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[redacted] reliable, made available the following information on 5/1/64:

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and told him they were not leaving until Tuesday or Wednesday (5/5-6/64). He said [redacted] wanted to talk to ELIJAH and ELIJAH said for [redacted] not to come to Phoenix. He said he could contact ELIJAH but it was not necessary. ELIJAH stated his place in Phoenix was for him and ELIJAH's family. [redacted] said [redacted] wanted to meet ELIJAH and he was in Chicago. ELIJAH said he would be in Chicago in about a week. [redacted] stated after they (he and [redacted] got through with the Muslim countries, he [redacted] was coming home. [redacted] mentioned an announcement on radio that day and they said something about MALCOLM over there and they got on Mm for breaking away. ELIJAH said [redacted] was over there and mentioned that he (MALCOLM) was doing that. ELIJAH said he (MALCOLM) is in a dangerous spot. ELIJAH stated he had a letter from [redacted] and mentioned he had some articles from Detroit Chronicle that was after MALCOLM spoke there. He said [redacted] sent them to him and he would send one to [redacted]. ELIJAH said they will learn that Allah is with ELIJAH. He hoped and prayed their [redacted] trip would be successful and he shouldn't be taken lightly on a trip like that. ELIJAH said they should go to the main places and cancel the others.

his wife they were all real happy over her.

ELIJAH MUHAMMAD was in contact with Secretary [REDACTED] and stated that he had talked to the editor [REDACTED] on May 1 who wanted ELIJAH to give him a name. ELIJAH told the editor that he would have to go through the same procedure as the rest. [REDACTED] told ELIJAH that they got Detroit and it would be at Cobo Hall, a new place in the Civic Center. He said it was for May 24. ELIJAH asked how much the hall cost and [REDACTED] said \$1600 and it would hold 12,000 people. ELIJAH said that was good. He told him that [REDACTED] could help them in Detroit. He also asked that [REDACTED] be told to send the Captain in Los Angeles the next payment for Boston and Washington and that it was due. ELIJAH said that he had taken care of Pittsburgh and Arkansas which was \$1,400. (Believed ELIJAH referring to the cost of advertising being conducted by [REDACTED] in Los Angeles.)

ELIJAH MUHAMMAD told his Secretary, [redacted], to make out a check for \$500.00 on Number Two (Temple in Chicago) and send it to [redacted]. He said he had dictated a letter to [redacted] and that he expected [redacted] to put out more work and spirit and that his writing should reflect his sincere support of the work MUHAMMAD is doing. ELIJAH mentioned in the letter that members of Number Two had charged [redacted] with dull writing and not being wholeheartedly with the Muslims. ELIJAH said he was afraid or ashamed that such an attitude would be of no help to the paper.

5/8/64

ELIJAH was in contact with an unknown man, and told the man to send the Times paper (believed referring to the New York Times) a note telling them to be careful in getting ELIJAH's followers mixed up with this. ELIJAH said he read in the paper here, and the headlines were wrong although explained in the body. ELIJAH told this unknown man to advise them that these people were not followers of his and to please tell them not to get them mixed up with MUHAMMAD's followers. (believed referring to publicity of instances in New York City allegedly involving Muslims).

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ELIJAH played a tape which had been forwarded to him by [redacted] of Mosque No. 25 (New Jersey area). [redacted] stated this was his weekly report and the date was 5/1/64. He said the spirit was good there in New York, and they were looking forward to ELIJAH's visit. He mentioned about a Minister's meeting that was supposed to have taken place and even No. 2 was called in regard to this. [redacted] said he had no reason for calling one and certainly would not have done so without ELIJAH's permission. He mentioned [redacted] of Boston was in New York and is there sometimes two or three times a week, but he never calls [redacted] when he comes in. [redacted] said [redacted] stops at the Hotel Americana and is in a room right next to [redacted] mentioned that they have many posters throughout the city advertising him [redacted] as ELIJAH's "West Coast" representative and [redacted] has not said anything as he was waiting to see if anyone would ask if it was a typographical error or not. [redacted] mentioned among the laborers in the New York Mosque that there had been some disturbance. He said he would like to mention that there is a smoke rising in the area over the killings of the "devils" in Harlem. He said the Police had been making some arrests, and the Police called him claiming it was tied to MALCOLM's group. [redacted] said he told them about the 32 years of ELIJAH's leadership, and in effect that ELIJAH's followers were not a part of it.

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[redacted] commented that [redacted] writes a good column in MUHAMMAD SPEAKS, but does not talk the same way, and also [redacted] is the same way. [redacted] mentioned that on Friday night [redacted] spoke and mentioned to [redacted] something about the trip being a success. [redacted] asked [redacted] what he meant, and [redacted] said the trip of MALCOLM. [redacted] said if [redacted] spoke like this to him [redacted] a Minister and follower of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, he wondered how [redacted] spoke to [redacted] said he had watched [redacted] and [redacted] does not make any converts. He said he used to watch MALCOLM teach on the streets, and [redacted] said [redacted] are waiting on the fence to see who is going to win. [redacted] said they were trying to do more work on the newspaper.

ELIJAH MUHAMMAD was in contact with [redacted] in Gary, Indiana, telephone [redacted]. ELIJAH mentioned that he would be in Chicago on 5/25. [redacted] stated he had a letter from MALCOLM of the Muslim Mosque, Inc. in which he wanted [redacted] to print a release. [redacted] said MALCOLM wanted to start advertising with him about the true Islam. [redacted] mentioned he had talked to [redacted] about this and told him that he would not do this as he was still with ELIJAH. ELIJAH told [redacted] that he did the right thing by not taking anything from MALCOLM. ELIJAH said MALCOLM is really trying to get the weak ones. [redacted] also mentioned he had a form letter from the Muslim Mosque, Inc. asking for a contribution of \$5.00 per week from the people across the country to help the Mosque get freedom, justice and equality for the Negro. ELIJAH said he would contact [redacted] whereupon [redacted] furnished his new office address and telephone number, namely, [redacted] Chicago, Illinois 60637, telephone [redacted].

Re Philadelphia airtel to Director, cc to Chicago, New York and Phoenix, dated 6/9/64, entitled, "MUSLIM MOSQUE, INC., IS - MMI".

Referenced airtel sets forth data to the effect that WALLACE MUHAMMAD was the individual who "really told" MALCOLM LITTLE as to what was going on in the Nation of Islam and as to the fact ELIJAH MUHAMMAD had fathered six illegitimate children; that WALLACE had told certain members of Muhammad's Mosque No. 12, in Philadelphia, that they should join up with MALCOLM.

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Set forth hereinafter is data made available on the dates indicated by [REDACTED] who has furnished reliable information, to the effect that WALLACE MUHAMMAD may be having trouble, particularly with his brother, ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, JR.

6/10/64

LORRAINE (MUHAMMAD, the wife of WALLACE MUHAMMAD) told CLARA MUHAMMAD she was worried about WALLACE as he had not come home yet. LORRAINE stated she was ready to call the police because WALLACE had been threatened by JUNIOR and by members of the temple and they had called WALLACE a hypocrite. CLARA (WALLACE MUHAMMAD's mother) replied she did not believe all the things that are being said and she told LORRAINE not to go too far as she might get caught in the net herself. CLARA stated that LORRAINE should not go to the police as she has to have proof as to what she says. LORRAINE replied she would get the proof and added she could not go on living like this because she is afraid everyday that someone is going to jump WALLACE. LORRAINE stated that all WALLACE is trying to do is to go to school and better himself. CLARA told LORRAINE to just go ahead and let the people talk and to trust in ALLAH as he will take care of everything.

6/11/64

CLARA MUHAMMAD told ETHEL (SHARRIEFF, WALLACE MUHAMMAD's sister) that she had talked to LORRAINE and it had upset her. ETHEL stated that she was sorry LORRAINE had told CLARA that stuff. CLARA stated that HASSAN (SHARRIEFF, the son of ETHEL SHARRIEFF and nephew of WALLACE MUHAMMAD) had also told her some of that junk too.

It was indicated that HASSAN has also told his mother that whoever he talks to makes him more confused about everything. ETHEL stated that she just did not understand JUNIOR. Both agreed there was nothing they could do about it and both commented they will just have to trust in ALLAH.

6/12/64.

LOTTIE (MUHAMMAD, WALLACE MUHAMMAD's sister) was in contact with her mother, CLARA MUHAMMAD. It was indicated that RAYMOND SHARRIEFF and JUNIOR had gone out yesterday to see the messenger and had come back the same day. CLARA instructed LOTTIE not to look into all this trouble that is going on around her and also out in Phoenix as it is bad, and the only thing they can do is to leave it all up to ALLAH. LOTTIE spoke of the publicity that has been on television and radio lately, commenting that they are saying so much about his being threatened (probably MALCOLM receiving threats on his life. LOTTIE commented that "if we don't stop clowning, I am going to be ashamed of being a Muslim).

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The above information furnished by [REDACTED] is not being put in a form suitable for dissemination. The information is not complete and tends only to indicate that WALLACE MUHAMMAD is involved in family trouble, particularly with his brother, ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, JR.

Confidential sources available to the Chicago Office in its efforts to cover activities at Muhammad Mosque No. 2, have been alerted for any information that may develop regarding activities of WALLACE MUHAMMAD and HASSAN SHARRIEFF, as well as others mentioned above. Pertinent data developed will be closely followed and the Bureau and interested offices advised in appropriate communication.

The Phoenix Office is requested to alert its sources close to ELIJAH MUHAMMAD in this regard. Phoenix should bear in mind that RAYMOND and ETHEL SHARRIEFF recently moved from MUHAMMAD's residence in Chicago. At present, coverage in Chicago is not nearly as complete as it was when SHARRIEFF and MUHAMMAD were available. Chicago is following this matter closely and at present the place where SHARRIEFF is conducting his business has not been determined. Indications at present are that MUHAMMAD plans to return to Chicago in the near future and may stay for the rest of the summer. As soon as this situation resolves itself an analysis of it will be made and appropriate recommendations for further coverage will be made to the Bureau.

# 8 Guards, 32 Police for Malcolm X

Malcolm X was taking no chances yesterday, and neither were police.

The former East Coast leader of the Black Muslims, professing fear that they were quite capable of assassinating him, showed up in Queens Civil Court, Kew Gardens, for an eviction trial with eight private guards, and was greeted by 28 uniformed policemen and 12 detectives.

The police and the guards were there because of anonymous telephone tips to the wire services and a newspaper that he would be shot if he appeared in court. The police took up strategic positions in the street, in the corridors and in the courtroom itself. Nothing happened.

After the trial, Malcolm X

said he was quite sure the threats came from the anti-white cult of which he was the No. 3 man until last December. He added:

"There is no people in the United States more able to carry out this threat than the Black Muslims. I know. I taught them myself."

Asked why he thought they had threatened him, he said it was because of a television interview in Boston last Friday in which he attacked Elijah Muhammad, leader of the Chicago-based movement.

"Muhammad was nobody until I came to New York as his emissary," Malcolm X said. "If they had left me alone, I would not have revealed any of this."

Malcolm X was suspended by Mr. Muhammad last December because of a speech in

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which he said he assassinated or President Kennedy was a case of "the chickens coming home to roost." He later resigned from the cult and started his own Muslim movement. He now rejects separation of the races as a goal for the Negro because of what he described as a "spiritual rebirth" on a recent trip to Mecca.

The Negro leader, whose full name on legal documents is listed as Malcolm X Little, was in court yesterday as defendant in a suit filed by the Muhammad Temple, also called the New York Temple of Islam, Inc., of which he formerly was minister.

The temple wants him evicted from a two-and-a-half-story brick and frame dwelling at 23-11 97th St., East Elmhurst, Queens, which was given over to him to be used as a parsonage while he

represented the Black Muslims. The temple maintains that since he no longer represents it, he is not entitled to live there with his wife and three children.

His attorney maintained that he was never properly informed that his services were actually terminated and that the only notice he ever got was an eviction notice. Judge Maurice Wahl reserved decision until today.

After the trial Malcolm X said, "If they want me to move, I will move out at once." He added that the Muslims "should not take internal differences into a white man's court."

After the trial, he and his guards were escorted to a private garage by police and formed a five-car caravan to Harlem, where he has an office in the Hotel Theresa at 125th St. and Seventh Ave.

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### Another Month For Malcolm X

Malcolm X gets to live in his house at 23-11 97th St., East Elmhurst, Queens, for another month.

Judge Maurice Wahl ruled in Queens Civil Court, Kew Gardens, yesterday that he could continue living there pending submission of legal briefs in the eviction proceedings brought against him by the Mohammad Temple of Islam.

Malcolm, militant Negro nationalist, was leader of the temple until he was suspended for remarks he made about the assassination of President Kennedy.

The temple maintains that, since he is no longer its leader, he should leave the leader's house.

Enclosed for the Bureau are eight copies of a letterhead memorandum (LHM) concerning a visit to the Chicago Office by seven NOI members on 6/11/64, claiming that they had been threatened with bodily harm and possibly death by leaders at Muhammad's Temple of Islam (MTI) #2. Three copies of the LHM are enclosed for New York and one copy for Philadelphia for information purposes.

The interviewing Agents in enclosed LHM were SA [redacted] and SA [redacted] was provided with pertinent information in enclosed letterhead memorandum by SA [redacted]. He advised he would alert all patrols in the area where the individuals resided. b7C

It is noted for information purposes that ARTHUR 10X did not from outward appearances seem to be beaten up very badly. He had a patch over one ear only.

The Bureau's interest in the NOI was explained to the visitors and they stated that they understood the situation completely.

It is noted that during April and May of 1964, [redacted] provided some indication of possible dissatisfaction regarding some of the NOI members referred to in LHM. However, the information was ambiguous and nothing specific was mentioned. b2 b7D

The Bureau is also advised that the visiting NOI members have no informant potential as they all affirmed completely their devotion to the Messenger and that their only concern was personal gripes with the specific individuals referred to in enclosed LHM.

The Bureau will be appropriately advised of any subsequent developments of pertinence in this matter.

The Nation of Islam (NOI), the Fruit of Islam (FOI), and the Muslim Girls Training (MGT), which have not been designated pursuant to Executive Order 10450, are described in the latter pages of this communication.

On June 11, 1964, seven (7) self-described members of the NOI at Muhammad's Temple of Islam (MTI) #2, Chicago, Illinois, appeared at the Chicago FBI Office and were interviewed by Special Agents of the FBI at their request. None of these individuals were officials in the NOI.

Wade X, 4847 South Michigan Avenue, stated that he was the official spokesman for the group and that their sole purpose in contacting the FBI was protection from members and officials of the NOI who have threatened them with bodily harm and possibly death. Wade stated that he had formerly been employed at the NOI Restaurant at 616 East 71st Street, and that he had complained personally to Elijah Muhammad that members of the NOI were being exploited by such officials as Captain Raymond Sharrieff of the FOI; Assistant Captain Elijah Muhammad, Jr., of the FOI; National Secretary John Ali; Ethel Sharrieff, Captain of the MGT; and Minister James Anderson of MTI #2. Wade X stated that he was not complaining about such lesser officials such as lieutenants and investigators, adding that they are merely subordinates of the above officials and took their orders directly from them. He emphasized that as spokesman of the group, they all admired Elijah Muhammad very much and did not hold him responsible for the conditions as set forth above. He said that the main grievance was the pressure put on members for selling the official NOI paper "Muhammad Speaks", greed on the part of the above officials, and their expensive living coupled with their "superior attitude".

He again added that they had been threatened with bodily harm and possibly death by the above officials with the exception of Elijah Muhammad, at one time or another.

Wade stated that they are loyal Muslims and although inactive at the present, they still considered themselves followers of Elijah Muhammad, his principles, and teachings, and that they have not been expelled from the NOI.

Wade stated that the group being interviewed is in no way connected with Malcolm X personally or with his organization, Muslim Mosque, Incorporated (MMI). He stated that he and those present know of no MMI Temple or organization in Chicago or the Chicago area.

The March 13, 1964, edition of the "New York Times," a daily newspaper published in New York, New York, contained an item on page 20, which reflected that Malcolm X, the former head of the Nation of Islam (NOI) Mosque in New York, had broken with the NOI and Elijah Muhammad on March 8, 1964, and that on March 12, 1964, had announced he would form his own mosque in New York and it would be a meeting place for his Muslim followers as well as the base of a political oriented Black Nationalist Movement.

On March 16, 1964, Mr. Samuel Drucker, Supervisor, Business Section, Clerk of Court, New York County, New York, advised that on March 16, 1964, incorporated papers were filed for Muslim Mosque, Incorporated; that Malcolm Little was one of the trustees of the corporation; and that the principal place of worship was to be in the Borough of Manhattan, New York County, New York.

The following Muslims were present during the interview and gave their "X" names but refused to give their "slave" names. They furnished their home addresses for identification purposes:

Wade X advised that all of the above addresses were in Chicago, Illinois.

Arthur 10X claimed he had been beaten up on June 10, 1964, near his residence, by Lieutenant Joseph 15X Smith and Lieutenant Albert 8X Thompson, when he returned from his work at the Ford Motor Company, 12800 Torrence Avenue, at 2:00 A.M. in the morning. He stated that he had filed a complaint and warrant for the arrest of Smith and Thompson with the Chicago Police Department (CPD) on June 11, 1964, and that when the complaint was served he would authorize prosecution for assault and battery.

Samuel 3X stated he was scheduled to be "beaten up" or possibly killed by Saturday, June 13, 1964, by John 21X, Luchrie X, and Lieutenant Albert 8X. He stated he was unable to furnish the basis for such assumption.

Wade X stated that the attackers all wear women's hosiery over their faces in an attempt to conceal their identity. He added that all members who attacked would be attacked in return, and that serious problems could develop. He said that Captain Raymond Sharrieff had given the direct orders to attack the above individuals. Wade X advised that they had discussed this matter with the CPD and with the Chicago newspapers. On June 11, 1964,

Wade X also advised that the same problem as mentioned above had occurred recently in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and that the following Philadelphia brothers were involved:

Wade X and the visiting group were advised that the Bureau could not provide protection for individuals in such matters as he referred to and that their only remedy would appear to be with the CPD which they had already contacted.

On June 12, 1964 [redacted]

[redacted] Boston, Massachusetts, advised that, approximately 1:40 PM on that date, the radio dispatcher of that Police Department had received an anonymous phone call concerning Malcolm X. The caller stated that he was calling concerning Malcolm X and that "he is going to be bumped off."

[redacted] advised that police from his department had been sent to guard Malcolm X, who was appearing on a radio program on Station WEEI, 182 Tremont Street, Boston, Massachusetts. This program would be on the air from 2:10 PM until 5 PM. Subsequent to that, Malcolm X would be at his sister's residence, Mrs. Ella Collins, 486 Massachusetts Avenue, Boston, Massachusetts, from 5 PM until 10 PM. At 10 PM, Malcolm X would appear on the Jerry Williams' show, Radio Station WMEX, Boston. [redacted] stated that the Boston Police would furnish Malcolm X with a police guard during the entire period.

Malcolm X's appearance on the Paul Benzaquin's program, "Conversation Piece", on Radio Station WEEI, Boston, Massachusetts, was monitored by an FBI Agent.

The program commenced at 2:10 PM and continued until 5 PM, with breaks at intervals for news broadcasts and advertisements.

Paul Benzaquin opened the program by announcing that a threat had been made on Malcolm X's life if he appeared on "Conversation Piece" that afternoon. Mr. Benzaquin then went on to tell Malcolm X that he understood that the reason for Malcolm's severing relationship with the Muslims and Elijah Muhammad was not the reason stated publicly by Elijah Muhammad; namely, that Malcolm's remarks concerning the late President Kennedy were not authorized by Elijah Muhammad. Mr. Benzaquin stated that he wondered if Malcolm would like to comment on the real reason. Malcolm stated that it was true that there was another reason, which pertained to a moral issue and which was something that he could no longer put up with and, consequently, severed relationship with Elijah Muhammad. However, Malcolm stated

that this reason was secret and he intended to keep it secret. Malcolm stated that the secret reason had been told to him by Wallace Muhammad, son of Elijah Muhammad, and Wallace was put out of the Muslims for telling this secret to Malcolm.

A group of Muslims from Philadelphia recently went to Chicago to question Wallace Muhammad concerning a rumor they had heard of this secret and Wallace Muhammad admitted to them that the rumor was true.

Malcolm X stated that, when the group returned from Philadelphia, they had told other members of the Philadelphia Temple about the secret and a tremendous fight had ensued between Muslims who could not accept the truth about the secret and the Muslims who could accept it. As a result of the fight, some Muslims were hospitalized and some were arrested.

Mr. Benzaquin turned the conversation to the recent cloture vote in the United States Senate concerning the pending Civil Rights Bill. Malcolm refused to admit that he believed any progress has been made in the civil rights field or the economic field of the Negro, or that he could foresee any progress. He stated he believes education of the Negro is the key to the whole program for betterment of the Negro and that the primary factor in the Negro's inability to advance is the Negro's lack of a cultural bond to hold the Negro together. He stated that, since his trip to Mecca, he no longer believes that the black man should seek to return to his African homeland, unless an individual expressly desires to do so. He feels that the Negro should stay in the United States and strive to unite and better himself economically.

At this stage in the program, telephone calls were accepted from listeners who wished to question Malcolm X. One of these callers identified himself as William 4X from Miami. He told Malcolm that Malcolm knew who he was and Malcolm replied in the affirmative. William 4X then stated

he would like to ask Malcolm if he still considered Elijah Muhammad as the Messenger of Allah. Malcolm replied that he no longer considers Elijah Muhammad as the Messenger of Allah. While he was in the Muslim world at Mecca and Jeda, he spoke to various Muslim officials over there who were very critical of the Black Muslims under Elijah Muhammad and their religious philosophies. However, something had come to his knowledge before he left the United States, told him by Mr. Muhammad's son Wallace, who was the former Minister of the Philadelphia Temple, which had already brought him to that conclusion.

William 4X then stated that his reason for asking Malcolm was because he, William 4X, had been accused of following Malcolm. Malcolm stated that he had represented Elijah Muhammad as long as he could but, when the situation became such that he could no longer represent Elijah Muhammad because of morality problems, he ceased to be Elijah's representative.

William 4X then stated he would like to see Malcolm personally sometime, as he has more questions to ask. Malcolm stated he would answer that question now. He then went on to state that in 1956 a teen-age sister of the Muslims left Detroit and went to Chicago to become Elijah Muhammad's secretary. A year later she became pregnant and was publicly humiliated in the temple, according to Muslim rules, for having been sexually intimate with someone to whom she was not married.

In 1957 another teen-age secretary who had gone to Chicago to work for Elijah Muhammad became pregnant. In both of these cases, the Muslims assumed that the male who had been the other part in the sexual affair had been a non-Muslim because of the fact that both the secretaries appeared in the temple to stand charges alone.

By 1959 the Nation of Islam had grown so rapidly that Elijah Muhammad had eight secretaries working for him. Six of these disappeared in 1959. Two of them re-appeared in Philadelphia and were apparently all right. In 1950, four of them re-appeared in Chicago and all had children.

It was taken for granted by Muslims that, in each case, a non-Muslim male was involved, since no other persons besides the girls were ever brought forth in the temple to stand charges.

Malcolm stated he knew nothing about this until Wallace Muhammad told him in February, 1963. Malcolm went to Elijah Muhammad and asked him if this were true. Elijah Muhammad admitted the truth of this and gave Malcolm a religious explanation, which Malcolm accepted.

In October, 1963, Wallace Muhammad told him that these matters were still going on and were getting worse. Malcolm then told Minister Louis of the Boston Temple and learned that Minister Louis already knew about it.

Malcolm stated that he realized that he could never again represent Elijah Muhammad, knowing that one of the most high officials in the Muslim movement was the father of the children of six secretaries.

William X then asked whether or not, in the movement that Malcolm X now leads, strict moral laws are still enforced. Malcolm stated that, in the religion of Islam, each member learns of the moral code and, after, it is explained to them, each member is left to follow his own behavior.

Mr. Benzaquin then asked whether Elijah Muhammad actually had a complete knowledge of this morality problem. Malcolm stated that Elijah Muhammad did have a complete knowledge and that two of the secretaries were from Boston, one of whom has one child; and the other, two children, and is currently having a third child by this same man.

After an interruption in the program for a news broadcast, Mr. Benzaquin stated that, from the remarks made by Malcolm X, he could only conclude that the person mentioned as being guilty of sexual involvement with the secretaries must be Elijah Muhammad himself. Malcolm answered

that, when he heard it himself, he found it rather hard to believe. He stated that Wallace Muhammad had told him and had been put out of the temple for telling Malcolm. No explanation has ever been given for Wallace's expulsion from the temple, but the explanation publicly given for Malcolm's dismissal was some remarks he made concerning the late President Kennedy's death. Malcolm stated that he went to Elijah Muhammad and questioned him concerning the sexual escapades and Elijah Muhammad admitted the truth of it. Malcolm then asked Elijah Muhammad for permission to tell other Ministers in the temples about the truth, so that they would be prepared to help individual members of their temple when the truth came out, as Malcolm believed it must. Elijah Muhammad gave Malcolm permission to do this, and Malcolm told the Minister of the New York Temple and Minister Louis of the Boston Temple. Captain Joseph of the New York Temple told temple members that Malcolm should be put out of the way for saying such things. Malcolm stated that this is one of the reasons he is making the facts public and that John Ali, National Secretary of the Nation of Islam, admitted on a radio program in Chicago last week that the Muslims were trying to kill Malcolm X.

Mr. Benzaquin asked, now that this news would probably make a vacuum of the leadership of the Muslims, if Malcolm X would be willing to assume leadership. Malcolm stated he was not trying to create a vacuum of leadership. Mr. Benzaquin asked if he would be willing to work with Wallace Muhammad to take over the leadership. Malcolm stated that neither Wallace nor himself was interested in taking over the Muslims. He stated the reason he waited this long to make the news public was that he wanted to protect Elijah Muhammad's image and to allow his followers to see him as they always saw him. Now the Muslims throughout the country are divided and are carrying guns, trying to kill each other. Malcolm X claimed that Elijah Muhammad has given orders to his followers to go out and fight the Muslims who broke away.

Malcolm X appeared on the Jerry Williams Radio Program, WMEK, Boston, Massachusetts, from 10 PM, June 12, 1964 to 1 AM, June 13, 1964. JERRY WILLIAMS introduced Malcolm X as the former spokesman for Elijah Muhammad and the Muslims. He stated he understood several threats had been made on Malcolm's life that day and Malcolm stated that several threats had been made on his life during the last five months. In answer to Williams' question as to why these threats were made, Malcolm stated it was because of the split-up in the Muslims. He stated this split locally in Boston was a large split but that the largest had occurred in Chicago, where more Muslims had left the temple than in any other city. This is because Chicago is Muslim Headquarters and more members are aware of some of the things which took place in Chicago than members in other cities. Malcolm pointed out that during the last Nation of Islam Convention in February, 1964, all Muslims attending were asked to spend only one day in Chicago, instead of the usual three to four days. This was done in the fear that, if members spent three to four days in Chicago, they would learn about some of the things which took place there.

Malcolm stated that he had never made an effort to recruit followers of Elijah Muhammad but had sought only non-Muslims to come to the aid of Black Nationalism.

Malcolm stated that recently on a radio program in Chicago, known as "Hot Line", John Ali, National Secretary of the Muslims had been asked by a telephone caller if it was true that the Muslim movement was trying to kill Malcolm X. John Ali replied that they were trying to kill Malcolm X and that he should be killed. Malcolm stated that no Muslim makes a move without Elijah Muhammad saying so and that charging Elijah Muhammad with sexual promiscuity was one of the best ways a person can lose his life in this country. Malcolm stated that this refers to fellow Muslims and not outsiders. He stated he did not open his mouth since his dismissal from the Muslims but feels free now only because of the poison being spread through the Muslims. As long as he believed that the Muslims stood for moral reformation,

he was able to represent Elijah Muhammad. When this basis was shattered, he could no longer represent him.

Malcolm then explained that Muslims guilty of sexual promiscuity are humiliated in the temple and are suspended for periods according to the seriousness of the offense. In 1955 a young girl named Rosella from Detroit became a secretary of Elijah Muhammad and a year later became pregnant. She was humiliated and insulted in the temple and suspended. In 1956 a young girl named Lavita from Lansing, Michigan, became a secretary to Elijah Muhammad and a year later became pregnant. She was also humiliated and suspended from the temple. By 1958 Elijah Muhammad's secretarial staff had grown to eight girls, two of whom came from Boston and were well known. In 1959, six of these secretaries disappeared. Two of them, who were blood sisters, re-appeared in Philadelphia as non-Muslims. In 1960, four of these girls re-appeared in Chicago, all of them with children. One of them came from Boston; and one from the Cape Cod area of Massachusetts. The one from Cape Cod is presently having her third child and is living in California under an assumed name. All of these girls got together and found that the same man was the father of their children and that this was Elijah Muhammad. They found that Elijah Muhammad had told each of them the same story; namely, that he was Divine and was Muhammad, the Prophet, and that each individual girl was Muhammad's wife, Aisha (phonetic).

Malcolm X stated that in 1962 two of these girls rebelled and went about Chicago telling about Elijah Muhammad, and even went to court. In 1963 Wallace Muhammad, Elijah Muhammad's son, who is very religious, was told the truth by one of the girls, named Ola. She told him that three of the girls were living in Chicago and Wallace questioned them himself. Wallace told Malcolm X, who wrote to Elijah Muhammad and was asked to go to Phoenix, Arizona, where Muhammad would explain the reason to him. In Phoenix, Elijah Muhammad admitted that he was the father of these children and stated that he was all of the Prophets together, including Muhammad, David and Noah, and that what he had done was right. Malcolm

stated that he believed in Elijah Muhammad and accepted what was told him. Later, Wallace Muhammad told him that things were bad and had not changed.

In February, 1963, Malcolm suggested to Muhammad that he tell some of the Ministers the truth to inoculate them, so that, if temple members came to them with questions, they could help those members. Muhammad agreed to this but told him not to tell Minister Louis of Boston. Malcolm told Louis and found that Minister Louis already knew. He told Minister Isaiah of Baltimore and Minister Honny of Washington and the Minister of the New York Temple. The Minister of the New York Temple told the temple members that what Malcolm had said was only rumor and the Captain of the New York Temple suggested to members that Malcolm had done such wrongs to Elijah Muhammad, that he ought to be killed. Malcolm stated that orders within the Nation of Islam are given as suggestions rather than commands, and they are given to members who it is known will understand these suggestions are orders. However, the brother to whom this was told warned Malcolm and the suggestion that Malcolm should be killed brought about a split in the New York Temple.

Malcolm stated that Minister Louis of Boston had known about the truth because the Sister Secretary from Boston, who had had two children by Elijah Muhammad, fell in love with a Robert 5X. In explaining where her children came from, she told him that Elijah Muhammad was their father. Robert 5X reported this to Captain Clarence of Temple 11, who reported it to Minister Louis. Malcolm stated that Elijah Muhammad is sixty-four years old and has had at least one child by four of his secretaries and two children by two others and one of these is pregnant by him for the third time. Malcolm stated that one of these girls, in fear for her life, recently made a recorded confession and sent it to her brother in Boston. Another girl, who is also from Boston, recently made the truth known to her sister in Boston and she has changed her name and is living in California.

On June 14, 1964, a confidential source, who has  
furnished reliable information in the past, furnished information  
that on that date MMI founder and leader Malcolm X Little had  
been contacted by an unknown person in Boston, Massachusetts.  
This person had informed Little that he and nine others  
had been arrested at the airport in Boston, were being charged  
with a misdemeanor and were being held at District 7, East  
Boston Jail.

This unknown person had informed Little that while  
they were en route to the Boston Airport, two car loads of  
NOI members forced them to stop in a tunnel causing a traffic  
jam. However, they drove them off with a shotgun. This  
unknown person advised that they had been arrested because  
they had guns with them but they were not loaded. The  
NOI members were not arrested but were being sought by the police.

According to this source, Little had instructed this  
person to tell reporters on the scene that this was an attempt  
by the NOI on Little's life. When the press inquired as to  
why the NOI would make an attempt on Little's life, the press

# Malcolm X Death Threat Brings Heavy Court Guard

An anonymous threat to assassinate black nationalist leader Malcolm X brought more than a dozen police today to Queens Civil Court in Kew Gardens, where Malcolm was battling an attempt to evict him from his East Elmhurst home.

Malcolm attributed the threat to followers of his former leader, Elijah Muhammed, head of the Chicago-based Black Muslim movement.

Malcolm, who was reportedly suspended from his high Black Muslim post by Elijah for remarks he made following the assassination of President Kennedy, split with the Black

Muslims in March to form his own organization, the New York Temple of Islam Mosque.

Today, Malcolm said Elijah had suspended him not for his remarks but because he knew of certain wanton misconduct on the part of the Black Muslim leader.

The action to evict Malcolm, 39, from his home at 23-11 97th St. was brought by the Mohammed Temple of Islam, maintaining the residence was given to him for the duration of his services as their minister, a post he no longer holds. Malcolm maintains the house was an outright gift.

Characterization of the Muslim Mosque, Incorporated (MMI), Nation of Islam (NOI) and NOI Mosque #7, New York City are attached hereto and all sources therein have furnished reliable information in the past.

A confidential source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised on June 14, 1964, that from 8:30 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. that date, the MMI held a public rally in the Audubon Ballroom, Broadway and 166th Street, New York City. There were approximately 375 to 400 persons in attendance, and the featured speaker was MMI founder and leader Malcolm X Little.

Little's topic was "Police Brutality" and he characterized Harlem as a police state being run by New York City Police Commissioner Michael Murphy. Little also spoke of his recently completed tour of Africa and repeated his idea that Negro leaders in America should take their civil rights grievances to the United Nations.

Little also explained to the audience that the real reason he split with the NOI was the result of a conspiracy against him by NOI officials. Little stated that he had learned that from 1956 to 1962, NOI leader Elijah Muhammad fathered six or seven illegitimate children, the mothers being six "teenage sisters" who were working for Muhammad as secretaries. Little claimed he was shocked by this information, and when he questioned Muhammad regarding it, the latter admitted it claiming that Allah had told him to do it. Little stated he recently learned that Muhammad was continuing these indiscretions, and in order to resolve the matter in some way, he told the whole story to the following NOI officials: Captain Joseph Gravitt and Secretary Maceo Owens of Mosque Number 7, New York City, and Ministers Lewis of Boston, Isaiiah of Baltimore and Lennie Cross of Washington, D.C. Instead of helping him, these officials reported him to Muhammad and they then successfully conspired to oust him from the NOI.

In his speech, Little also announced that one of his members, Benjamin ZK Goodman, had gone to Boston, Massachusetts, on June 14, 1964, to make a speech at 2:00 p.m. After the speech, while brothers from Boston were taking Goodman to the airport, they were accosted by Boston NOI members but drove the latter off by displaying a rifle. Upon arrival at the Boston airport, Goodman and the Boston brothers were arrested and put in jail.

- The confidential source advised that during the above meeting, Little was guarded by eight men each carrying a rifle. These armed riflemen escorted Little in and out of the building, and stood in front of the speaker's stand during his speech. No incidents occurred and source did not know if the rifles were loaded.

# Malcolm X — Tells 1,200 of Africa Trip

Malcom X made his first public appearance here last night since his five-week visit to Africa.

The dissident Muslim leader praised whites he met in Mecca. "The difference in those whites and the American white is monumental," he told an audience of 1,200 at the Audubon Ballroom, 166th St. and Broadway.

"When the white Muslim says 'I'm white,' he is only giving a description of himself — the color is incidental. But when the American white says 'I'm white,' he means, 'I'm boss.'"

"If he [the white man] changes his attitude, I'll shake his hand, if he doesn't change his attitude, we'll shake his head," Malcolm X told the cheering audience in the Audubon Ballroom.

Malcolm spoke favorably of the Chinese Communists and Fidel Castro, and said the only head of state to offer its support to the American Negro at the March on Washington last August was Mao Tse-tung.

Speaking of the citizen's patrol in Brooklyn's Crown Heights section, he said:

"If whites can 'Maccabees,' we can 'Maccabees,' too. If whites can vigilante, we can vigilante, too."

"We'll be invisible. They won't know who's doing it, they won't see it, they'll just feel it."

The crowd roared. After two calls for donations to his cause, Malcolm X, flanked by bodyguards, hurried out into the rain. A turquoise late-model car pulled up to the curb, and took Malcolm off into the night.

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# Malcolm vs. Elijah: Muslim Showdown

By WILLIAM McCULLAN

The cauldron of Harlem racism was kept bubbling yesterday by an imminent showdown between Elijah Muhammad and Malcolm X.

Both denied there is any rivalry between them, but all Harlem knows differently.

Scores of Negroes have been defecting from the New York ranks of Muhammad, leader of the Nationwide Black Muslim Serp, and joining Malcolm X Muhammad's former chief lieutenant who broke away to lead his own, more violent anti-white group.

Scores of Negroes have been defecting from Muhammad's New York area ranks to join Malcolm X.

Even police are waiting to see what happens on Sunday, June 28, when Muhammad, advocate of non-violence, returns to Harlem for the first time in three years to address a huge Black Muslim rally.

On the same day Malcolm X, whose membership in the more extreme group is increasing, will address supporters who have followed him into the rival Moslem Mosques, Inc.

Many of Muhammad's former supporters, particularly those trained in judo and karate, who once formed his elite guard called "Fruit of Islam," have followed Malcolm X who quit the Black Muslims last March.

In one of his rare interviews, Muhammad told the N. Y. Journal-American by telephone yesterday that he had decided to come to New York in "an effort to bring peace" to Harlem.

Speaking from his home in Phoenix Ariz., the 65-year-old Negro patriarch swept Malcolm X aside with this comment:

"Defectors from our organization are dead. They do not concern us."

At the same time he admitted he was concerned about the potentially-explosive anti-white atmosphere being encouraged in Harlem by those who contend that a Negro social revolution can succeed only with violent action.

## NEED A SOLUTION

Carefully avoiding the mention of any names, the self-styled Messenger of Allah declared:

"The situation in Harlem is very bad, very dangerous. The people are demanding a solution to the situation between white and black. They must have a peaceful solution. We do not want it solved by violence."

"I am not saying I am an angel or a god to change the minds of the people in Harlem, but I think by speaking to them I might bring about more understanding and peace."

Muhammad was asked to comment specifically on what effect the defection of Malcolm X has on the whole Black Muslim movement.

"I have nothing to do with those who deviate from me," he said. "Defections have had no effect on us at all. Our meetings are now bigger and better than ever."

"I am returning to Harlem to give our message again to the people. I am not trying to do anything else but carry out the mission given to me by God."

Muhammad, who last spoke in New York on Aug. 27, 1961, will have his rally at 3 p. m. June 28 in the 369th Infantry Armory, 142d st. and 8th ave.

Although the Armory holds only 15,000 persons, advance publicity claims 500,000 people will try to attend.

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# Black Muslims Seek Eviction Of Malcolm X

The plaintiffs were the Black Muslims, the defendant was Malcolm X, and the scene today was Queens Civil Court, Jamaica, where the Temple of Islam Mosque was trying to evict Malcolm X from his home.

"I should be brought before a Muslim Court," Malcolm X said of the notice which would evict him out of 22-11 97th st., Jamaica.

"They are deviating from our religious principles in bringing me in here."

The Black Muslim organization, which owns the house in question, feels that Malcolm X deviated when he broke with the Elijah Muhammad group to form his own organization, and therefore no longer is entitled to the home.

The case was set off until June 15, but Malcolm X used the opportunity to bring reporters up to date on his views.

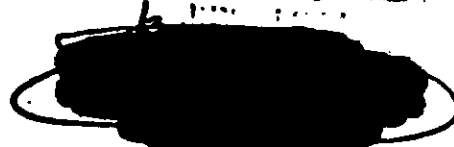
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
