No definite determination could be made whether KEN ETO.

K1, or K2, did or did not prepare the questioned writing on the submitted evidence due to the limited and distorted nature of portions of the questioned writing and to the limited submitted known writings. However, some handwriting characteristics were noted indicating that KEN ETO, K1, may have prepared the questioned writing appearing on Q13 and Q14.

The investigation was predicated upon informant information and past organized crime investigations in the Chicago Division since 1956. This investigation disclosed that subject, Ken Eto was a close associate of such organized crime figures in Chicago as Vincent Solano, Northside Boss, Joseph Arnold, known LCN member, Joseph Divarco, known LCN member, and the deceased Ross Prio, former gambling boss for the LCN.
