ORGANIZATION OF AFRO-AMERICAN UNITY INTERNAL SECURITY - MISCELLANEOUS

On June 28, 1964, a source, who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that Malcolm X. Little, leader of Muslim Mosque, Inc. and the Organization of Afro-American Unity, was attempting to organize a branch of the Organization of Afro-American Unity in Boston, Massachusetts. According to this source, Ella Collins, sister of Malcolm X. Little, was leading the effort to establish a branch of this organization in Boston. The source stated that Ella Collins indicated that she had picked Brothers John, Aubrey, Harry, Charles, Willie, Cedric and Richard to be in the organization.

A characterization of Muslim Mosque, Inc. is contained in the appendix hereto.

On August 4, 1964, another source, who has furnished reliable information in the past, advised that there is still no group in Boston under the name Muslim Mosque, Inc. The source feels that this organization is no longer being pushed by Malcdm X. Little, instead Malcolm Little is trying to form the Organization of Afro-American Unity.

This source stated that Malcolm Little has been successful in a small way, and that Harry Thompson, former member of Muhammad's Temple of Islam No. 11 in Boston, Massachusetts, is the leading figure in the Boston area in trying to organize this new group.

A characterization of Muhammad's Temple of Islam No. 11 is contained in the appendix hereto.

The source stated that this group consists of only a handfull so far and that these are all waiting to see what type
of program Malcolm Little will set up before committing themselves to follow his program. If it is a positive one towards
improving the financial, social and educational status of
the Negro and is a reasonable and sensible program without
involving violence, then the source believes that the current
members will stay with the organization and that many other
persons will join it.

ORGANIZATION OF AFRO-AMERICAN UNITY

According to the source, Malcolm Little, so far, has talked in general terms of setting up a school for Negroes and organizing the Negroes to advance their economic standards by patronizing Negroes and setting up Negroes in business. Little is borrowing many phases of the Muslim program but has done nothing as yet to implement the program.

The source identified the Brothers mentioned by the previous source as being John Thimas, Aubrey Barnette, Harry Thompson, Charles James, Willie James, and Richard Varing. These are all members of the Organization of Afro-American Unity in Boston. The source stated that he knows of no Brother Celric and believes that instead of Cedric, this is Frederic Entzminger, who is a member of this group.

The source stated that female members of the group are Ruth Barnette, wife of Aubrey Barnette, and sisters Bertha and Vicki, both of whom are known to the source only by their given names. The source stated that the only other member of the group that he knows of is Ella Collins, sister of Malcolm Little. He stated he believes that her interest in the organization is due to the fact that her brother is organizing it. She formerly was a member of the Muslim temple in Boston but in the source's opinion was not a real member, but again was only interested in the Muslims because of her brother, Malcolm Little, who was active in it.

The source stated that this group meets at 539 Columbus Avenue, Boston, Massachusetts, a building owned by Ella Collins and which she utilizes as a kindergarten school. No regular meetings have been scheduled as yet and meetings held have been infrequent.

The source stated that he knows intimately all the persons identified above as belonging to the group and is positive the group has no potential for violence. The source feels violence is the one thing that would cause the group to dissolve.

The source stated that the court action brought against the men who were arrested by the Massachusetts State Police at Logan International Airport, East Boston, Massachusetts, on June 14, 1964, for possession of firearms, has been deferred until August 26, 1964.

On March 18, 1954, a source stated that the Nation of Islam (NOI) had become active in Boston, Massachusetts, and knew that it had held meetings as early as November, 1953.

On May 11, 1964, a second source stated that the Temple of Islam in Boston, Massachusetts, is known as Muhammad's Temple of Islam No. 11 or Muhammad's Mosque No. 11. It is located at 35 Intervale Street, Dorchester (Boston), Massachusetts, and is the local branch of Muhammad's Temple of Islam whose headquarters are in Chicago, Illinois.



Malcolm X and the Red Chinese

CAIRO—Malcolm X, whom the Chinese Communists call the "chairman of the Afro-American unity organization," spent a considerable amount of his time in the presence of international Communist propagandists here.

Not only did he endorse the rioting back home, but he publicly called for retaliation against the white community. He said the time had come to meet "violence with violence; an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth."

He prepared a series of inflammatory anti-U.S. documents here on the pretext of presenting them to the recent meeting of the Organization of African Unity, and it was reported across the world that he attended the conference. This is nonsense. He did not get near the parley. He was not accredited to it

Malcolm X was not at any of the conference sessions. I was informed that it "is ridiculous" and "undignified" to think for a moment that anyone such as Malcolm X would be heard by the African counterpart of the Organization of American States.

Malcolm X's activity here was strictly a propaganda operation which he set up at the Hotel Semiramis, where some newsmen gathered. He made certain that his violent anti-U.S. distribes were put in the hands of the Chinese Communist correspondents planted here by the New China News Agency.

But when Malcolm X wanted to be with his pro-Communist friends he came over to the Hotel Omar Khayam, a former palace. I vouch for this personally. I was there when he met Mrs. Shirley Graham DuBois, widow of the late Dr. W. E. DuBois, in the lobby. When the aged Dr. DuBois died recently, he was a member of the Communist Party, U.S.A., and had switched his citizenship to Ghana.

The Hotel Omar Khayam was also the headquarters of the violently anti-U.S., pro-Communist Ghanaian delegation to the African States' conference. On Thursday, July 16 Malcolm X and his frequent companion, Mrs. DuBois, met for hours in the garden restaurant of the hotel.

Mrs. DuBois and her late husband spent much time in Peking. They were frequent guests of Mao Tee-tung. Dr. DuBois delivered many anti-U.S. speeches which were broadcast across the world by the powerful Chinese mainland radio.

Mrs. Dubois has long been active in world Communist circles. Her background is important here to show the strange inter-weaving of characters now attempting to infilitrate and agitate the Negro communities of the U.S.

Mrs. DuBois knew the Castro brothers, Fidel and Raoul. in Mexico as far back as the late '40s. She now is afformated with the pro-Communist "Freedomways," a publication allegedly devoted to the Negroes.

In the past few years she has been a prolific writer in defense of the pro-Communist dictatorial state of Ghana.

Intelligence agents of several countries now are easer to learn just how Black Nationalist leader Malcolm X made contact with such Communist activists as Mrs. DuBois. Of considerable interest is the source of Malcolm X's funds now that the Muslims under Elijah Muhammed have declared war on him.

Malcolm X has been making expensive and extensive trips across Africa. I ran into his trail in several cities—especially in Ibadan, Nigeria, where he delivered speeches on anti-U.S., so incendiary, that they could be printed only on asbestos.

It is also being noticed that the Chinese Communist broadcasts have been featuring him and his splinter sect.

The March 13, 1964 edition of "The New York Times", a daily newspaper published in New York, New York, contained an article on page 20 which indicated that Malcolm X (Little), former national official of the Nation of Islam (NOI) and Minister of NOI Mosque #7, New York, who broke with the NOI on March 8, 1964, publicly announced in New York City on March 12, 1964, that he had formed the Muslim Mosque, Incorporated (MMI). The MMI, according to the article, would be a broadly based politically oriented black nationalist movement for Negroes only, financed by voluntary contributions. In this public statement Malcolm X urged Negroes to abandon the doctrine of non-violence when it is necessary to defend themselves in the civil rights struggle, and he also suggested that Negroes form rifle clubs to protect their lives and property in times of emergencies in areas where the government is unable or unwilling to protect them. (The NOI is described in the appendix section of this memorandum.) Incorporation papers of the MMI filed on March 16, 1964, with the Business Section, Clerk of Courts, Mew York County, New York, New York, reflect that the -MMI was incorporated under the Religious Corporation Law of the State of New York to work for the imparting of the Islamic Faith and Islamic Religion in accordance with "accepted Islamic principals." The principal place of worship to be located in the Borough of Manhattan, New York, New York.

During an appearance over KYW - Television, Cleveland, Ohio, on April 7, 1964, Malcolm X stated that the MMI does not stand for integration, but for complete freedom,

justice, and equality for Negroes. He stated that Islam was the religious philosophy of the MMI, while the political, economic and social philosophy was black nationalism.

On May 15, 1964, a confidential source advised that the headquarters of the MMI are located in Suite 128, Hotel Theresa, 2090 Seventh Avenue, New York City, where they were established on March 16, 1964.

The July 4th edition of the "Chicago Courier", a weekly Chicago newspaper, page 2, column 1, contained an item captioned "Malcolm X Declares War On Bigots. Orders Guerrilla Tactics In Mississippi". This item, in substance, stated that Malcolm X, described as a militant Black Muslim who broke with the main body of the Black Muslim organization, made a caustic statement in Omaha this week suggesting that Negroes fight fire with fire in Mississippi and engage in guerrilla tactics against the bigots who seek to murder Negroes who demand their freedom from the yoke of Southern segregationists. Malcolm X stated that "guerrilla tactics are the only way of letting the underdog equalize the situation." He suggested the sending of the militant Muslim organization to Mississippi to fight the Southern way of battle.

Matcolm X: Don't Count Goldwater Out

London, July 25 (Reuters)— An interview with U. S. Negroleader Malcolm X was one of the highlights of British television this week.

Appearing on Independent Television, Malcolm said he thought Republican Presidential nominee Barry Goldwater "stands a better chance than a whole lot of people think." He said whites in the U. S. were militantly against Negro pressure for civil rights.

Malcolm denied he was an advocate of violence. He said that out of necessity the Negro in America had reacher the point of having to form self-defense units against Southern racist organizations like the Ku-Houx Man and the White Chilzena Council.

But he admitted his policy amounted to guerrilla warfare.

"If the oppressed people in Asia, Africa and elsewhere have to resort to guerrilla warfare to protect themselves, or to gain their freedom, I think it is only a matter of intelligence to expect 22,000,000 black people in America eventually to develop the same strategy and the samet actics," he said.

Asked whether his "Black Nationalism" theories meant separate Negro state in the U.S. Malcom said no. He said, "With us it (Black Nationalism) only means that we should control the politics and the politicians in the community where we live."


He added that the economic philosophy of Black Nationalism meant that "we should control the businesses and create employment opportunities for ourselves."

Asked if he thought world heavyweight champion Cassius Clay, now known as Mohammed Ali, was a sincere follower, Malcolm said he thought the boxer was sincere.

"Whether he has understanding to equal his sincerity is another thing," he said. CLIPPING FROM THE

In Search Of Armagedon

WASHINGTON—The recent Cairo adventures of Malcolm X are one answer to the thesis that extremism in the defense of liberty is no vice.

This angriest of U.S. Negroes journeyed to. Cairo for the African summit conference. He wanted the assembled leaders to adopt a resolution of condemnation against the United States.

His account in Cairo of the racial evils in the United States was vivid. "We were taken forcibly in chains from this mother continent and have now spent over 300 years in America, suffering the most inhuman forms of physical and psychological tortures imaginable," he said.

"All of these inhuman atrocities have been in flicted upon us by American governmental authorities. We stand defenseless at the mercy of American racists, who murder us at will for no reason other than that we are black and of African descent." This was strong talk, well calculated to arouse African sensitivities.

But the lobbying by Malcolm X for a condemnation of his native land failed, reportedly as a consequence of intervention by President Gamal Abdel Nasser of the U.A.R. Although friendly with Malcolm X, Nasser praised the United States for the passage of the Civil Rights Act in his address to the conference,

THIS WAS only the latest chapter of a crusade by Malcolm X to stir African antagonisms. In a tour of West Africa last spring be uttered similar diatribes.

It must be remembered that Malcolm X is essentially an extremist pursuing his own concept, of liberty. He claims to have been embittered as a youth in Lansing, Mich., where

his home was burned and his father murdered. Now 38, he spent his young manhood as a Harlem hoodlum and a jailbird. He was converted while in jail to the Black Muslims.

"There is no white man a Muslim can trust," Malcolm X said in his days as aide to Elijah Muhammad, the chief prophet of the group of some 80,000 American Negroes, all dedicated to the ultimate establishment of their own country in an area carved from the United States.

A DEGREE OF MYSTERY attended Malcolm X's recent break with the Black Muslims. More aggressive and more brilliant than Muhammad, Malcolm X is believed to have grown impatient with the peaceful coexistence philosophy of the Black Muslims.

Some Muslim sources say there were other factors in this separation. Muhammad is reported to have grown weary of competing with his aide for the spotlight. Malcolm K developed some ties with Moslems in the Near East. He began to brag that these friends would furnish arms and help for an immediate revolt. When he commended the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, Muhammad seized the opportunity to drop him.

Malcolm X now leads a smaller, less intelligent, and less disciplined band which wants its Armageddon as soon as possible. He has an estimated 1,100 followers, young Negroes drawn by emotion to the cause. They are terrorists who attract continuing scrutiny from the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

The potential of the group is enhanced by Muhammad's age and poor health. Some believe that Malcolm X will strike to seize the leadership of the 80,000 Black Muslims as soon as the moment is propitious.

Like the extremism of the John Birch Society, Malcolm X's extremism may be no vice, but it is of no help to the nation's stability.



Malcolm X Predicts 'Blood Bath' in South

London, July 10 (AP)-Malcolm X declared today that violence against Negroes in the southern United States "has now reached the point where members of my race will soon react and America will see a blood bath."

The former leader of the Black \$ Muslim movement talked with spend one day in London confer reporters at London Airport en route from New York to the conference of African states in Cairo,

He said a primary purpose of his trip was to enlist the help of new African Negro nations in pringing the U.S. before the United Nations as a violator of auman rights.

"Right now," he said, "Negroes in the United States are being bitten by police dogs and paralyzed by police clubs just because they want to vote. It is an organized campaign of violence.

"We want the issue of the American Negro lifted from that of their civil rights to that of their human rights. We want the United States charged with violation of human rights. This is where the African states can help, by getting it on to the floor of the United Nations."

ring with leaders of African Ne gro nations attending the Brit ish Commonwealth prime ministers' meeting.

The secretariat for the African summit conference said in Cairo that Malcolm X has not applied for observer status at the conference and any request would have to be decided by the conference.

Observers in Cairo considered it highly unlikely that Malcolm X would be given official status at the conference. They pointed out that at the Addis Ababa conference last-year-the African leaders were extremely reluctant to involve themselves in-U. S. racial problems.



Information available indicates she was brought to trial during a meeting held by Muhammad's Temple (MT) No. 2, Chicago, on 1/13/60, on charges of having accused RAYMOND SHARRIEFF, the Supreme Captain of the Fruit of Islam (FOI) of misappropriating Temple funds. SHARRIEFF, after the trial, suspended her from the Temple for 90 days.

On 4/20/60, MITZIE went before the bedy of MT No. 2 during a meeting of that Temple and asked to be reinstated. After the Temple bedy had veted to reaccept her back into the MOI, SHARRIEFF teld her that she talked to much and gave her another suspension of 90 days and teld her she could return at that time but would be placed in "Class C" (under the watchful eyes of the Muslims) for six menths. The advised they did not know any HUNT from Texas and did not know of financial support being given MUHANMAD by HUNT or by anyone else. FOREIGN BANKING - ELIJAH and CLARA MUHAMMAD

Reference is made to report of SA dated 5/12/64, page 75-78, wherein data is set forth showing MT No. 2 maintains both checking and savings accounts at American National Bank and Trust Company of Chicage, 33 North La Salle Street; Continental Illineis National Bank and Trust Company of Chicage, 231 South La Salle Street; and South East National Bank of Chicage, 1180 East 63rd Street, all Chicage, Illineis.

In an effort to determine whether funds may have been transferred from these accounts to a foreign bank, contact was had with the below individuals on 7/17/64. They advised that a check of the MT No. 2 accounts known to them failed to reflect any transfer of funds from said accounts to a foreign banking establishment. They advised, with the exception of the said as set forth below, that ELIJAH and/or CLARA MUHAMMAD did not maintain either savings or checking accounts under those names at their institutions.

All of the above sources have been alerted in this regard.

The confidential informants mentioned previously advised on the dates indicated that they had no knowledge regarding funds maintained by ELIJAH or CLARA MUHAMMAD. They opined that ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, as absolute authority in the NOI, would have access to any and all NOI funds. They stated that on occasion collections are taken up from members of MT No. 2 to be given to CLARA MUHAMMAD and these generally occur on special occasions such as Savier's Day, February 26 of each year. They advised they had no knowledge as to the extent of CLARA MUHAMMAD's income but felt it would not be great as the denations miquired of the female members is small. The sources commented that they did know that MUHAMMAD and other members of his family live in expensive homes, drive expensive cars and dress well.

Re Bureau letter of 7/14/64 notes that the Bureau will, upon receipt of replies from the various field effices receiving same, request appropriate Legal Attaches to conduct investigation regarding the foreign banking allegations. In this regard, Chicago desires to bring the fellowing to the Bureau's attention:

ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, accompanied by his sens HERBERT and AKBAR, travelled to Africa and the Middle East in late 1959, returning to Chicage abruptly in early January, 1960. Information available appears to indicate MUHAMMAD was most dissatisfied with the trip. Included on his itinerary were the cities of Caire, Egypt and Beirut, Lebanon. AKBAR MUHAMMAD is presently residing in Caire, Egypt and is acting as a foreign correspondent for "Muhammad Speaks" newspaper.

HERBERT MUHAMMAD has made several visits to Africa from 1959 to as recent as 1964, when he journied to that area with CASSIUS CLAY. Presumably he has made the trips both as a correspondent for "Muhammad Speaks" newspaper and to visit his brother AKBAR in Cairo.

CLARA MUHAMMAD travelled to Caire, Egypt in beth 1962 and 1963, presumably to visit AKBAR.

There has been no information from sources close to the NOI indicating ELIJAH or CLARA MUHAMMAD have shown any interest in Switzerland or any particular interest in Lebanon, specifically Beirut, other than the above. Chicage feels that if either CLARA or ELIJAH de have foreign banking centacts, the most legical place would be in Caire, Egypt, because their sen AKBAR is residing there. Chicago feels, however, that ELIJAH MUHAMMAD, in all likelihood, keeps his money either in the MT No. 2 banking accounts in Chicage, which would be readily accessible to him, or possibly keeps cash on hand in his residence at 4847 South Woodlawn, Chicage, or in Phoenix, Arizona. It is known that someone is always in these homes. It is considered unlikely, based on information available to date, that MUHAMMAD has deposited money outside the United States.

It is, therefore, suggested that the Bureau, if it considers it necessary upon receipt of outstanding leads to set out further leads in this regard for Legatic concentrate on ascertaining if ARBAR may be banking in Caire, Egypt, and if so attempt to ascertain where so the institution may be examined for accounts belonging to

ELIJAH and/or CLARA MUHAMMAD Based on the recent de-Tection of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD's son and grandson, WALLACE MUHAMMAD and HASSAH SHARRIEFF, it is deemed unlikely that ELIJAH MUHAMMAD would trust any of his sons with large sums of his money.

Chicago notes that the MOI has spent considerable funds in purchasing properties in Chicago and Phoenix, these properties including both business locations and homes for MUHANNAD and other members of his family.

INTERVIEW - WALLACE MCHAMMED

Re Bureau airtel of 7/15/64, requested views concerning a possible interview of WALLACE MCHAMMED for any knowledge he may have regarding the possession of foreign banking accounts by ELIJAH and CLARA MUHAMMAD and regarding the inner operations of the NOI.

Chicago feels WALLACE MCHAMMED should be interviewed at this time and requests Bureau give authority to do same. If cooperative, he will be asked to clarify his present position insofar as his plans for teaching or for the formation of a new organization is concerned; for his knowledge of the use of funds by ELIJAH and CLARA MUHAMMAD, his father and mother, and for any knowledge he may have of deposits made by them in foreign banking institutions; for any knowledge he may have of financial support given to ELIJAH MUHAMMAD by any group or individual, specifically one HUHT, a millionaire in Texas; for any knowledge of possession of guns or stocking of guns by HOI members or the HOI; and for any knowledge he may have of the inner operations of the HOI such as its structure, authority, etc.

In making this recommendation, Chicago has given consideration to the fact that WALLACE MCHAMMED was interviewed by representatives of the "Chicago Daily Defender," which interview appeared in its issue of 7/8/64 and stated during the interview he had contacted the FBI. Chicago notes that WALLACE MCHAMMED did not contact this office until 7/13/64; that WALLACE MCHAMMED apparently submitted to an interview which was to appear in "Sepia," "Jet," "Pageant," and "Life" magazines. He stated at the time he would teach any group desiring him after 10/30/64, the date his parole ends.

In making this recommendation Chicago recognizes that WALLACE MCHANNED has been granting interviews to the press in his efforts to discredit his family and officials of the NOI.

It is also recognized he may in some way attempt to use a contact by this Bureau as a means to further discredit his father. This could be done by him by going to the press charging that the FBI is actively investigating his father and his organization and by making some ridiculous allegations as to what was said during the interview. It is also further recognized he could use an FBI interview to enhance his own cause by claiming through the press media that he was cooperating with the FBI and therefore whatever plans he has for forming a group or teaching had the blessings of the Bureau.

Since it is already known the FBI is conducting an investigation of ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and the NOI, and, since WALLACE MOHAMMED could make such claims on his own to the press at any time, it is felt the advantages of such an interview, if he proves cooperative, would far outweigh the disadvantages. It is recommended authority be given to approach WALLACE MOHAMMED for the purposes set forth above.





Malcolm X Lays H<u>arlem Ri</u>ot To 'Scare Tactics' of Police

CAIRO, July 20 (UPI) — Malcolm X said today that the violence in Harlem was a result of "outright scare tactics" by the New York police.

"I am surprised that the trouble has been contained to the degree it has," the Black Nationalist leader said. "Until two years ago New York City used wiser methods than any other city to deal with racial problems."

Malcohn, who is attending the Organisation of African Unity as an observer, said that under Police Commissioner Michael J. Murphy, "for some strange reason, tactics have changed."

"Now it is a case of outright scare tactics," he said.
