The victim stated that for approximately the past year, every time his name is linked by the press to that of a girl, he has received letters similar to the above. He stated he has destroyed all of these letters and they were postmarked Oakland and San Francisco, Calif. He stated in the same mail in which he received the above-mentioned letter, he received two others which contained no threat but which appeared to be written by the same person due to the fact that all three were addressed to his home, were typewritten, had no indentations at the beginning of the paragraphs, and the space between the paragraphs is

The victim is described as a white male, born 11/25/14, at Martinez, Calif., 6'-6'l", slender build, grey hair, possible

, is described as white male, in New York City, about 5'8 1/2", 143 lbs., dark hair and dark eyes, resembles his father.

There are enclosed for the FBI Laboratory the threatening letter quoted above together with the accompanying envelope. Also enclosed is an unsigned letter beginning "Joe, This girl you are interested.... ending "that noone can every take her place." and an unsigned letter beginning "Joe DiMaggio, You didn't get by with a thing...." ending "you will get in serious trouble." The accompanying envelopes for these letters are enclosed as is one Xerox copy for all of the above.

The Laboratory is requested to (1) process all of the above original letters for latent fingerprints, (2) process the letters for indented writing, (3) determine the make and model of the typewriter utilized to write the 3 letters, (4) compare the typewriting with notes in the Anonymous Note File, (5) determine the source of the envelopes and paper in the above letters, and (6) conduct any other examination which appears logical to the Laboratory.

At the conclusion of this examination, it is requested the original of the above enclosures be returned to the San Francisco Office.

However, some characteristics—common to the typewriting on these three items indicate the possibility that they were prepared with the same typewriter.

On January 21, 1964, the contents of enclosed letters were discussed with Assistant United States Attorney KEVIN O'CONNELL. Los Angeles, who advised assertion to kill or disfigure contained in one of the letters constitutes violation or extortion statute. Requested investigation to identify author of this communication.

The substance of the Los Angeles letters is as follows:

"REVUE STUDIOS

MAYBE SHE WILL LEAVE HERE.

Result of examination:

The submitted material was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. Copies of these items are not being placed in file at the present time.

The style of type used to prepare the typewritten material on specimens Q1,Q2, Q5 and Q6 resembles the standard on file for a Remington pica style of type which

is spaced ten characters to the inch. The spic of type used to prepare the typewritten material on Q3 and Q4 resembles the standard on file for a Remington elite style of type except for the lower-case letter "j." This indicates the possibility that the typewriter involved may have been repaired and that a lower-case letter "j" was replaced.

The Q2, Q4 and Q6 papers are similar but do not contain any particular significant characteristics. Likewise, the Q1 and Q5 envelopes are similar in regard to the paper used, but these envelopes do not contain any particular significant physical characteristics. The Q3 envelope is smaller than the Q1 and Q5 specimens.

All of the above letters were addressed to the Revue Studios, Hollywood, California, and were postmarked at Oakland, California, January 15, 1964, at 7:30 p.m.

He advised that he has been receiving similar letters for about the past nine months to a year. He stated that the letters were similar in that they were all typed, were all sent to his home, the paragraphs were not indented, and they were usually double spaced between paragraphs, and the texts of the letters were usually generally the same although previous letters had contained no threats. He stated he has destroyed all previous letters of this type. He advised that whenever his name was linked by the press with a girl, he would receive these letters, and that they would be critical of him for going out with a girl. He stated that some of them were postmarked in Oakland and some of them in San Francisco. He stated that in the beginning the letters were signed in pencil with the name BILL, and some of the letters, in the beginning, were signed with a girl's name, which he does not recall.

DI MAGGIO, Sr. stated he has absolutely no suspects in this matter, and has no idea who could have written the

The letters were taken to the post office annex in Oakland and were put through the cancellation machines at the annex. He said that the numbers listed on the postmark other than the number designating the time referred to the cancellation machine number through which the letter had gone. He said, however, that since the cancellation machines were all located in the annex, there was no way to tell from this number at which post office box the letters had been mailed. that since the times on the postmark were between 5:30 and 7:30 p.m. he would assume that the letters had either been mailed at a post office box some distance away from the main post office, or had been mailed at the Main Post Office shortly before 5 p.m. He noted that the stamps on the envelopes were for the most part 1963 Christmas stamps.
