MEDIA PEOPLE INVOLVED IN THIS MATTER. THIS IS TO INCLUDE PERSONS WHO WRITE ARTICLES ABOUT THE PT (HE SPECIFICALLY NAMED GORDON LINDSEY) AND MEDIA REPRESENTATIVES ACCOMPANYING RYAN TO GUYANA. HE DESIRES TO TALK WITH THE "CONCERNED RELATIVES GROUP", DEFECTORS, AND ACTIVE MEMBERS. IT APPEARS, HOWEVER, THAT NOT MUCH PRELIMINARY WORK HAS BEEN DONE BY THIS GROUP IN THAT HE ASSUMED SEVERAL PEOPLE HE NAMED WERE IN THE SAN FRANCISCO AREA WHEN IN FACT THEY ARE IN THE LOS ANGELES AREA. (u)

HE QUERIED ASAC LAWLER AS TO THE COOPERATIVENESS OF SEVERAL PEOPLE HE NAMED AND ALSO THE BEST WAY TO GET IN CONTACT WITH THE CURRENT MEMBERS. ONLY GENERAL ANSWERS WERE GIVEN. (u)

IT APPEARED TO ASAC LAWLER DURING THE APPROXIMATE HALF OF AN HOUR CONVERSATION, THAT A FULL SCALE INVESTIGATION INTO ALL ASPECTS OF THE PT WAS CONTEMPLATED. HOWEVER, AT ALMOST THE VERY END OF THE CONVERSATION HE INDICATED THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF HIS INVESTIGATION WOULD BE THE STATE DEPARTMENT'S PERFORMANCE IN THIS MATTER; SPECIFICALLY, DID THEY DO ENOUGH TO BRIEF RYAN. (u)

IN CONDUCTING INTERVIEWS IN THIS INVESTIGATION, SAN FRANCISCO HAS IDENTIFIED SEVERAL PEOPLE WHO ARE VERY CRITICAL OF THE STATE DEPARTMENT'S HANDLING OF THIS MATTER. WE HAVE ALSO IDENTIFIED SOME PEOPLE WHO HAVE COMPLIMENTED THE STATE DEPARTMENT. WE WOULD BE WILLING TO GIVE THE INVESTIGATORS THE IDENTITIES OF THESE PEOPLE AND FEEL THAT INTERVIEWS OF THESE INDIVIDUALS WOULD NOT ADVERSELY AFFECT OUR INVESTIGATION. HOWEVER, WE FEEL THAT WITH THE INVESTIGATORS' TWO-THREE WEEK STAY, THAT THEY WOULD RAPIDLY EXPAND THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE WITH WHOM THEY WOULD LIKE TO SPEAK AND THIS COULD ADVERSELY AFFECT OUR ONGOING INVESTIGATION. (u)

BERTISS ADVISED THAT ONE MEMBER OF HIS STAFF, [REDACTED] IS WORKING ON THE LIST OF PEOPLE THEY DESIRE TO INTERVIEW AND WOULD PROBABLY BE IN CONTACT WITH ASAC LAWLER TO GET A READING AS TO WHAT ASAC LAWLER FEELS WOULD BE THE BENEFIT OF INTERVIEWING VARIOUS PEOPLE. (u)

A letter postmarked November 20, 1978, and directed to Attorney General Griffin Bell was received by the U. S. Department of Justice on November 28, 1978. This letter was written by a [REDACTED] a prisoner in the Bexar County Jail, San Antonio, Texas, and states as follows:

"Dear Mr. Bell,

"I am confident I can supply information about recent developments in South America and that might in a background sense shed light on the recent fate of U.S. Congressman Leo Ryan.

A review of files maintained in the San Antonio, Texas, Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation revealed that on August 11, 1977, [REDACTED] voluntarily appeared at the San Antonio Office of the FBI. In this letter, Mr. [REDACTED] makes reference to information which he possessed and desired to furnish concerning an unsolved crime which allegedly occurred outside of the State of Texas. When questioned about this, Mr. [REDACTED] stated that it concerned the Watergate breakin. (u)

Mr. [REDACTED] stated that he had been previously incarcerated in the Bexar County Jail in December, 1971. 

Abbell further stated he did not know the exact date that the above items would be forwarded to the United States.

Upon receipt of above information, attempts were immediately initiated to contact Legal Attache Dwight Garretson at the American Embassy, Guyana, in order to determine the exact date the above materials would be released by GOG. At approximately 7:45 p.m., Garretson contacted Criminal Investigative Division Night Duty Supervisor [REDACTED] and advised that the above materials were to be shipped on Thursday, 12/28/78, via Pan Am and that he would accompany the materials to Trinidad and from there they would be shipped non-stop to JFK Airport, New York City. [redacted] advised that [redacted] another Ham Radio Operator, assigned call letters [redacted] who maintains a teletype terminal, notified him the previous evening that the American Radio Relay Leg (ARRL), Newington, Connecticut, had sent a nationwide teletype advising that the FBI wished to interview anyone who might have had radio contact with parties in Guyana, South America, prior to the assassination of Congressman RYAN and the subsequent mass murder-suicide. The teletype mentioned two stations in Guyana, a Jonestown station with call letters WB6 MID/8R3, and a Georgetown station with call letters WB6 (next three letters unrecalled)/8R1 (u)

[redacted] stated that he had radio contact during the summer of 1978 with the first mentioned Jonestown station, operated by an individual who identified himself as ALBERT TOUCHETTE. [redacted] confirmed this identity through the American Amateur Radio Call Book, which reflected the call letters as being assigned to one ALBERT TOUCHETTE, believed located in Redwood, California. [redacted] stated that the three figures following the slash mark in the call letters is an indication that the station is operating portable in Guyana. (u)

[redacted] stated that he had contact with the station on one or two occasions and communicated for the most part with a female named SARA, whom he understood to be ALBERT TOUCHETTE'S sister. He furnished a copy of a "QSL" card confirming a radio conversation on April 9, 1978. He stated that prior to receiving the card, he received a letter, which is unsigned but believed to be from SARA. He furnished a copy of the letter also. [redacted] stated the conversation in April, 1978, concerned basically the same information contained in the letter. [redacted] recalls a (u)

He is also in a position to furnish the originals of the card and letter if necessary. u

[REDACTED] stated that he has heard through the public news media that ALBERT TOUCHETTE has been confirmed dead; however, he has heard nothing concerning SARA. He furnished the foregoing information for whatever assistance it might be in the FBI's investigation of the incident. u





Agriculture, livestock, Construction, and all kinds of projects that have been developed are proving that even in the jungle, people who work together can accomplish much.




