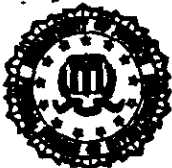

The Nation of Islam (NOI) referred to herein, is characterized in the appendix section of this communication.

Reference is made to Chicago memorandum dated August 19, 1964, captioned as above.

On August 24, 1964, a source advised that there was no substance to the information that Akbar Muhammad would break with the NOI and denounce his father Elijah Muhammad. This source advised that Akbar Muhammad was not aware of the news that had come to Chicago about his breaking with the NOI and that he had never even spoken to a reporter about the matter.

A second source advised during August, 1964, that Akbar Muhammad was a member of the NOI, a student in Cairo, Egypt, and was also the African correspondent for the official NOI publication, "Muhammad Speaks".

Brother [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD. ELIJAH stated that everyday you can see people on the street that Allah is punishing because they did not believe in him, the Messenger, and won't do as he says. MUHAMMAD stated that they were the people who were walking around in a daze. [REDACTED] replied that everything the Messenger has said is coming true day by day. ELIJAH stated that many of them have been in the temple sitting contented and filled and are now walking out and walking away when they have been right at the door of heaven. ELIJAH stated we are right at the judgement now adding, "In fact, we is in the judgement days now."

[REDACTED] told of some of the followers who seemed to resent giving any more when they think that some are in there only because of what they can get from the followers. ELIJAH replied that they are not the true followers and they resent what they have given as well as what they are asked to give. b7c

ELIJAH then spoke about [REDACTED] stating that he was a very good man. He said [REDACTED] has been with him since he was a boy and has always been afraid of him. ELIJAH said that even today if [REDACTED] thinks he is angry with him about something he goes home and cries like a baby.

ELIJAH said that since this trouble many of the Ministers are getting all or nearly all of the lost found that come to the Temple to accept Islam.

July 20, 1964

[REDACTED] of [REDACTED] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he was planning another article for the paper ("Muhammad Speaks"), which he will send to ELIJAH for approval. ELIJAH stated that everything he writes is approved and he has told the people to

accept everything [redacted] writes and to print it as soon as they can.

ELIJAH stated he was going to send [redacted] a ticket for the Los Angeles affair (August 9, 1964) adding he would like to have [redacted] at all of these affairs and would like to have him write something special for each of them. [redacted] replied he would be very happy to do this.

[redacted] continued that ELIJAH has saved him from being put out once again. ELIJAH promised [redacted] that as long as he has a place here he would provide a place for the [redacted] ELIJAH offered to buy a place in Chicago for [redacted] and set him up with the paper if [redacted] would like that. [redacted] stated he would be willing to listen to anything ELIJAH would suggest.

July 21, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD. ELIJAH told [redacted] to go to the funeral and say a prayer over the body. ELIJAH further told [redacted] that he can and should go to visit the various ministers to see how they are doing and then report back. He added it would not be necessary for [redacted] to check with him before he leaves, but all he had to do was just let him know when he got back.

July 22, 1964

It was indicated [redacted] was receiving monthly news letters from [redacted] in Havana, Cuba.

July 22, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with [redacted] [redacted] stated [redacted] was over for a time yesterday and was crying about the way things were going and the way people were doing. [redacted] thought perhaps it was about the baby, which he had been trying to get from [redacted] who is going to get

married soon. [redacted] said [redacted] wanted to do it before she gets a year older but was having trouble.

[redacted] said that some of the Muslims have said that [redacted] was buying a house for [redacted] adding she had heard this directly from [redacted] stated she knew that [redacted] had been making calls to Muslims and had been telling them nasty things about [redacted]

[redacted] stated that [redacted] and [redacted] were all pregnant again, [redacted] and [redacted] said [redacted] was sloppy and did not teach her children good manners. They criticized [redacted] severely. [redacted] stated she was going to try to keep [redacted] and [redacted] out of her place as much as possible. [redacted] stated she was turning towards entertaining doctors and lawyers and such in her home. b7c

July 23, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he wanted to talk with ELIJAH about a letter he had received from [redacted] which concerned things that were said in New York. ELIJAH called [redacted] and [redacted] told [redacted] that on the letter that was sent to him, those people made the report after they came back but he had also gone to others that have not come to him. [redacted] asked if the same thing should happen to him. [redacted] replied it should adding that all of those that made the statement should stay out of the temple until someone from the headquarters had discussed it with them and cleared them. [redacted] stated he wished they could do it as soon as possible because it would mean that otherwise they might as well close up Grand Rapids. [redacted] stated he would try to do so in a week. He added that this came up last Saturday and he doesn't care if they have to close up the whole state. He said that they are going to keep these people out of the temple.

[redacted] stated that the other matter that was sent to the Minister was about charges against himself made by some of his people. [redacted] said that in cases like this he always sends the charges to the Minister and lets him do the investigation. [redacted] stated he could not understand it, adding that the people were "real sweet" to him last night.

July 23, 1964

[redacted] and ELIJAH MUHAMMAD were in contact with [redacted]

[redacted] ELIJAH stated he wanted to contact [redacted] adding that [redacted] had called him this morning for an appointment and since then he has found out more of what it was about and wants to talk to [redacted] ELIJAH continued: [redacted]

b7C [redacted] is supposed to have made some statement in New York about the insanity in your family, especially in your mother and in other members of the family. This was not directed towards [redacted] and [redacted] and he is very incensed that they are taking it up. You know [redacted] (MALCOLM X LITTLE) would have been slain outright if it had not been for me. You should know that if the followers go against you they are going against me. If [redacted] wants to go to the time and expense of coming here and of bringing other people just to hash it over and to chase all around about it, it was his lack of understanding, lack of sincerity, as well as his immaturity and his ignorance. If he is so tender and angry about this he is not with me. I could put them all out.

ELIJAH expressed the opinion that his sons have been very nice because they have continued to let him (MALCOLM) walk around alive. He continued: Allah is on his side and it should be apparent to them all. If you got to hold up [redacted] as a terror to your people, I will drop you because I have 22 million followers to pick from. I have been nice to you as I was not letting the sins of [redacted] condemn you. If you want to face [redacted] leave your post and face him, don't stay at one end and do so as he can see nothing wrong with what he did and he is my son, who is your leader.

██████████ agreed with everything ELIJAH said and tried to put in a few extra words himself.

ELIJAH continued: Allah told him in person that in the end he and Allah will have to close up things and do the teaching themselves. He could lose all his ministers and all his followers and wait 20 years and build it up again. Nothing in particular has been said and ██████████ is ignorant for trying to make something out of it. We will be persecuted until Allah comes. His son has shown no lack of respect for you or ██████████ and he will spill his blood for you if you will show your respect for me and stand up for me. He has often taken the stand and the position that he will defend the truth to the death. He must have those that are 100% with him but these things are child's play. If you can't take these things and a lot worse, much worse, as all his followers are asked to take, he should leave. You tell him this and also tell him if he wants to do so he can call me here.

July 23, 1964

██████████ was in contact with CLARA MUHAMMAD and stated the reason they closed the store (probably the temple number 2 store at 553 East 79th Street) is because they have no merchandise in it. She said they are not going to keep it open until they get merchandise. She said she does not want any more to do with it and doesn't want to have to do anything except her house. She continued: Part of the time ██████████ says it's theirs and they put their money and time into it and then he says it's his and the nation's and he did not intend to give it to them. She is going to let him run it then. At one time last year they put over \$5,000 worth of merchandise into it through the use of their own money and it made a profit last year of \$1,600. ██████████ stated she had heard from Detroit and she is having trouble keeping the sisters down. She said I am going to tell them "to heck with the sisters". "Let them go with the wind if they want to. That is what it is for, seeing it is a strong wind, because ██████████ says when the storm is over, the weak will be gone and most of them will be dead".

CLARA MUHAMMAD stated that MUHAMMAD was being told about contacts with the lawyer (believed to be [REDACTED] who will represent [REDACTED] in their paternity suits against ELIJAH MUHAMMAD in Los Angeles.) CLARA said that she made a mistake and said who she was when she talked to the lawyer. CLARA said the lawyer said things that meant they had better get in touch with her. [REDACTED] stated she knew all about it and added the lawyer said she wants either publicity or some money and they had better do as she says despite the fact the publicity has been blasted from coast to coast.

[REDACTED] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated the officer who was over to the house called him and said he told [REDACTED] everything ELIJAH had said there about the condition that you told him [REDACTED] would submit to all of this. [REDACTED] said the officer suggested [REDACTED] go over and talk to ELIJAH MUHAMMAD but he seemed to be afraid. b7C

[REDACTED] continued the officer asked him why he was afraid of [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did not have any answer for that. [REDACTED] said the officer related [REDACTED] stated he would like to talk to ELIJAH and seemed to be very sincere. [REDACTED] continued: [REDACTED] is supposed to call and ask if he could talk to you. He says the boy is scared because he knows he did wrong and wants to apologize.

ELIJAH stated that nobody should help [REDACTED] do so as nobody helped him to do what he did. He said that if [REDACTED] wants to get back they should let him crawl back on his knees and nobody should offer him a crutch to walk. ELIJAH stated [REDACTED] has a long story to be listened to and Allah will give him plenty of hell and he is catching it now and is getting scared.

ELIJAH stated he has talked to [redacted] and asked [redacted] what he told [redacted] and then bawled [redacted] out for making the decision without consulting him. [redacted] replied he did not know there were more than three people involved. ELIJAH stated [redacted] must take up everything with him before telling [redacted] and added [redacted] must not give orders without his permission as it all belongs to him. ELIJAH told [redacted] "Don't give any orders before consulting." [redacted] denied he gave orders to put a lot of people out or to be sent home. ELIJAH said that he is the only who can foresee what effect his actions today will have tomorrow. [redacted] says [redacted] was quoting him wrong.

[redacted] told ELIJAH MUHAMMAD they were doing well out there but added he needed some guidance. [redacted] stated he was [redacted]

July 23, 1964

[redacted] attempted to contact ELIJAH MUHAMMAD but was told ELIJAH MUHAMMAD was out.

July 24, 1964

A brother from Los Angeles, California, was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated that they have well over 100,000 Negroes in the Buffalo, New York, area. He added that in Newark we will have to put up new cards and asked how long they were to carry Newark or asked if it should be cut in half. MUHAMMAD told him to cut it in half adding the only one that would have to be cut down would be Los Angeles, which would be done later. ELIJAH said that is going to cut our expenses down to half. ELIJAH instructed the brother to tell [redacted] that what he wants will be coming next week.

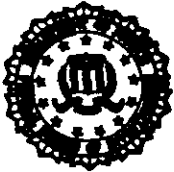

Source also furnished information indicating that ELIJAH MUHAMMAD on 8/17/64 made arrangements to have a personal interview with JOHN SENGSTACKE, the publisher of the "Chicago Daily Defender".

Chicago will follow developments in this regard and pertinent information will be furnished the Bureau in communication suitable for dissemination.

The "Chicago Daily Defender", a daily newspaper published on the south side of Chicago, Illinois, in its issue of August 17, 1964, carried headlines of "Muhammad's 2nd Son to Quit". On page two, an article appeared under a headline similar to the one above, which had a dateline of Cairo, U.A.R. (UPI). This article reflected as follows:

"Akbar Muhammad, a son of Black Muslim leader Elijah Muhammad, will break with the movement and denounce his father, informed sources here said.

"Akbar, who has been studying Islamic law at Alazhar University for the past three years, met dissident Black Muslim Malcolm X here last week, but the sources said he had already made up his mind to make the break before the meeting.

"A source close to the Black Nationalist movement said Akbar was making the move because his father allegedly failed to answer charges made against him by another son, Wallace, who left the Black Muslims last month.

"Wallace allegedly accused his father of immorality, religious deception and political sterility.

"The sources said Akbar sent messages to Elijah appealing for an explanation of the charges made by Wallace but received no answer.

"Because Elijah did not answer the charges, the sources said, Akbar was following Wallace in publicly announcing his separation from the Black Muslim Movement and denouncing his father's leadership.

"Two other sons of Elijah, Herbert and Junior, remain loyal to their father's leadership, the sources said.

"This latest split marks the third major 'crumbling brick' in the foundation of the Black Muslim empire.

"One-time New York Muslim leader Malcolm X broke from the sect to form his own Black nationalist group. He was later castigated from the pulpit by sect leader Elijah Muhammad.

"The second big split came when Muhammad's son, Wallace, 32, broke away from the religion, charging that his father and officers in the Nation of Islam were corrupt.

"Wallace is in the process of organizing a religion here which is presently composed of about 500 persons on a nation-wide scale. Approximately 50 here have left the senior Muhammad's Mosque to join forces with Wallace, sources said."

A confidential informant advised in March, 1964 that Elijah Muhammad, Jr. was the Assistant Supreme Captain of the Fruit of Islam at Muhammad's Temple of Islam #2, 5335 South Greenwood Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, the national headquarters of the Nation of Islam, and that Herbert Muhammad was the Public Relations Director of the Nation of Islam, both being national leaders in the Nation of Islam.

# MALCOLM X SEEKS U.N. NEGRO DEBATE

## He Asks African States to Cite U.S. Over Rights

WASHINGTON, Aug. 13

The State Department and the Justice Department have begun to take an interest in Malcolm X's campaign to convince African states to raise the question of persecution of American Negroes at the United Nations.

The Black Nationalist leader started his campaign July 17 in Cairo, where the 33 heads of independent African states held their second meeting since the Organization of African Unity was founded in Addis Ababa 14 months ago.

Before leaving for Cairo, Malcolm told friends in New York that it was his intention to add a new dimension to the civil rights struggle in the United States. This, he said, could be achieved by "internationalizing" the Negro question at the United Nations in the manner that South African apartheid was transferred into an international problem.

Malcolm's eight-page memorandum to the heads of state at the Cairo conference requesting their support became available here only recently. After studying it, officials said that if Malcolm succeeded in convincing just one African Government to bring up the charge at the United Nations, the United States Government would be faced with a touchy problem.

The United States officials here believe, would find itself in the same category as South Africa, Hungary and other countries whose domestic politics

have become debating issues at the United Nations. The issue, officials say, would be of service to critics of the United States, Communist and non-Communist, and contribute to the undermining of the position the United States has asserted, for itself as the leader of West in the advocacy of human rights.

In a letter from Cairo to a friend Malcolm wrote: "I have gotten several promises of support in bringing our plight before the U. N. this year."

According to one diplomatic report, Malcolm had not met with success, but the report was not documented and officials here today conceded the possibility that Malcolm might have succeeded.

Passages in Malcolm's memorandum indicated that he had encountered resistance to his idea.

"Some African leaders at this conference," he said in his memorandum, "have implied that they have enough problems here on the mother continent without adding the Afro-American problem."

"With all due respect to your esteemed positions, I must remind all of you that the good shepherd will leave 99 sheep at home to go to the aid of the one who is lost and has fallen into the hands of the imperialist wolf."

"We, in America, are your long lost brothers and sisters, and I am here to remind you that our problems are your problems." The memorandum continued:

"The American Government is either unable or unwilling to protect the lives and property of your 22 million African-American brothers and sisters. We stand defenseless, at the mercy of American racists who murder us at will for no reason other than we are black and of African descent."

"Our problems are your problems. We have lived for over

Asserting that the Negro

but of human rights, Malcolm

berg a few weeks ago, could  
find legal grounds to threaten  
to bring Russia before the Uni-  
ted Nations and charge her with  
violating the human rights of  
less than three million Russian  
Jews—what makes our African  
brothers hesitate to bring the  
United States Government be-  
fore the United Nations and  
charge her with violating the  
human rights of 22 million  
African-Americans?"

"We pray that our African  
brothers have not freed them-  
selves of European colonialism  
only to be overcome and held  
in check by American dollarism.  
Don't let American racism be  
'legalized' by American dollar-  
ism."

Malcolm argued that "if  
South African racism is not a  
domestic issue, then American  
racism also is not a domestic  
issue."

The Black Nationalist, who  
quit the Chicago-based Black  
Muslim movement led by Elijah  
Muhammad to form his non-  
sectarian Organization of Afri-  
American Unity, said it was the  
intention of his group in coal-  
ition with other Negro groups  
"to elevate our freedom strug-  
gle above the domestic level of  
civil rights."

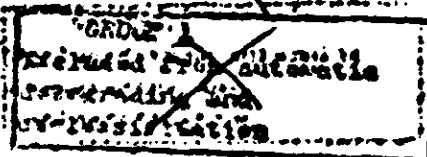

He continued that what [redacted] was trying to tell her was not to accept a subpoena to be a witness and what they want them to say is that they were not cared for. MUHAMMAD stated this was not true as they have been taken care of by the "poor treasury".

[redacted] stated she did not like that term either and ELIJAH replied that they all live on the poor treasury and all the ministers too. ELIJAH told her that the Holy Koran tells them they should not bear witness against another Muslim. He told her to call the other one and explain this to her.

July 7, 1964

[redacted] asked ELIJAH MUHAMMAD if [redacted] has spoken to him about going down about the taxes on the

property on July 8, 1964. MUHAMMAD said no but [redacted] and the [redacted] had done so and they have Lawyers [redacted] and the hearing was set for July 8, 1964, in Judge [redacted] court. MUHAMMAD stated they will ask consideration about the religious aspect and want to know whether to exempt them from taxes. [redacted] stated the taxes were from 1960 through the present. MUHAMMAD stated they have been trying to get them on this for many years but they know their work is nation-wide and JAMES knows his teachings and will know how to answer them.

July 8, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with CLARA MUHAMMAD and spoke of a call from [redacted]

b7c [redacted] she stated [redacted] wants to see her and [redacted] stated she was not going to talk to him unless [redacted] agrees to it. [redacted] stated she is afraid of [redacted] adding he is crazy and it might be another trick. She stated she is not going to see him and would not let him in the house.

July 9, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated she had heard they can get some advertising in Buffalo, New York. She continued the man told her this morning that they had talked very favorably about Chicago and they were changing the boss there over the transit line. She indicated they had been rejected in Chicago but they had changed the department head and the man feels they may get something in Chicago in the near future. [redacted] asked MUHAMMAD how he felt about Buffalo and MUHAMMAD stated he did not think they would do anything in Buffalo, adding there were a few Muslims who are very sincere but it was very expensive.

She stated they would take "this place" (Chicago) if they can get it. [redacted] said she had sent him a letter regarding Los Angeles and it was indicated they have not sent a check yet for the advertising in Los Angeles. MUHAMMAD said the check was on the road. [redacted] reported everything was doing well in Los Angeles, adding she was on her way to San Diego.

July 9, 1964

ELIJAH MUHAMMAD said there was a Muslim living in Tempe, Arizona, who had subscribed for the paper ("Muhammad Speaks") sometime ago but who had not been receiving it. He said this man used to teach for a number of years at the University [redacted]

MUHAMMAD described this person as a very nice fellow who was anxious to read everything they have.

July 10, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he was taking care of the situation out there very capably. MUHAMMAD stated truth would always outshine the lies and he added this is a trial for all his followers and a trial period for the whole world and this will be proof of whether or not God is with him. MUHAMMAD continued that if God was with him, then he will prevail and they will not get the upper hand. [redacted] agreed stating he was stopping this all over the United States. MUHAMMAD told him to go right ahead. "You and I believe in God and righteousness and we will win out as there will be no place else for those others to go but to hell".

MUHAMMAD stated he would be in Phoenix probably in a week or two and would want [redacted] to come in so they can go over these things.

July 10, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with [redacted] stating he was supposed

to report of an incident that happened there to [REDACTED] but he could not reach him. He said one of the believers was out the other night about midnight with two of the Muslim sisters and was seen by other Muslims who caught him, manhandled him, and brought him to Newark. [REDACTED] said this man was headed for New York. [REDACTED] told him to write him full details.

July 10, 1964

b7C [REDACTED] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD stating he would like an appointment with him about a large parcel of real estate in the city that involves about two and three quarters million dollars. He said three fourths of this could be financed by a savings and loan association. MUHAMMAD laughingly stated that would be too much money for them to handle. [REDACTED] said he would still like to talk to him about it, adding there were 238 furnished apartments and the land was worth \$5 a foot. MUHAMMAD suggested [REDACTED] see him when he gets back to Phoenix:

July 12, 1964

[REDACTED] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he had gotten together an article on the slander to "divine messages" and would have a copy on the Messenger's desk tomorrow and wondered if he could use it for sending to the newspapers. MUHAMMAD stated they would always welcome any article the Minister writes, and told him to go ahead and be sure and send them to [REDACTED] in Los Angeles.

ELIJAH stated that the [REDACTED] story is being written up by [REDACTED]. He stated they were just doing this to cause trouble and to cover up. He stated they have not been here for three years and do not even come here to visit and have been talking with MALCOLM (MALCOLM X LITTLE) for a year about this. ELIJAH continued that MALCOLM is just jumping from one thing to another as he is getting no where. They indicated that they heard MALCOLM had left the country and commented this was just a case of being exiled by Allah. ELIJAH stated the same thing had happened to his brother when he opposed ELIJAH and Allah exiled him and he was never heard of again over here. ELIJAH stated MALCOLM got one of his followers killed and another one shot three times. He stated they got what they deserved from the devil when he started carrying pistols and the Holy Koran tells them not to carry them.

The minister stated he had visited Washington and things were wonderful there and the people were "so enthused" with the love of the Messenger. The minister said he then visited in the prison where [REDACTED] was doing a wonderful job and he added there were 200 originals there and they were enthused and welcomed him in all the things they said and did. He added that they had really taken down the cross and put up the crescent.

7/12/64 [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] lives between Los Angeles and San Francisco and wanted to find out what the official position was on the scandle out there. [REDACTED] said it was part of their plans to embarrass the Messenger and they were doing anything they could to stop Islam from either within or without. [REDACTED] stated these girls were former girl friends of MALCOLM and they were using this means of causing trouble to the Messenger.

7/9/64

ELIJAH MUHAMMAD indicated he was still using his apartment (8205 South Vernon, Chicago, Illinois).

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he had been on pins and needles as to what the crowd would do yesterday (referring to ELIJAH MUHAMMAD's appearance in New York City), but feels very good today. MUHAMMAD stated the Koran tells that nothing will stop

[redacted] stated MALCOLM gave the club a new name, which was something like "Afro-American" MUHAMMAD stated he was dying a little at a time and that is what happens to them when they try to make a fool of the righteous. He stated he will end up making a fool of himself and will be out in the bread lines before long and his children will be too. MUHAMMAD instructed [redacted] to keep them out and added that as long as you find one push him out. MUHAMMAD stated that if [redacted] finds the whole temple is with him push them all out. He stated we will go get another one; we have a big nation here, 22 million; the people are with me.

June 30, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he was calling to thank him for a great and tremendously wonderful day Sunday. MUHAMMAD stated: "God has given the truth to him and more and more of it yet, which the whole world will soon recognize." "My followers are the most sincere of any of the others in the whole world. It was proved on Sunday, we are the only people of God." He heard that "big mouth" had his meeting Sunday saying he was going to change from religion to politics. Of course, that was only way open to him. He had maybe a 100 or 200 people there and a lot of them were the undependable hanger-ons. In a few days he will be forgotten as Allah is not with him. Soon, in a few days, he (MUHAMMAD) will have all of the 22 million of our people with me as this is a God directed thing and there is no other way out.

July 1, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and mentioned MALCOLM having said he would send guerillas down to Mississippi and MUHAMMAD said he would not do this. MUHAMMAD laughed at this statement saying he (MALCOLM) hasn't anyone to send down there. [redacted] then told MUHAMMAD of a brother from St. Louis who was in New York on Sunday and who had had water put in the gas tank of his car. [redacted] stated the brother assumes it was done by MALCOLM's

followers. [redacted] then spoke of a letter sent by a [redacted] which had some charges against [redacted] saying he was causing a breakup between her and her husband. MUHAMMAD instructed [redacted] not to pay any attention to this as she was not right and he should just put her out of the temple. [redacted] also mentioned a [redacted] wife having received the package sent her and he commented she is now back in the temple. [redacted] stated that they have about 20 that will be making the trip to Los Angeles (probably refers to a scheduled speech by MALCOLM in Los Angeles on August 9, 1964).

July 1, 1964

A Brother Minister was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he was calling because a television station wants to interview him, the brother. He stated that they want to go to the two restaurants, the grocery store and the mosque and want to ask if they have progressed or retrogressed as a result of MALCOLM's move. MUHAMMAD instructed the brother that he can tell them all these things, adding they have nothing secret; let them see, it will do no harm. MUHAMMAD stated he was going there to carry out our program "there" (Los Angeles) on the 9th. MUHAMMAD asked how the write-up was in the other fellow's paper and was told it was good. MUHAMMAD said that one of the papers said that "big mouth" was going to start a revolution against the whites. MUHAMMAD asked where would he get the ammunition and guns?, and stated "He's got nobody". The brother said the "New York Journal American" had written him (MALCOLM) off and had called him a General without an army. MUHAMMAD replied that he is no General, he is a fool. He stated that what he wants to do is get a lot of people killed. MUHAMMAD commented he ought to take a double barreled shotgun and put it against his own head.

July 3, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, stating he thought he would like to talk to MUHAMMAD as they had a very close relationship. [redacted]

stated he does not forget his friends and the Messenger has been nothing but good to him. MUHAMMAD stated they have had some very good relationships in the past but he had not heard from [REDACTED] in some time [REDACTED]

b7c [REDACTED] stated he was greatly honored to be part of ELIJAH's group of workers in the past and commented that if there was anything he could do for MUHAMMAD in the future he should let him know as he thinks MUHAMMAD is a great leader for his people. MUHAMMAD invited [REDACTED] to drop in at any time.

July 3, 1964

b7c A brother (believed to be from Newark, New Jersey) was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated he had just picked up [REDACTED] at the airport and he told him to call. MUHAMMAD thought it would be best if they could arrange somewhere where they have Ministers rotating as he thought "he" would take care of one of them nicely. The brother stated he could drop MUHAMMAD a letter naming the one he has picked up and commented "my Brooklyn has about three attendants". MUHAMMAD instructed the brother to pick out whatever he thought and let him know.

July 3, 1964

b7c A brother minister, believed to be [REDACTED] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, stating he was still enthused over the New York affair. The brother went on to say he had learned that while in New York they had a briefing session on Saturday and during this session it was reported to him by brothers from Muskegon, Grand Rapids and Flint, the brothers have been acting strangely towards him since he got back. He stated he found out that while brother [REDACTED] was briefing the fruit he had cussed out [REDACTED] whole family and had said his whole family was nothing but a bunch of crazy lunatics from his mother on-down. MUHAMMAD replied he was certain [REDACTED] did not say that, commenting that he

and all the rest were here on Monday giving [redacted] great credit for speaking out: [redacted]

[redacted] MUHAMMAD stated he didn't see how this could be, adding he thinks they must have misunderstood. [redacted] replied it was quite possible they did. MUHAMMAD stated he would get after this immediately but added he was almost certain [redacted] was not against [redacted]. MUHAMMAD stated he expected [redacted] soon and would have him write [redacted] and state his side of the story. [redacted] stated he would check further into this too, adding he wants to find out about it. MUHAMMAD stated that he thought it was possible some enemy was there, adding he has heard that [redacted] (MALCOLM) is doing everything possible to do these things and they involve his working against [redacted] who are not taking steps with him. MUHAMMAD stated he has two sons here who have gone over hypocrites, but not [redacted]. He stated it was the [redacted]

67C He stated both of them have turned hypocrites. He continued: "They don't even pay them any attention. They don't even speak to them. Don't have nothing to do with them. All this is written in the Holy Koran, mother against daughter, daughter against mother and father against son. This is the end for everything is "busting forth" and the book is being fulfilled and the next thing is the striking of the evil ones. You'll see all of these that fall out after a while will be struck with the chastisement of Allah." MUHAMMAD thanked [redacted] for reporting this before it went any further and commented that if it had been someone else he wouldn't have been surprised but just the other day [redacted] talked of how he admired [redacted] and how good he was.

July 5, 1964

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and asked if he had received his letter of last week. MUHAMMAD stated he had and had been trying to find time when he could come here. [redacted] stated this particular brother has a mental problem which goes way back to his youth and which was injured while in the service. [redacted] stated he

b7c has been put out but continues to come back and wondered what action they should take about him. MUHAMMAD instructed [redacted] to turn it over to the authorities and explain to them the problem, that they are afraid he will harm himself, etc.

July 5, 1964

b7c [redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and stated she had contacted those people and it seems that they want to discredit him. ELIJAH replied that's all they want to do and they are sweethearts of the evil enemy who has come out and lied; that he got with them to help frame a worse lie since he couldn't get anything to go on on the East coast. MUHAMMAD stated he had seen the paper himself and they are sending a press release to all the papers concerning it. [redacted] stated she had talked with her [redacted] and had let her know she had infuriated his followers to the extent their children and their lives were in danger and whatever she has to say she knows the white man is a devil and she would not let him use her. MUHAMMAD said she should have brought it to the temple. b7c [redacted] continued saying that she said she had gone to his home and couldn't get anyone to talk to her. [redacted] said she told her she could have talked to her as they know each other, but was told she would have to talk to her lawyer as it is completely out of her hands. ELIJAH stated they have nothing in the lawyer's hands, it is something they are trying to make in the lawyer's hands. ELIJAH continued: This big mouth hypocrite said on JERRY WALLACE's show in Boston 3 or 4 weeks ago that they had found a plan to pull him (ELIJAH MUHAMMAD) into court. ELIJAH b7c said he has a tape of it and [redacted] had asked if he thought he could do it (get him in court) and he said he thought they could. They are not seeking any aid, they are just trying to smear someone. In fact about it, "I'm clear and my conscience is clear and my heart is clear and Allah will take care of all of this." "Messengers of God in the past, all of them had hypocrites and all tried to do the worst and I am supposed to get the worst of all as God has told me and I have the worst job that any prophet has yet."

ELIJAH continued: "He", (MALCOLM) was here on Wednesday trying to get followers. He was also supposed to be on TV here but they dismissed him. [redacted] stated she thought she could get "her" to make a retraction. ELIJAH said, No, "he" has been visiting [redacted] for nearly a year and discussing things in hotels and whatnot. He said they have that on them but added he is not going to discuss temple affairs in public and he is not going to court for it. He said he is not taking no cases of the Muslims to court, adding he is not going down in history as making his followers available to an infidel court to be judged. He said he does not care what they say about him and will leave it go. As far as them saying they have not been taken care of, they lie. He said [redacted] has a five room "nation" apartment here and has been receiving cash from the "poor treasury" here and everything has been taken care of for those people better than they have ever lived in their lives. He said they should ask how they got out there (Los Angeles) and who has been taking care of their upkeep, who is paying their rent now. He said if they aren't being taken care of why didn't they appeal to some charitable institution.

[redacted] stated she knows the whole attempt is just to destroy MUHAMMAD's organization. MUHAMMAD stated they are afraid he will win the whole world like he did the East coast and want to try to do everything before the 9th, (August 9th, when ELIJAH is to speak in Los Angeles). MUHAMMAD claimed MALCOLM's followers called the restaurant at New York and said that if he came to New York they were going to get him. MUHAMMAD said this was reported to the police.

[redacted] mentioned that they infuriated his followers by making these charges and added their lives are nothing, worthless because they are playing with them and she let "her" know it. MUHAMMAD stated "I would not bother them myself. As the world knows I have not said anything, only just listened to them make their threats and I know one thing they have no proof of these things and I am not going to take them to court to try to prove they are against another enemy of mine. They are taken care of up to the first of this month by the "poor treasury" and the children will continue to be taken care of. MUHAMMAD laughed

off "these evil and lying charges that I am the father" and added, "They are the real enemies and the court could ask them where they have been getting the food and shelter they have had for the past few years, that is the only way they could get this to a lawyer, to claim non-support, and "We ain't got nothing to do with where they have got the children. We just don't want no disgrace to come to the temple and we tried to keep them in the temple and tried to take care of them since they held good jobs and also held other jobs here, but they wanted to befriend enemies of ours, but that is up to them, but they won't get nowhere".

MUHAMMAD claimed that MALCOLM is just dying to shame him because he can't take the leadership and now he has given up religion altogether and wants to take up politics and doesn't have any education farther than the eighth grade.

b7c MUHAMMAD told [redacted] to announce this to the temple but added the press release would explain it all. He stated that as he is the last messenger he will be washed down with all kinds of unwanted and absolutely unbelieving things against him. MUHAMMAD stated he (MALCOLM) must be beat and right after that the end comes. He stated this is the judgement day and they don't know it. He said they have no proof of these things and they have got to have proof. He added, "That one girl

b7c [redacted] stayed in Boston all the while and she don't even stay here." He said that he doesn't go to Boston and she don't make no trips here and she hasn't make a trip here but once in two years and then she stopped, he thinks, in the loop and he doesn't go down to see her. MUHAMMAD said she comes here one night and also come the next morning to see the one she is with now and probably that was their plan. MUHAMMAD said that the young one she has he knows nothing about who the father is and is not going to no court to argue about it either.

b7c [redacted] told MUHAMMAD the San Diego Mosque has 36 sisters now and a very good Muslim Girls Training class. She stated that the sister captain there, the one in her 60's, is doing a terrific job.
