Facts of complaint

Complainant telephonically contacted the Washington Metropolitan Field Office on the above date and time and identified himself as [redacted] (LNU) [redacted]. He stated that he was calling from [redacted], England, telephone [redacted] to warn President Bush and Prime Minister Thatcher of an assassination plot to kill them by a group called GODS SOLDIERS. He indicated that the group, GODS SOLDIERS, is located all over the world, including the United States.

Complainant stated that if Bush and Thatcher don't start telling the truth they will be assassinated and it could happen even before Christmas. Complainant continued that if Bush and Thatcher are executed they won't be nailed to a cross as Jesus was. Complainant advised that he would attempt to find out more information regarding the above assassination plot and would call WMFO again to relay the information.

Special Agent [redacted] at U.S. Secret Service, telephone [redacted] was notified of above at 7:15 PM, 12/11/89. It is noted that above call sounded long distance and complainant had an English Accent.

On December 11, 1989, at approximately 7:00 p.m., this writer was working as the Duty Agent at Washington Metropolitan Field Office (WMFO) and received a telephone call from an individual who identified himself as [redacted]. The caller stated that he was calling from [redacted] England, telephone [redacted].

Caller advised that he was calling to warn United States President, GEORGE BUSH, and England's Prime Minister, MARGARET THATCHER, of an assassination plot against them by a group, he identified as Gods Soldiers. Caller indicated that the members of God's Soldiers are located all over the world including the United States.

Caller stated that the members of God's Soldiers are tired of President BUSH and Prime Minister THATCHER not telling the truth. He continued that if President BUSH and Prime Minister THATCHER do not start telling the truth they would be assassinated. He stated that the assassination could occur before Christmas. He advised that if President BUSH and Prime Minister THATCHER are assassinated, their assassination would be worse than Jesus Christ being nailed to the cross.

Caller advised that he was unaware of any further details regarding the above assassination plot and would call the FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION's (FBI) WMFO if he learned of any additional information.

It was noted that the above telephone call sounded as though it were placed long distance and that the caller possessed a British accent.

[redacted] stated he asked a park ranger for directions to a town in Pennsylvania and then asked the ranger if he was near Camp David. [redacted] stated that the park ranger noticed the license tag on the stolen motorcycle was expired and a subsequent NCIC check revealed the motorcycle had been stolen. Ranger [] Maryland Department of Natural Resources, Maryland Forest, Park, and Wildlife Service, Cunningham Falls State Park, Thurmont, Maryland, advised as follows:

On November 16, 1986 at approximately noon, he observed an unknown white male, whom he later identified as [] pull up to a campsite at the state park. He was driving a motorcycle and when the cycle came to a complete stop, the driver fell off. Ranger [] immediately rushed to the driver's assistance and immediately determined that the rider ([]) was dressed too light for the weather and was extremely cold. [] felt that his appearance, namely his clothing, left him with the impression that the motorcycle and the helmet he was wearing were far too expensive for him. He subsequently noticed that the Texas license plate had expired, but he recalled the individual had indicated he came from the state of Florida. When queried about that, the rider ([]) advised that all the registration for the vehicle had been stolen from a briefcase that he had carried on the motorcycle and that the theft occurred at a truck stop in Virginia. He further advised Ranger [] that he had just purchased the motorcycle from an individual named []. Ranger [] felt that this individual acted disoriented, detached, and his "sense of reality was not what it should be." After making a radio request for a stolen motor vehicle check on the license plate, he was subsequently advised that the motorcycle had been reported stolen. He then called for a back-up from the Maryland State Police and was assisted by Trooper [] and upon Trooper [] arrival, Ranger [] placed [] under arrest. A subsequent search of the rider's bedpack disclosed a .41 caliber pistol which contained only one round and it was in the cylinder directly below the hammer. A National Crime Information Center check of this pistol disclosed it, too, was reported stolen.

[] then transported [] back to Barrack "B" of the Maryland State Police Barrack in Frederick, Maryland, and he recalled that [] refused to be fingerprinted. He was subsequently placed in a holding cell in the basement of the barracks and he tried to commit suicide. Ranger [] stated that [] removed his sweater and tried to hang himself and was nearly successful, except that [] came to check on him and saw him gurgling because the sweater was so tight around his neck. After running upstairs to get the key for the cell, Ranger [] and another state trooper

were able to untie the sweater and they called for medical assistance. [REDACTED] was then transported via ambulance to the Frederick Memorial Hospital and later committed by an emergency room physician to the Springfield Mental Hospital in Sykesville, Maryland.

Ranger [REDACTED] advised that [REDACTED] had never made any comments concerning Prime Minister MARGARET THATCHER, Camp David, or the President of the United States. He further indicated to Ranger [REDACTED] that he thought he was in Pennsylvania as he was traveling that way to meet with a brother who worked as a groom at the Penn National Racetrack. Additionally, he told Ranger [REDACTED] that he had taken the gun from his friend, [REDACTED], in order to protect himself and that the gun was there with the hope that if he pulled it on the police, maybe the police would, in fact, shoot him ([REDACTED]).

Enclosed for Tampa are the original and two copies of an FD-302 of Ranger one 1-A envelope containing notes of the interview, and a 1-A envelope containing the arrest report.

Baltimore suggests that Tampa seriously consider the subject's mental status in this matter as he is suicidal. Besides trying to hang himself in the holding cell of the Maryland State Police Barracks in Frederick, Maryland in 11/86, he also indicated that the weapon he had with him would be used to draw fire from the police. This action is known as "suicide by cop" and is a well-known way of committing suicide by depressed individuals. Additionally, at no time during the incident in the state of Maryland did the subject ever indicate he was en route to Camp David and, in all actuality, thought he was in the state of Pennsylvania at the time of the arrest. He never mentioned the name of MARGARET THATCHER or RONALD REAGAN nor was he on a mission of violence.

In view of the fact that all leads have been conducted in this matter, Baltimore considers this case RUC'd. // not needed

Demand for Thatcher tickets exhausts supply

Tickets for Lady Margaret Thatcher's lecture on April 27 are no longer available.

According to Scott Morris, assistant director of public relations, the demand for the free tickets was extremely high. Distribution began on March 27, and by March 29, the American Studies Institute had run out.

Bob Reely, associate executive director of the ASI, said that 50 percent of the tickets went to students and staff, and that most of the rest were for friends of Harding, the Board of Trustees and ASI sponsors. A very small percentage went to the public, Reely said.

Lady Thatcher will arrive in Searcy at 1 p.m. April 27, and will spend the afternoon privately in her room in the Heritage. A dinner will be offered in her honor at Heritage banquet rooms A, B and C at 6 p.m. Reely said that approximately 600 people among students, faculty, board members and the press will attend the dinner.

After the dinner, Lady Thatcher will speak in the Benson Auditorium about the future of the 21st century. The lecture will last 30-45 minutes, followed by a question and answer session. Lady Thatcher will leave immediately after the event. Between 3,400 and 3,500 people are expected to attend the lecture, according to Morris. He said that folding chairs will probably be set up on both

sides of the auditorium in order to accommodate more people.

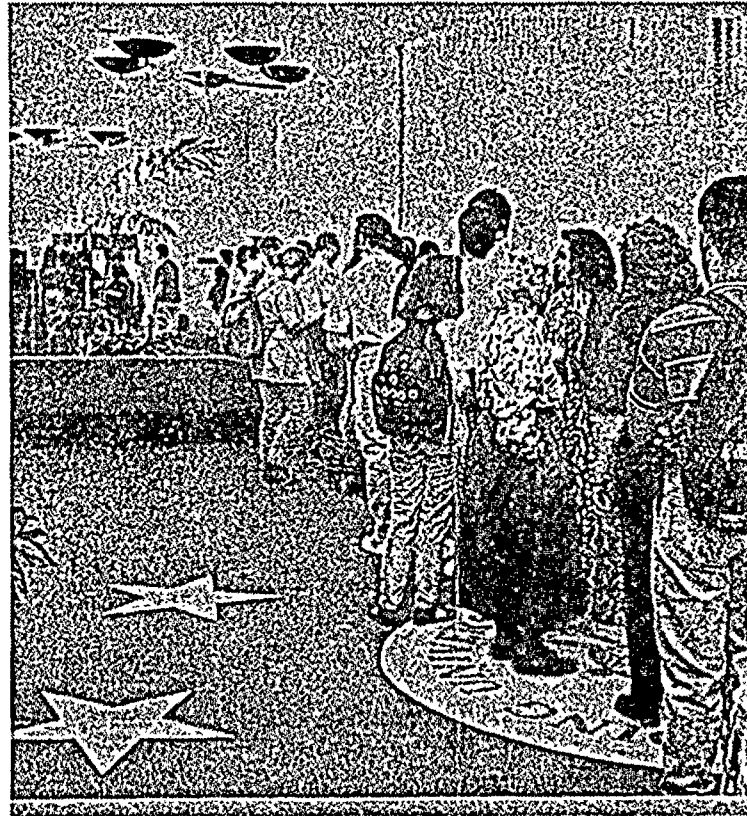
The event will receive limited media coverage as prescribed by Lady Thatcher.

Morris said that several radio stations and TV channels have requested coverage, among them C-SPAN, a channel that features government-related speakers. Morris also said that Lady Thatcher will only allow newspaper reporters and photo opportunities. She will not hold press conferences nor allow TV cameras. "We only have room for 35 media people. We had to turn the others away," Morris said.

Regarding publicity, Reely said that Lady Thatcher's speech will be treated as a private event. "If we publicize it too much, we will have lots of people coming, and there will not be enough room," he said.

Reely said that the ASI was able to contact Lady Thatcher through the Washington Speakers Bureau, which exclusively represents her. She has been in the United States for several weeks, speaking in different locations. Lady Thatcher is traveling with her husband, Sir Denis Thatcher, and two Scotland Yard guards.

Lady Thatcher has served as British prime minister, first lord of the treasury and minister for the civil service. She resigned as prime minister in 1990 after holding the office for 11 years. She continued to serve as a member of Parliament for Barnet, Finchley, until

1992, the year in which she became Baronet Thatcher of Kesteven.

Lady Thatcher is chancellor of Buckingham University in England and William and Mary College in Virginia. She has received many awards and

honorary degrees. She was elected Fellow of the Royal Society in 1983 and was awarded the Order of Merit by Queen Elizabeth II in 1990. Lady Thatcher is a patron of various charities and has established her own foundation.

The Bureau did not reply so commencing on 4/28/94 MP made phone calls to the substantive desk. SSA [redacted] called on 4/29/94 and advised he could not locate MP's teletype nor could he locate a Hdqs file. Renewed calls were made to the Bureau on 5/2 and 3/94 and then late on 5/3/94 a [redacted] (ph) called and indicated the Bureau had no threat information and had also checked with the Dept. of State.

It should be noted that when [redacted] called on 4/29/94 he requested a fax of MP's 4/7/94 teletype and it was sent.

On 5/3/94 Lt. [redacted] R.C. P.D. was advised that neither the FBIHQ nor Dept. of State had any threat info.
