

## Malcolm X Calls For Negro Unity

Black Muslim leader Malcolm X was in Brooklyn Sunday, preaching unity among Negro civit rights leaders. He spoke before some 500 persons in front of Muhammad's Mosque 7, 130 Madison St.

Malcolm X drew cheers as be suggested that Negro leaders hold an internal caucus and settle any differences they may have. Thus united, they could beter fight their opponents.



And he pointed to one of the wiley tactics used by some white people in their attack on Negro leadership. This was to ask subtle questions that if answered, would tend to pit one Negro leader against the other.

Malcolm X refrained from any public criticisms of other Negro civil rights groups. But he warned they would be more easily entrapped and destroyed by opposing whites than the Black Muslim movement could be.

The afternoon rally was enlivened by African music from tape recordings. This was follawed by the music of a Carlo seel band. And then Malcolm

### BROOKLYN RALLY HELD BY MUSLIMS

Malcolm X Urges Ali Negro Groups to Settle Feuds

#### By MARTIN ABNOLD

More than 300 persons attended the first Black Muslim rally in Brooklyn yesterday and heard a leader in the movement preach unity among Negro civil rights groups.

Malcolm X, the leader, said that all the Negro groups "should retire to our homes, settle our issues and then come out and punch the same men."

Meanwhile, the Rev. William A. Jones, coordinator of the demonstrations against alleged job discrimination at the Downstate Medical Center site in Brooklyn, said yesterday that Negro Protestant churches might send 20,000 children to march on the site tomorrow.

More than 500 persons have been arrested for de.aonstrating at the hospital construction

"Perhaps the police will then want to charge the Protestant churches with contributing to the delinquency of minors," Mr. Jones said. He is pastor of the Bethany Baptist Church in the Bedford-Stuyvesant section of Brooklyn.

#### Pica to Governor

About 100 ministers at the church yesterday voted unanimously to wire Governor Rockefeller requesting a meeting on "the mounting origin around the construction program."

"There is an injustice to be corrected and the people want assurance that the inequities shall be righted or the construction sites closed down," the telegram said.

The Brooklyn crowd around the Muslim leader endorsed his sell for unity with shouts of "yes" and "right."

Malcolm X said that he would not criticise other civil rights seganizations such as the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People or the Congress of Racial Equality. But he predicted that the white man would "sust the heads" of the landers of those groups before "they'll bust my

#### African Muses reayed

"We're all going to ste," he said, "and the only thing is to die honorably, which you can only do if you take an enemy with you."

Once again, he was greeted with "yes" and "right" from the croked.

Yesterday's raily was sponsored by Mohammad's Mosque 7, in front of its beadquarters at 120 Madison Street, just off Bedford Avenue.

It started at 2 P.M. with tape recordings of native African music being played from a wooden platform that had been set up on the sidewalk jutting into the street.

At 2:30 P.M. the recordings were replaced by a six-piece steel band. Shortly after 3 P.M., Malcolm X started to speak.

Ten police officers, including two captains, were the most that were on duty at any one time. Considering that the area is mainly Negro, the rally did not draw a very large crowd.

Before the raily, Malcolm X said that the only reason that white persons joined Negro demonstrations was to keep the Negro from becoming violent over injustices practiced against him.

#### Doubts Gaining Rights

He said that there were no real differences between the civil rights groups involved in ending racial discrimination, but that he did not believe the white man would ever give the Negro equal rights in the United States.

"The Rev. Martin Luther King is an intelligent man," Malcolm X said. "When he sees his method [nonviolent action] won't work, he'll try something else."

Malcelm Mondered whether any Negroes had been planted in the audience for the purpose of sowing disunity.

And though the crowd seemed all in favor of his remarks (apparently no one had been planted), Malcolm X indicated that if such undercover Negroes were indeed in the crowd, "we'll take care of them."

In other civil rights demonstrations, sit-ins continued at Governor Rockefeller's office, 22 West 55th Street, and at Mayor Wagner's City Hall office.



The Nation of Islam (NOI), is described in the latter part of this memorandum.

On July 17, 1963, a source advised that Minister Malcolm X had been contacted by the "Civil Liberties Committee" (CLC) and that that committee had indicated that they would like to take care of some of the court cases involving Muslims, government positions and the failure to hire Muslims in United States Service.

This source further advised that Elijah Muhammad indicated on July 17, 1963, that he approved of the CLC taking the proposed action as stated by Minister Malcolm X.

The July 16, 1963, five star edition of "Chicago's American", page seven, column three, a Chicago, Illinois, daily newspaper, contained an item datelined Washington and captioned "Muslims Lose Federal Jobs Over Loyalty". This item in part stated as follows:

"About one dozen members of the Black Muslim sect have been dropped from government jobs the Washington Post said Tuesday.





## Brother, which side are you on?

HE AMERICAN Civil Liberties Union has pledged legal assistance to 42 Black
Muslims fired from government service on the grounds that they took their eaths
of office with mental reservations.

A Civil Service Commission official explained that the Muslims had been asked the hypothetical question: "Let's suppose a conflict develops in the future between the State of Islam and the United States. Whom would you defend?" The Muslims said they would support Islam, the official said.

Muslim leader Malcolm X wanted to know if members of White Citizens Comcils were also checked. A CSC spokesman said white members of racist groups were not being asked which side they would support in the event of another secession.

Malcolm X also asked about Jehovah's Witnesses who do not take the oath of alliegance. "Is this focilish question being asked of them?" he wanted to know. A Washington spokesman said Jehovah's Witnesses refuse to take up arms in any army but the Lord's, but say they will fight on His side in the Battle of Armageddon, the final conflict which they foresee between God and the Devil.

The CSC man said Jehovah's Witnesses were not being asked which side they would support if the United States should be aligned with Satan in the Battle of


"Mr. Muhammad teaches us that integration is only a trick on the part of the white man today to hill Negroes to sleep, to lull them into thinking that the white man is changing and actually trying to keep as here.

Elijah Muhammad teaches us that America has to pay today for the crime it committed in enalaving the so-called Negroes." As for the Rev. Martin Luther King:

"Any Negro who teaches other Negroes to turn the other cheek in the face of attack is disarming that Negro of his God-given right, of his natural right, of his intelligent right to defend himself. Everything in nature can defend itself, and is right in defending itself, except the American

And men like King then

job is to go among Negroes and teach Negroes, Don't fight back." He doesn't tell them, Don't fight each other.' Don't fight the white man' is what he's saying in essence, because the followers of Martin Luther King will cut each other from head to foot, but they will not do anything to defend themselves against the attack of the white man."

"Burned Our Home"

Malcolm X said his father was a Garveyite and a Baptist minister, and in 1925 "they burned our home" in Omaha and the family moved to Michigan, where the home was burned again.

"And he was, like I say, a clergyman, a Christian, and it was Christians who burned the home in both places — people who teach, you know religious tolerance and brotherhood and all of them ;... My father was killed by whites at a later date."

The father had continued his militant support of Marcus Garvey, the African Nationalist. He was found dead with his head bashed in. Malcolm X himself is a light coffee color, a shade he would not have chosen himself but which was produced, he says, when his mother's mother was raped by a white man.

On 6/5/63, the writer listened to a tape recording, made by the office, of the special television program "A Conversation with Malcolm", over New York City television channel 13, on Tuesday, 6/4/63, 10:30 to 11:00 p.m.

The interview was conducted by Doctor KENNETH CLARK, Psychology professor at City College of New York, and an authority on the psychological facts of racial segregation.

The 6/5/63 edition of the "New York Herald Tribune" contained an article relative to the program, and a letterhead memorandum was submitted to the Bureau on 6/5/63.

During the interview, subject discussed his background indicating that he had been born in 1925 in Omaha, Nebraska, and that his father was an outspoken Baptist minister and a Garveyite, and the Ku Klux Klan burned their home and forced them to move to Lansing, Michigan.

Subject claimed he completed the eighth grade in Michigan and that was as far as he went to school. He also claimed that while in Lansing, the Ku Klux Klan also gave his family problems and were responsible for the death of his father. He claimed to have then moved to Boston, Massachusetts, residing there and in New York City until he was arrested and jailed in Boston.

While in jail in 1947, he heard of ELIJAH MUHAMMED through his brother, was converted and became

a follower of the NOI.

In response to questions, subject blaimed Christian society for creating problems that send Negroes to jail, and that jails only breed more crime and do not reform anyone. He classified Christian society as "religious hypocracy". He further stated that the NOI does not actively recruit Negroes in prison but that these Negroes in prison have had experiences that enables them to recognize their racial pride in the teachings of ELIJAH MUHAMMED, and they rehabilitate themselves by joining the NOI. He went on to say that all blacks in the United States are in prison and the President is the warden, and they are unable to rehabilitate themselves or change their position without the help of ELIJAH MUHAMMED.

He critized liberals who pat Negroes on the back and talk intergration while they are thinking segregation, and he critized the Jews for being violent against Nazi organizations but upon joing Negro organizations encourage non-violence by the Negroes. He also critized the Jews for exploiting Negroes by controlling 90% of all the businesses in every Negro community. He critized Doctor MARTIN LUTHER KING for teaching a philosophy of "turn the other cheek" and declared that it was disarming the Negro of his moral and natural right to defend himself. He claimed that KING is supported and subsidized by whites and declared that the masses of black people did not support him.

He classified as a "sell out" the recent agreement negotiated by Doctor KING in Birmingham, Alabama during the racial crisis. In speaking of the teachings of ELIJAH MUHAMMED, he stated that "Mr. MUHAMMED teaches us to love each other", which MALCOLM claimed meant to "love our own kind". He went on to say that the NOI is for complete physical and moral separation from whites, and encourages their members to do things for themselves and feel that this complete separation will be brought about by God.

He claimed that ELIJAH MUHAMMED wants to stop vice among the Negroes to set an example for the children and considers intergration a white man's trick.

He quoted ELIJAH MUHAMMED as saying that "America will pay for the error of enslaving the Negroes". He further claimed that the NOI is against oppression and exploitation of the Negro.

When questioned as to the presence of American Nazi Party leader GEORGE LINCOLN ROCKWELL at an NOI convention, he claimed that ROCKWELL is no different from any other white man and that he and others were present and gave financial support on the open invitation of ELIJAH MUHAMMED.



The "Hartford Courant", a daily newspaper published at Hartford, Connecticut, in its issue of June 6, 1963, carried an article reflecting that Minister MALCOLN X. YOUNG, leader of the Black Muslims, espoused his movement's views of American racial conditions Wednesday evening, Sone 5, 1963, at the Bushnell Memorial Auditorium, at Hartfo d. He addressed an integrated audience of about 1200 persons for more than two hours, dealing with the teachings of Elijah Muhammad and Black Muslim practice. He condemned the Negro "Toms", "White liberals", Fresident Kennedy and the American "power structure". Le als. included the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People, the Congress of Racial Equality, the Urban League, Governor Dempsey of Connecticut, and Governors Barnett and Wallace of Mississippi and Alabama.

Malcolm X described American democracy as perhaps "hypocrisy" and claimed that the so-called Negro or the white people who encouraged anything but separation of the races were ignoring historical fact, devine intent and most often their own real desires. He referred to Washington, D.C., as "a black city at night", because the white populace "flees to the suburbs". He suggested that rather than try to follow the white man there, the

Negro should regain he: "black mind" and literally his own country. He added that "the black man in this country doesn't have a nationality and never will have".

Malcolm X proposed that the black populace accept the necessity of building its own viable, separate society. He call for a balanced black community materially as well as spiritually and the elimination of any subservience to the white man on the part of the black man. He stressed the impossibility of 'wooly haired sheep lying down with straight haired goats". He added that this was the Biblically suggested "harvest time" when the goats would be led to the slaughter. He portrayed Elijah Muhammad, the Plack Muslim prophet, as Allah's messenger to the black people. He declared that Elijah would "ctand the black man on his feet, put a bone in his back and make a new man of him."



# Muslims Seeking Divorce

# From Devil-White Man

#### Ey H. D. QUIGG United Press International

"As-salaam-alaikum" (peace be unto you) says the gifted speaker on the stand. And the faithful gathered below respond: "Wa-alaikum-salaam" (and unto you be peace).

"The message of God to the Flon. Elijah Muhammad was: "Complete and immediate separation of the slave master and his slave," the speaker tells them. No mixing. And a separate Negro state.

The God of whom he speaks is Aliah. The Elijah is a Georgian-born Negro, now in his mid-60s, who leads a membership of A merican Negroes that competent observers estimate at more than 100,000. They are law-abiding to the last letter, clean, debt-paying, non-s moking, non-quinking, non-narcotics, non-gambling and bitterly non-white-man.

"Messenger of Allah"

Elijah Muhammad, born Elijah Poole, has as one of his titles "messenger of Allah" to the "lost-found nation of Islam in North America." That last is the official name of the movement most often called Black Muslims. In their more than 80 temples the

white man is known as "the devil" or, as Malcolm X, Elijah's chief lieutenant, says the Holy Koran calls him, "the guilty blue-eyes."

They and their leaders consider themselves members of the great international religion Islam, whose followers are called Muslims (or Moslems), whose prophet was Muhammad (or Morammed) and whose holy book is the Quran (or Koran). The Black Muslims pray five times a day, facing Mecca, the holy city. (The Orthodox Muslims in America have rejected the Black Muslims.)

The Black Muslims keep down juvenile delinquency in their families by exemplary conduct at home and try to improve the community around them, clean it up as they do their persons.

#### Disavow Christianity

They abjure Christianity and make light of it. Although they scorn non-violence, they are told to be peaceful unless attacked. When the battle of Armageddon comes, in 1970 or 1972, it is rather vague (as is true of much about the Black Muslims) just what they'll do.



Malcolm X can get up in public mass meeting on the street and say things like: "We rejoice when the white man dies." Yet he testified in federal court in Buffalo that the Negro Muslims are not a hate organization: "Elijah Muhammad never taught us to hate anybody."

#### Chicago Headquarters

"And Elijah Muhammad was directly commissioned by Allah himself who appeared somewhat mysteriously in Detroit in midsummer of 1930 as a peddler of silks named W. D. Fard. He said he came from Mecca, to awaken the black nation and rid them of white rule. He disappeared mysteriously in 1934 after making Elijah the chief minister of Islam.

Elijah Muhammad moved

the headquarters to Chicago, where it still is, and under him the movement has become in recent years one of the fastest-growing racist sects—predominently young men. Informed conjecture right now is that the growth has leveled off, but the fringe movements—sympathizers who have their own groups and those who have "signed up mentally"—are growing.

Many lack the strict Black Muslim discipline.

"They have circling around them other groups that are autonomous but that the Muslims can rally," said one observer ."I can count right now 16 such nationalist organizations.

"The Muslims stay very much within the law. But they do use mass pressure. In one trial there were 182 seats in court and every day 182 strong men in dark suits and red ties came in and sat down. It's a smart way of operating; no whooping and hollering."

One source guesses Black Muslim membership in Chicago at 20,000, in New York at 15,000, and names Detroit, Los Angeles and St. Louis as other main centers, although perhaps 100 cities are involved.

Call Selves Nation

In his recent book 'The Negro Revolt," Negro author Louis E. Lomax says of the Black Muslims:

"Their withdrawal from America is almost complete. They speak of themselves as 'nation,' indicating that

they are not of the American body-politic; they do not vote nor do they participate in political affairs. The Muslim women keep their heads covered at all times; they wear the long, flowing, white skirts one associates with Islam. They have their own stores, supermarkets, barbershops, department stores and fish markets. . . .

"In essence, Muhammad is saying this: God and black are one, therefore all blacks are divine; the opposite or black is evil, therefore all white men are evil.

"Strangely enough Muhammad's demand for a "separate state' gets symbolic support from many non-Muslims.
... Many Negroes feel ... that white people will never really yield, that we will spend the remainder of our lives waging a major war over a morsel. This results in a strange kind of withdrawal from the American community..."

If Trouble Comes . . .

The Black Muslims are not aggressors. But neither are they pacifists. Malcolm X, the talented and studious

New York and Washington leader, once explained in an addices that they are taught: "Never be the aggressor. Never look for trouble. But if any man molests you, may Allah bless you!"

A traditional leading demand of the movement is that they be allowed to set up a separate state in the United States. A more recent one is that, as Malcolm X put it, "for 400 years of labor, sweat and blood" the black man be exempt from all taxation "as long as we are deprived from equal justice under the laws of the land."

C. Eric Lincoln, author of the first full study, "The Elack Muslims in America," points out that the movement has been associated with comparatively little violence but says: "Nevertheless, the Muslim image is such that an eventual eruption of violence is not unanticipated."
