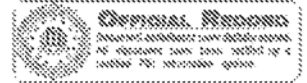

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SYNOPSIS:

On Friday, August 29, 2014, the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation (NCSBI) was contacted by the Bladenboro Police Department for assistance in investigating the death of a black male found hanging from a swing set at the Bladen Rental Properties in Bladenboro, North Carolina. Special Agent (SA) [redacted] with the NCSBI responded to the crime scene and conducted the crime scene search and examination. Detective [redacted] with the Bladenboro Police Department assisted SA [redacted] in conducting the crime scene examination. [redacted] was also present at the crime scene. SA [redacted] and Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) [redacted] conducted a neighborhood canvass of the Bladenboro Rental Properties in an attempt to locate any witnesses to the incident and to help identify the unknown black male. ASAC [redacted] interviewed [redacted] DOB: [redacted] while at the scene. [redacted] who found the body of the unknown black male as she was preparing to cut the grass at the Bladen Rental Properties. [redacted] approached the swing set where the unknown black male was and observed him hanging by his neck. [redacted] called 911 and informed the 911 operator of the situation. [redacted] said the 911 operator asked her to cut the man down. [redacted] untied the belts/straps releasing him to the ground. After the unknown black male was placed in the back of an ambulance, [redacted] DOB: [redacted] identified him as [redacted] Lennon Lee Lacy, B/M/DOB: 08/14/1997.

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SA [redacted] interviewed [redacted] in his NCSBI-issued vehicle after [redacted] identified the victim [redacted] said the funeral for Lennon Lacy's great uncle was on August 28, 2014. [redacted] said Lennon Lacy was really close with his great uncle. [redacted] said [redacted] called West Bladen High School earlier in the week because [redacted] had seen Lennon Lacy was depressed and [redacted] wanted to let the counselors know about it. SA [redacted] asked [redacted] why Lennon Lacy would want to harm or kill himself. [redacted] said because he was depressed. [redacted] did not know of anybody who would want to do Lennon Lacy harm.

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The autopsy examination of Lennon Lacy was performed on Saturday, August 30, 2014, at the Chief Medical Examiner's Office in Raleigh, North Carolina, by Doctor (Dr.) Radisch.



SYNOPSIS:

SA [redacted] with the NCSBI attended the autopsy examination of Lennon Lacy. Dr. Radisch informed SA [redacted] that it appeared Lennon Lacy died due to asphyxiation from hanging. Dr. Radisch told SA [redacted] that Lennon Lacy did not have any other injuries other than superficial ant bites on his body. SA [redacted] also requested a full toxicology on Lacy during the investigation. The results came back negative on the full toxicology.

Lennon Lacy had really bad depression over the passing of his great uncle.

SA [redacted] interviewed [redacted] on September 2, 2014, at [redacted]

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[redacted] had known him for about two to three years. [redacted]

[redacted] Lennon Lacy was saying that he wanted to kill himself. [redacted]

[redacted] Lennon Lacy told [redacted] he was upset because his uncle had just died [redacted]

[redacted] he had previously tried to hang himself down the road at the "trailer park" with two belts, but it broke. [redacted]

On September 10, 2014, SA [redacted] and ASAC [redacted] received the cellular phone belonging to Lennon Lacy. A [redacted]

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[redacted] during the investigation. SA [redacted] did not locate any evidence suggesting foul play on the cellular phone belonging to Lacy. SA [redacted] did locate some photographs on Lacy's phone of evidentiary value. One of the photographs was Lacy wearing a blue belt that was consistent with the blue belt recovered from the neck of Lacy on August 29, 2014. SA [redacted] also found [redacted]

SYNOPSIS:

a photograph of Lacy wearing a black belt that was consistent with the black belt that was tied to the blue belt on August 29, 2014.

On October 16, 2014, SA [redacted] interviewed [redacted]

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Lacy was a student in [redacted] ROTC class. [redacted] was shown a photograph of the white Nike shoes recovered from the crime scene on August 29, 2014. [redacted] said he recognized the shoes to belong to Lacy. [redacted] said they conduct physical fitness on Fridays and those were the shoes [redacted] recognized. SA [redacted] asked [redacted] how sure [redacted] was and [redacted] was very sure and would put [redacted] reputation on it. [redacted] provided investigators with a new pair of ROTC low quarter/dress shoes. [redacted] said the shoes were to go to Lacy and Lacy had been custom fitted for the shoes. [redacted] said Lacy had already tried on the shoes. [redacted] said the shoes were a size 10½. [redacted] said he was positive Lacy's shoe size was a size 10½ because [redacted] said athletic-style shoes will typically run a size larger than the dress shoes.

During the investigation, SA [redacted] obtained surveillance footage from the Spinner Court Apartments. There were two cameras located at the Spinner Court Apartments. Upon review of the surveillance footage, SA [redacted] noted someone walking from [redacted] in the direction of the Bladen Rental Properties. The unknown person was seen walking at approximately 1:02 a.m. on 08/29/2014 (according to the date and time listed on the surveillance footage).

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A copy of the case file has been turned over to the Bladen County District Attorney's Office for review. This is just a synopsis of the case and does not include every detail, fact, or interview. The reader of this synopsis should review the complete case file for a full account.

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[REDACTED] was interviewed on Friday, August 29, 2014, at approximately 9:26 a.m., by Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] of the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation (NCSBI). The interview took place in SA [REDACTED] SBI-issued vehicle in front of [REDACTED] at the crime scene. Nobody else was present during the interview.

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[REDACTED] was interviewed because he was one of the first people to initially make contact with the victim's body at the crime scene.

[REDACTED] said Medic One was dispatched at 7:28 a.m. (0728 hours). [REDACTED] said he checked in en route and arrived on scene at 7:30 a.m. (0730 hours). [REDACTED] who works for the town of Bladenboro and is also a [REDACTED] arrived at the same time. [REDACTED] said a [REDACTED] (LNU), was on scene and was very upset. [REDACTED] told them that she found the victim and did not know what to do so she let him down and called 911. [REDACTED] said the body was prone at that time. [REDACTED] rolled the victim supine and [REDACTED] checked for a pulse. [REDACTED] said there was no pulse and apparent "Rigor Mortis" had set in. [REDACTED] said they backed away from the body at that point. [REDACTED] called for law enforcement and the medical examiner.

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[redacted] had [redacted] medic unit break down to routine traffic from emergency traffic. [redacted] said that unit arrived on scene and [redacted] would remain on scene and they could go back in service. [redacted] would remain on scene until the SBI arrived. [redacted] said that was [redacted] only involvement.

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SA [redacted] read back the handwritten notes to [redacted] [redacted] for accuracy. [redacted] confirmed the handwritten notes to be true and accurate. [redacted] then signed the handwritten notes confirming them to be true and accurate.

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On Friday, August 29, 2014, at approximately 9:45 a.m., Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) [REDACTED] interviewed [REDACTED]. The interview was conducted in ASAC [REDACTED] Bureau-issued vehicle which was parked at Bladen Rental Properties business office located at 121 Mill Street. No one else was present during the interview.

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[REDACTED] was interviewed because [REDACTED] had found the victim, Lennon Lacy, hanging from a swing set located on the playground area of Bladen Rental Properties Trailer Park which is owned by Bladen Rental Properties.

[REDACTED] advised ASAC [REDACTED] had arrived at the office of Bladen Rental Properties in order for [REDACTED] to mow the grass of the trailer park. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are friends and [REDACTED] [REDACTED] in return for [REDACTED] the trailer park. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] is not employed by Bladen Rental Properties which is [REDACTED]

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[REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] arrived at the trailer park's office at approximately 7:15 a.m., and [REDACTED] drove into the neighborhood, [REDACTED] noticed a silver-colored [REDACTED] had also pulled into the driveway of [REDACTED] located on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] stated that this vehicle's owner lives at [REDACTED] but could not recall the person's name. [REDACTED] advised that the owner of [REDACTED]

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home from work. [redacted] then glanced over to the playground area and saw what appeared to be someone standing by the swing set that has an attached sliding board. [redacted] continued to drive to the office in order to start mowing grass.

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[redacted] stated that as [redacted] was getting the mower ready for mowing that a tenant known [redacted] (LNU) approached [redacted] advised that [redacted] (LNU) told [redacted] that a man had been loitering around the swing set and [redacted] did not recognize the man as a tenant. [redacted] stated that [redacted] (LNU) never told [redacted] how long the man had been loitering around the swing set. [redacted] advised that [redacted] told [redacted] (LNU) that [redacted] would check it out. [redacted] advised that [redacted]

[redacted] advised that she climbed onto the riding lawnmower and drove towards the man loitering around the swing set. [redacted] told ASAC [redacted] that as [redacted] got closer to the man that had appeared to be standing under the swing set, [redacted] noticed that the man was hanging from the swing set. [redacted] stated that there are three swing sets on the playground but where the man was hanging from was the only swing set that had an attached sliding board.

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[redacted] could see a black male hanging by the neck with his feet approximately five inches off the ground and the black male appeared to be lifeless. [redacted] advised that the black male was hanging by some type of strap/belt and [redacted] believed that there were two straps, one that was black in color and one that was blue in color. ASAC [redacted] noted that during this portion of the interview, [redacted] continued to say rope in reference to the straps/belt.

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[redacted] then called 911 and advised the 911 operator of the situation. [redacted] stated that the 911 operator asked [redacted] if the man was breathing and [redacted] advised no. [redacted] stated that then the 911 operator asked for [redacted] to cut the man down. [redacted] did not have a knife so [redacted] began to untie the rope. [redacted] recalled that the rope went around the top horizontal pole of the swing set and may have looped around twice before going through the hook from the pole where a swing would be attached. [redacted] advised that there was no swing attached to this swing set where the man was hanging.

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[redacted] advised that when she untied the rope, that the knots appeared to be a general tied knot and she did not recall any type of specialized knot. [redacted] advised that the 911 operator was on the telephone while [redacted] untied the knot. [redacted] stated that once the knot was untied, the man fell to the ground. [redacted] stated that the knot was not hard to untie and the weight of the man's lifeless body may have been supported by the hook which allowed the knot to be untied.

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[redacted] advised that [redacted] had to climb up on a ladder to a platform which led to the sliding board in order to untie the black male. [redacted] then advised that after she untied the knot, she climbed down and checked for a pulse. [redacted] advised that she could not find a pulse. [redacted] stated that at about this time, [redacted] arrived on scene so [redacted] ended the telephone conversation with the 911 operator. [redacted] stated that [redacted] works for the city of Bladenboro. [redacted] then advised that Bladenboro Police and EMS began to arrive on the scene so she walked over to the lawnmower and sat down.

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[redacted] stated that she then called [redacted] the trailer park and advised [redacted] about the situation. ASAC [redacted] asked [redacted] if there was any gang activity going on in the trailer park or around Bladenboro. [redacted] stated that she was unaware of any gang activity and that the trailer park is generally a quiet and peaceful neighborhood. ASAC [redacted] if the black man's hands were tied or bound. [redacted] advised that the black male was not tied or bound.

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ASAC [redacted] asked [redacted] could provide any further information that would assist ASAC [redacted] with this investigation and [redacted] stated she could not.

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ASAC [redacted] reviewed [redacted] statements for accuracy and [redacted] advised that all statements appeared to be correct.

The interview ended at 10:05 a.m.

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On Friday, August 29, 2014, at approximately 10:15 a.m., Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) [REDACTED] interviewed [REDACTED]. The interview was conducted at the [REDACTED].

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[REDACTED] No one else was present during the interview.

[REDACTED] was interviewed because [REDACTED] the trailer park where the victim Lennon Lacy was found hanging from a swing set.

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[REDACTED] advised ASAC [REDACTED] that at approximately 7:35 a.m., on today's date, [REDACTED] received a telephone call from [REDACTED] cell phone. [REDACTED] advised that when [REDACTED] answered the phone, [REDACTED] was on the phone and advised [REDACTED] to come to the mobile home park [REDACTED] advised [REDACTED] had found a person hanging from one of the swing sets located on the property.

[REDACTED] came immediately to Bladen Rental Properties trailer park and arrived at approximately 7:40 a.m. [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] drove [REDACTED] vehicle onto the playground and saw the body of a black male lying on the ground near a swing set [REDACTED] also saw [REDACTED] and two paramedics [REDACTED] described the two paramedics as being white males but [REDACTED] did not know them.

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[redacted] stated that she also saw Bladenboro Police Sergeant [redacted]

[redacted] stated that the black male appeared to be lifeless and swollen as if the black male had been there for a while.

[redacted] advised that she did not recognize the black male as being a tenant. [redacted] stated [redacted] about finding the black male and [redacted] was upset about finding the black male.

ASAC [redacted] if there had been any gang or drug problems in the trailer park. [redacted] stated that there has not been any problems with gangs or drugs within the trailer park. [redacted] stated that the trailer park is normally a quiet and peaceful neighborhood.

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ASAC [redacted] if all trailers located in the park were occupied. [redacted] advised ASAC [redacted] that there are 20 lots located in the park and 3 trailers were vacant. [redacted] provided ASAC [redacted] with a map of the trailer park and showed ASAC [redacted] what trailers were vacant. A copy of that map is hereby attached to this report as Attachment #780-1.

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ASAC [redacted] asked [redacted] could provide any further information that would assist ASAC [redacted] with this investigation. [redacted] could not provide any further details.

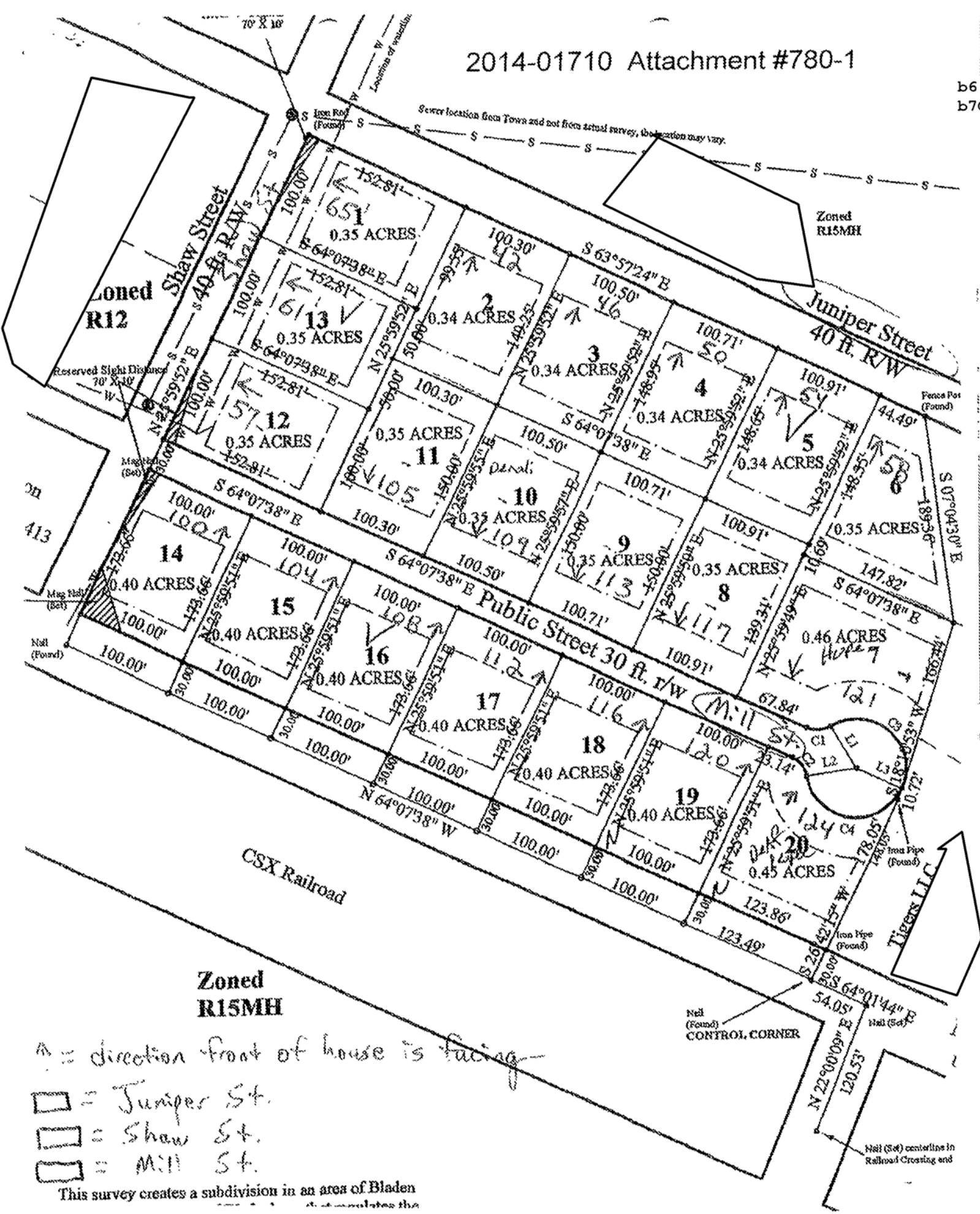

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[REDACTED] advised that he arrived at the trailer park within a minute after receiving the call. [REDACTED] stated that when he arrived, that he saw [REDACTED] standing by the swing set and [REDACTED] was also arriving. [REDACTED] advised that moments later, Bladenboro Police Officer [REDACTED] arrived.

[REDACTED] stated that he approached and saw a black male lying on the ground face down. [REDACTED] stated that he and officer

[redacted] rolled the black male over and [redacted] saw a blue belt tied around the black male's neck. [redacted] advised that [redacted] did not recognize the black male and the black male appeared to be stiff and swollen. [redacted] stated that the black male was wearing a dark blue Nike shirt with the word Bladen located on the right side chest area. [redacted] noticed the black male was wearing one shoe and the other shoe was off. [redacted] stated that the black male appeared to be dead.

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[redacted] stated that he then talked to [redacted] and used [redacted] cell phone to call [redacted] stated that he informed [redacted] of the situation and then gave the phone back to [redacted] stated that [redacted] seemed to be upset about finding the black male hanging from the swing set.

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ASAC [redacted] asked [redacted] could provide any further information that would assist ASAC [redacted] with this investigation. [redacted] stated that he could not provide any further details.

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ASAC [redacted] reviewed [redacted] statements for accuracy and [redacted] advised that all statements appeared to be correct.

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CRIME SCENE SEARCH AND EXAMINATION OF THE PLAYGROUND AREA  
AT BLADEN RENTAL PROPERTIES LOCATED BEHIND MILL STREET IN  
BLADENBORO, NORTH CAROLINA:

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On Friday, August 29, 2014, Special Agent (SA) [REDACTED] with the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation (NCSBI) was contacted by Assistant Special Agent in Charge (ASAC) [REDACTED]. ASAC [REDACTED] advised SA [REDACTED] to respond to Bladen Rental Properties in Bladenboro, North Carolina, in reference to a death investigation. ASAC [REDACTED] instructed SA [REDACTED] to conduct a crime scene search and examination at the location. ASAC [REDACTED] advised that a male was found hanging from a swing set at a playground area at Bladen Rental Properties. ASAC [REDACTED] also advised that SA [REDACTED] was the case agent in this investigation.

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SA [REDACTED] arrived at the scene at approximately 9:45 a.m. Bladen Rental Properties was a community which contained trailer houses on the property. Upon arrival, SA [REDACTED] spoke to SA [REDACTED]. SA [REDACTED] advised that a female was cutting grass on the property located behind Mill Street. The female saw a young black male hanging from a swing set located on the playground. The female was able to untie the male from the swing set.

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SA [REDACTED] spoke to Interim EMS Director [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was located at the crime scene when SA [REDACTED] arrived. [REDACTED] advised he was dispatched to this location at approximately 7:28 a.m. and arrived at approximately 7:30 a.m. [REDACTED] advised that when he arrived the male was in the prone position. [REDACTED] said the male did not have a pulse and appeared to be in "rigor mortis."

Also at the scene was Bladen County Medical Examiner [redacted]. Prior to the search and examination, SA [redacted] spoke to [redacted] gave permission to move the body, examine the body for evidence, and collect any evidence from the body. [redacted] advised he wanted to be present when the crime scene examination of the body was conducted.

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SA [redacted] spoke to Bladenboro Officer [redacted] and Bladenboro Detective [redacted]. Officer [redacted] advised that when he arrived he checked the deceased for any possible identification. Detective [redacted] assisted SA [redacted] with the crime scene search and examination. SA [redacted] observed that the playground area was roped off with yellow crime scene tape. The crime scene tape was utilized with an outer perimeter and an inner perimeter. The crime scene log was maintained by the Bladenboro Police Department. A Consent to Search form was signed prior to the crime scene examination by the owner of the property. The crime scene log and consent to search were attached on a separate report.

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SA [redacted] began his examination of the crime scene on Friday, August 29, 2014, by conducting a walkthrough of the crime scene and documenting his initial observations. Also with SA [redacted] were SA [redacted] Detective [redacted] and [redacted]. The temperature when SA [redacted] arrived was approximately 91 degrees Fahrenheit. The weather was sunny and clear.

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SA [redacted] took photographs of this crime scene using a Nikon D600 digital camera. The crime scene was photographed using available lighting. The photographs from this crime scene search taken by SA [redacted] were downloaded from SA [redacted] camera to a non-rewritable DVD-R disk. A copy of the photographs is attached to this report as Attachment #1078-01. There are also copies made available for SA [redacted] and SA [redacted] file and a copy made available for the district attorney.

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SA [redacted] also created a sketch of this crime scene, which is attached to this report as Attachment #1078-02.

Description of the crime scene:

This crime scene consisted of a grassy area with playground equipment located on it. The playground area was surrounded by trailer homes. The trailer houses' back doors were facing the playground. Detective [redacted] was able to get GPS coordinates at the swing set where the male was located. The coordinates are 34,32,34 North and 78,48,10 West.

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The victim, who was later identified as Lennon Lacy, was lying on his back underneath the swing set in the playground area of Bladen Rental Properties. The top portion of the swing set, which was made of wood, measured approximately 7'7" from the bottom of the wood frame to the ground. The top portion of the wood frame itself was approximately 5.5" in height. A visible inspection on the top portion of the swing set located close to the platform and slide was conducted. There appeared to be some type of marks on the top portion of the wood.

There was also a red Gravely zero-turn radius lawn mower near the swing set.

Reference points were used to assist in documenting the location of items. The following reference points were used during this crime scene examination:

Reference Point A: The southeast corner of trailer home listed as 50 Juniper Street, Bladenboro, North Carolina.

Reference Point B: The southwest corner of trailer home listed as 50 Juniper Street, Bladenboro, North Carolina.

The measurements were conducted utilizing a Hilti PD 42 laser measuring device.

**Description of Lennon Lacy:**

Lacy was a deceased black male with short dark hair. Lacy was wearing a blue Nike polo shirt with the word "Bladen" on the shirt. The shirt had a tagless emblem on the inside collar with the words "Nike dry fit" and "made in Indonesia." Lacy also wore blue pants. Lacy had a white Nike 10.5 size tennis shoe on his right foot. A second white Nike tennis shoe, size 10.5, was near the feet of Lacy. Lacy did not have a shoe on his left foot. The shoes did not have laces. Lacy also had on multicolored

Fruit of the Loom boxer shorts. The boxer shorts' colors were green, blue, and yellow.

Lacy had two "March of Dimes" wristbands on the right wrist and another multicolored band on the left wrist. Lacy's left leg was crossed over the right leg at the ankles. There was a blue strap or belt around Lacy's neck.

Detective [redacted] slowly removed the strap around Lacy's neck so photographs could be taken. Originally, only a blue strap was visible. However, there was a black strap which was attached to the blue strap. The black strap or belt was located under Lacy's back.

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It should be noted that Lacy's body was covered with ants. The ants were visible at Lacy's mouth, arms, joints of his fingers, and elbows.

At approximately 10:53 a.m., Detective [redacted] checked Lacy's pocket for identification. It should be noted at this point Lacy had not been identified. Detective [redacted] located in the front left pocket a key with a Florida key chain that had sea shells on it. The key had AA-19 displayed. It was suggested by [redacted] that the key resembled a post office box key.

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SA [redacted] noted that there were some scrapes on the elbow area and white marks or patches on the right arm. Lacy's right shoe was removed to observe any possible injuries. Detective [redacted] lifted Lacy's clothing up and turned Lacy over to inspect any possible injuries. There did not appear to be any other visible external injuries on Lacy.

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Lacy's head was positioned north and his feet were positioned south. Lacy's head was located approximately 93'7" from Reference Point A, and approximately 97'9" from Reference Point B.

When SA [redacted] went to his vehicle to retrieve some equipment, [redacted] took control of the key at approximately 11:11 a.m. [redacted] advised he was going to the post office in an attempt to make an identification of Lacy. [redacted] returned the key to Detective [redacted] at approximately 11:46 a.m.

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The white tennis shoes, size 10.5, were seized as Item #1. The key was seized by Detective [redacted] as Item #3. The

blue/black strap was originally documented as an item of evidence (Item #2). However, the blue/black strap went with Lacy's body to the Chief Medical Examiner's (ME) Office for forensic comparison. The blue/black strap was turned over to the Bladenboro Police Department after the autopsy was completed. The white tennis shoes were located approximately 98'9" from Reference Point A, and 104'3" from Reference Point B. The key was not measured due to the fact that [redacted] took the key prior to it being measured. The strap measured approximately 94' from Reference Point A, and 99'4" from Reference Point B. The strap was measured prior to it being transported to the ME's office with Lacy.

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**Evidence Collected During Crime Scene Examination:**

The following items of evidence were collected by Detective [redacted] with the Bladenboro Police Department:

Item #1: One (1) pair of white Nike tennis shoes, size 10.5. This item of evidence was collected on August 29, 2014, at approximately 11:53 a.m.

Item #3: One (1) key with AA-19 on the key attached to a Florida key chain with sea shells. This item of evidence was turned over to Detective [redacted] from [redacted] on August 29, 2014, at approximately 11:46 a.m.

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The crime scene search concluded on August 29, 2014, at approximately 12:01 p.m. The times in this report were taken from SA [redacted] wristwatch and may vary from times recorded in other reports. At the conclusion of the crime scene search, this area was released back to the owner of Bladen Rental Properties.

Lacy, who at this point was not identified, was placed in a body bag by [redacted] and [redacted] with Bladen County EMS. The body bag was sealed at the zipper by Detective [redacted] on August 29, 2014, at approximately 12:11 p.m. Detective [redacted] initialed the seal.

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The Bladenboro Police Department located a person who could possibly identify the body. The body bag was unsealed for identification purposes. [redacted] DOB:

[redacted] said he knew the person in the body bag.

[redacted] said he went to West Bladen High School. [redacted]

left to go get Lacy's mother. [redacted] lived on [redacted] [redacted] said he did not know the numbered address. [redacted] said his contact phone number was [redacted] cell phone number, [redacted]

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Lacy's mother came to the scene and identified the body as Lennon Lee Lacy. She commented that was her "baby boy." SA [redacted] interviewed the mother. The interview will be documented on a separate report.

The body bag was resealed on August 29, 2014, at approximately 12:36 p.m. by Detective [redacted] EMS transported Lacy from the scene on August 29, 2014, at approximately 12:44 p.m.

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All of the items of evidence were collected and maintained by Detective [redacted] with the Bladenboro Police Department. SA [redacted] was notified later by SA [redacted] that the Bladenboro Police Department assigned different item numbers to the collected evidence.

Radisch advised a pattern injury found on the neck of the victim was consistent with the "noose" that had been seized as evidence. Radisch stated that she did not observe any other injuries on the body of the victim, with the exception of superficial ant bites.

Several items of evidence were collected during this autopsy and were turned over to SA [REDACTED] after the autopsy was completed. They included a blood stain card, the victim's clothing, and the noose that had been around the victim's neck. The collection of these items of evidence is documented separately in a report attached to this investigative file.

History of Present Illness

EMS-1 responded to the area of 102 Cypress St and Mill St in Bladenboro for a signal 9-EJ U/A of EMS-1 to Mill St LOT#113, which was a mobile home park, found a bystander standing next to riding mower and swing set very upset. Then saw a 17y/o male pt lying on ground under the swing set in the prone position. Fire Fighter [Redacted] with Station 51 arrived on scene with EMS-1 at the same time. Bystander known only by first name [Redacted] explained she saw the patient hanging from the swing set, she called 911, and then let him down because she didn't know what to do. Assessed pt found appeared to not be breathing EMS-1 and Firefighter [Redacted] rolled the patient supine found to be pulseless and apneic, very cold to the touch with rigor already set in. Noted a belt snatched around the neck, and noted eye prominence. At this time backed away and called for law enforcement. Then called for K-1 (Bladen County Coroner [Redacted] by radio. Officer [Redacted] with Bladenboro arrived on scene at this time and took control of the scene. Medic-1 arrived on scene crew members never exited the ambulance EMS-1 instructed them to check back in service due to having to wait for K-1. SBI and K-1 on scene investigated the scene and the body of the patient was not moved. T-8 was called on scene to transport the body on completion of law enforcement and SBI. Pt's body placed in body bag by EMS and sealed by law enforcement. Body moved to stretcher and moved to unit. Patients body moved to BCH EE MORGUE. Body placed in morgue. Report given to RN [Redacted] and body transferred to RN [Redacted]

**Details:**

For information of the file, the above captioned Assessment was initiated based on a request from the United States Attorney's Office, Eastern District of North Carolina (EDNC). Specifically, the EDNC contacted the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Charlotte Division and requested an agent be assigned to investigate potential Civil Rights violations pertaining to the death of LENNON LACY.

As background, on August 29, 2014 at approximately 7:30am, LENNON LACY (LACY) was found dead, hanging from a swing set in a Bladenboro, North Carolina trailer park community. LACY, described as a 17 year old black male, was a student at West Bladen High School and a member of its varsity football team. Investigation into the death of LACY is

being conducted by the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation (NCSBI) with the assistance of the Bladenboro Police Department (BPD) and the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, Office of the Chief Medical Examiner. The investigation is being conducted under the direction of the Bladen County District Attorney's Office. During the course of the local investigation into the death of LACY, representatives of the North Carolina National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NCNAACP) expressed concerns with regard to the thoroughness and direction of the investigation. The NCNAACP felt the state investigators made a "quick call" to categorize LACY's death as a suicide and did not look at all of the facts. These concerns were expressed by the NCNAACP even though the investigation was ongoing and an investigative report had not yet been issued. The NCNAACP detailed an attorney/investigator to monitor and review the investigation. It also hired a medical pathologist to review the state's autopsy report.

The NCNAACP expressed its concerns through the media and formally to the United States Attorney's Office, EDNC. Specifically, the NCNAACP requested the EDNC and the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Civil Rights Division join the investigation into LACY's death. Upon meeting with the EDNC, the NCNAACP expressed concerns that LACY's death was the result of a hate crime and not a suicide. In coming to this conclusion, the NCNAACP cited numerous issues and irregularities. The main issues and irregularities are as follows:

- The sneakers found on LACY did not belong to him. In fact, the family contends they were two sizes too small.
- The family contends the two belts used as the ligature LACY was found hanged with did not belong to LACY.
- The family does not believe the suicide could have been physically carried out at the location the body was found.
- The family contends LACY was not in a depressed state.

Upon meeting with the NCNAACP, the EDNC agreed to take a look into this matter and subsequently requested the FBI, Charlotte Division

assign an agent to assist. On December 2, 2014 an Assessment was initiated by the Charlotte Division based on this request. The authorized purpose of this Assessment was to seek information related to activities constituting violations of federal criminal law, specifically Civil Rights Violations. In conducting this Assessment, the Charlotte Division worked closely with the EDNC and DOJ, Civil Rights Division.

Investigation by the Charlotte Division into this matter began with a review of the NCSBI Investigative Report dated November 30, 2014. This report, which is made up of three volumes, documents the investigative steps taken by the NCSBI. A review of this report found the investigation conducted by the NCSBI to be comprehensive and thorough. Investigation conducted by the NCSBI included a thorough processing of the crime scene, the collection and analysis of electronic data and the interview of all relevant individuals. An autopsy was also performed by the North Carolina State Medical Examiner's Office, upon the request of the Bladen County District Attorney's Office. The NCSBI was also responsive with regard to lead information brought forth by family members of LACY. In all, the NCSBI conducted 54 interviews of 49 individuals. The NCSBI currently documents the status of the case as "Pending Review by the District Attorney."

**CRIME SCENE:**

LACY's body was first discovered in the early morning hours of August 29, 2014 by a resident of the trailer park community. The resident, however, saw LACY at a distance and believed him to be standing by a swing set. This resident reported what she saw to another person who arrived at the complex to cut the grass. This individual approached LACY at which time she found him unresponsive and hanging from the swing set. Specifically, LACY had a blue canvas belt around his neck. The blue belt was tied to another black canvas belt which was wrapped around and tied to the top bar of the swing set. This individual immediately called 911 and proceeded to untie the belt from

the top bar of the swing set releasing the body to the ground. Emergency units arrived within minutes and LACY was pronounced dead at the scene.

The swing set is described as an A-Frame structure. Although designed for multiple swings, only one swing was attached to the structure at the time LACY's body was found. Attached to one side of the swing set was a slide which included a set of stairs and a platform at the top of the slide. LACY's body was discovered at the end of the swing set in close proximity to this platform. The swing set is several hundred yards from LACY's residence and a place he had frequented in the past.

During the course of its investigation, the NCSBI conducted a re-enactment of the discovery of LACY's body and the method on how it was taken down from the swing set. The NCSBI video recorded this re-enactment. Review of this re-enactment found no irregularities. The Charlotte Division physically inspected the site and found the platform for the slide provided access for someone to hang themselves without much difficulty at this location.

During the course of processing the crime scene, both NCSBI and the BPD took a combined 134 crime scene photos. All clothing, to include LACY's sneakers, was seized and processed as evidence. The belts, which were used as a ligature, were also seized and processed as evidence.

**AUTOPSY:**

Upon the request of the Bladen County District Attorney's Office, on August 30, 2014 an autopsy was performed on LACY by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Chief Medical Examiner, State of North Carolina. Upon completion of the autopsy, [REDACTED] determined LACY's cause of death to be "Asphyxia Due to Hanging."

[REDACTED] was interviewed by the Charlotte Division, EDNC and DOJ with regard to this matter. [REDACTED] confirmed the cause of death as "Asphyxia Due to Hanging." She further stated her observations and findings during the course of her examination were "straight forward"

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and "typical of death by hanging." [redacted] found no defensive wounds on LACY's body or any physical evidence to indicate he was strangled to death. A toxicology report found no evidence of drugs or alcohol in LACY's system. Upon completion of autopsy and toxicology examinations, [redacted] prepared a "Supplemental Report of Cause of Death" documenting the cause of death as "Asphyxia Due to Hanging" and the manner of death as "Suicide." This report was forwarded to [redacted] [redacted] Bladen County Coroner who expressed no objections and signed off on the death certificate.

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[redacted] further advised when she later heard the assertions it would be physically challenging for someone to hang themselves where LACY was found, she was compelled to examine the site herself. Upon her physical examination of the site, [redacted] concluded it would be easy for someone to hang themselves where LACY was found.

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b7C**INTERVIEWS:**

During the course of the investigation, NCSBI conducted logical interviews of witnesses, family members and friends. NCSBI also conducted numerous interviews in response to lead information provided by LACY's family and the NCNAACP. The Charlotte Division conducted 18 interviews. Most were of individuals previously interviewed by the NCSBI. None of the interviews conducted by either NCSBI or the Charlotte Division developed any evidence to indicate LACY's death was the result of a homicide. Interviews conducted by the Charlotte Division found no major discrepancies with regard to interviews conducted by NCSBI.

The interviews provided information pertaining to LACY's state of mind. They also developed a reliable time line regarding the events which occurred on the evening of August 28, 2014. Interviews of family members and friends documented the passing of a relative who LACY was very close with identified as LACY's great uncle. The funeral was on August 28, 2014. During that same time period, [redacted] identified as [redacted] LACY had [redacted]

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[redacted] This upset LACY and resulted in an argument with both his mother and father.

Shortly after these conversations with his parents, LACY travelled to Virginia to spend time at his godparents' house. LACY would routinely spend most summers at his godparents' home and spend time with their son, [redacted] Upon interview, both LACY's godfather and his son commented on LACY's change in demeanor. Both described him as being withdrawn and wanting to remain in his room.

Upon returning home, LACY spoke with [redacted] [redacted] was interviewed by the NCSBI, the Charlotte Division and EDNC. Information provided by [redacted] established a reliable time line regarding LACY's actions the evening of August 28, 2014. [redacted] estimated LACY returned home from the [redacted] residence sometime around 10:00pm. She described LACY as being upset regarding his conversation [redacted]

[redacted] They talked for a short period of time after which, [redacted] went into her bedroom to watch television. At approximately 11:00pm, LACY knocked on her door requesting she come out. At this time, LACY brought [redacted] to the front of the apartment. [redacted]

seeing LACY at approximately midnight. At approximately 1:00am, [redacted] heard LACY's father tell him to get ready for school the next day. This was the last time anyone reported seeing LACY.

LACY's father, [redacted] was interviewed by the Charlotte Division and the EDNC. [redacted] confirmed the parents' [redacted] He also confirmed that [redacted] advised that after LACY's great uncle's funeral, the family met at [redacted] brother's home. During this period, [redacted] found LACY to be withdrawn. Specifically he described LACY as having a "distant look."

[redacted] corroborated [redacted] recollection that afterwards, he encountered LACY in the kitchen of their apartment. [redacted] estimated this to be approximately 1:00am on August 29, 2014. [redacted] commented to LACY it was late and reminded him he had school and football the next

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day. [redacted] recalled LACY reply, in what he described as a very sad way, "Okay Dad." [redacted] further advised he heard someone go out of the apartment shortly after. Based on all of the information gathered to date, it is believed the person [redacted] heard leaving the apartment was LACY.

Upon interview by the NCSBI, [redacted] advised of the great uncle's passing and his funeral on August 28, 2014. [redacted] described LACY to NCSBI as being depressed over the uncle's passing. She was so concerned she contacted the guidance counselor at LACY's school. Specifically, on August 27, 2014 LACY's mother informed the guidance counselor of the passing of a close relative and asked her to watch out for her son. She also asked that the JROTC Instructor be notified regarding this matter. This has been verified through interviews conducted at the school.

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b7C**ELECTRONIC EVIDENCE:**

During the course of its investigation, NCSBI obtained the cellular telephone used by LACY. All stored data on the phone was extracted to include text messages, digital images, video files, audio files, call logs and contact information. In all, there were an excess of 1,500 text messages; most of which were between LACY [redacted] Review of these text messages confirmed LACY's [redacted] No evidence was retrieved from the telephone to indicate LACY's death was a homicide.

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NCSBI also collected video footage of surveillance cameras [redacted] located between LACY's residence and the location his body was found. Review of this video footage met with negative results.

NCSBI also obtained the video footage from security cameras at LACY's apartment complex. Review of one of the camera views showed a lone individual walking past the front of the [redacted] residence at approximately 1:03am on August 29, 2014. This lone individual was walking towards the trailer park community from the direction of LACY's

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apartment. The distance of this individual from the camera makes it impossible to determine identification to include gender or race. What is certain is that it is a lone individual. No other individuals are seen walking past the [redacted] residence around this time period. This time period is within the time frame it is believed LACY left his apartment.

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**BELTS:**

Review of digital images found in LACY's cellular telephone found numerous self taken photographs of LACY wearing a black belt which appears to be identical to the one LACY was found hanged with. Further review found another self taken photograph with LACY wearing a blue belt which appears to be identical to the one LACY was found hanged with. Specifically, the double D-ringed buckle on the blue belt seized as evidence was worn with rust spots. The double D-ringed buckle seen in the photograph found in LACY's telephone also appeared to be worn with rust spots. During the course of the investigation, LACY's family produced a photograph of a blue belt which was in their possession which they advised belonged to LACY. An examination of this photograph, however, found the double D-ringed buckle not to be similar to the one depicted in the photograph found in LACY's telephone. The belt in the possession of the family had a double D-ring buckle which was clearly like new and unmarked. Upon interview, [redacted] was in possession of this belt. Upon request by the Charlotte Division and EDNC to inspect the belt, [redacted]

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**SNEAKERS:**

Upon the discovery of LACY's body, he was found to be in possession of a pair of white, Nike sneakers. Specifically, the right sneaker was on his right foot while the left sneaker was off his left foot; however, in close proximity. The sneakers were a size 10.5 absent of laces. The family believed the sneakers found on and by LACY at the crime scene did not belong to him. In fact, the family contends the sneakers were two sizes too small. Interviews conducted by both NCSBI

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and the Charlotte Division determined that in early August, 2014, LACY was sized for dress shoes by the West Bladen High School Junior Reserve Officers Training Corps (JROTC) Instructor. Although the JROTC Instructor could not find a record of the measurement he took of LACY's shoe size, he did turn over, as evidence, the shoes he ordered for LACY based on this measurement. An inspection of these shoes found them to be a size 10.5; the same size as the white sneakers found on LACY. The JROTC Instructor further advised these sneakers were consistent with ones used for JROTC physical fitness class. [REDACTED] also advised he had seen LACY wear plain white sneakers in the past.

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In conclusion, the investigation conducted by the Charlotte Division pursuant to this Assessment found no evidence to indicate LACY's death was the result of a Civil Rights violation. Therefore, no further investigation is warranted by the Charlotte Division and this Assessment will be closed.

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
