The victim stated that for approximately the past year, every time his name is linked by the press to that of a girl, he has received letters similar to the above. He stated he has destroyed all of these letters and they were postmarked oakland and San Francisco, Calif. He stated in the same mail others which contained no threat but which appeared to be written by the same person due to the fact that all three were addressed to his home, were typewritten, had no indentations at the beginning of the paragraphs, and the space between the paragraphs is

The victim is described as a white male, born 11/25/14, at Martinez, Calif., 6'-6'1", slender build, grey hair, possible Air Force No. 39124484.

born in New York City, about 5'8 1/2", 143 lbs., dark hair and dark eyes, resembles his father.

There are enclosed for the FBI Laboratory the threatening letter quoted above together with the accompanying envelope. Also enclosed is an unsigned letter beginning "Joe, This girl you are interested...." ending "that noone can every take her place." and an unsigned letter beginning "Joe DiMaggio, You didn't get by with a thing...." ending "you will get in serious trouble." The accompanying envelopes for these letters are enclosed as is one Xerox copy for all of the above.

The Laboratory is requested to (1) process all of the above original letters for latent fingerprints, (2) process the letters for indented writing, (3) determine the make and model of the typewriter utilized to write the 3 letters, (4) compare the typewriting with notes in the Anonymous Note File, (5) determine the source of the envelopes and paper in the above letters, and (6) conduct any other examination which appears logical to the Laboratory.

At the conclusion of this examination, it is requested the original of the above enclosures be returned to the San

3) The source of the paper used in the letters and envelopes be determined.

4) The make and model of typewriter used to type letters and envelopes be determined and the typing compared with letters previously furnished in this case.

5) The letters be searched through the Anonymous Letter 14

The original of these letters should be returned to the San Francisco Office and results of the examination be furnished to San Francisco and Los Angeles.

Nothing of particular significance was noted during the paper examination of specimens Q27 and Q28 and no indented handwriting was found. However, under one of the flaps on the reverse side of the Q28 envelope was found a printed notation which appears to be a printed number "2" over a second printed number "2" separated by a short horizontal line. The significance of this notation was not determined.

Result of examination:

The submitted material was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. Copies of these items are not being placed in file at the present time.

The style of type used to prepare the typewritten material on specimens Q1,Q2, Q5 and Q6 resembles the standard on file for a Remington pica style of type which

is spaced ten characters to the inch. The stile of type used to prepare the typewritten material on Q3 and Q4 resembles the standard on file for a Remington elite style of type except for the lower-case letter "j." This indicates the possibility that the typewriter involved may have been repaired and that a lower-case letter "j" was replaced.

The Q2, Q4 and Q6 papers are similar but do not contain any particular significant characteristics. Likewise, the Q1 and Q5 envelopes are similar in regard to the paper used, but these envelopes do not contain any particular significant physical characteristics. The Q3 envelope is smaller than the Q1 and Q5 specimens.

All of the above letters were addressed to the Revue Studios, Hollywood, California, and were postmarked at Oakland, California, January 15, 1964, at 7:30 p.m.

He advised that he has been receiving similar letters for about the past nine months to a year. He stated that the letters were similar in that they were all typed, were all sent to his home, the paragraphs were not indented, and they were usually double spaced between paragraphs, and the texts of the letters were usually generally the same although previous letters had contained no threats. He stated he has destroyed all previous letters of this type. He advised that whenever his name was linked by the press with a girl, he would receive these letters, and that they would be critical of him for going out with a girl. He stated that some of them were postmarked in Oakland and some of them in San Francisco. He stated that in the beginning the letters were signed in pencil with the name BILL, and some of the letters, in the beginning, were signed with a girl's name, which he does not recall.

DI MAGGIO, Sr. stated he has absolutely no suspects in this matter, and has no idea who could have written the letters.

DI MAGGIO stated that his son, was born in New York City; is about 5'82 tall; weighs about 143 pounds; has dark hair and dark eyes; and looks a great deal like him, DI MAGGIO, Sr.

DI MAGGIO, Sr. stated that he has previously been in the Air Force, and he believes his Air Force Serial Number is 39124484. He stated that he was born November 25, 1914, in Martinez, California. He was observed to be approximately 6' to 6'1" tall, having a slender build, and greying hair.

information that would aid in identifying the post office box where the letter was mailed since cancellation machines are used at the Main Post Office in San-Leandro, also.

On January 31, 1964, Cap
Oakland, California Police Department, checked
his records concerning poison pen writers, but was
unable to find any record that would appear to be of
value to this investigation.

On March 3, 1964, Oakland Typewriter Exchange, 141 16th Street, advised that he had a Bent typewriter available to the public at the San Leandro Public Bibrary, but that this was an Underwood typewriter. He knew of no place where a Remington typewriter was available in a public place.

Oakland, California, Campbell Typewriter Company, advised that she had publitypewriters available at the Lemington Hotel, Oakland, but that these typewriters were Underwoods, and that she did not know where any Remington typewriters were available to the public.

Investigationat the Public Library, Oakland, California, revealed that there are four Woodstock typewriters available to the public in the library, two with pica type and two with elite type, owned by the Cathray Company, 285 Buckingham Way, San Francisco.

On March 4, 1964

Oakland Public Library, the Berkeley Library, the Berkeley YMCA, the University of California Library, and the Royal Hotel in Oakland. He said that his company has numerous typewriters at public buildings throughout. San Francisco. He said that all the typewriters were

Woodstock typewriters and that a few had been repaired using Underwood type, but that none had Remington type. He knew of no place in the Oakland-San Francisco area where Remington typewriters were available to the public.

Several efforts have been made to locate of the above company, who has a list of the locations of all his pay-typewriters, with negative results to date.

Typewriting samples obtained from were furnished to the rBI Laboratory for comparison with the typewriting of the threatening letters in this case.

On the same date the Latent Fingerpring Section of the Identification Division. was requested to compare the fingerprints of with any latents found on the threatening letters in this case.

The smaller type resembles the standard on file for an elite Remington style of type which is spaced twelve characters to the inch, except for the lower-case letter "j". This indicates the possibility that the elite typewriter may have been repaired.

No indented handwriting was noted during the examination of the Q7 through Q14 papers and nothing of particular significance was noted during the physical examination of the papers involved.
