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Jones: ... How very much I have loved you...how very much I have tried my best to give you the good life ... But in spite of all that I've tried, a handful of our people, with their lives, have made our life impossible. There's no way to detach ourself from what's happened today. Not only - We're in a compound situation, not only are there those who have left and committed the betrayal of the century, some have stolen children from others and they're in pursuit right now to kill them because they stole their children, and we, we are sitting here waiting on a powder keq. I don't think this is what we want to do with our babies. I don't think that's what we had in mind to do with our babies. said by the greatest of prophets, from time immemorial, "No man lay, takes my life from me, I lay my life down." ... So, to, to sit here and wait for the castastrophe that's going to happen on that airplane, it's gonna be a catastrophe ... It almost happened here, almost happened, the congressman was nearly killed here... But you can't steal people's children. (Crowd: That right.) You can't take off with people's children without expecting a violent reaction. (Crowd: That's right) And, that's not so unfamiliar to us, either, if we, even if we were

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Judeo-Christian, even if we weren't Communists. The world, the kingdom suffers violence and the violent shall take it by force. If we can't live in peace then let's die in peace... We've been so betrayed, we have been so terribly betrayed. But we've tried, and as Jack Beam often said, and I don't know where he's at right this moment, poor Jack, he says if it's only worked one day, it was worthwhile ... Of what's going to happen here in a matter of a few minutes, is that one of those people on that plane is gonna, gonna shoot the pilot. I know that. I didn't plan it, but I know it's gonna happen. They're gonna shoot that pilot, and down comes that plane into the jungle and we had better not have any of our children left when it's over, 'cause they'll parachute in here on us. I'm telling you just as plain as I know how to tell you, I've never lied to you... (Crowd: That's right) I never have lied to (Crowd: That's right) I know that's what's gonna happen, that's what he intends to do and he will do it. He'll do it.... Fortunately, being so bewildered with many, many pressures on my brain, seeing all these people behave so treasonous, it was just too much for me to put together, but, I now

know what he was telling me and it'll happen. If the plane gets in the air even. So my opinion is that we be kind to children and be kind to seniors and take the potion like they used to take in ancient Greece, and step over quietly because we are not committing suicide. It's a revolutionary act. We can't go back. They won't leave us alone. They're now going back to tell more lies which means more congressmen. And there's no way, no way we can survive. Anybody wish to... Anyone that has any dissenting opinion, please speak ... Yes ... You can have an opportunity, but if our children are left we're gonna have them butchered. We can make a strike but we'll be striking against people that we, we don't want to strike against. And what we'd like to get the people who caused this stuff and some, if some people here are prepared to know how to do that, to go in town and get Timothy Stoen, but there's no plane, there's no plane, you can't catch a plane in time. He's responsible for it. He brought these people to us. He and Deanna Myrtle. But people in San Francisco will not, not be idle over this. And not take our death in vain, you know ... Yes, Christine ...

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Christine: Is it too late for Russia?

Here's why it's too late for Russia. They killed. Jones: They started to kill. That's why it makes it too late for Russia. Otherwise I'd said, "Russia, you bet your life." But it's too late. I can't control these people. They're out there. gone with the guns and it's too late. And once we kill anybody, at least, that's the way I've always, I've always put my lot with you. And when one of my people do something, it's me. ... Understand, I don't have, I don't have to take the blame for this, but I can't, I don't, I don't live that way. They said deliver up Jjara, who tried to get the man back here. Jjara, who's wife, mother's been lying on him and lying on him and trying to break up this family and they've all agreed to kill us by any means necessary.

Unknown male: Is there any way if I go, that it'll help?

Jones: No, you're not going. You're not going.

You think I'm going to deliver them Jjara?

Not on your life. (Crowd: No! No!) No.

(Crowd: No! No!)

Jones: You're not going. I can't live that way. I cannot live that way. I've lived with for all and I've died for all. ... I've been living on hope for a long time, Christine, and I appreciate, you've always been a very good agitator.

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I like agitation because you got to see two sides of one issue, two sides of a question. But what those people gonna get done, what they get through, will make our life worse than hell, they'll make us, make the Russias not accept us. When they get through lying. They told so many lies between there and that truck that we are, we are done in as far as any other alternative.

Christine: Well, I say let's make an air, airlift to Russia,
that's what I say. I don't think nothing is impossible,
if you believe it.

Jones: But how we gonna air ... How're you going to airlift to Russia?

Christine: Why, I thought he, they said if we got in an emergency, they gave you a code to let them know.

Jones: No, they didn't. They gave us the code that they'd let us know of an issue, not us create an issue for them. They said if we, if they saw the country coming down, they'd agreed they'd give us the code, they'd give us a code. You can check on there and see if it's on the code, didn't you? Check with Russia to see if they'll take us in immediately. Otherwise we die. I don't know what else you say to these people.

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But to me death is not, death is not a fearful thing, it's living that's treacherous. (Crowd: that's right) ...

I have never, never, never, never seen anything like this before in my life. I've never seen people take the law, and do, in their own hands, and provoke us and try to purposely agitate murder of children. There's no use, Christine, it's just not, it's not worth living like this ... not worth living like this. (Crowd: That's right)

Christine: I think that there were too few who left for twelve hundred people to give them their lives, for those people that left.

Jones: Do you know how many left?

Christine: Oooh, twenty odd ... that's, that's a small amount

Jones: ... twenty-odd, twenty-odd ...

Christine: Compared to, compared to, compared to what's here.

Jones: ... twenty-odd. But what's gonna happen when they
don't leave. I hope that they could leave ... but
what's gonna happen when they don't, when they don't leave?

Christine: You mean the people here?

Jones: Yeah, what's gonna happen to us when they don't leave? When they get on the plane and the plane

goes down?

Christine: I don't think it'll go down.

Jones: You don't think it'll go down? (Crowd: Yes it will ...) I wish I could tell you you were right, but I'm right. There's one man there, who blames, and rightfully so, Debbie Blakey, for the murder, for the murder of his mother and he'll sh-, he'll stop that pilot by any means necessary. He'll do it. That plane will come out of the air. There's no way you fly a plane without a pilot.

Christine: I wasn't speaking about that plane. I was speaking about the plane for us to go to Russia.

Jones: How do ... To Russia? Do you think Russia's gonna want .. no they're not gonna ... (Jones studders) Do you think Russia's gonna want us with all this stigma?

We had, we, we had some value...but now we don't have any value.

Christine: Well, I don't see it like that. I mean, I feel like that as long as there's life, there's hope. That's my faith.

Jones: Well, someday everybody dies, someplace that hope runs out. 'cause everybody dies. (Crowd: that's right, right) ... I haven't seen anybody yet that didn't die. And I'd like to choose my own kind of death

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for a change. I'm tired of being tormented to hell, that's what I'm tired of. (Crowd: right, right)...Tired of it ... 1200 people's lives in my hands and I certainly don't want your life in my hand but I'm going to tell you, Christine, without me, life has no meaning... (Crowd: right, right!) I'm the best friend you'll ever have. (Crowd: right!) And once, once I have to pay, I'm standing with Jjara, I'm standing with those people. They're part of me. I can detach myself, my attorney says detach myself...no, no, no, no, no, no...I never detached myself from any of your troubles. (Crowd: that's right) I've always taken you troubles right on my shoulders...(${\cal V}_l$ (Crowd: that's right) and I'm not gonna change that now. It's too late. I've been running too long. Not gonna change now... Maybe the next time you'll get to go to Russia, the next time 'round. This is, what I'm talking about to now is in the dispensation of judgment. This is the revolutionary, this is revolutionary suicide council, I'm not talking about self, selfdestruction. I'm talking about, what, we have no other road. I will take your, your call. We will put it to the Russians, and I can tell you the answer now, because I'm a prophet. Call the Russians and tell them and see if they'll take us.

Christine: Not that I'm afraid to die ...

Jones: I don't think you are ...

Christine: by no means ...

Jones: I don't think you are ...

Christine: But, I look at all the babies and I think they

deserve to live ...

Jones: I agree ...

Christine: you know ...

Jones: They deserve, but also they deserve, what's more, they

deserve peace.

Crowd: That's right

Christine: We all came here for peace ...

Jones: And we, have we had it?

Crowd: Yes. No

Christine: No ...

Jones:

practically, I've practically died every day to give you peace ... and you still not have any peace. You look better than I've seen you in a long while, but it's still not the kind of peace that I want to give you. The person's a fool who continues to say that you're a winner when you're

I tried to give it to you. I've laid down my life,

I didn't hear you, ma'am, you'll have to speak up...(inaudible)
That's a sweet thought, who said that? ... come, come on up
and speak it again, honey. Stand on up and say it about,
talk about it ... is taking off, no

a loser. (Crowd: That's right) Win one, lose two. What?...

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plane is taking off. It's suicide. They have done
it. Stoen has done it. But somebody ought to live,
somebody, can they talk, can they not talk to San Francisco
to see that Stoen does not get by with this infamy?
(Crowd: that's right!) with this infamy. He has done the
thing he wanted to do, to have us destroyed. (Unknown
female: that's right)

Christine: Then, when you, when you, when we destroy ourselves we're defeated ... we let them, the enemy, defeat us.

Jones: Did you see, did you see "I Live to Fight No More Forever"?

Christine: Yes, I saw that.

Jones: Did you not have some sense of pride and victory in that man, that he would not subject himself to the will and whim of people who tell that they are gonna come in whenever they please, and push into our house, come when they please, take who they want to, talk to who they want to. Does, is that living? That's not living to me. (Crowd: No!) That's not freedom.

That's not the kind of freedom I sought.

Christine: But I think where they made their mistake is when they stopped to rest. If they had gone on, they would have made it. But they stopped to rest ...

Unknown Male: It's over, sister, it's over. We've made that day, we made a beautiful day and let's make it a beautiful day. That's what I say.

Jones: We win, we win when we go down. Tim Stoen has nobody else to hate ... He has nobody else to hate. Then he'll destroy himself. I'm speaking here not as the administrator, I'm speaking as a prophet today. I wouldn't sit up in this seat and talk so serious if I did not know what I was talking about. Is there any way to call back the immense amount of damage that's going to be done? But I cannot separate myself from the pain of my people. And you can't either, Christine, if you stop to think of it. You can't separate yourself. We've walked too long together.

Christine: I, I know that. But I still think, as an individual,

I have a right to ...

Jones: You do, and I'm listening ...

Christine: What I think, what I feel, and I think we all have the right to our own destiny as individuals.

Jones: Right ...

Christine: And I think I have the right to choose mine and everybody else has the right to choose theirs.

Jones: Mm-hmm ...

Christine: You know ...

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Jones: Mm-hmmm. I'm not criticizing, I'm not (inaudible) ...
What's that?

Unknown Female: She talks like she wants to leave us, well, then go ahead...they're our individual lives, that's what you're saying.

Christine: That's right

Jones: That's today, that's what twenty people said today with their lives.

Crowd: That's right.

Christine: I think that I still have the right to my own opinion.

Jones: I'm not taking it from you. I'm not taking it from you.

Unknown Male: Christine, you're only standing here because he was here in the first place. So I don't know what you're talking about having an individual life. Your life has been extended to the day that you're standing there because of him.

Jones: ... voiced back there, she has as much right to speak as anybody else, too. What did you say, Louvie (ph.)? Well, you will regret that this very day if you don't die.

You'll regret it if you don't ... that you don't die.

You'll regret it.

Christine: (inaudible) ... A man who saved too many people?

Jones: I saved them, I saved them but I made my example.

I made my expression. I made my manifestation and

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the world was ready, not ready for me.

Paul said, "I was a man born out of due season." I've been born out of due season just like all we are and the best testimony we can make is to leave this God-damn world. ... Unknown male: Peace, Peace.

Unknown female: You must be scared to die.

Christine: I'm not talking to her. Will you let, will you, will you let her or let me talk?

Unknown male: Keep talking, keep talking.

Christine: Would you make her sit down and let me talk while

I'm on the floor or let her talk?

... (inaudible) ...

Jones: ... proper to tell your leader what to do. It really isn't. I've listened to you. You asked me about Russia. I'm right now making a call to Russia.

What more do you suggest? I'm listening to you. ...

If Russia gives me one slight bit of encouragement,

I just now instructed them to go there and do that.

Unknown female: You won't be no fuckin' good in Russia, God-damn it ... (inaudible)

Unknown male: All right, now everybody hold it, we didn't come ... hold it, hold it, hold it, hold it ...

JOnes: ... much longer to maintain. (Crowd: That's right)

Jones: To lay down your burdens, I'm gonna lay down my burdens, down by the riverside, so we lay them down here, inside of Guyana. What's the difference? No man didn't take our life, right now, he hadn't taken it, but when they start parachuting out of the air, they'll, they'll shoot some of our innocent babies. I'm not, I don't want to see this, Christine. 'Cause they gotta shoot me to get through to some of these people. I'm not letting them take Jjara. Can you let them take Jjara? (Crowd: No-no!)

Christine: You mean you wanna see John die?

Jones: What's that?

Christine: You mean you wanna see John, the little one, to keep ...

Jones: I want to keep ...

(inaudible) I, I, ... peace, peace, peace, peace, peace, peace, peace, peace, peace, peace,

Unknown female: Christine, are you saying that you think he thinks more of them than other children here?

Jones: John, John ...

Unknown female: That's what you're saying ...

Jones: Do you actually, do you think I would put John's life above others? If I put John's life above others I wouldn't be standing with Jjara. I'd send John out, out, he could go out on the driveway tonight.

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Christine: ... Because he's young, they're young.

Jones: I know, but he's no, he's no different to me than any of these children here. He's just one of my children.

I don't prefer one above another. I don't prefer him above Jjara. I can't do that. I can't separate myself from your actions or his actions.

Unknown female: Never (inaudible)

Jones: If you'd done something wrong, I'd stand with you. If they wanted to come and get you they'd have to take me.

Unknown male: Well, we're all ready to go. If you tell us we have to give our lives now, we're ready. I'm pretty sure all the rest of sisters and brothers are with me.

Crowd: That's right.

Jones: For months I've tried to keep this thing from happening but I now see it's the will, it's the will of Sovereign Being that this happened to us. That we lay down our lives in protest against what's been done. That we lay down our lives to protest in what's being done. The criminality of people, the cruelty of people. Who walked out of here today? Did you notice who walked out?

(Crowd: Yes) Mostly white people. (Crowd: That's right)

Mostly white people walked. I'm so grateful for the ones that didn't, those who knew who they are.

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There's, there's no point, there's no point to this. We have, we are born before our time. (Crowd: that's right) They won't accept us. And I don't think we should sit here and take any more time for our children to be endangered, for if they come after our children and we give them our children, then our children will suffer forever.

Christine: ... Anybody that differs right here.

Jone: I have no quarrel with you coming up, I like you.

I personally like you very much.

Christine: These people get hostile when you try to ..

Jones: Oh well, some people do. But then, some people do.

Put it that way. I'm not hostile. (Unknown female: They
got tired of the shit.) You had to be honest and you
stayed. If you'd have wanted to run, you'd have had to
run with them because anybody coulda run today, they
would have wanted to. I know you're not a runner and I, I,
your life is precious to me. It's as precious as John's.
And I, I don't, what I do, I do with weight and justice and
judgment. I'm, I've weighed it against all evidence.

Christine: OK, that's all I've got to say.

Jones: And what comes now, folks, what comes now?

Unknown male: Everybody hold it! Sit down right here.

Stay seated ...

Jones: Say peace, say peace, say peace, say peace ... whats come don't let death(?) ... take Dwyer on down to the middle of the east house. Take Dwyer on down the east house, please.

Unknown female: Everybody be quiet, please.

Jones: ...and show you got some respect for our lives.

Unknown male: That means sit down, sit down, sit down.

Jones: I know ... Mmmm mmmm mmmm. (Unknown female: (inaudible - seem to be call signs), do you copy?) I

tried so very, very hard. (Unknown female: (inaudible - seem to be call signs), do you copy?)

I've been trying over here to see what can,
what can happen in Los Angeles ... who is it ...

Unknown female: ...last carload left (inaudible) road, jammed with security people.

Unknown male: ...planned, pick up with about ten of our folks on it.

Jones: ... Get Dwyer out of here before something happens to him...

(Unknown female: (inaudible), do you copy?) ... Dwyer?

Unknown male: Jjara?

Jones: I'm not talking Jjara, I said Dwyer, Ain't nobody gonna take Jjara, I'm not letting 'em take Jjara ... Gather in, folks, it's easy, it's easy.

Yes, my love ...

Unknown female: At one time I felt just like Christine felt.

But after today I don't feel anything because the biggest majority of the people that left here were white and I know it really hurt my heart because ...

Jones: Broke your heart, didn't it?

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Unknown female: It broke my heart to think that all of these years that these white people have been with us and they're not a part of us. So we might as well end it now because I don't see ...

Unknown male: It's too late, we must quit talking, the Congressman has been murdered ...

Unknown female: I'm ready.

Unknown male: Be quiet, ...

Unknown male: It's all over anyway.

Unknown: It's all over ...

Jones: It's all over, all over ... what a legacy, what a legacy.

But the Red Brigade's the only one that's ever made any sense anyway. They invaded our privacy, they came into our home, they followed us 6,000 miles away. The Red Brigade showed them justice, the Congressman's dead ... please get us some medication. It's simple, it's simple, there's no convulsions with it, it's just simple, just please get it before it's too late. The GDF will be here. I tell you get moving, get moving, get moving.

Crowd: Hurry up, hurry up.

Inknown: Shut you mouths

Jones: Don't be afraid to die ... you'll feel, if these people land out here, they'll, they'll torture some of our children here. They'll torture our people,

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they'll torture our seniors. We cannot have this.

(crowd: that's right, right) ... are you gonna separate yourself from whoever shot the Congressman?

I don't know who shot him ... (crowd: no, no, no, hell no.)

Jones: Speak her piece and those had a right to go and they had a right to. How many are dead? Oh, God almighty, God almighty ... Mmmm? ...

Unknown male: Patty Parks is dead.

Jones: Patty Parks is dead.

Unknown female: ...(inaudible) the others to endure long enough in a safe place, to write about the goodness of Jim Jones ...

Jones: I don't know how in the world they're ever gonna write about us. It's just too late, it's too late. The congressman's dead, the congressman lays dead, many of our traitors are dead, they're all laying out there dead. (Unknown female: right on) Mmmm? ... (Crowd: good, good) ... I didn't but, but my people did. My people did. They're my people ... (crowd: that's right, right) ... and they, they've been provoked too much ... (crowd: that's right, right) ... They've been provoked too much. What's happened here's been to, this has been an act of provocation ...

Unknown female: They did it themselves ... they did it ... (inaudible)

Unknown female: If it's anyways possible to have them to give

Ted something to take him, I'm satisfied. O.K.?

Jones: What's that?

Unknown female: I said, if it's any way you can do, if you can have them to give Ted something so that he won't have to let him go, too, O.K.? And I'm satisfied.

Jones: Yes, that's fine ... Ted, yes, yes, yes ...

Unknown female: 'cause I said I never wanted to live if he dies, this is my hope. I appreciate you for everything.

Jones: (unaudible)

Unknown female: You are, you are the only, you're the only and I appreciate you ...

Jones: Please, please. Can we hasten, can we hasten with that medication. You don't know what you've done ... (Unknown female: And I want you to know you give me the happiest days of my life) I've tried. Let's move, please move ... (Unknown male: Dad, Lester told me there were 2 GDF (inaudible)) ... They saw it happen and ran in the bush and dropped the machine guns, I never in my life ... But there'll be more ... (Unknown female: Why don't you, stop it right there) ... You've got to move. Are you gonna get that medication here? You've got to move ...

Unknown female: Hurry up!

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Jones: Marsha, we got 40 minutes.

Unknown female: You have to move and the people that are standing there in the aisle go stand in the radio-room yard but everybody get behind the table and back this way,

O.K.? (Unknown female: Please everybody hurry.

Unknown male: there's nothing to it) There's nothing to worry about, so, so everybody keep calm and try and keep your children calm. (Unknown female: Have the older children give love to the little ones that act scared.)

And the older children can help love the little children and, and reassure them. They're not crying from pain.

It's just a little bitter tasting but, they're, they're not crying out of any pain. Annie McGowan, can I please see you back ...

Unknown male: ... I used to do before I came here. So let me

tell you about it; it might make a lot of you feel a

little more comfortable. Sit down and be quiet, please.

One of the things that I used to do I used to be a therapist.

And the kind of the therapy that I did had to do with

reincarnation and past life situations. And every time

anybody had the experience of going into a past life, I

was fortunate enough through Father to be able to let them

experience it all the way through their death, so to speak.

And everybody was so happy when they made that step to the

other side.

Jones: When you step through, there's no other thing ... you can do but step that way, it's the only way to step. ...

(inaudible) that choice is not ours now. It's out of our hands.

Unknown male: If you have a body that's been crippled,

suddenly you have the kind of body that you want to have (Unknown: calm the children ... something to give them a little rest, a little rest. Calm the children ...)

Unknown male: It feels good, it never felt so good, family, I tell yuh ... you've never felt so good as how that feels ...

Unknown male: Thank you

Jones: And I do hope that those attorneys will stay where they belong and don't come up here ... What is it Unknown male: What happened?

Jones: What is it? (Unknown male: What did you say, Tom?) ...

Did what? ... Hard. It's hard, it's hard. ... only

first, only at first is it hard. It's hard only at

first. Living, you you're looking at death. It only

looks, living is much, much more difficult. Raising up

every morning and not knowing what's going to be the night's

bringing. It's much more difficult. It's much more difficult.

Unknown female: I just want to say something to everyone that I see
that is standing around and are crying. This is nothing to
cry about. This is something we should all rejoice

about. We should be happy about this.

They always told us that we should cry when you're coming into this world, but when we're leaving it and we're leaving it peaceful ... I think we should be p-, we should be happy about this. I was just thinking about Jim Jones. He just has suffered and suffered and suffered. He is the only god and he don't even have a chance to enjoy his death here. ... I, I wanted to say one more thing. This is one thing I want to say. That few that's gone, there's many more here. He's still, the way, that's not all of us, that's not all yet. just a few that have got a chance to get to the one that they could tell their stories to, their lies to. So and I say I'm looking at so many people crying, I wish you would not cry, and just thank Father, just thank him. I, I tell you about ... I've been here, uh, one year and nine months and I never felt better in my life. Not in San Francisco, but until I came to Jonestown. I've enjoyed this life. I had a beautiful life. And I don't see nothing for us to be crying about. We should be happy.

At least I am. That's all I'm gonna say.

Unknown female: ... Wouldn't be alive today. I'd just like to thank Dad 'cause he was the only one that stood up for me when I needed him and thank you, Dad.

Unknown female: (inaudible) and I'm glad you're my brothers and sisters and I'm glad to be here ...

Unknown male: Let's not have a lot of testimonies.

Unknown female: O.K.

Unknown male: Let's get on with it, please.

Jones: Please, for God's sake, let's get on with it.

We've lived, we've lived as no other people have lived and loved. We've had as much of this world that you're gonna get. Let's just be done with it. Let's be done with the agony of it ... 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

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

(b) At all times during the period of this conspiracy, Leo J. Ryan was a Member of the Congress of the United States, being elected to the U. S. House of Representatives from the 11th Congressional District of the State of California, a district which is within the Northern District of California.

The Conspirators

- 2. (a) At all times during the period of the conspiracy, Peoples Temple was an organization composed primarily of American citizens and it had a settlement known as Jonestown located in the Republic of Guyana, where a large number of its members lived. At all times during the period of the conspiracy, the defendant, Larry Layton, was a member of Peoples Temple.
- (b) At all times during the period of the conspiracy, Jim Jones was the leader of Peoples Temple and lived in the Jonestown settlement.
- (c) At all times during the period of the conspiracy, Joe Wilson, Tom Kice, Bob Kice, Wesley Breidenbach, Ed Crenshaw, and other co-conspirators both known and unknown to the Grand Jury were members of Peoples Temple and lived in the Jonestown settlement.

The Means Used by the Co-Conspirators to Further the Objects of the Conspiracy

- 3. It was a part of said conspiracy that members of the conspiracy would and did perform the following functions:
- (a) Jim Jones, the leader of People Temple, acting together with other co-conspirators, would and did agree to and did order the assassination of Congressman Leo J.

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Ryan and members of his party, and initiated acts which resulted in the deaths of members of Peoples Temple in Jonestown, including the named co-conspirators.

- (b) Defendant, Larry Layton, a member of Peoples Temple, would and did falsely represent himself to the Ryan party as a defector from Peoples Temple so as to accompany them out of Jonestown, and to carry out his role in the conspiracy to kill Congressman Leo J. Ryan and members of his party.
- (c) Joe Wilson, a member of Peoples Temple, would and did accompany the Ryan party to the Port Kaituma airstrip on November 18, 1978, and pass a gun to Layton, and later participate in the killing of Congressman Leo J. Ryan and members of his party.
- (d) Tom Kice, Bob Kice, Wesley Breidenbach, Ed Crenshaw, and other co-conspirators, all members of Peoples Temple, would and did commence shooting Congressman Leo J. Ryan and members of his party at the Port Kaituma airstrip on November 18, 1978, for the purpose of murdering them.
- (e) Defendant, Larry Layton, would and did commence shooting other members of Congressman Leo J. Ryan's party for the purpose of murdering them.
- (f) Joe Wilson, Tom Kice, Bob Kice, Wesley Breidenbach, Ed Crenshaw and other co-conspirators of Layton, all members of Peoples Temple, would and did return to Jonestown following the shootings to conduct and supervise executions and suicides of members of the Peoples Temple.

Overt Acts

4. In furtherance of the conspiracy and to effect its objects, the following overt acts, among others, were committed in the Republic of Guyana and the Northern District of California:

(a) In the early part of November 1978, Timothy Carter, a member of Peoples Temple, traveled to the Northern District of California, and made contact with former members of Peoples Temple, some of whom were planning to visit Guyana with Congressman Leo J. Ryan.

- (b) In the early part of November 1978, the Peoples Temple settlement in Jonestown obtained a quantity of poison.
- (c) On or about Thursday, November 16, 1978,

 Jim Jones gave a speech concerning the visit of Congressman

 Ryan to the members of Peoples Temple membership in Jonestown.
- (d) On or about Friday, November 17, 1978, members of Peoples Temple in Jonestown conducted an "alert" in anticipation of the arrival of Congressman Leo J. Ryan.
- (e) On or about Saturday, November 18, 1978,

 Jim Jones met with Larry Layton, Joe Wilson, and others, before

 Congressman Leo J. Ryan left Jonestown for the Port Kaituma

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DETAILS: On 10/9/80, a Federal Grand Jury, Northern District of California, San Francisco, California, returned a sealed indictment charging Lawrence John Layton with violation of Title 18, U. S. Code, Section 351(d) - Conspiracy to Murder; Section 351(a), 2 - Aid and Abet Murder of Congressman; Section 1117 - Conspiracy to Kill an Internationally Protected Person; and Section 1116(a), 2 - Aid and Abet Attempted Murder of Internationally Protected Person.

On 10/10/80, U. S. District Court Judge Samuel Conti, San Francisco, California, signed an order unsealing the indictment. A no bail warrant was issued for Layton's arrest. (\mathcal{U})

As you will recall, Layton was scheduled to return to the United States on 10/10/80 from Guyana. Layton was to have been escorted by FBI Agents of our San Francisco Office and arrested upon his arrival at the JFK International Airport, New York. On 10/10/80 the Guyanese attorneys for Layton filed the equivalent of a \$35,000 civil suit against Layton for payment of legal fees. As a result, the Government of Guyana continues to hold Layton on the outstanding charges stemming from the Port Kaituma assault.

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

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

The FBI's Rymur computer information is not programmed for full text retrieval and is not an online system at the San Francisco Division. Rymur computer information is provided to the San Francisco Division by FBIHQ in hard copy form. (~)

USA Hunter has advised our San Francisco Division that inclusion of the FBI's Rymur computer information into DOJ's JURIS System would enable his office to achieve a timely retrieval of pertinent Rymur information and would be most valuable in the upcoming prosecution of Lawrence John Layton

It is our understanding the JURIS System is not a secure system. Furthermore, it may be in violation of the Privacy Act because the JURIS System is not an approved system published in the Federal Register. Because of these considerations, it is CID's view that Rymur information should not be included in JURIS. As an alternative, TSD is being asked to comment regarding the conversion of the Rymur information to an on-line system for the San Francisco Division.

ADDENDUM: TECHNICAL SERVICES DIVISION (TSD), TW:bjt, 10/15/80

within the FBI's Central Records System (CRS), and the Investigative Support Information System (ISIS) is documented in the Federal Register as a subsystem of the FBI's CRS. It should be noted that ISIS supports both the retrieval of information from the field office case file(s) and the actual management of the case(s). The ISIS has both an on-line capability with access provided via a terminal and an off-line capability with access provided via sorted printed listings. In view of the fact that on-line resources are limited, the Technical Services Division (TSD) only provides on-line ISIS access when it is cost justified. A cost analysis indicated that on-line support of RYMUR was not justified.

The TSD will provide the San Francisco Field Office with up-to-date listings of the RYMUR ISIS application; however, it must be understood that these listings do not contain full-text data such as the FD-302s.* The TSD will not support the inclusion of ISIS data into JURIS in view of the fact that JURIS does not meet FBI computer and telecommunication security standards.

* In order to have available a full text processing capability, it would be necessary for the Bureau to rekey in their entirety 13,929 serials (as of this date) most of which contain multiple pages. In addition to the formidable task of keying these documents, it would be necessary to create the computer software to effect full text retrieval.



IN ADDITION TO THE FORMIDABLE TASK OF KEYING THESE DOCUMENTS, IT WOULD BE NECESSARY TO CREATE THE COMPUTER SOFTWARE TO EFFECT FULL TEXT RETRIEVAL.
