Telephone number [redacted] as reflected in Superior telephone directory is listed to [redacted] Superior, Wisconsin.

[redacted] Superior, Wisconsin, Police Department, advised on May 25, 1970, that they have no record for KENNETH ETO. or other names he uses. [redacted]

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[redacted] Douglas County Sheriff's Office, Superior, Wisconsin, advised on May 25, 1970, that they have no record for the above persons.

[redacted] Merchants Credit Association, 1325 Banks Avenue, Superior, Wisconsin, advised on May 25, 1970, that they have a record for [redacted] and they have good credit. Nothing unusual was noted in the credit files.

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[redacted] has made a great deal of money in his various enterprises, and he has no information that he may be involved with the subject ETO. He stated ETO is unknown to him and to his knowledge has never been in Superior. He stated that there is a possibility that ETO or someone at his place in Chicago could be calling [redacted]

[redacted] He advised he will attempt to obtain pertinent information regarding this matter and advise. He added that [redacted] or a friend could have some connection with [redacted] i.e. a relative or friend.

He advised that telephone 763-3775 is located in the service station of the complex that included service station, garage, towing service, cafe and motel. He said numerous motorists traveling the interstate highway come to the station and while there some utilize the phone for local calls and calls made collect to other numbers [redacted] advised he makes no log or record of these calls and has no idea of the identity of persons making such calls.

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[redacted] had no information concerning a call from there to Chicago, Illinois, on March 11, 1970. He advised KEN ETO as well as [redacted] [redacted] are unknown to him and he failed to recognize a photo of ETO.

AT MIAMI, FLORIDA

A check of the Criss-Cross Telephone Directory for the Miami area disclosed that Miami

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telephone number 751-8696 is listed to the Biscayne Arms Motel, 5255 Biscayne Boulevard, Miami, Florida, and Miami telephone 532-3611 is listed to the Mt. Sinai Hospital, Miami Beach, Florida.

[redacted] Biscayne Arms Motel, advised SA [redacted] on June 18, 1970, that he had no record of any guest by the name of KEN ETO, JOE LEE, JOE MONTANA, or [redacted] ever being a guest at the motel.

After a check of the motel's past winter guests, it was stated by SA [redacted] that DOMINIC NUCCIO, known by SA [redacted] and the Chicago Office as a gambler, was staying at the motel with a lady by the name of [redacted] from November 14, 1969, through March 31, 1970. In all probability the subject was in contact with NUCCIO while at the Biscayne Arms Motel. NUCCIO's registration card was in the name of Mr. and Mrs. D. NUCCIO, 206 Sherman Road, Glenview, Illinois, 60025. A notation on the card [redacted] was made by the hotel manager. A registration card noted that NUCCIO was the owner of a 1967 Buick with Illinois Registration BN 205.

[redacted] stated that he recalled that NUCCIO went to the track almost daily while staying at the Biscayne Arms. He also recalled that NUCCIO was confined to Mt. Sinai Hospital for about a week for gall stones or a similar matter during his stay at the Biscayne Arms. (It is to be noted that a telephone call to Mt. Sinai Hospital was made by the subject and in all probability it was to NUCCIO when he was confined there.)

On July 28, 1970, attempts to contact [redacted] were unsuccessful. [redacted] advised [redacted] at this address is employed as a [redacted] further advised he does not know [redacted] and is not aware that [redacted] ever resided in the apartment building.

On July 29, 1970, [redacted] was interviewed at [redacted]. She advised that she is acquainted with [redacted] and that [redacted] had lived with her at [redacted] [redacted] moved from this address approximately [redacted]

She stated she is familiar with ETO's activities only through what she reads in the newspapers in that every Nisei in Chicago knows about him.

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At this time she said she did not have any further statements to make.

At the conclusion of this interview an elderly Japanese man was observed approaching [redacted] with several \$100 bills in his hands. He said, "this is for [redacted] he knows what it is for." This man drove away in a vehicle bearing 1970 Illinois license [redacted]

KEN ETO, Apartment 2806, 3200 North Lake Shore Drive, was contacted on his home phone at that address at which time the phone was answered by a female. ETO stated he would be happy to speak with Special Agent [redacted] across the street in the Coffee Shop in the Belmont Hotel.

ETO was advised he was being contacted in connection with his "alleged involvement" with organized crime. He stated that he had no information to furnish about individuals he was in contact with. He stated that it was too late for him to change his way of living and perhaps if the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) had contacted him 20 years ago he may have taken a different course in life. During the discussion ETO stated he was born in Stockton, California, then went to Livingston, California, and remained there until the fourth grade at which time he went to Los Angeles. He stated that his father was a gardener and a preacher in the Nazarene Church in Los Angeles. At the time the war broke out ETO stated he was in Seattle, Washington. He stated that he ran away from home at 14 because of the fanatical religious beliefs of his father. He stated that these beliefs of his father caused [redacted]

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When advised of his involvement in the Den, Bourbon Street, and gambling among Puerto Ricans in Chicago, ETO did not make any denial. He stated he has no worries about the future for himself because he is willing to take whatever is his due. He said he could always support himself by gambling for he was a shrewd card and dice player.

He said he and [redacted] have been successful in Chicago and have been able to send their father for a visit to Japan. ETO concluded by stating that he does not mind the FBI investigating his background as long as it is done with "integrity."

[redacted] Biscayne Arms Motel, Miami, Florida, was exhibited a photograph of DOMINICK NUCCIO by SA [redacted] on August 18, 1970, at which time he identified the photograph of NUCCIO as identical to the person staying at the Biscayne Arms Motel from November 14, 1969, through March 31, 1970, as previously reported.

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AT LAS VEGAS, NEVADA

The following investigation was conducted by SA [redacted] on August 20, 1970, at Las Vegas, Nevada:

[redacted] who resides [redacted] was interviewed in her residence.

She stated that prior to coming to Las Vegas she resided in Chicago, Illinois. She resided in [redacted]. It was her recollection that approximately one or two days before departing the Chicago area, she was able to sub-lease this apartment to a female whose name she could not recall because the realty company handled all of the paper work relative to the sub-leasing. She recalls that this unknown white female who sub-leased her apartment was accompanied by an unknown male who appeared to be oriental in appearance and was short and slender.

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[redacted] stated that names KEN ETO and [redacted] were unknown to her relative to the transaction involving the sub-leasing of her former apartment in Chicago, Illinois.

AT CHICAGO, ILLINOIS

On [redacted] advised that ETO has been seen at the Chicago race tracks betting large sums of money at the track windows. Source believes that ETO has been a loser in this

activity. Source further stated that he believes that if ROSS PRIO was apprised of KEN ETO's extensive gambling and spending of money he would call ETO in for an account and perhaps cause much trouble from him. In addition to his spending at the race track, ETO has been lavishly spending money on young girls.

[redacted] was contacted by Special Agent [redacted] at approximately 8:30 p.m. in his office located in the rear of Bourbon Street. This is a nightclub that opens around 8:00 p.m. and has go-go girls entertaining.

[redacted] was born on [redacted] [redacted] He stated that he does not personally know KEN ETO, but he does know him by reputation. On his desk was noted a large manila envelope with the pencil written notation thereon to Bourbon Street from [redacted]

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[redacted] had nothing to do with the Den or the Rumpus Room, [redacted] their mail [redacted] some of his employees are as follows:

On August 28, 1970, efforts were made to contact [redacted] unsuccessfully. It was noted that the apartment listed a [redacted] residing with [redacted] The building is managed by [redacted]

On August 26, 1970, [redacted] was contacted at the Back Room, a Rush Street nightclub, where he advised that he could provide no information on KEN ETO other than non-specifics already known to the Federal Bureau of Investigation. [redacted]

On August 26, 1970, Special Agent [redacted] went to [redacted] building was located, with one mailbox bearing the name [redacted] with a newsletter sticking out bearing the name [redacted] and another newsletter from the Lakeside Japanese Church, 2233 North Burling. Efforts to get a response at the door were unsuccessful. Approaching the back yard Special Agent [redacted] hailed an individual who identified himself as [redacted]. [redacted] went into a long discussion of his new philosophy of life in which he does not become involved and does not want to hurt anyone. He said the Federal Government has caused him great pain and they already know everything they need to know about [redacted]. He said he is not involved [redacted] in any criminal activities. [redacted]

[redacted] concluded by stating that he believes that KEN was an official of Kim Enterprises. [redacted]

On August 17, 1970 [redacted] [redacted] was contacted at her place of employment, [redacted] [redacted] telephone [redacted] She stated that she knows KENT ETO as JOE LEE when she went to a taster's party at the Chinese Restaurant located at 44 East Walton Street. She stated she has no idea where [redacted] is located.

In approximately [redacted] stated that [redacted] visited Los Angeles and stayed at the [redacted] California.

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On this occasion [redacted] was accompanied by [redacted]. She stated that she cannot recall the exact date, but knows that it was on a Friday night that [redacted] arrived, and they were joined by ETO on the next morning, which was Saturday, and all of them left to return to Chicago on Sunday. [redacted] stated that [redacted] visited with them on Saturday at [redacted].

In [redacted] stated that [redacted] the subject, and [redacted] were in Hawaii where he was allegedly visiting some of his relatives. [redacted] called [redacted] from Los Angeles, and persuaded her to spend a few extra days in Hawaii, and she and [redacted] flew to Hawaii and spent a few days with [redacted]. However, she stated on this occasion, she did not see ETO as ETO and [redacted] had to return to the Chicago area as [redacted] was scheduled to go to [redacted].

[redacted] stated that she knew nothing of the background of ETO, and had no information that he was associated with the gambling or racketeering element. She stated that [redacted] had never told her anything about ETO, but that he seemed to be nice, and that she

believes that [redacted] felt that ETO might marry her.

cocktail lounges in the Rush Street area of Chicago under  
subterfuge. ETO was arrested in Chicago by the Intelligence  
Unit of the Chicago Police Department on 4/16/70. Among  
other information developed during the search of his person,  
were toll call records for telephone number [redacted] listed  
to [redacted]  
Chicago, Illinois. Chicago is desirous of having [redacted]  
located and interviewed concerning the subject.
