Title is marked "CHANGED" to reflect the addition of the alias WILBUR B. TRAMMEL, whose name appears on the envelope of the threatening letter sent to New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO.

Re Buffalo teletype to the Bureau dated 3/6/85.

Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory, Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section, is the original letter and envelope sent to New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO, threatening his life. One copy of each of the above is enclosed for Buffalo.

On 3/7/85, Senior Investigator [redacted] New York State Police (NYSP), Protective Services, detail, Governor's Mansion, Albany, New York, made available an original of a letter and envelope mailed from Buffalo, New York, on 2/26/85, threatening the life of New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO. Senior Investigator [redacted] advised that this letter was addressed to "MARIO M. CUOMO, State Capital, Albany, New York, 12224," with a return address of "WILBUR B. TRAMMEL, City Court, Buffalo, New York". [redacted] further stated that this letter was originally received by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital and turned over to him on 3/4/85. Investigator [redacted] allowed that both the letter and the envelope would have been routinely handled by several persons before it came into his possession.

Investigator [redacted] further advised that several other threatening letters containing the exact text of the one enclosed had been received previously by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital and have since been forwarded to the Buffalo Office of the FBI. These included letters to New York State Assemblyman DENNIS GORSKI; New York State Comptroller, EDWARD NED REGAN, and New York State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS. The enclosed original extortion letter should be forwarded to Buffalo Division as office of origin in this matter upon completion of FBI Laboratory examinations.

Since no further active investigation remains at Albany, this matter is referred upon completion to Buffalo.

Laboratory please note that the evidence submitted herein should be handled in such a manner as to preserve any Latent Fingerprints for subsequent examination by the Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section.

Is requested to compare the text and type of the enclosed letter to that of those submitted by Buffalo Division in this case. Document Section is also requested to conduct whatever other examinations it deems appropriate.

FBI IDENTIFICATION DIVISION-LATENT FINGERPRINT SECTION:

The Latent Fingerprint Section is requested to process the enclosed letter for Latent Fingerprints. Any Latent Fingerprints developed should be compared with any fingerprints which might be developed on similar letters in this case submitted by the Buffalo Division.

According to the attached Buffalo teletype, seven additional individuals were mailed copies of the same threatening letters which were originally sent to U. S. Supreme Court Justices Lewis F. Powell, Jr. and Harry A. Blackmun and U. S. Senator Alfonse D'Amato. The new recipients include the Mayor of Buffalo, the Governor, Attorney General and Comptroller of New York State, two New York State Assemblymen and one 60-year-old waitress. Buffalo has interviewed the return addressees in an effort to determine who may have authored the original letter. Thus far, there is no known common denominator which connects any of the return addressees to the letter writer. Buffalo has b6 submitted all the letters and the envelopes to b7C the FBI Laboratory for analysis and comparison in the Anonymous Letter File.

Result of examination:

It was determined the photocopied messages, designated Qc8, Qc10, Qc12, Qc14, Qc16, Qc18, Qc20 and Qc21 originated from the same source as previous questioned specimens, an example being Qc2.

The typewriting appearing on specimens Q7 through Qc14, Qc16 and Qc18 through Qc22 closely resembles the Laboratory standards for an IBM Prestige elite typewriter having a horizontal spacing of 12 letters per inch.

The typewriting appearing on specimen Q15 closely resembles the Laboratory standards for a Prestige IBM pica typewriter having a horizontal spacing of 10 letters per inch.

Q17 closely resembles the Laboratory standards for an IBM Scribe typewriter having a horizontal spacing of 10 letters per inch.

No watermark or indented writing of value was observed on specimens Q7 through Qc22.

The submitted evidence was photographed and is being returned separately with the results of the requested latent fingerprint examinations.

It was determined the photocopied messages, designated Q48, Q49, Q52, Q54, Q56, Q58, Q60 and Q61 originated from the same source as previous guest opac, an example being Q62.

The typing appearing on ^{Q7-Q14, Q16, Q18, Q19} Q62 closely resembles the Laboratory standard for an IBM Prestige elite II having a horizontal spacing of 12 letters per in.

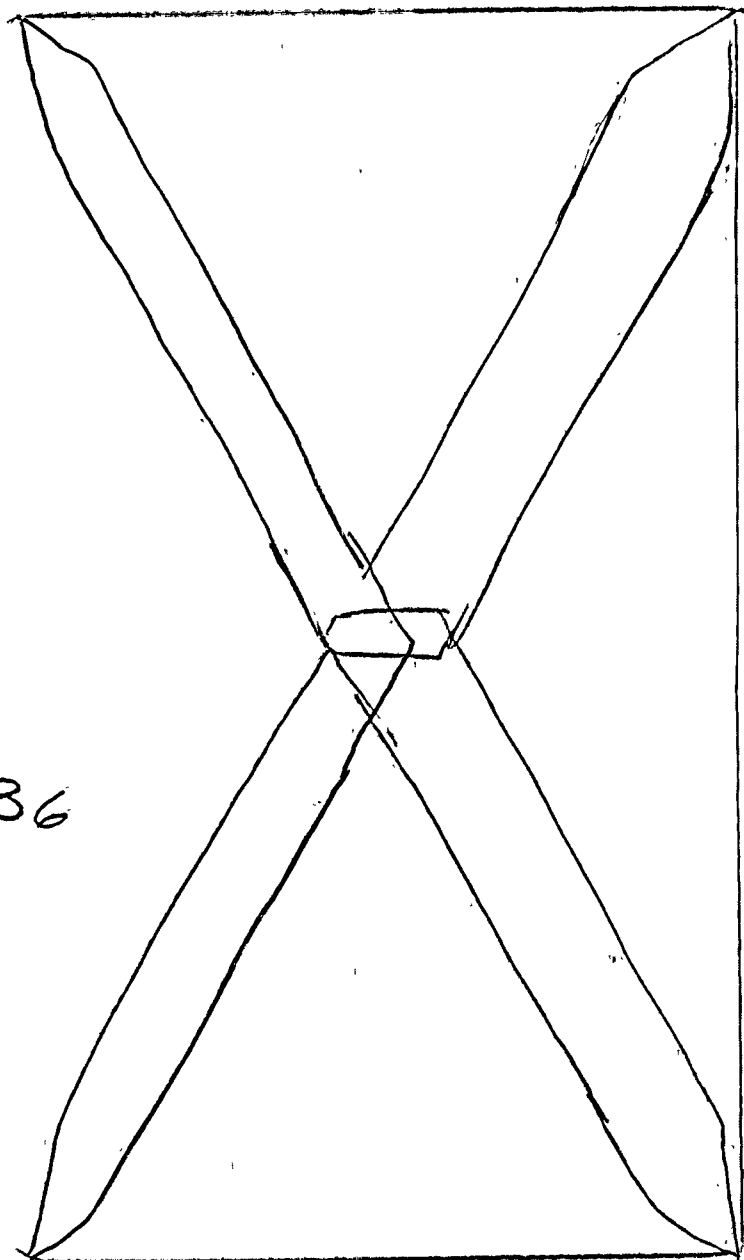

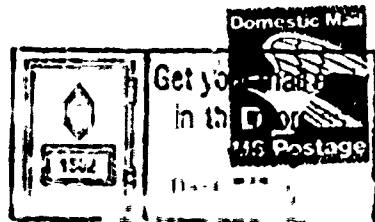

ON THE OTHER HAND, THE REMAINING BLACK RETURN ADDRESSES ARE NOT
LISTED IN THE BUFFALO TELEPHONE DIRECTORY. ADDITIONALLY, OF THE
SEVEN, THREE AND THREE LIVE IN TWO ADJOINING NEIGHBORHOODS IN CLOSE
PROXIMITY TO EACH OTHER. THESE INDIVIDUALS' RETURN ADDRESSES DID
HAVE ZIP CODES ATTACHED TO THE RETURN ADDRESS. IT WOULD, THEREFORE,
APPEAR THE UNSUB HAS ACCESS TO THESE INDIVIDUALS EITHER THROUGH
PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE OR SOME PRIOR ADDRESS LISTING. ADDITIONALLY,
INVESTIGATION HAS DETERMINED THAT [REDACTED] b6 b7C

[REDACTED] BLACK MALES AND FEMALES AND HAVE SOME
KNOWLEDGE OR ACQUAINTANCE OF EACH OTHER EITHER DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY,
INCLUDING NEIGHBORHOOD AFFILIATION.

THE ONE EXCEPTION TO THIS RULE IS WILBUR TRAMMELL, WHO IS A CITY OF BUFFALO COURT JUDGE AND WHO IS ALSO BLACK. THE BUFFALO DIVISION FEELS AT THIS TIME THAT TRAMMELL'S NAME WAS INADVERTENTLY UTILIZED BY THE UNSUB AS AN ADDRESSOR AND IT MAY HAVE BEEN INTENDED FOR TRAMMELL TO BE LISTED AS AN ADDRESSEE [REDACTED] TO BE IN FACT ADDRESSOR. [REDACTED] IS ANOTHER EXCEPTION IN THAT SHE IS A BLACK FEMALE IN HER EARLY FIFTIES BUT THE COMMON BOND IS THAT SHE RESIDES IN THE TOWN GARDEN APARTMENTS ALONG WITH [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] ALL OF THE PUBLIC OFFICIALS AND THEIR ADDRESSES ARE READILY AVAILABLE AT THE MAIN BRANCH OF THE BUFFALO LIBRARY IN THE REFERENCE SECTION WHICH IS IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE BLACK NEIGHBORHOODS. ADDITIONALLY, THE ADDRESSEES' ADDRESSES ARE ALMOST IDENTICAL IN MOST INSTANCES.

IN CONCLUSION, IT APPEARS ALL OF ADDRESSEES ARE RANDOMLY SELECTED PUBLIC OFFICIALS THAT APPEAR IN ANY PUBLIC-READY REFERENCE. THE WHITE ADDRESSORS ARE TAKEN FROM THE TELEPHONE BOOK AT RANDOM AND HAVE NO KNOWLEDGE OF EACH OTHER. THE BLACK ADDRESSORS ARE NOT AVAILABLE IN THE TELEPHONE DIRECTORY, LIVE IN THE SAME NEIGHBORHOOD AREAS, AND HAVE SOME KNOWLEDGE OF EACH OTHER. IT IS, THEREFORE, FELT BY THE

BUFFALO DIVISION AT THIS TIME, THAT THE UNSUB IS IN ALL PROBABILITY BLACK AND HAS SOME AFFILIATION WITH THE BLACK ADDRESSORS WITH THE ONE NOTED EXCEPTION OF JUDGE TRAMMELL. INVESTIGATION IS, THEREFORE, BEING PURSUED ALONG THESE LINES.

THE NAMES OF TWO POSSIBLE SUSPECTS IN THIS REGARD HAVE SURFACED.

ONE [REDACTED] BLACK MALE, [REDACTED] IS A BUS BOY EMPLOYED AT THE RAMADA INN, LANCASTER, NEW YORK. HIS [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] HAS STATED THAT SHE HAS HAD WORK-RELATED PROBLEMS IN THE PAST WITH [REDACTED] AND THERE IS BAD BLOOD BETWEEN THEM AND HE COULD LOGICALLY BE A SUSPECT.

A SECOND SUSPECT WHICH HAS SURFACED THROUGH INVESTIGATION IS A

[REDACTED] RESIDING AT [REDACTED] [REDACTED] B. APPROX [REDACTED] KNOWN AS [REDACTED] (PH). THIS INDIVIDUAL ALSO RESIDES IN THE TOWN GARDEN APARTMENTS AND HAS BEEN DESCRIBED THROUGH NEIGHBORHOOD INVESTIGATION AS A VOCAL, OUT-SPOKEN CRITIC, NOT ONLY OF BOTH WHITE AND BLACK POLITICIANS, BUT OF THE AMERICAN SYSTEM OF GOVERNMENT IN GENERAL. HE HAS BEEN DESCRIBED AS A FOLLOWER OF MUSLIM LEADER [REDACTED] BUFFALO DIVISION IS PURSUING THIS FACET OF THE INVESTIGATION FURTHER.

On 3/7/85, Senior Investigator [redacted] New York State Police (NYSP), Protective Services, detail, Governor's Mansion, Albany, New York, made available an original of a letter and envelope mailed from Buffalo, New York, on 2/26/85, threatening the life of New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO. Senior Investigator [redacted] advised that this letter was addressed to "MARIO M. CUOMO, State Capital, Albany, New York, 12224," with a return address of "WILBUR B. TRAMMEL, City Court, Buffalo, New York". [redacted] further stated that this letter was originally received by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital and turned over to him on 3/4/85. Investigator [redacted] allowed that both the letter and the envelope would have been routinely handled by several persons before it came into his possession.
