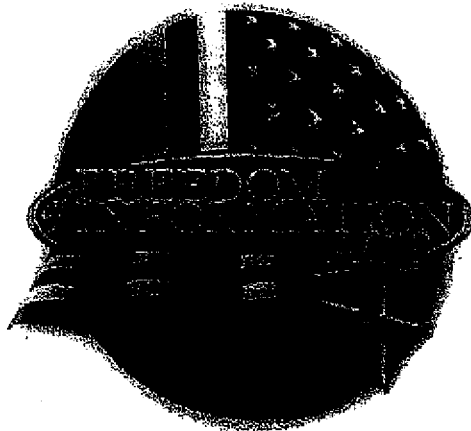

Pakistani Muslim Tells:

'Why, At Times, I Refused To Cooperate With Malcolm'

(The third of a four-part series to be concluded next week)

As I stated in my article in last week's issue of MUHAMMAD SPEAKS, I had reasons for refusing to cooperate with the late Malcolm X in such matters as appearing with him on his lectures at universities and on radio and television interviews. These were not necessarily identical in all instances. I shall, therefore, mention specific reasons for each specific occasion.

Let us take, first of all, the famed Mike Wallace TV program (produced several years ago) called "The Hate That Hate Produced . . ." I had refused to have anything to do with it because the idea of this program originated not with the producers but with an "ambitious" American Muslim (of West Indies background) known at the time to be avowedly hostile to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. It was he, according to my information, who had approached and, with the help of "mutual friends in the networks," persuaded Mr. Wallace to produce the telecast—whose original script, incidentally, was supposed to have included a lengthy "anti-Muhammad tirade" volunteered by the "rival Muslim leader."

The Messenger's adversary had hoped to gain, through the Wallace expose, "much public sympathy" for his own Islamic propagation movement. He had speculated, I believe, that even if the program failed to generate any support for his organization, it would "un-doubtedly cause irreparable damage to the mission of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad and hasten the doom of

this racist movement . . . " Thus, it is that while Brother Malcolm gave enthusiastic approval to the Wallace project and eagerly cooperated with the show's responsible staff, I, for one, remained totally disinterested—and doubtful that the telecast, as projected, would actually benefit the Muslims' cause: I was not prepared, therefore, to participate in a program which, in my considered judgment, was likely to do more harm than good to the "young and precious" Nation of Islam in America.

A SECOND SPECIFIC instance I recall was when Brother Malcolm invited me to come along with him to appear at a series of talks he was scheduled to deliver at several eastern university campuses. On this particular occasion, I simply asked the brother Minister to ". . . first secure for me the necessary approval of the Honorable Messenger." (This was, I confess, my own special way of ascertaining whether or not Brother Malcolm was actually keeping his leader and teacher, the Honorable Elijah Muhammad, fully informed of his various "non-ministerial" undertakings.) As far as I

know, Malcolm never made that call in my behalf . . . In fact, he never touched that subject again, though we met a number of times during the weeks that followed.

On another occasion, I remember, Malcolm X gave me a batch of newspapers—or rather, student publications issued by some of the schools he had visited as a guest speaker. Each of these contained a report on his "local" appearance and a few excerpts from his speech. Brother Malcolm asked me if I would consider preparing an article describing his "lecture tour" based on the write-ups in the said publications and send it ("on your own") to MUHAMMAD SPEAKS. Curious to examine those student newspapers at length, I accepted the assignment and told Brother Malcolm that I would try to oblige him.

As I began to work on his material a few days later, however, I couldn't help but notice that practically all the write-ups glorified "Mr. X" and mentioned little or (comparatively) nothing of the very source of his knowledge, eloquence and art of persuasion—the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. Realizing, thus, that my brother Minister's assignment constituted a severe imposition, I decided not to **SEARCHED** **REMARKED** with it.

appointment, at the Muslims' Shabazz Restaurant in Harlem—I found him in an unusually depressed mood. Never before had I seen him looking as dejected and worried as he did then. At first, he did not even wish to speak to me; he said he suffered from a headache, caused by sustained sleeplessness. Then, perhaps by a slip of tongue, suddenly he mentioned, almost in a whisper, that "... I've just had my ears chewed . . . We

haven't had any membership gains on the east coast in over a year. . . . " My tongue, too, somehow slipped and in one quick breath I pronounced, "Maybe you've been spending too much of your time 'fishing' in the wrong waters . . . " Malcolm X was silent for a good, long minute. Then, with a faint smile and his head gently clasped between his fists, he muttered, "No . . . No, it isn't that . . . " Seconds later, deciding all of a sudden to "go home," he got up from his seat and as he walked toward the door,

he motioned to me and, with a grin that was not free of symptoms of anger, told me to "forget about that article . . . and keep those papers if you want to. . . . "

THE POINTS OF FRICTION such as those described above did not, of course, lead to a termination of the mutual, fraternal relationship existing between Brother Malcolm X and myself. They did, nevertheless, develop into a "gulf of iced water" between us that somehow only widened as time went on. . . .

Malcolm's Doom Decried By God, Not The Messenger

The first time I realized that the late Brother Malcolm X and I stood literally worlds apart in our views on publicity and public relations endeavors in behalf of the Nation of Islam is when, in a conversation with me about two or three months before he was removed as Minister of Muhammad's Mosque No. 7 in New York City, he had called certain European (white) reporters and columnists his "good friends."

To assure myself that I had heard the "able and trusted follower of the Honorable Elijah Muhammad" right, I asked him to repeat "what you've just said..." I had heard him correctly all right—Minister Malcolm even explained to me how interested and understanding his good friends were.

NEEDLESS TO SAY, the "new Malcolm" deeply perplexed me. His latest perspective on many matters pertaining to the Nation of Islam represented a sharp departure from his old "established line." Moreover, it certainly did not reflect the respected Messenger's philosophy and wisdom—as Brother Malcolm himself had often expounded and interpreted it to me.

At the same time that Malcolm X had stopped seeing me "behind the deep blue eyes and coming right through the colorless skin" of his new-found "friends," I also noticed that many of his statements appearing in the various (white) newspapers no longer contained the customary references to the Honorable Elijah Muhammad. That is to say, instead of stating that "the Honorable Elijah Muhammad teaches us that..." or "the Honorable Messenger says such and such..." Malcolm X was now expressing himself in the first person (I say... I believe, etc.).

Honorable Elijah Muhammad and vehemently opposed every single aspect of his Islamic movement would simultaneously want to "build up" and enhance the stature of one particular individual out of the Messenger's many capable laborers. Brother Malcolm, of course, failed to perceive and heed my fraternal warning.

True, the Nation of Islam is no longer the fragile seedling of two decades ago; it has today (All praises are due to Allah!) well-established roots as well as the capacity to survive both the poisonous nature of its environment and the menace of evil hands constantly seeking to reach and tear at its limbs. The Muslims thus need not fear, shun or shy away from the curious and inquisitive reporters—white or non-white. But must we deliberately risk and put our strength to test — through extensive, incessant "exposures" — as Malcolm apparently favored. In my humble opinion, the Muslims possess a formidable weapon of defense in keeping their true, intrinsic capabilities a "matter that's none of the devil's business."

LET ANY OF the Honorable Elijah Muhammad's followers and my brothers and sisters in Islam misunderstand me. I reiterate that I'm not, in principle, opposed to cooperating with the various media of information in this country. However, I shall not deny that I am personally very much

against the type of cooperation that Malcolm X had been permitted to extend... especially to the white-controlled media elements.

To further elaborate my viewpoint, I would like to state unequivocally that the Honorable Elijah Muhammad alone possesses the right to speak "with the fullest authority" on the Nation of Islam. He alone can most adequately define its aspirations, its program and its objectives. He alone can advise his followers and offer them guidance in matters that affect them as a whole. He alone, therefore, has the invisible and legitimate right to express the Muslims' collective opinion on national and international issues, political, cultural or economic. Likewise, no one but the Honorable Elijah Muhammad should grant "official" interviews to journalists and writers seeking to learn more of his God-inspired work and accomplishments as well as personal philosophy and wisdom.

As pointed out in this series of articles, Malcolm X, by virtue of repeatedly ignoring and disrespecting the "rule" described immediately above, was guilty of exceeding the bounds prescribed for him as a Minister of one of Muhammad's Mosques of Islam. His dismissal from his post was thus inevitable as well as due and in order.

HOWEVER, I shudder at the thought of the "extreme punishment" decreed for him (and by the Honorable Elijah Muhammad as pronounced and prophecies alluded to by the Muslims' enemies too) by Allah (God) when the subordinate and increasingly defiant "Mr. X" further attempted to defile and defame his own former mentor and leader. Eternal silence and confinement to a cold and dark underground vault.

CONVINCED THAT THE (white) people of the news media obviously recognizing Malcolm's fondness for publicity as his major weakness — were determined to exploit it and thus "hurt" him, I tried (in my own particular way) to warn him of their evil designs. I remember telling him bluntly at one time that the (white) media were out to "use" him and that "they may try somehow to set you against the others in the Nation of Islam..."

I had arrived at this logical conclusion as I failed to see why or how those who bitterly criticized the Hon-

See Early Trial On Malcolm

Denying that the prosecution case against the killers of the late Malcolm X had collapsed, New York County District Attorney Frank S. Hogan told the Amsterdam News this week that he has ordered his staff to press the case for early trial this fall.

to reports that the case is collapsing, and as a matter of fact, it is either first or second on the calendar of the cases which we have instructed Assistant District Attorney Vincent Dermody to prosecute," Hogan declared.

Hogan's comments thus put an end to rumors which have been floating throughout the city that the three accused men, still in the city prison awaiting trial, may not face a trial.

Set Date

Hogan said it was not considered long for a six months delay in the case, noting that the date of the killing was six months ago, on Feb. 21, 1965. Another spokesman in the D.A.'s office said that Mr. Dermody is on vacation and would not return until after Labor Day when the case is due on the Supreme Court docket to have a definite trial date set.

The three suspects, Norman SX Butler, 28, of 661 Rosedale Ave., Bronx, Thomas 15X Johnson, 30, of 932 Bronx Park South, and Thomas Hagan, 22, of Paterson, N.J., have had a battery of six lawyers assigned to represent them in the first degree murder trial in the killing of the nationally — known black nationalist leader at the Audubon Ballroom.

Defense lawyers have indicated to newsmen that they believe two of the men accused in the killing have airtight stories of being at other places at the time of the killing, despite their arrests. At the W. 100th St., stationhouse, police said they were still investigating the case.

Malcolm X Trio Still Marking Time Waiting for Trial

Five months ago the three men accused of killing Malcolm X were arrested.

Today they are still in the Tombs waiting for a murder trial—a trial one defense lawyer believes may never take place.

The lawyer, who asked that his name be withheld, is one of six assigned by the court to represent the trio. He said he has learned that the prosecution case has collapsed, and added:

"Something is wrong with the DA's case or he would have moved before this to get

a trial date. I understand the chief prosecution witness has died."

The lawyer said the witness was a police informer.

Trouble Denied

A spokesman for Manhattan District Attorney Frank S. Hogan denied that the prosecution was having any trouble or that the trial was being purposely delayed.

"A six-month wait for a murder trial is not unusual and we expect that a trial date will be set in September," Hogan's aide said.

He also noted that two of the six defense lawyers had recently completed long trials and they would have been unprepared to proceed immediately.

Hogan has assigned Vincent Dermody, an assistant district attorney and one of the most highly regarded homicide prosecutors on his staff, to handle the case. Dermody, who will be on vacation until mid-September, was unavailable for comment.

Suspect Shot

Malcolm X, 39, the militant black nationalist leader, was shot to death Feb. 21 while he was addressing 400 followers in the Audubon Ballroom, W. 166th St. and Broadway.

One suspect, Thomas Hagan, alias Talmadge Hayer, 22, of Paterson, N. J., was shot and wounded by one of Malcolm's bodyguards and captured by police outside the ballroom.

On March 3, the police said they had solved the case with the arrest of two Muslim "enforcers," Norman 3X Butler, 28, of 661 Rosedale Ave., and Thomas 15X Johnson, 30, of 932 Bronx Park South, both of the Bronx.

Johnson and Butler were free on bail on a shooting charge when they were picked up.

Two defense lawyers indicated they would move soon to have the indictments dismissed if a trial date is not put on the criminal court calendar.

Charles Beavers, one of Johnson's two lawyers, said: "If the DA doesn't bring this case to trial in September then we will ask for a dismissal on the grounds Johnson is entitled to a speedy trial."

MALCOLM X

Of all the national Negro leaders in this country, the one who was known uniquely for his militancy, intransigence, and refusal to be the liberals' front-man has been shot down. This new political assassination is another indicator of the rising current of irrationality and individual terrorism which the decay of our society begets. Liberal reaction is predictable, and predictably disgusting. They are, of course, apposed to assassination, and some may even contribute to the fund for the education of Malcolm's children, but their mourning at the death of the head of world imperialism had a considerably greater ring of sincerity than their regret at the murder of a black militant who wouldn't play their game.

Black Muslims?

The official story is that Black Muslims killed Malcolm. But we should not hasten to accept this to date unproved hypothesis. The New York Police, for example, had good cause to be afraid of Malcolm, and with the vast resources of blackmail and coercion which are at their disposal, they also had ample opportunity, and of course would have little reason to fear exposure were they involved. At the same time, the Muslim theory cannot be discounted out of hand because the Muslims are not a political group, and in substituting religion for science, and color mysticism for rational analysis, they have a world view which could encompass the efficacy and morality of assassination. A man who has a direct pipeline to God can justify anything.

No Program

The main point, however, is not who killed Malcolm, but why could he be killed? In the literal sense, of course, any man can be killed, but why was Malcolm particularly vulnerable? The answer to this question makes of Malcolm's death tragedy of the sharpest kind, and in the literal Greek sense. Liberals and Elijah have tried to make Malcolm a victim of his own (non-existent) doctrines of violence. This is totally wrong and totally hypocritical. Malcolm was the most dynamic national leader to have appeared in America in the last decade. Compared with him the famous Kennedy personality was a flimsy cardboard creation of money, publicity, makeup, and the media. Malcolm had none of these, but a righteous cause and iron character forged by white America in the fire of discrimination, addition, prison, and incredible calumny. He had a difficult to define but almost tangible attribute called

charisma. When you heard Malcolm speak, even when you heard him say things that were wrong and confusing, you wanted to believe. Malcolm could move men deeply. He was the stuff of which mass leaders are made. Commencing his public life in the context of the apolitical, irrational religiosity and racial mysticism of the Muslim movement, his break toward politicalness and rationality was slow, painful, and terribly incomplete. It is useless to speculate on how far it would have gone had he lived. He had entered prison a burgler, an addict, and a victim. He emerged a Muslim and a free man forever. Elijah Muhammed and the Lost-Found Nation of Islam were thus inextricably bound up with his personal emancipation. In any event, at the time of his death he had not yet developed a clear, explicit, and rational social program. Nor had he led his followers in the kind of transitional struggle necessary to the creation of a successful mass movement. Lacking such a program, he could not develop cadres based on program. What cadre he had was based on Malcolm X instead. Hated and feared by the power structure, and the focus of the paranoid feelings of his former colleagues, his charisma made him dangerous, and his lack of developed program and cadre made him vulnerable. His death by violence had a high order of probability, as he himself clearly felt.

Heroic and Tragic Figure

The murder of Malcolm, and the disastrous consequences flowing from that murder for Malcolm's organization and black militancy in general, does not mean that the militant black movement can always be decapitated with a shotgun. True, there is an agonizing gap in black leadership today. On the one hand there are the respectable servants of the liberal establishment; men like James Farmer whose contemptible effort to blame Malcolm's murder on "Chinese Communists" will only hasten his eclipse as a leader, and on the other hand the ranks of the militants have yet to produce a man with the leadership potential of Malcolm. But such leadership will eventually be forthcoming. This is a statistical as well as a social certainty. This leadership, building on the experience of others such as ~~Malcolm~~, and emancipated from his religiosity, will build a movement in which the black masses and their allies can lead the third great American revolution. Then Malcolm X will be remembered by black and white alike as a heroic and tragic figure in a dark period of our common history.
