived long enough to see history come and go - a bit of it - and what goes around comes around...Mc Carthy in the 50's and who knows who in the 70's....some sort of radical movement in the 30's and again in the 60's, two generations who worked (more or less seriously) see the total reversal of their work. I have never experienced anything but emotional pain with sex (even the highs are tainted by the lows which are bound to follow). I do not feel anyone is attracted to me, either male or female. The only continuously good sexual experiences are in fantasyland. My sexuality is repressed - that is its major characteristic - especially my homosexuality which is no weaker than the other in terms of drive but just a little more repressed. Above the limited physical gratification is the pain of trying to work through ones own selfishness and indifference in order to attempt a genuine relationship with another human being ... and the pain of facing its ultimate futility and failure. It just doesn't seem worth it. The only relationship sexually I can visualise for myself at this time is a one night stand.

I am selfish, and tired. I have little concern for or patience with others. Living has never been easy nor pleasant for me. I can't get out of my own bag. In my purview saving a life is a sort of crime - a condemnation to further suffering. I live with the constant feeling of the futility of all things. There is much truth in Dicks analysis of the role of the intellectual, but I hate the thought of a world where the right to life is predicated on the persons (or animals) utility in the political, social or economic sphere.

I have little hope for the success of the community here. It is obvious to me that a lot of people here just do not want it. They drag the rest - the more concerned people - down badly. What will happen to our children, brought up in such a specialized society, if they must ultimately adjust to the outer world? Their pain will surely be our responsibility if we do not keep this together.

If I functioned based upon love or concern for my fellow man I doubt if I would get out of bed in the morning. I function on duty. Though I would much prefer to die I have a duty to live, and that as creatively and constructively as I can. It is my duty to make the future as pain free as possible for the children - to work against oppression and exploitation. That is why I am a Socialist. That is why I am here. That is why I will stay, and work diligently to try to make Jonestown a viable community with some prospect of continuity.



Dear Mr. Freitas:

It has come to our attention that Tim Stoen has attempted to persuade you to use your influence regarding a custody dispute between him and members of Peoples Temple. The matter is being adjudicated by the Guyana court system, and we maintain that it would be unethical were any pressure or influence exercised on behalf of either of the parties in the dispute. It is for this reason that we ask you to resist any attempts by Mr. Stoen or others representing him to induce you or members of your staff to interfere in the determination of this private matter.

We have recently spoken with representatives from the U.S. State Department and the American Embassy in Guyana. They have insisted that their position is one of total neutrality. Nevertheless, Mr. Stoen has attempted to influence them to exert pressure on behalf of him and his wife. He has even gone so far as to accuse members of Peoples Temple of crimes which he later admitted to U.S. officials were never committed.

You are no doubt aware of the background and circumstances in the case. If not, we refer you to Herb Caen's column of a few weeks ago. We are sure that after reading this material you will not wish to take a position in the matter. There are other factors in the case of which you may not be aware that would make it especially inappropriate for your office to attempt in any way to prejudice the Guyana court system. For one thing, Tim Stoen was openly insulting and condescending to local officials, stating that he did not trust the Guyanese to handle the matter fairly, behaving in a manner most unbecoming -- indeed, arrogant -- to anyone visiting a third world nation. Though unsuccessful, he was very likely (and still may be) attempting to provoke an international incident over the matter.

It is not for us to reflect here on what may be Mr. Stoen's motivations, except to say that they are assuredly less than honorable, and should he be successful in enlisting your aid in his dubious cause, it would -- needless to say -- reflect poorly on the integrity of your office which, to date, has shown itself totally impartial and above-board in its handling of the entire Peoples Temple matter.

I am asking that our office in San Francisco enclose with my letter some material about the community here, which has been very highly praised by all who have visited as a model of co-operative living and constructive development. We are thoroughly fed up with the despicable attempts to portray this community in some quarters of the press as some type of dismal 'hard-labor' camp; this has been done to provide a 'cover' for the kind of schemes which Tim Stoen and others have been pursuing. It amounts to a **BR-10-1-6**

tragic and cruel exercise that has almost made us ashamed of our many stands for press freedom. We are especially sorry about Tim, who for several years appeared to do an outstanding job on behalf of the people we serve, but who is evidently under some kind of pressure or fear for his professional reputation -- we don't profess to understand the complexity of the forces and the personal morass that have caused him to participate in a desperate and reprehensible scheme, and to enlist the help of others in positions of responsibility.

We would be happy to answer any questions you may have, and are confident that your office will continue to act with fairness, impartiality, and a high regard for justice.

SOME COMMENTS BY WAY OF PERSONAL ANALYSIS, GENE CHAIKIN

Since beginning a relationship I felt it a good time to look into my head - changes require analysis. First, it feels good to be "settling down" in a way that I guess I just can't do in a barracks style life. The surroundings are too impermanent. I just couldn't feel settled and belonging without a little "private" space, and a little privacy. As much as I might like to say I am "above" wanting a relationship it is obviously not true. At this point, beyond the obvious physical, there is a need I have that it seems to fulfill (at least now) but which I can't really identify. I am certainly willing to assume the burden to get the benefit.

What I have already clearly experienced is the conflict between the one-to-one and the relationship to the group. I doubt if it is possible to harmonize the inevitable conflict, but they can be compartmentalized so as to create a minimum of interference. We intend to structure ourselves along that line.

One interesting thing that I have experienced is that a lot of people have been very friendly with me since word got out that Inez and I are together - most of them black. It could be that I am more relaxed and friendly than before but I don't believe it. What I think is that there is a black and a white society here as well as an integrated society, and that marriage to a black woman provided an entree into the black society. I guess you know all about this, but it was my first realization, and I thought of some interest.

Dear Ray,

I'll try to radio you in the next few days, but in the meantime, I thought to get you an "up to date" since most of this I would not be able to discuss over the air in any event. First, I would like to invite you and hon, with Carole and your kids if you like, to come down for a visit during November or December. I would like to see you, badly, and hon as well and she can't make the trip unless someone goes with her. I know it will be somewhat of a drag, but.....I don't know if I will have any other opportunity to see her again.

We were doing good work until the inevitable sneer came, with maybe much worse to come. It is expected that groups of our type are infiltrated by Agency people, and we always expected that we had a few but we never identified them, nor did we think that they were high up. Just a few days ago, we got a real break. Donald Freed, author of "Executive Action" and Mark Lane (who will be here tomorrow) agreed to help us and in fact, did succeed in obtaining the cooperation of one of the conspiracy working against us - a sleaze of an ex-con investigator by the name of Hazor. He has done a lot of talking - all on consensual tape, and Freed/Lane intend to break the story soon.

The fact is that we have merited considerable agency attention and have had at least four agents with us over the years. The principle one appears to be one Timothy C. Stoen, who in fact was on the C.I.A. payroll during the middle and late 1960's. We now believe that he has been a witting agent for the C.I.A. since 1958. He worked in East Germany, the College Movement, on the Panthers in the Bay Area; then was switched to us in 1969 when Jim drew attention in the Northern California area, which was Stoen's area, as well. 'Nuff said? Additionally, Stoen has intimate connections with INTERCOM and we speculate with several private right-wing organizations as well. He is a "pig" par excellence. We have confirmed Hazor's story, in part, by some belated research in the newspapers which document his role in East Germany; found some of his old notes which support the same thesis, and we do know that he did some legal work for the Panthers, but joined our ranks before he got too far into it. Obviously, there is no possibility of my returning to the U.S.

Freed, who lives in Los Angeles, has been here last week, Hazor has just left after enlightening us on such heart-warming projects as how they were planning to come in here with an "A Tear" and hit us with rockets and mortars, and how the whole damn publicity sneer was developed. Mark Lane, as I said, is coming tomorrow. On the whole, our position has improved immensely and we have garnered quite a bit of ammunition to fight back with. In addition, our position here is very good. The Guyanese Government is totally supportive of us. Last week, when the conspiracy sent an agent in on us, the Government threw her out and confiscated all of her film and cameras. We are also making some very good friends among the progressive nations of the world. So... there is now a great deal of security in our position here. Stoen has not moved in several areas because to do so, he would have to drop his "cover". When we do so for him, and expose a number of agents, then we must expect some action of a retaliatory nature, so the situation is not without concern.

At this point, however, the area of tension is the office of the Los Angeles District Attorney. Stoen, et al., are pushing him to file theft charges against three of our people, including Jim MacElvane, who you have met, by contriving an issue of duress in

the donation of the proceeds of sale, through escrow, of two pieces of property. The thing was entirely consensual, but they have a series of witnesses who wittingly assist Stoen, so the position is difficult. If there is any way that Van de Kamp can be approached by an acquaintance for whom he has some respect; who could inform him of these facts so he would hold off from filing till all of the elements of the conspiracy are unraveled and publicized (including the likelihood of Stoen himself being indicted for certain crimes), they would be doing him and us a great service. We do not need the expense or bad publicity that the case would bring and he does not need to be characterized as a witting agent of the C.I.A. when the story breaks; not that we would do it, we wouldn't - but if he has filed on us, it will look that way. Besides, from what we know of him, we do not believe that he would wish to participate in a neo-Nazi plot to destroy an interracial group. I do not know whether there is any possibility that Dick could be persuaded to do such a thing, but if you feel that there is any chance, would you try? Whatever Dick's politics, he is not a racist, and I am sure that this scenario would not go down well with him. Perhaps you might know someone else. If you can use any evidence, we will be able to get you a newspaper file on the conspiracy including Lazor's role, Lazor's criminal record and a copy of his tape. You might also care to speak to Don Freed; he met me here and will know me - but please speak to him in person.

If you wish more details or have a hard time locating Freed, call the San Francisco Temple. Terri Buford should be there and she will get what you want. If she is out of town, there will be someone assigned there to take her calls. Identify yourself. Though the things that I am telling you here are not really "secret", yet we need some working time before being totally hassled in order to organize our campaign so we are not being too open about it. Anyway, if you feel that there is anything that needs to be communicated that you cannot allow to be public, I suggest you do it in person, direct....but I see no real reason for any such thing.

One last point in the remote chance that it may affect you. For years, people have been saying that they were getting threatening phone calls from us, and have been quite hysterical about it. We didn't make them, and until very recently, believed that the folks were lying to stir up trouble. All of them had in common, that they were attacking us when the calls came; usually in the media. Now, we are not so sure. We believe that this stuff was done by our own "insiders" who knew just what to do because they were privy to both sides of all of these events, in order to "egg" the opposition on. I doubt that anyone would think to involve you, but be circumspect, and if something should happen, do not be confused. The last batch of calls went to Van de Kamp.

My love to your companion and the children. I am writing separately to her, but say I wrote to you. Of course, not of this to her. Thanks for anything you can do. I hope to see you later on in the year.



Dear Mom;

I guess my last letter just didn't get through. Don't know what the problem is but seeing as it exists I'll make a point to write more often. Firstly, all of us here are fine. Things are looking up for us in a number of particulars. David is now working with me and I am landscaping the whole area. It is a really gratifying job and one that an endless amount of creativity can be exercised. David is a really good little gardner and a very hard worker. He is doing quite well in a role where he has not only to contend with a father, but also a supervisor in the same person. Gail is fine and busy as usual. Phyllis is, as always, caught up in medical administration.

Our guest facilities are nearing completion and it is quite likely that I will be able to invite you all by this fall. It is my hope that you will be able to come then, so Ray too if business permits. (Pardon the lousy typing, I am going too fast.) Actually the place is growing quite rapidly - so that there is always a tight fit to get everyone in a reasonable comfortable quarters but somehow we always manage.

I am quite interested in your impending trip to China. It will surely be most interesting for you. I do hope that there will not be any hitches. At this point I have some real question as to "where their heads are at" but the social system is organized to a very high degree and the impact of that sort of social system on the mental health of the country should be readily visible by now.

Things are a lot lighter here for us than you recall in the U.S. If you can believe me it I have the time to do some studying! I have started with Russian literature, first Tolstoy, next Turgenev. We have quite a substantial library for a "small outpost" in the bush. It is currently over 20,000 volumes, so there is much to choose from.

It has been quite rainy here lately which has put something of a quietus on the agriculture. Here, I guess as all over the world in agriculture there are times when you work like hell and times when you wait on the weather. None the less one of our teams of 15 persons and a tractor managed to plant out almost 2,000 banana trees in four days last week. Considering that the average annual production for one plant is up around 30 pounds that is a lot of food. The citrus is also starting to produce well now. Some of the trees are quite large. It gives a real sense of fulfillment since it was I who planted them. Nice to see things grow.

I wonder if all of our mail is not getting through. Since your last letter I expected to get letters from several people but have not. This is not a complaint. After all, I have not written them. I would really like to know about it if mails are not reaching here. I got yours dated 21 Aug. today.

Anyway, keep well and don't overdo it. I hope that you do get to China and have a most rewarding experience. Do say hello to Ray for me and assure him that I am all right. Say hello to Carole and the kids. I hope Ray's back is not giving him fits still. The best thing that he could do is to take a long vacation. I realise that he can't do it now, but soon it may be possible. He better before it becomes irreversible - arthritis and so forth in the back.

Take care and let me hear from you.

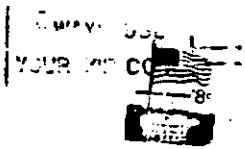
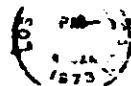

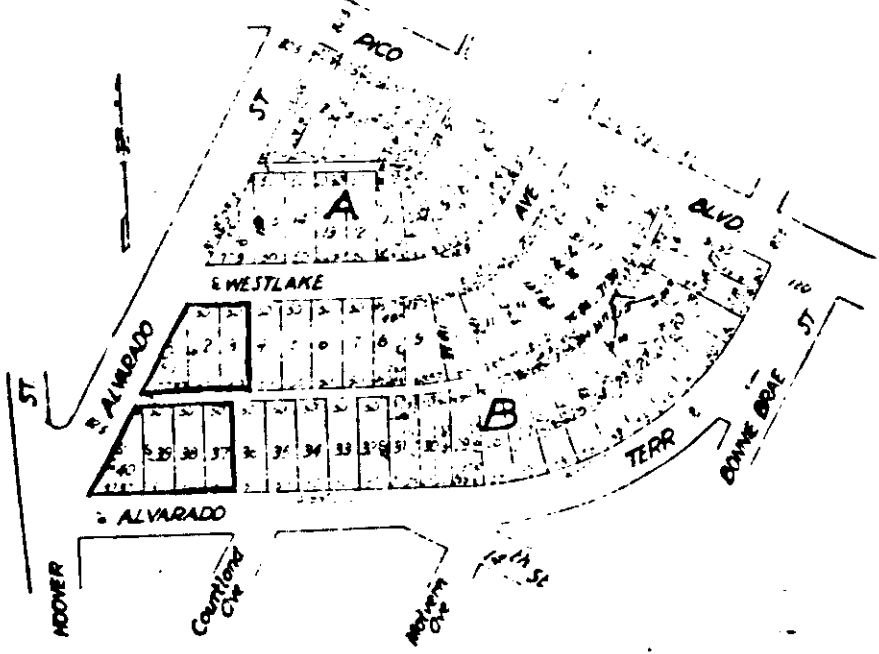

MEMO: PHOTOGRAPHIC DEPT., LACK OF ORGANISATION, COMMUNITY NEEDS

TO: Administration, Johnny Jones
FROM: Legal Dept., Gene Chaikin

The photo department is one of the unsupervised areas left in our structure. The inefficiency of this arrangement is seen in lost equipment (no central supply or checkout), duplication, lack of co-ordination, confusion in ordering, and ill feelings among the "photographers".

Photography here has the following functions (among others):

1. Security
2. Publicity
3. Public Relations, including Medical
4. Identification (passport, drivers licence photos)
5. Pacifying relatives.

I have the following suggestions to make:

1. That the program be centralized under one supervisor, who would assign out all work, and control all equipment and supplies;
2. That all equipment and supplies be centrally maintained under lock and key, and be distributed by the Supervisor either daily or on a long term check out system;
3. That all photographic assignments be given out by the Supervisor and that no equipment or supplies be issued for any other purposes;
4. That the dark room be formally set up under the control of one operator, only, or two on a rotating basis so that responsibility for the use of supplies and equipment is clearly defined;
5. That an Identification Photo system be set up at once to do passport photos, and other I.D. photos for people here as we need them for newlyborne infants, and also for passport renewals which are starting to come up. This will involve bringing over some of our equipment from S.F., but only the purchase of supplies.

There are several persons here who like to do photography and are reasonably competent, but who have been "taken off" and "put on" projects, generally causing ill will and jealousy. I think that there are enough varieties of work so it can be spread around to all, and yet keep the work that requires higher degrees of skill in the hands of those best trained.

If there is any way I can help please let me know.
