

, Capital Police Service, On October 2, 1978, State Supreme Court Building, Richmond, Virginia, telephone telephonically advised a representative of the number 786-Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) that the above captioned individual had presented himself to the State Supreme Court Building, Richmond, Virginia, and requested to speak with Justice Lewis F. Powell, of the United States Supreme Court. further requested the home address of Justice Powell, Indicating that he wished to speak with Justice Powell. Officer to be carrying an object wrapped in a blanket, observed which appeared to be a rifle. Voluntarily surrendered who upon examination determined it to be same to Officer who upon examination determined it to be an eight millimeter, Model 700, Remington rifle, Serial Number A6578105, with magazine containing three rounds. thereafter arrested by Capital Police for a carrying a concealed weapon.

On October 2, 1978, was interviewed by representatives of the FBI at the Richmond Bureau of Police Lockup, Richmond, Virginia. advised he is a citizen of the United Kingdom, travelling in the United States of America, has been travelling under Passport Number throughout the United States since May, 1978. travels included horseback riding expeditions throughout the western portion of the United States, to include the Rocky Mountain regions; and other backpacking expeditions. purchased the above described weapon as a means of personal protection against bears and other animals while camping out. During the interview, stated that his mother, (maiden name) (deceased in 1974), was employed by the British Intelligence during World War II. further believed that Supreme Court Justice Lewis F. Powell was an

As a result of this working relationship, Justice Powell became acquainted with mother and thereafter they became friends. Further advised that he has read the book "Man from Intrepid", and that he has an interest in the events that transpired during World War II. Out of curiosity, he was hoping to learn more about Justice Powell's involvement with the British Intelligence Service during this period of time. In addition, father, urged the subject to renew the friendship with Justice Powell, by means of an informal contact with Powell, while was travelling in the United States.

further indicated that, as he was about to depart from the United States, he made an effort to communicate with Justice Powell, via the United States mail. Accordingly, had mailed Justice Powell a letter approximately one week before the October 2, 1978 incident, addressing it to Justice Lewis F. Powell, Richmond, Virginia. This letter introduced Powell and requested Powell to make an appointment for letter by sending a Richmond. Powell was to answer name to the Main Post Office in Richmond, letter in checked the Post Office in the morning hours of Virginia. October 2, 1978, and when he found no letter, he then proceeded to the Supreme Court Building, Richmond, Virginia, in hopes of believed the State Supreme Court Building finding Powell. to be United States Supreme Court Building.

had hitchhiked throughout the United States carrying his rifle rolled in a blanket as he had no rifle case. had full intentions of declaring the rifle to British customs and comply with all laws governing transportation and ownership of firearms.
