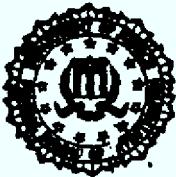

The October 23, 1963, issue of the "Michigan Daily", a University of Michigan student publication, Ann Arbor, Michigan, contains an article captioned "Muslim Demands Separation", which states "the only permanent solution to the Negro problem is the Negroes' complete separation from the whites so that they can live alone among their own people in peace," Malcolm X, Minister for Muslim Mosque No. 7 of New York City, said last night at the Union.

"How can America atone for her crimes against the Negroes?" he asked.

"A desegregated movie house or restaurant isn't the answer, and equal employment opportunity is only a temporary solution. Complete separation is the only true answer, Malcolm X said. He added that the United States should provide transportation for the Negroes to their nation, and everything they need to get started. 'This is justice,' he commented.

"He also said that they don't want desert land, but fertile productive land on which they can produce. 'The United States should give us everything we need for 20-25 years until we can produce for ourselves,' he continued. 'This is just repayment for 400 years of slavery.'

"The American Negroes are getting angrier and more explosive every day," he said. There are two revolts going on in the country today - the Negro revolt and the Black revolt.

"The Negro revolt is made up of those Negroes who follow the civil rights leaders, asking for equality. The Black revolt is made up of the followers of Elijah Muhammad, leader of the Muslims in America, who want separation," he continued.

"He was very critical of the so-called 'Negro revolt', saying, 'who ever heard of a "friendly" or a "non-violent" or a "peaceful" revolution?' as the Negro revolt is often called.

" 'We are not Black Muslims, we are Muslims.

" 'Islam is a religion of brotherhood in which color is not recognized,' Malcolm X said at a discussion session at the Guild House yesterday following his talk at the Michigan Union.

" 'Elijah Muhammad is hoping to establish a religious nation under Islam,' he said. 'I must emphasize that we don't want a separate place for this nation in the United States - we want to go back home.'

" 'We are most optimistic on achieving Elijah Muhammad's aims, whereas we think that the Negro civil rights groups will never succeed, because they are satisfied with tokenism,' he said.

"The Muslim program is in three parts: 'Wake-up, clean up, and stand up,' he continued. The black people must be educated to the fact that complete integration is wishful thinking. He must then clean up his way of living, giving up the drinking, crime and dope addiction which are destroying the moral fibre of the Negro community, Malcolm X said.

"Finally, he must restore his identification with the Negro people, and restore his racial pride, he added.

" 'Negro who has been exposed to Elijah Muhammad thinks of himself as a Negro - never as an American,' he said. 'He realizes that the price of his independence is the willingness to give life - and to take life.'

"Malcolm X said the worst crime that the American slave traders and the American people committed against the Negroes was the dehumanizing of the Negro people."

Re: Nation of Islam

A source advised on October 23, 1963, that Malcolm Little, leader of the NOI in New York, appeared on radio station WLAV, Grand Rapids, Michigan, on a program called "Party Five". Source advised that the format of the program is that the guest speaker answers questions called in by listeners. Source advised that Malcolm Little was asked to explain why the NOI claims to have 100,000 members when the Federal Bureau of Investigation has reported only 10,000. Source advised that Malcolm Little denounced the Federal Bureau of Investigation, stating that the Federal Bureau of Investigation should send its agents to the south to investigate bombings against the Negroes rather than investigate the Muslims.

On 10/10/63, at approximately 9:55 a.m., Agents observed MALCOLM X, [REDACTED] and several other male Negroes enter the Alameda Room at Del Webb's Towne-House. Shortly thereafter [REDACTED] entered this room and in a short while [REDACTED] accompanied by a Negro female, entered the room. Present at this conference were representatives of the various San Francisco newspapers, radio and TV stations. Agents stationed themselves outside of the Alameda Room in the corridor and through the open doors could see and hear what was transpiring.

67C MALCOLM X was seated at a speakers table with [REDACTED] sitting at his left side. [REDACTED] was standing near the rear door and the other Muslims present were seated throughout the room. There were approximately 10 to 15 representatives from the press, radio and television. The press conference commenced at 10:00 a.m. and lasted until approximately 11:30 a.m. MALCOLM X, who did all of the talking for the NOI, announced at the beginning of the conference that he had called this meeting to present the Black Muslim views on the racial problem in the U.S. and he said that he hoped the press would not distort the views of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD as has been the case in the past.

For the most part the conference consisted of questions by the press representatives and answers by MALCOLM. During the course of this conference, in response to questions put to him, MALCOLM X stated that Mr. MUHAMMAD teaches that separation of the races is the only answer to the racial problem in America and that all black men in the U.S. are willing or should be willing to abide by these teachings. He said at one point that the attempts by the present administration to speed up integration of the races is at best feeble and to his belief hypocritical. He characterized all white men as deceitful and he said the only salvation for the black man in the world is to accept Islam as the true religion and ELIJAH MUHAMMAD as the true prophet. MALCOLM continued that the Black Muslim movement is misunderstood to varying degrees in the U.S. and that it is misunderstood in California, more than it is in any other state. He said this is principally because of police intervention in Black Muslim activity and at this point he chided the press as continually projecting the Negro as a criminal and consequently is partially to blame for much of the misunderstanding between the races.

MALCOLM said at one point the average black man in the U.S. is not accepted nor is he interested in being accepted into the mainstream of American life. He said the ideal situation is for all black people in the U.S. to return to Africa.

During his talk MALCOLM was extremely critical of the NAACP and Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. He saved most of

his extreme criticism for the Los Angeles Police Department, its Chief, the City officials of Los Angeles and the various courts in Southern California. He went into great ~~deal~~ *detail* regarding the prosecution of the Black Muslims in Los Angeles recently stemming from a riot in that city about 18 months ago. He decried the lack of justice afforded to the Black Muslims whom he described as prosecuted victims in this frame-up. He said that to him it appears that the only common ground for discussion between blacks and whites would be based on mutual distrust of each other. He said that he has no confidence whatsoever in the morals or the ethics of the white man but that he does accept and have confidence in the white man's intelligence and that it appears that any common ground between the races should be an intellectual achievement rather than one based on morals, ethics or emotions.

It appeared that the main points that MALCOLM made were embodied in the theory that the black and white races in America must be separated for the respective survival of each and he put it that the ~~MMXKXKX~~ should be separated from the oppressor. oppressed

He closed his comments by stating that the Honorable ELIJAH MUHAMMAD is the only black man in America who has the solution to the racial problems facing this nation.

On Friday, October 11, 1963, the writer was present at Dwinelle Plaza on the UC campus at Berkeley when MALCOLM X addressed a crowd of approximately 4,000 students and faculty members from 12 noon to 1 pm. The appearance of MALCOLM X was sponsored by SLATE and MALCOLM was introduced to the audience by [REDACTED] of SLATE.

MALCOLM X spoke for 45 minutes and answered questions for 15 minutes. In opening his talk, he remarked that in 1961 he was prohibited from speaking on the UC campus because the university officials ruled that he represented a religious group, while at the same time other officials in the California state government ruled that Muslim inmates in the state prisons could not have access to ministers and teaching materials because the religion they followed was not considered to be an accepted faith. He drew some laughter from the audience while pointing out that these rulings appear to contradict one another. MALCOLM said that he was speaking this date on secular matters and that his talk would embody the plan that the Honorable ELIJAH MUHAMMAD has for solving the racial problem in the United States. He announced that he would speak on the religious aspects of MUHAMMAD's programs on Sunday, October 13, 1963 at Richmond Auditorium, Richmond, California.

At the beginning of his talk, MALCOLM X said that a great and bloody racial war is going to take place in America and that ELIJAH MUHAMMAD is the only one who can prevent it. He mentioned that the black man wants to integrate and the white man resents this and will prevent it. The only answer then is to follow MUHAMMAD's plan of establishing a separate black nation, if not in Africa, then somewhere else, financed by the United States Government as partial payment for the three hundred years of free labor extracted from the slaves. MALCOLM said that the Revolutionary War was fought by the American whiteman to free himself from the English whiteman and that the Civil War was fought to preserve the Union and not to free the slaves. He said the Emancipation Proclamation was signed a hundred years ago and yet the ex-slave still does not have freedom. He said the Supreme Court decision upholding school integration was signed nine years ago and still the schools are not integrated. MALCOLM continued that the whiteman has reluctantly given up his house in the city to the blackman, moved out to the suburbs and thereby created a black ghetto supervised by rent gouging landlords. He said the whiteman then gave up his schools to the blackman and built new schools for himself in the suburbs, thereby creating crowded, run down, poorly run black schools for the Negro.

He said that the next step should be for the whiteman to give up his job in the city to the blackman and create a job in suburbia for himself; but the whiteman isn't going to do this because it would create a civil war among whites that would lead to a racial war between blacks and whites.

In his talk, MALCOLM referred to the whiteman in the South as the "wolf" and he called the "white liberal" in the North the "fox". He said he knows what the wolf is like and can predict how he'll act toward the blackman and can respect him for it. The "white liberal" or "fox" pretends to be the friend of the blackman, MALCOLM said, and he infiltrates the blackman's organizations so he can rule them and in the end is nothing but a political hypocrite. He said the present "Catholic Administration" under KENNEDY offers the blackman civil rights bills but not civil rights. He pictured the Negro as one in a constant state of oppression and one whose life of poverty, crime, disease and death is traceable directly to the white hypocritical power structure. In the end, he predicted, the blackman will overcome all and Islam will prevail because Allah is the one and only true God who has given His message to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, the modern day Moses sent here to lead the black people out of bondage. MALCOLM decried the four hundred years of injustice for the blackman in America and he promised that the Black Muslims will extract an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, a head for a head and a body for a body.

MALCOLM's speech was received politely but with no apparent enthusiasm. There was a small smattering of applause at times during his talk and about the same type reception when he was finished. It is quite probable that the large audience was due to the controversial nature of MALCOLM's announced subject matter, the fact that he was banned from the campus in 1961 and the general political climate among the UC student body.

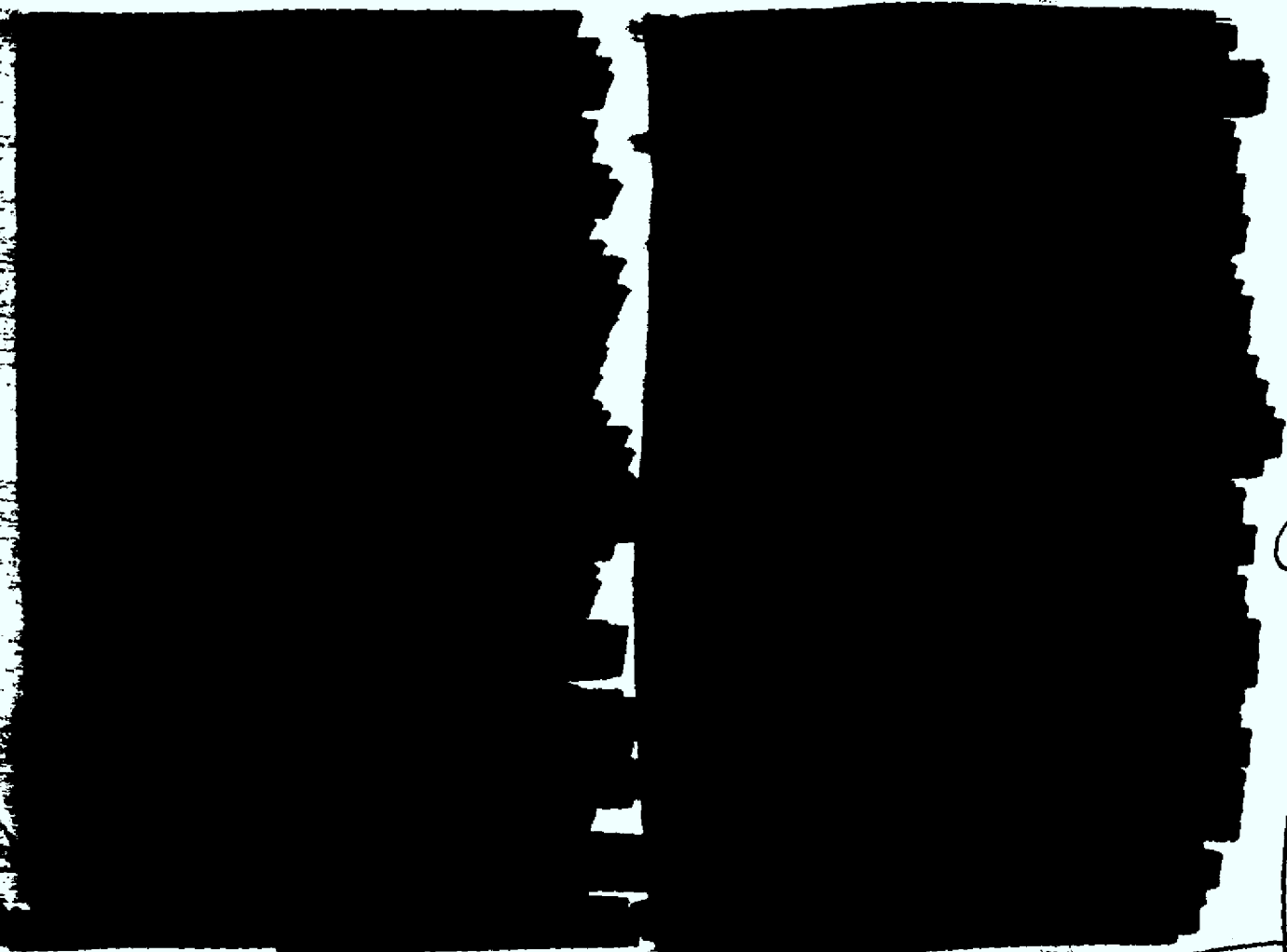

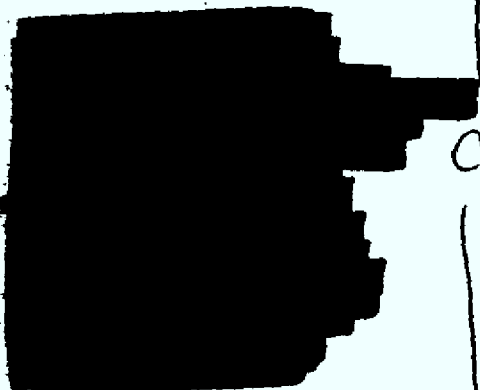
