

Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory, Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section, is the original letter and envelope sent to New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO, threatening his life. One copy of each of the above is enclosed for Buffalo.

On 3/7/85, Senior Investigator

New York State Police (NYSP), Protective Services, detail,
Governor's Mansion, Albany, New York, made available an
original of a letter and envelope mailed from Buffalo,
New York, on 2/26/85, threatening the life of New York
State Governor MARIO CUOMO. Senior Investigator
advised that this letter was addressed to "MARIO M. CUOMO,
State Capital, Albany, New York, 12224," with a return
address of "WILBUR B. TRAMMEL, City Court, Buffalo, New
York".

further stated that this letter was originally
received by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital
and turned over to him on 3/4/85. Investigator
allowed that both the letter and the envelope would have
been routinely handled by several persons before it came
into his possession.

other threatening letters containing the exact text of the one enclosed had been received previously by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital and have since been forwarded to the Buffalo Office of the FBI. These included letters to New York State Assemblyman DENNIS GORSKI; New York State Comptroller, EDWARD NED REGAN, and New York State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS. The enclosed original extortion letter should be forwarded to Buffalo Division as office of origin in this matter upon completion of FBI Laboratory examinations.

Since no further active investigation remains at Albany, this matter is referred upon completion to Buffalo.

FBI Laboratory Division:

Laboratory please note that the evidence submitted herein should be handled in such a manner as to preserve any Latent Fingerprints for subsequent examination by the Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section.

Document Section:

Is requested to compare the text and type of the enclosed letter to that of those submitted by Buffalo Division in this case. Document Section is also requested to conduct whatever other examinations it deems appropriate.

FBI IDENTIFICATION DIVISION-LATENT FINGERPRINT SECTION:

The Latent Fingerprint Section is requested to process the enclosed letter for Latent Fingerprints. Any Latent Fingerprints developed should be compared with any fingerprints which might be developed on similar letters in this case submitted by the Buffalo Division.

According to the attached Buffalo teletype,
seven additional individuals were mailed copies
of the same threatening letters which were
originally sent to U.S. Supreme Court Justices
Lewis F. Powell, Jr. and Harry A. Blackmun and
U. S. Senator Alfonse D'Amato. The new
recipients include the Mayor of Buffalo, the
Governor, Attorney General and Comptroller of
New York State, two New York State Assemblymen

and one 60-year-old waitress. Buffalo has interviewed the return addressees in an effort to determine who may have authored the original letter. Thus far, there is no known common

Buffalo is aggressively pursuing this investigation and has enlisted the cooperation of the U. S. Postal Service in an effort to locate the individual responsible for these threatening letters. At this time there is nothing to indicate that the person responsible for these letters was involved in the shooting at Supreme Court Justice Blackmun's residence on 2/28/85.

Result of examination:

It was determined the photocopied messages, designated Qc8, Qc10, Qc12, Qc14, Qc16, Qc18, Qc20 and Qc21 originated from the same source as previous questioned specimens, an example being Qc2.

The typewriting appearing on specimens Q7 through Qc14, Qc16 and Qc18 through Qc22 closely resembles the Laboratory standards for an IBM Prestige elite typewriter having a horizontal spacing of 12 letters per inch.

The typewriting appearing on specimen Q15 closely resembles the Laboratory standards for a Prestige IBM pica typewriter having a horizontal spacing of 10 letters per inch.

Q17 closely resembles the Laboratory standards for an IBM Scribe typewriter having a horizontal spacing of 10 letters per inch.

No watermark or indented writing of value was observed on specimens Q7 through Qc22.

The submitted evidence was photographed and is being returned separately with the results of the requested latent fingerprint examinations.

Enclosed for the FBI Laboratory, Identification Division, Latent Fingerprint Section, is the original letter and envelope sent to New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO, threatening his life. One copy of each of the above is enclosed for Buffalo.

New York State Police (NYSP), Protective Services, detail, Governor's Mansion, Albany, New York, made available an original of a letter and envelope mailed from Buffalo, New York, on 2/26/85, threatening the life of New York State Governor MARIO CUOMO. Senior Investigator advised that this letter was addressed to "MARIO M. CUOMO, State Capital, Albany, New York, 12224," with a return address of "WILBUR B. TRAMMEL, City Court, Buffalo, New York".

Further stated that this letter was originally received by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital and turned over to him on 3/4/85. Investigator allowed that both the letter and the envelope would nave been routinely handled by several persons before it came into his possession.

Investigator further advised that several other threatening letters containing the exact text of the one enclosed had been received previously by the Correspondence Unit at the State Capital and have since been forwarded to the Buffalo Office of the FBI. These included letters to New York State Assemblyman DENNIS GORSKI; New York State Comptroller, EDWARD NED REGAN, and New York State Attorney General ROBERT ABRAMS. The enclosed original extortion letter should be forwarded to Buffalo Division as office of origin in this matter upon completion of FBI Laboratory examinations.

Since no further active investigation remains at Albany, this matter is referred upon completion to Buffalo.
