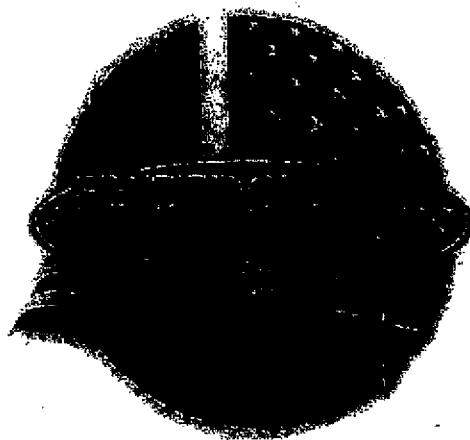

Malcolm To Speak Here, And Abroad

The militant voice of Malcolm X will be heard on both sides of the Atlantic during the month of February.

The controversial Muslim and former spokesman for Elijah Muhammad is scheduled to speak at Tuskegee (Ala.) Institute on Feb. 3 during a voter registration drive there.

Malcolm is to spend Feb. 6, 7 and 8 in Europe, speaking in London and Paris. The England appearance is to be sponsored by the Council of African Organizations. In France, the sponsor is the Africans and Afro-Americans.

Brother Reuben, an associate of Malcolm X, made the announcement. He described the European sponsors as "African student organizations."

Muslim Minister Blasts Malcolm X

Muslims' Minister James, head of Muhammad Temple No. 7, this week blasted Leon Ameer, Malcolm X and Akbar Muhammad, the second son of Elijah Muhammad, during a press conference at Shabazz Restaurant, Lenox Ave., at 115th St.

Minister James called Malcolm the "big hypocrite" and the others "little hypocrites."

Answering Leon Ameer's charges that he was assaulted and persecuted by the Muslims, Minister James said:

"We of the Muslim faith don't believe in courts. We can't get justice in the white man's courts and that is the reason why formal complaint to the police was not made," he said.

"We believe that Ameer is a fool of Malcolm who is insane with envy and jealousy and uses such people to blackguard Elijah Muhammad who is beneficial to every black man that is exposed to his teachings.

Minister 25 Years

"In the last 34 years," he continued, "Elijah Muhammad has trained many ministers and placed the spotlight on several. There have been some misfits, men who can't live by the laws of Islam.

"I have been a member for 25 years and Elijah Muhammad has taught the black man the things he lost in slavery. He has taught them how to walk, to talk, socialize, self defense and carry themselves with dignity.

"Muslims are not sent on errands of death or assault. Anyone who has been exposed to the teachings of Elijah Muhammad knows that Islam is the religion of love. Our enemy is the white devils," James said.

Malcolm Speaks

Malcolm X, when asked for comment, told the Amsterdam News that he has no intentions of getting involved in a verbal debate with Minister James.

"I'm working on a constructive program. I have no time for small-minded people," Malcolm said.

Leon Ameer told the Amsterdam News that he has not deserted his wife, Eartha Lee, who is now living in New Haven.

"I can't return to my home because they are still out to get me. I must keep on the move. My disabled veteran check," the former U.S. Marine said, "is turned over to my wife every month. My children are, Darcel, Leon, Pamela, Michael, Magda, Daud, and Ali Hassan. We were married in 1953 and lived in the Bronx at 759 E. 153th Street. Then we moved to 316 W. 116th Street. From there I was sent to New Haven by the Muslims," Ameer said.

Sea Quits

Akbar Muhammad, the youngest of Elijah Muhammad's six sons, became the second to quit and the third member of Muhammad's family to sever relations with the Muslims.

Akbar, who is a student of Islamic Law at Al Azhar University in Cairo, Egypt, said:

"My father's concocted religious teachings are far from, and in most cases, diametrically opposed to Islam."

No Black State

The 25-year-old Akbar said he rejected his father's proposal for setting up separate black states for American Negroes or returning them to Africa. He also refused to accept his father's teachings that the white race is devils. He said he would cooperate with the NAACP, CORE and Dr. Martin Luther King's Southern Christian Leadership Conference.

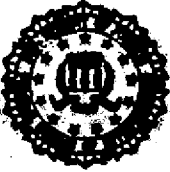

VICTOR RIESEL: INSIDE LABOR

A PHALANX of left-wing Negro activists, led by the Rev. Milton Galamison and Jesse Gray, appear to be on a collision course with Dr. Martin Luther King. Allied with the Galamison-Gray bloc are the globe-trotting Malcolm X and other militants who want to use New York as the base for an all-Negro political party.

From inside their newly organized coalition, known as the Federation for Independent Political Action, comes word that they want to run Mr. Galamison for Mayor and Mr. Gray for a seat on the City Council this Fall on a straight Negro ticket.

They are realists, so they, of course, have little hope of polling heavily for their front runner, who now is specializing in school boycotts. But they believe they can roll up enough votes to put themselves in a bargaining position in the future -- and possibly get Gray on the City Council.

★

They unveiled their organization during a little-noticed, all-day parley Dec. 19 after issuing a call for "Black independent political action."

"With independent political power, the black revolution can boldly move forward in advancing the interests of the masses," their statement said. The conference created an interim action committee of eight men including Mr. Galamison, Gray, Malcolm X and John Henrik Clarke, editor of Freedomways, founded by Mrs. W.E.B. Dubois.

This coalition's effort to launch an all-Negro political machine runs contrary to the broad philosophical concepts of Dr. King and other national Negro and liberal leaders now directing the vast civil rights offensive.

The latter will make this quite apparent during a unique national parley a week hence at Riverside Church. Beginning Saturday morning, January 30, these leaders will run a two-day "State of the Negro People" conference.

Dr. King will be there to report his experiences in Selma, Ala. He'll be but one of scores of delegates from most of the national civil rights organizations.

★

These men have long rejected suggestions for narrow independent political action. They see it as self-defeating, pre-doomed isolation.

Instead, the conference next weekend will make plans for broadening the political base. Dr. King has not only spoken of a drive to register several million Negroes on the voting lists of the Southern states, but has also been seeking to broaden the drive.

He wants to join with the American labor movement on two fronts. The first is a campaign to convince a large part of the 40,000,000 Americans who did not vote in the 1964 elections to register and cast votes in '68 and '69. The second is to coordinate the economic power of the Negroes and the trade unions.

Dr. King is expected to urge the conference to dispatch a delegation to President Johnson. It would be instructed to urge him to ask Congress to pass laws at this session which would wipe out the restrictive literacy tests.

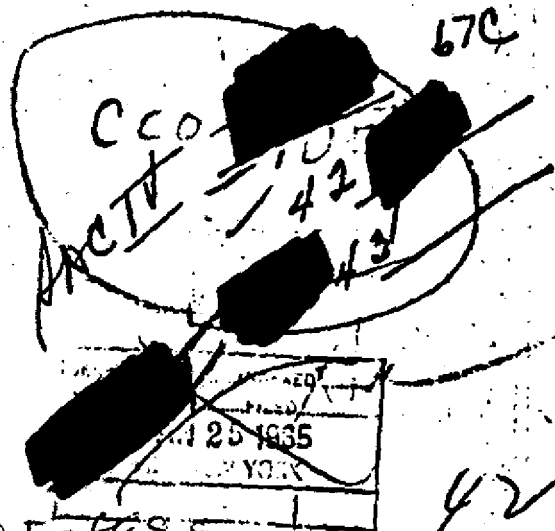

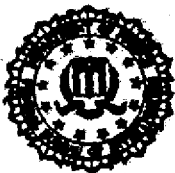

On December 29, 1964, a source who has furnished reliable information in the past advised that Malcolm Little had visited Boston on December 16, 1964 to participate in the Harvard University Ford Hall Forum at Cambridge, Massachusetts. He later appeared on the Jerry Williams Radio Program, station WMEX, Boston, Massachusetts.

This source stated that both the Ford Hall Forum and the radio show fell into the usual format established by Little in his public appearances and nothing new took place.

The source learned that while in Boston, Malcolm Little stated that he had spoken with Wallace Muhammad in New York earlier in that week and that Wallace and himself were joining together. The source advised that Wallace Muhammad is one of the sons of Elijah Muhammad, National leader of the Nation of Islam, and that Wallace has broken away from the Nation of Islam and has been repudiated by his father as a hypocrite. The source also advised that Malcolm Little was formerly the National representative of Elijah Muhammad who fell into disfavor with Elijah Muhammad and formed his own group known as the Organization of Afro-American Unity. A characterization of the Nation of Islam and the Organization of Afro-American Unity are found in the appendix attached hereto.

The source advised that Little has a foreign born Muslim from one of the African countries living at his home. This person has been sent to New York to help Little set up his mosque in New York. Little has

in his possession a telegram authorizing him to establish this mosque and authorizing him to spend \$500.00 per month for this purpose. Little hopes to set up Mosques in New York, Philadelphia and Boston.

Little has twenty sholarships for a university in Egypt good for a two-year period with all expenses paid.

This source stated that Little hinted, while in Boston, that Cassius Clay would break away from the Muslims and possibly join up with Wallace and Little.

This same source heard recently that Akbar Muhammad is dissatisfied with his father, Elijah Muhammad, and publicly expressed this in an article in a New York paper on Christmas Day.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.
