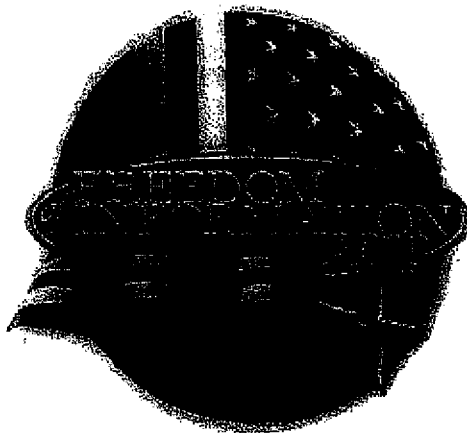

^{b7D}  MALCOLM X.'s speech at Corn Hill Methodist Church  and is summarized as follows:

MALCOLM X. opened his talk with a discussion of the Black Revolution in the U. S., Africa, England and France, saying that England and France are having trouble within their countries that has not been publicized because the U. S. Negro problems overwhelm their problems. MALCOLM X. continued that all three countries, England, France and the U. S. have the same problem, pointing out the Western Hemisphere has black people in Brazil, as well as all South America calling them Apo-Americans. He then divided the Western Hemisphere into four classifications:

1. French West Indies ^{b7C}
2. British West Indies
3. Spanish influence, Latin America
4. United States

MALCOLM X. said the U. S., the British and the French all have a common problem, "The African Revolution" calling it the "new mood." He explained the Negro militancy in the U. S. has frightened the white people, but such is not the case in England and France. He then explained the U. S. Negro will never understand the Negro problem if he only considers the local level; he must take the world situation into consideration.

MALCOLM X. said he was a Muslim, stating "I believe in one God, I believe in the brotherhood of man." He explained that in the U. S., society believes in brotherhood, but practically they do not practice brotherhood.

MALCOLM X. said "We believe in no segregation; we are against any form of segregation," saying this society judges a man by the color of his skin; white skin people go forward, black skin people do not move forward.

MALCOLM X. then said that the U. S. cannot justify the dropping bombs in Asia calling this "racism," and was against bombings in this area. He said "racism" is in the U. S. and Rochester. He stated, we are for peace, but the people we are up against are not peaceful.

MALCOLM X. then claimed the press was used to get public opinion for the white people, pointing out the Black community as a criminal area, resulting in the white people believing this situation exists along with turning some Black people against Black people. He said this situation with the press "makes the victims look like the criminal and the criminal look like the victims."

MALCOLM X. proceeded to talk against the war in Africa, calling the bombing of African villages mass murder; black skin against white skin. He claimed the African people struck out for more freedom and it has now influenced those people in the Western Hemisphere to do the same.

According to MALCOLM X., CORE and the NAACP were under investigation prior to the Black Muslim Groups, but when the Black Muslim came along "talking that kind of

talk they talk," the white man said "Thank God for the NAACP" and made the NAACP members responsible Negroes; responsible to the white man. The Black Muslim movement, MALCOLM X. said, attracted the most militant youth in the Black community, and the movement was rejected in the U. S. Government because it was not accepted as a bonafide religion. This action on the part of the U. S. Government put the Muslims in a vacuum, preventing the Muslims movement from any action and many members have now become disillusioned.

MALCOLM X. stated he has established a Muslim Mosque in New York City, N.Y., claiming to be based on the real Muslim religion, calling his organization "African American Unity" and their motto is "By any means necessary."

MALCOLM X. said we believe (referring to the African American Unity) in the right to fight for freedom; since the Federal Government, whose hands are tied, has shown an unwillingness to protect the Black man as illustrated by the bombing of churches and murders of Negroes in the South, we must equip ourselves and we will equip ourselves for our fight for freedom.

A grand jury indicted three Negroes yesterday in the slaying of Malcolm X, Black Nationalist leader, and indicted Malcolm's bodyguard for shooting and wounding one of the trio.

Charges of willfully killing Malcolm "with a shotgun and pistols" were made against Thomas Hagan, also known as Talmadge Hayer and Thomas Hayer, 22 years old, of 347 Marshall Street, Paterson, N. J.; Norman 3X Butler, 26, of 661 Rosedale Avenue, the Bronx; and Thomas 15X Johnson, 29, of 902 Bronx Park South, the Bronx.

A separate indictment accused Reubin Francis, under that spelling and also as Reubin X, on one count of first-degree felonious assault for "aiming and discharging a pistol" at Hagan, two counts of second-degree assault and a fourth count of possessing a pistol. Francis, 33, has given his address as 871 East 179th Street, the Bronx.

Hagan is in Bellevue Hospital's prison ward. Butler and Johnson are being held without bail, and Francis, whose bail has been set at \$10,000, are to be arraigned in Supreme Court tomorrow. The numbered "X" names are used in the Black Muslim movement, from which Malcolm split in April, 1964.

Malcolm was shot down before 400 persons at a rally Feb. 21 of his Organization of Afro-American Unity in the Audubon Ballroom, Broadway and 166th Street.

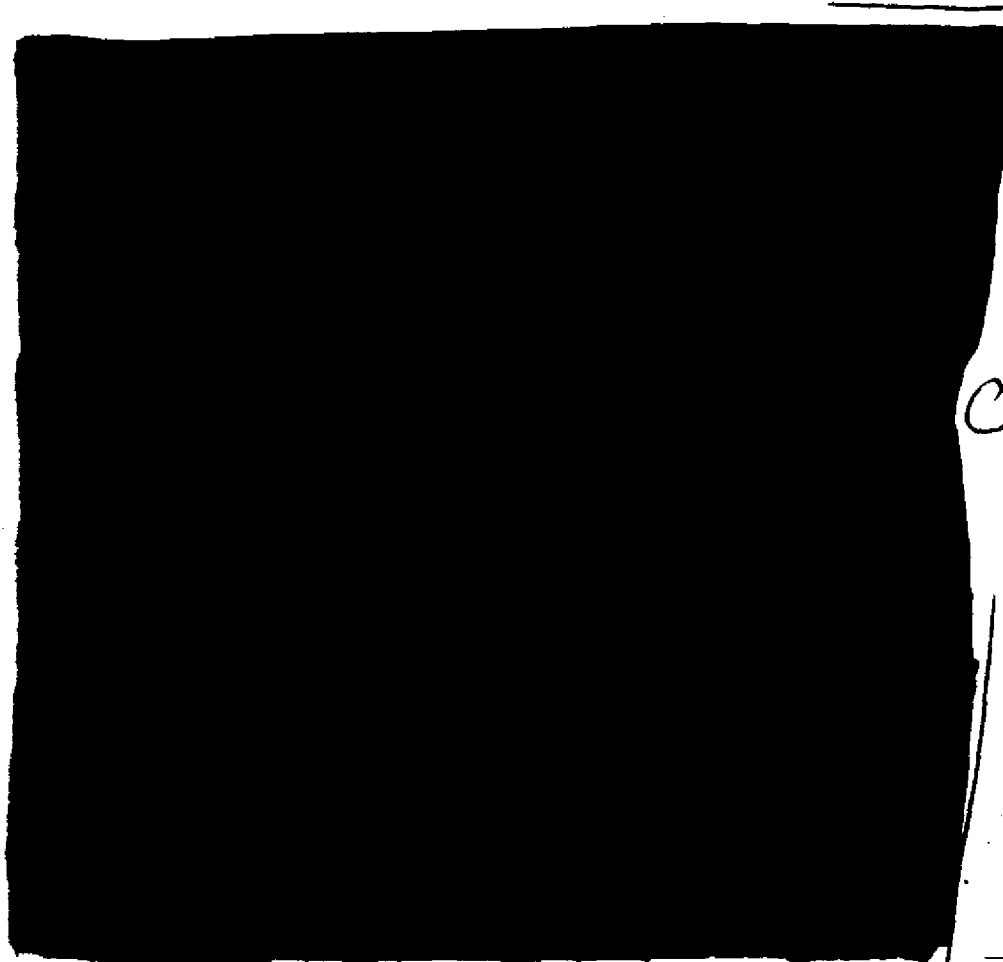

The call is one we have endorsed and can politically support. We are getting the chance to show that we are not a 'sectarian' group as we have been slandered in the past.

"Our tour speakers are distributing buttons and calls and are helping to persuade people to go on the march. The SDS has maintained its policy of allowing all groups to sell and pass out literature on the march. This is the first time such a large march has had this explicit policy.

"The policy for signs according to SDS is that SDS will silk screen signs for the march and will ask everyone to carry these signs. The slogans are not yet determined, but there will be a spectrum of different slogans such as 'Withdraw Troops' and 'Negociate' etc. These signs will not even say SDS. SDS is encouraging people to bring signs indicating their schools

"and cities so that the march will reflect clearly a broad geographical representation. We had encouraged SDS to allow organizations to bring signs with their organizations on them, but we do not consider this key. If the SDS slogans are not pro-Johnson and if SDS continues to stick to its present policy concerning literature sales, the march will certainly have an anti-Johnson and militant tone and will be more free than former marches. We will co-operate with the sign policy of SDS so long as the slogans chosen are in agreement with the line of the call. In areas where sympathy demonstrations are being held we will push for an 'everybody bring your own signs' policy with any signs being drawn up by sponsoring organizations to reflect the line of the call.

"As soon as definite information on what the slogans will be comes out, we will notify the locals.

██████████ Reports on the progress of local March on Washington Committees have come in from around the country. In some areas committees have been formed which welcome all tendencies and which are signing up people for the March on the basis of the call. Such is the case in Philadelphia, Detroit and Minneapolis. Ann Arbor has reported that SDSers are willing to sell our pamphlet at their literature tables. In Boston arrangements have been made for us to send ██████████ to a large number of schools in different parts of New England. In some areas there has been some trouble with Stalinists, Social Democrats or PLers trying to exclude us. Berkeley reports that the DuBois Club is doing what it can to make this march reflect their own pro-Johnson views. A general rule seems to be that we have a better opportunity to help build united committees if we get bargaining power by actively building the march and organizing schools in the area so that our opponents find it difficult to rationalize excluding us.

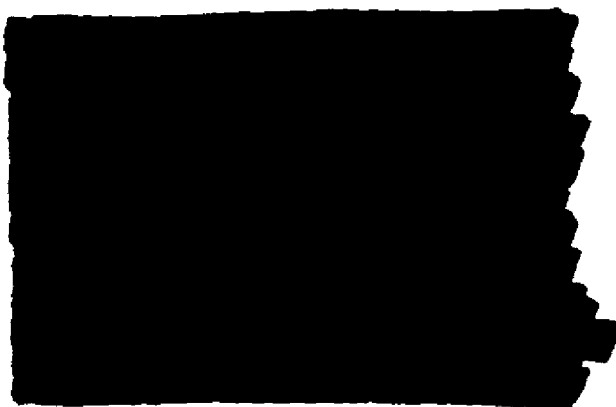

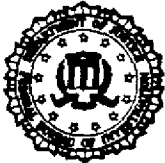

Malcolm Double-X'd From Within: 37X

By WILLIAM FEDERICI and HENRY LEE

Malcom X was the victim of treachery by a fanatic "third group" that has infiltrated both his organization and the parent Black Muslim sect, a long-time associate of the murdered leader told THE NEWS last night.

According to Charles 37X, who followed Malcolm out of prophet Elijah Muhammad's fold, Elijah could gain nothing by killing Malcolm. And the bombing of a regular Muslim temple in Harlem was not a retaliatory gesture by Malcolm's followers, he added.

"We think we know who ordered the killing," Charles 37X said. "The bombing of the temple and the murder of Malcolm were not done by Muslims. Nothing can be gained by Muslims rising against one another."

Fears Vengeance Killings

"There are other elements implicated who have everything to gain. The Muslims from both sides know who they are. This is not a time for brother to kill brother."

The 45-year-old associate of Malcolm confirmed earlier disclosures by THE NEWS that the killers and bombers come from the Revolutionary Action Movement, a Negro terrorist group that follows the Red Chinese line and is dedicated to violence.

James Farmer, national director of CORE, speaking to newsmen at convocation ceremonies yesterday at Adelphi University in Garden City, L. I., also blamed "a third party." Malcolm's murder, he said, "was calculated to produce more violence and murder and vengeance killings."

Assistant Chief Inspector Joseph L. Coyle reported his detectives are "on the right track" in the murder investigation. Other sources indicated that police have obtained movies taken at the Audubon Ballroom Sunday when Malcolm was slain as he addressed 400 followers.

Why They Left Elijah

Charles 37X told why he and Malcolm left the parent body: "Elijah played the fiddle and brought his people to the brink many times, but then would stop and call them back. Elijah will do nothing for the black people,

and this is why Malcolm was at odds with him."

But when Malcolm set up shop for himself, Charles disclosed, "we were infiltrated by a highly-trained intellectual group who were definitely Communists or Socialists."

"Malcolm was a beautiful tool to be used unwittingly," he said. "He was fiery, he was articulate."

Charles said he and several other close supporters warned Malcolm that they were being gradually taken over, and not by supporters of the prophet, but he shrugged off their warnings.

Letter to Egypt

During the Harlem riots last summer, Malcolm was in Egypt, and the takeover elements accelerated their efforts, Charles said.

"I sent a letter to Malcolm, begging him to come home," he disclosed. "I knew Malcolm might have been able to calm the young hotheads who were pushed into the riots."

"But he wrote back: 'You are guilty again of looking at one tree in the middle of the forest.' Malcolm wouldn't understand that I was watching and seeing these people pushing the black folk into rioting. I was getting sick watching this."

"When Malcolm came back and preached a little differently, the other group got restless. He was no longer the tool they'd had. All the whites weren't devils."

Planned by Pros

When he attended the Audubon Ballroom meeting, Charles said, he sensed something was wrong. At the door, no one was checking for guns. When he asked about it, he was told to mind his business.

Then he tried to warn Malcolm, he said, but the Black Na-

tionalist told him, "I'm with my people here, I have nothing to worry about."

As usual, a shield of supporters protected Malcolm from the front, but after an hour, the shield was shifted. "This disturbed me," Charles 37X said.

Shortly afterwards came the fusillade of shots that cut down Malcolm. "I hit the ground," Charles 37X said. "I'm No. 2 to get knocked off in this."

The assassination, he said, was professionally planned and executed. "If it had been done in a frenzy," he said, "it would not have been done so well." Similarly, the mosque bombing was a professional job, rather than hot-headed retaliation by Malcolm's followers, he insisted.

Malcolm's now leaderless group

of more than 1,000 is being reorganized by a half dozen of his associates, Charles reported. He wants no part of them, he said, and he suspects the new leaders will be figureheads.

At the Unity funeral home, 2352 Eighth Ave. at 126th St., heavily guarded by police, including sharpshooters on rooftops, crowds again queued up to view Malcolm's body.

Bomb Threat Received

In early afternoon, a telephoned bomb threat was received, and the two-story building was evacuated while the bomb squad searched the premises. Later, the public viewing was resumed. A number of children showed up during the noon hour.

A bomb threat also was received at the Faith Temple, Church of God in Christ, 147th St. and Amsterdam Ave., where services are scheduled for Saturday at 9:30 A.M.

At Bellevue Hospital, uniformed and plainclothes police protected Talmadge Hayer, 22, one of the suspected assassins. Hayer, who was shot and also suffered a broken thigh bone during the melee, will undergo surgery soon, the hospital said.

In Criminal Court, bespectacled Reuben Francis, 33, of 871 E. 179th St., Bronx, one of Malcolm's bodyguards who assertedly shot Hayer, was continued in \$10,000 bail yesterday for a hearing March 3 on charges of felonious assault and Sullivan Law violation.

Elijah Guards Spin A Tizzy Over Gift

Chicago, Feb. 24 (AP)—Police guarding Elijah Muhammad from assassins intercepted a suspicious crate at the Black Muslim leader's home today but bomb squad experts, after an examination, pronounced the contents—a grandfather clock—harmless.

A flurry of activity broke out at the sect leader's 19-room South Side mansion when a truck pulled up at the front entrance.

Police halted the driver who announced he was delivering a crated grandfather's clock from a Philadelphia department store to Muhammad.

Bodyguards from the sect's Fruit of Islam elite corps said Muhammad had not ordered a clock. Three police specialists in explosives opened the crated

Malcolm Aides Seek Funds to Defend Guard

By KENNETH GROSS

A photograph of assassinated Black Nationalist leader Malcolm X—blown up larger than life—dominated the meeting.

Under that black-framed portrait, the men closest to Malcolm in life stood and spoke of their lost leader at the Militant Labor Forum, 116 University Pl., Friday night.

It was the first public appearance of the men in Malcolm's movement since Sunday, Feb. 21, when three men gunned down the 39-year-old former Black Muslim in Harlem's Audubon Ballroom.

Take No Chances

Members of the forum were not taking any chances on violence at their meeting and stationed, at intervals around the crowded room, white and Negro guards who faced the audience.

"There was a house on 113th St. where 11 or 12 of us planned the movement to free the black man," said James 3X Shabazz, now president of the New York Mosque Malcolm founded after leaving the Black Muslims.

There were about 100 in the room. The meeting was called to raise money for defense of Reuben Francis 32, free on \$10,000 for allegedly wounding one of Malcolm's assassins. They raised \$317.35.

Answers Questions

"I'm not supposed to talk about this too much," said Francis, "but I merely want to assure you that, of the charges brought against me I'm innocent."

There were questions, which Shabazz answered. A woman asked what would become of the movement now that Malcolm was gone.

"We have problems," he said. Apparently Malcolm's older sister, Mrs. Ella Mae Collins of Boston, will take charge of the Organization of Afro-American Unity. Shabazz will apparently head the mosque.

An April 23 Apollo Theatre benefit show with such top names as Sammy Davis, Brook Benton, Dick Gregory and Michael Olatunji and a June 6 jazz festival and fashion show at the home of the Sidney Poitiers in Pleasantville, N.Y., have been planned to aid the family of the late Malcolm X.

Mrs. Sidney Poitier, chairman of the Committee of Concerned Mothers which is raising funds to give the family a home and help to provide for the education of the children, said interest in the two affairs was high with scores of entertainers agreeing to participate.

To date, Mrs. Poitier revealed, over \$6,000 has been raised to aid the family and the two planned events are expected to raise several thousand dollars more.

Meanwhile the Manhattan Division of the Protestant Council revealed that it has raised \$1,700 as of March 19 for the Educational Fund for the Children of Malcolm X in Harlem churches. Malcolm X died leaving his family broke and with his wife expecting a fifth child this fall.

Malcolm X An Electric Prodder

I could not subscribe to the racial concept of Malcolm X. His experiences were different from mine. In my travels at home and abroad I found some surprisingly good white people and needless to say, some awfully mean and disagreeable Negroes. However, the crux of the matter is, there are eighteen states in this union which have laws against Negroes loving white people. As long as there is a Sheriff Clark in Alabama who would brutalize Negroes because they are determined to be good citizens, as long as there are Sheriff Lawrence Rainey and his deputies in Mississippi who would hate to give freedom to the dark Americans to the degree that he and his several deputies are charged with slaying three civil rights workers, Michael Scheerner, Andrew Goodman and James Chaney, as long as there are white haters who would blow up a church and kill little Sunday School girls — as long as such crimes exist, we are going to have a Malcolm X.

The tragedy is that the two black groups are now fighting each other. We must not counsel killing, but if these black men just have killing in their blood there is a sheriff in Selma and some in Mississippi. I believe in prayer but Dr. King's prayers have not changed these evil sheriffs. Is anything wrong with using Malcolm X's method? One day the radio tells us "there's a white man armed. He hates Negroes." That's the understatement of the century. The white men that are dangerously armed against Negroes are quite a number and those that hate are not a few. The hate exhibits itself in many ways. When Malcolm X's home was bombed

firemen and police tended to believe that Malcolm bombed his own home to gain publicity. Both questioned him along that line but never looked for the bomber. Not much difference between that and the Mississippi officials who said the three civil rights workers were in hiding to gain publicity, when, in truth, they knew the workers had been killed if not with their aid, certainly with the hatemongers blessing.

Malcolm X, the tormentor of the white man's conscience is sorely needed in this country where car loads of armed white men can order a church to dismiss its minister and have that order obeyed, dismiss him because he teaches his parishioners to register and vote. So it was in Selma last Sunday. For every car load of race hating crackers we need its complement of dedicated, determined Malcolms. Remember such white haters are out gunning for Dr. King because he "loves 'em." They wanted Malcolm dead because he hated 'em. What would be our penalty if we just like 'em—murder?

Cruel Treatment By Whites Drove Malcolm To Preach Hate

Malcolm X, the Black Nationalist leader was buried last Saturday a martyr to his cause. His death has set rumors flying that there will be violence within the ranks of the opposing sects of the Muslim faith ... the followers of Elijah Muhammad and the supporters of the late Malcolm.

Also set in motion is the cardinal question—Why was Malcolm bitter? Why did he preach hate?

A check of the record on Malcolm's life might well be the cause. He suffered numerous pains

of humiliation and indignation during his life because of his color in addition to those heaped upon him by the memory of his parents' experiences with vicious whites.

Malcolm X was born 38 years ago in Omaha, Nebraska, where his birthplace was set afire by the Ku Klux Klan. Twice he saw the night-riding, robed Ku Kluxers burn his family from their home. The second burning took place in Lansing, Michigan, where his family had moved. He said that a white man had raped his mother — something he could never forget.

Malcolm's father had been a Baptist minister and once belonged to the Marcus Garvey organization. He had joined in the early stages of the Garvey movement. Garvey was a Negro who advocated the building of a black nation in Africa and the return of American Negroes to bolster its growth. Garvey raised quite a bit and several other phases of business. When he seemed to be get-

ting strong and powerful, his foes finally toppled him and the movement finally faded.

A reporter who talked to Malcolm last year, said Malcolm told him that his father was a clergyman and a Christian and it was Christians who burned his homes in both places — people who preach brotherhood and religious tolerance.

Malcolm's family later lived in New York and Boston and he gained a reputation for shrewd-

ness in the Harlem ghetto and became a much sought spokesman while he was still in prison.

He submitted to serving two prison terms for larceny. It was during one of these terms that he learned of the emergence of Elijah Muhammad.

He became very active about the Muslims while he was in the prison. He was given a place of leadership in the movement and became a spokesman for the cult. He gave his stage name back to the white man and became Malcolm X. He obtained his conversion to Islam while in a six year history of work and addition within the group. It also gave him the post of Elijah's secretary.

As minister of mosque number 7 in New York, he began to emerge as a personality that overshadowed the Muslim movement, according to the spokesman for the group.

In 1963 and 1964 there were rumors of a power struggle between Malcolm and Chicago based Elijah Muhammad.

Finally Malcolm's dispute with the Muslims, after Muhammad forbade him to make further utterances following a remark about

the death of President John F. Kennedy. He carried with him a number of followers. At the time he said his organization would place emphasis on black nationalism and political activities and would form social action against the oppressors.

He was a dominant figure in the movement. He demanded respect from white men and some of the black men. He had capacity to grow when he made his appearance. He was admitted studying Muhammad's speaking techniques.

At the time the movement was growing and the black groups grew hotter and Malcolm X fully declared there was a plot on his life. His home in Long Island was bombed and he and his family barely escaped. Then on that fatal Sunday, October 1964, at a Harlem rally, he was shot and killed. He fell to the platform fatally wounded by gunshot bullets.

But had not so many things happened to him in a day, Malcolm might not have grown to hate the white man as he did and might never have met Elijah.

Third Suspect Arrested In Malcolm X Assassination

Police are gradually unraveling the mystery of the assassination of Malcolm X, fiery Black nationalist organization leader who was cut down in gunfire during a speech in a Harlem ballroom last Sunday. A third man was arrested in the slaying.

The man held this week was identified as Thomas 15 X Johnson, 30, a tall, neatly dressed Negro with a thin mustache, who pounce say, once served as an elite

guard in the Muslim organiza-
tion.

Assistant District Attorney Herbert J. Stern of New York said, "I have ordered him booked for the homicide of Malcolm X which he perpetrated with the others." Stern would give no details.

During the week, another man in his 20s was held under \$50,000 bail as a material witness. He was listed as Cary Thomas, Jr. District Attorney Robert McKeever said Thomas is believed to have been present at the assassination and to have vital information concerning the identity of the persons involved in the plot.

Five men are believed to have participated in the February 21 slaying of Malcolm as he arose to address a rally in the ballroom in upper Harlem. Two were reportedly decoys, while the other three gunned down Malcolm with

a loaded-off shotgun and pistol.
Tammam, an unemployed gambler,
married and living with his family
in the Bronx, was a companion
of the reputed Black Legion
member Herman H. Butler, who
was arrested last Saturday in the
slaying. The two are now on bond
in the slaying of another Black
Muslim, detective named Benjamin
Brown. Brown's identity escaped
with his son.

The shooting took place at the
clubbing was Talmadge Mayer, 32,
who was born in New York as a
Black Muslim, was said to be in the
bedroom following the assassina-
tion. He had been taken to St. Michael's Hospital,
where he has refused to say whether
he had shot or if anyone else did.
